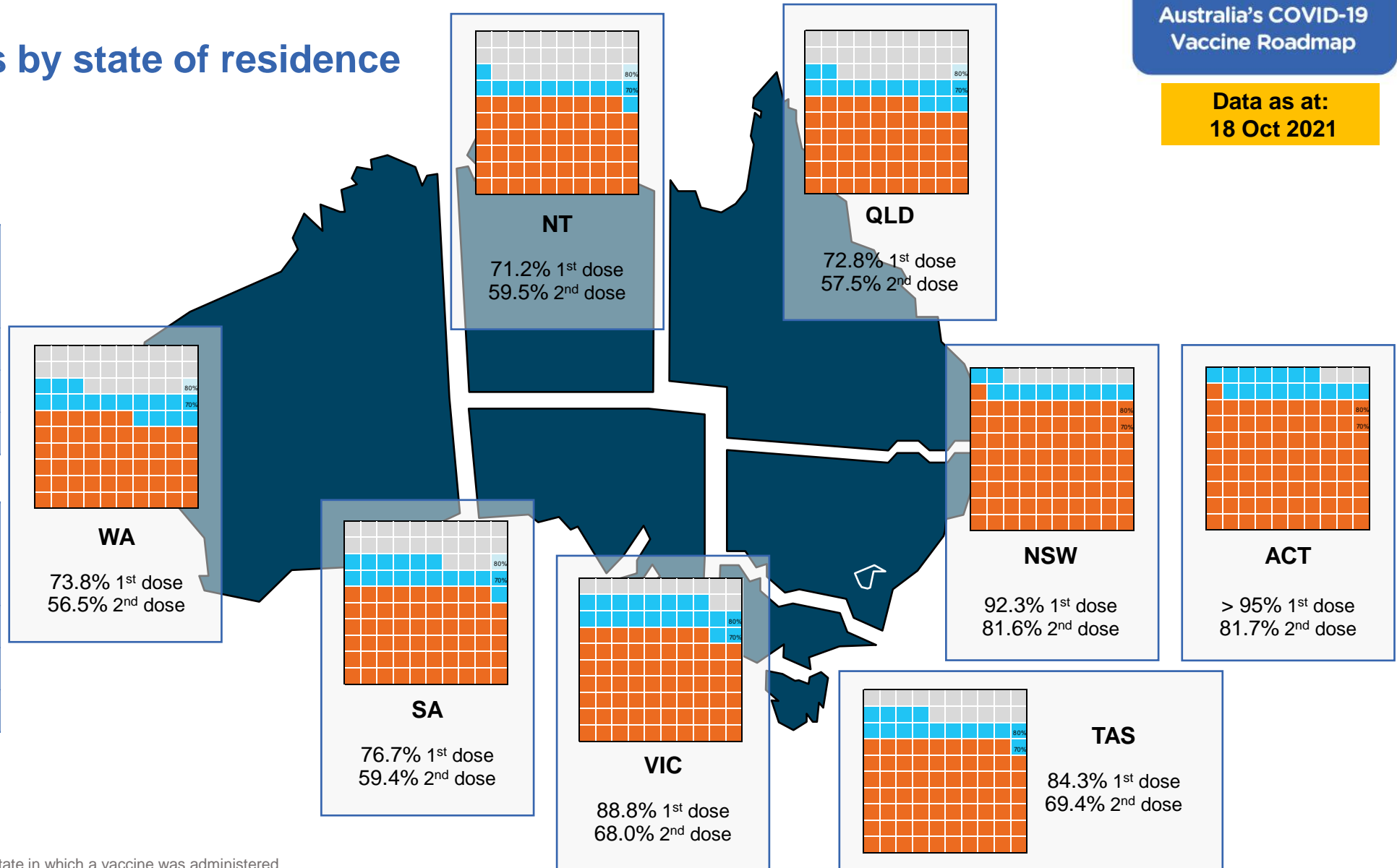

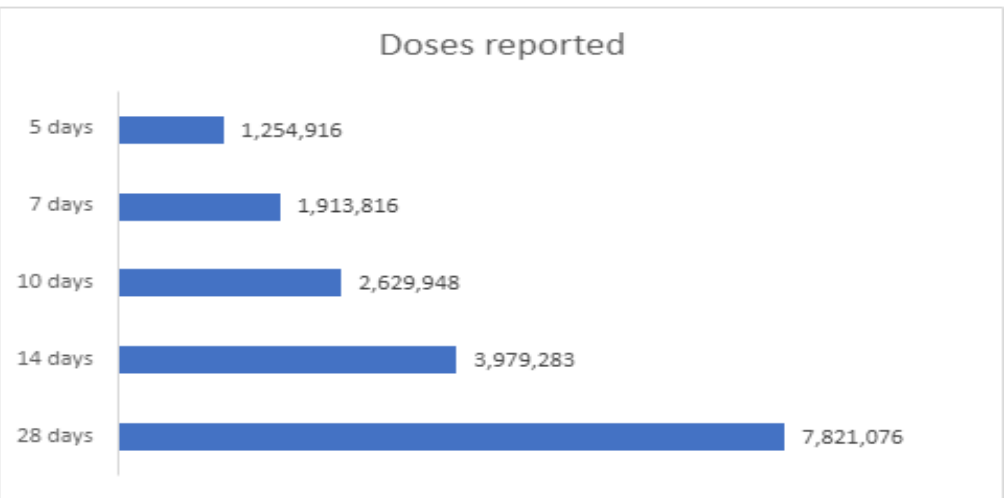

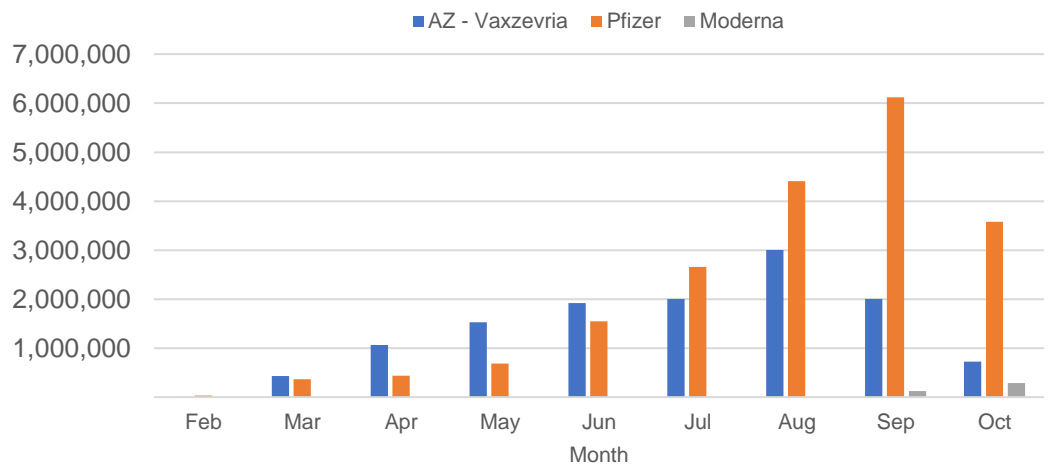

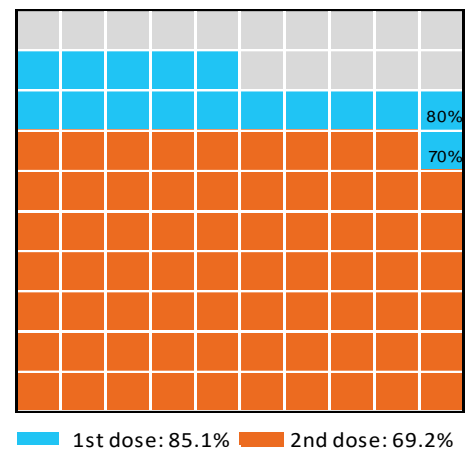

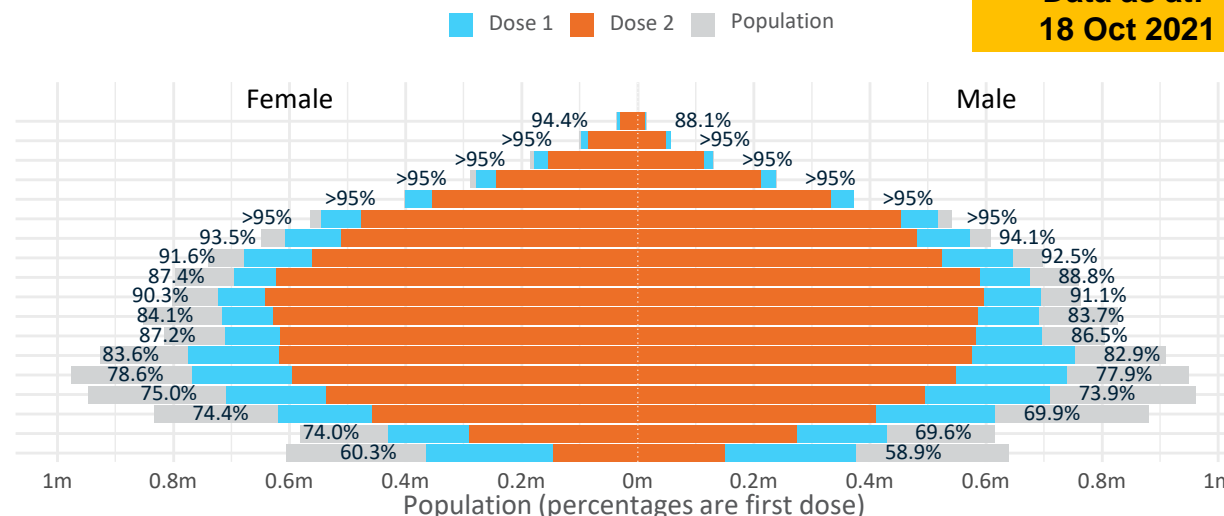

Cumulative total doses administered vs state populations*

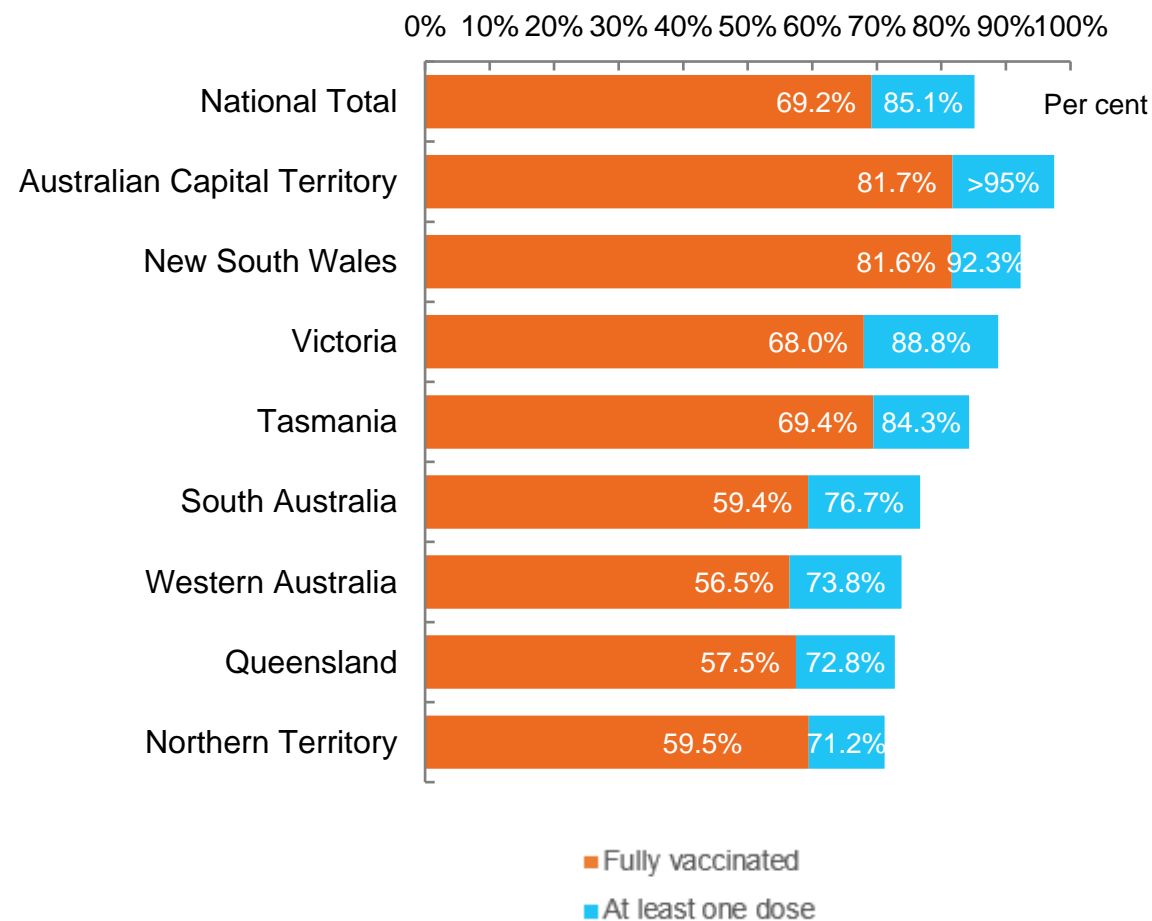

First and Second Doses by state of residence

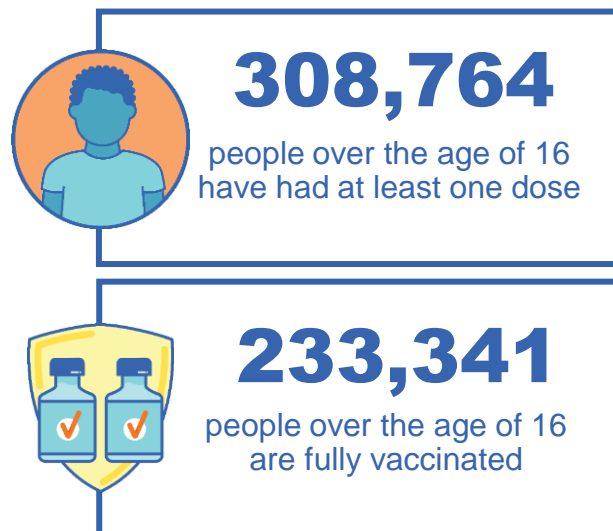

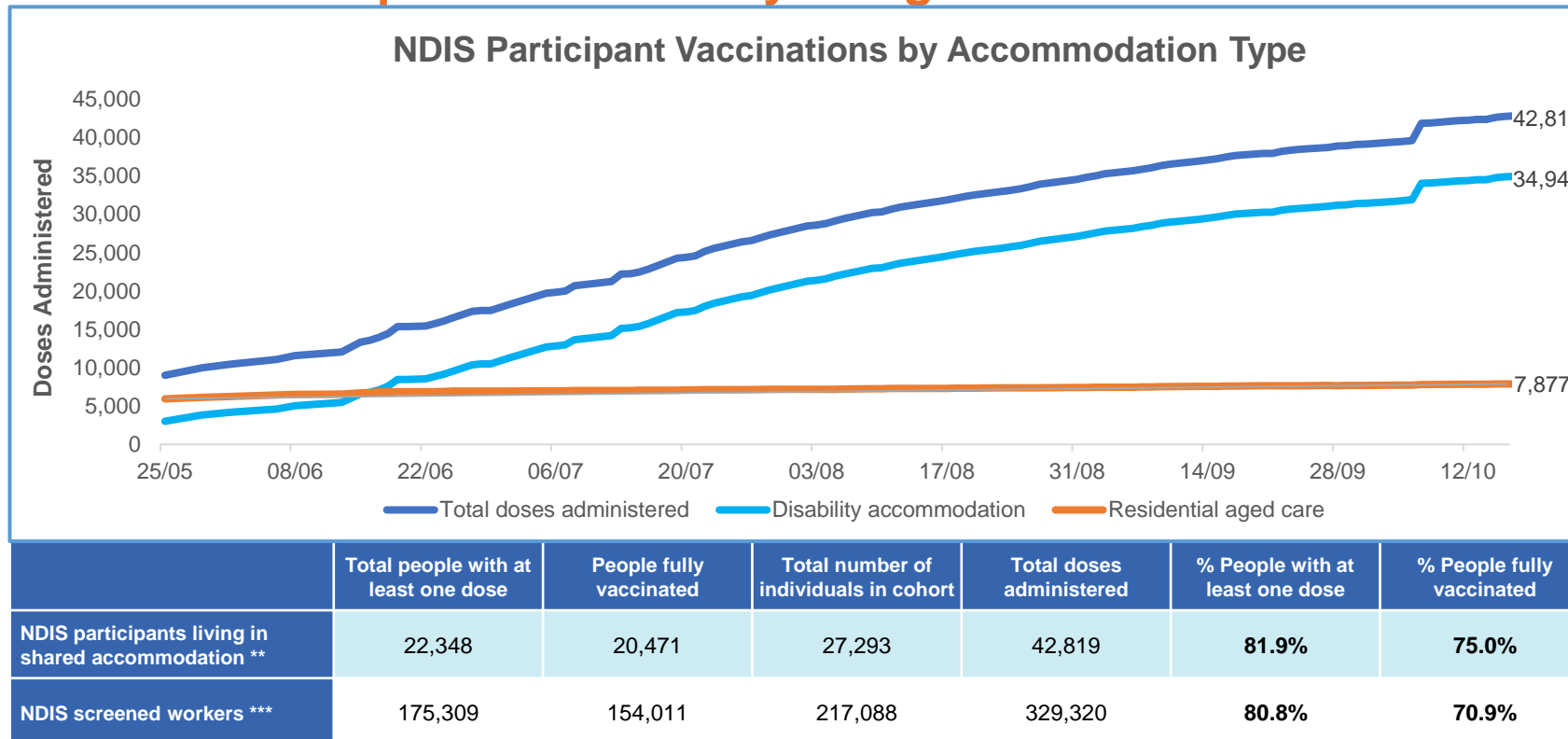

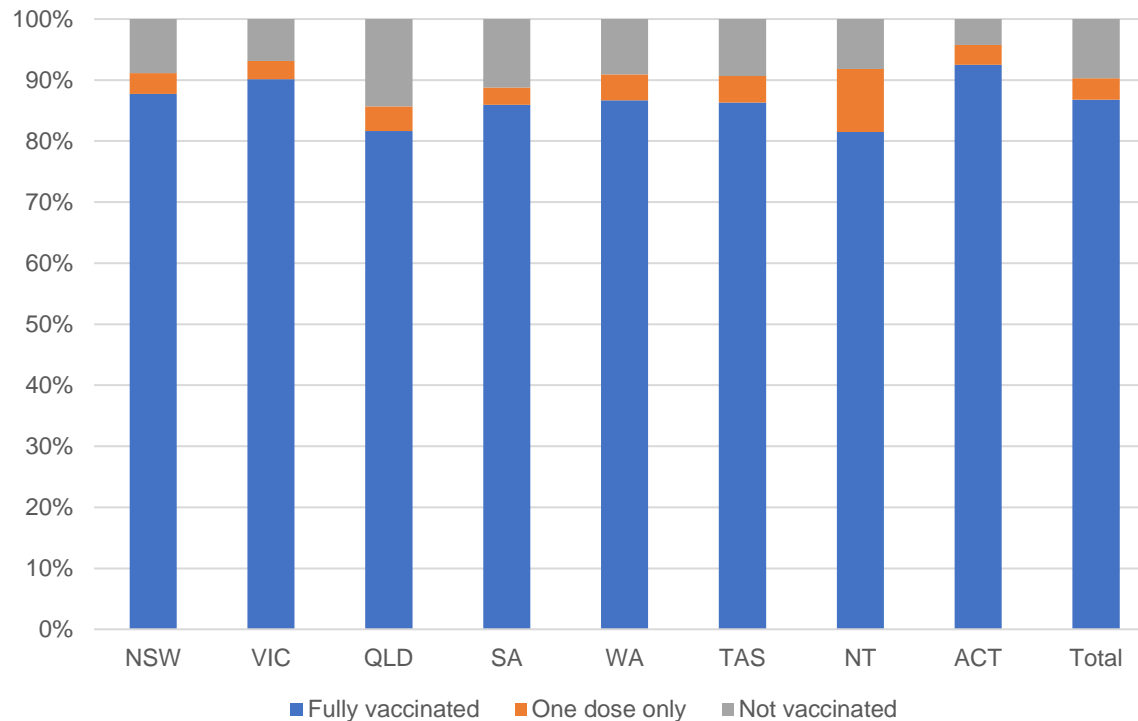

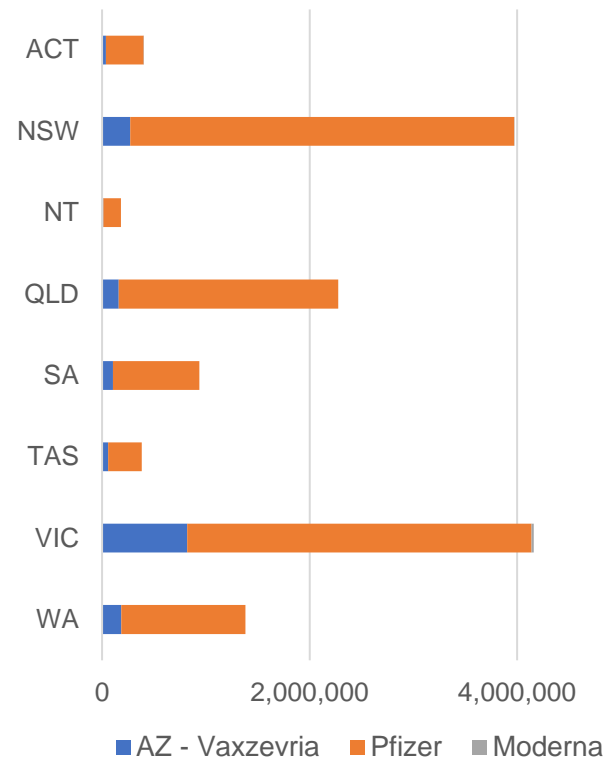

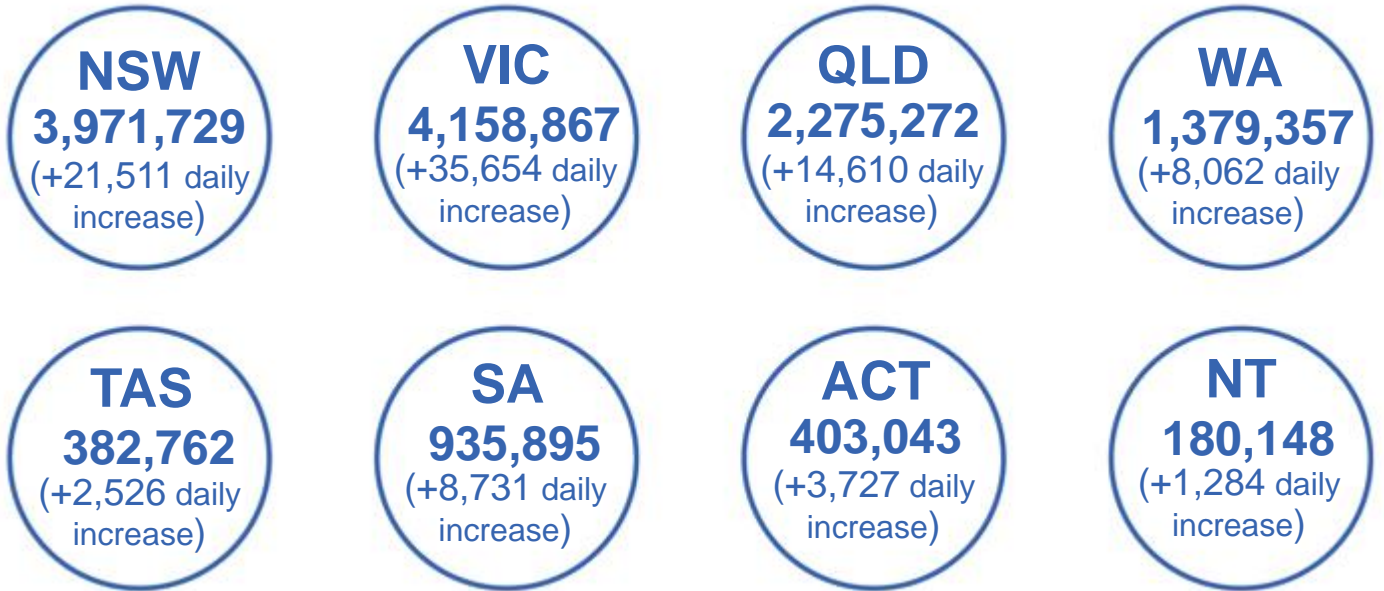

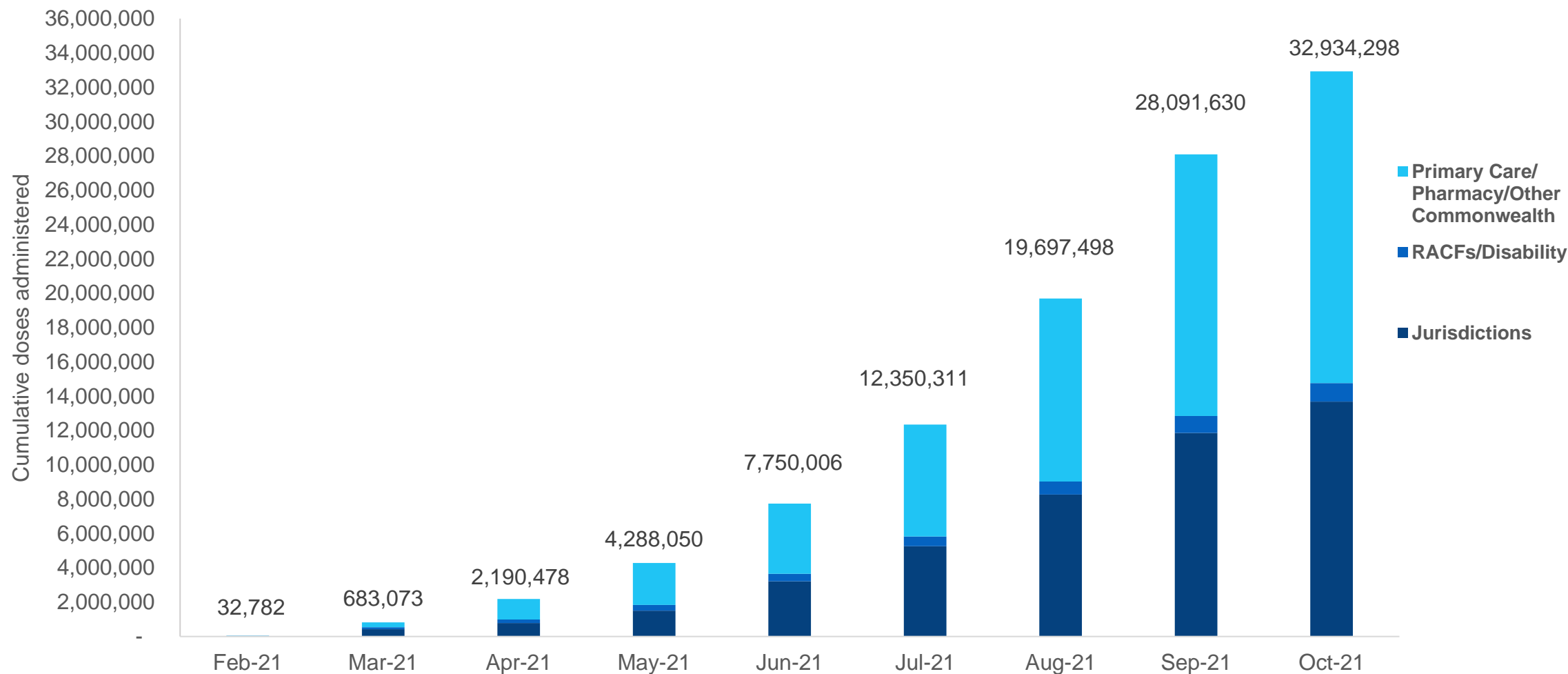

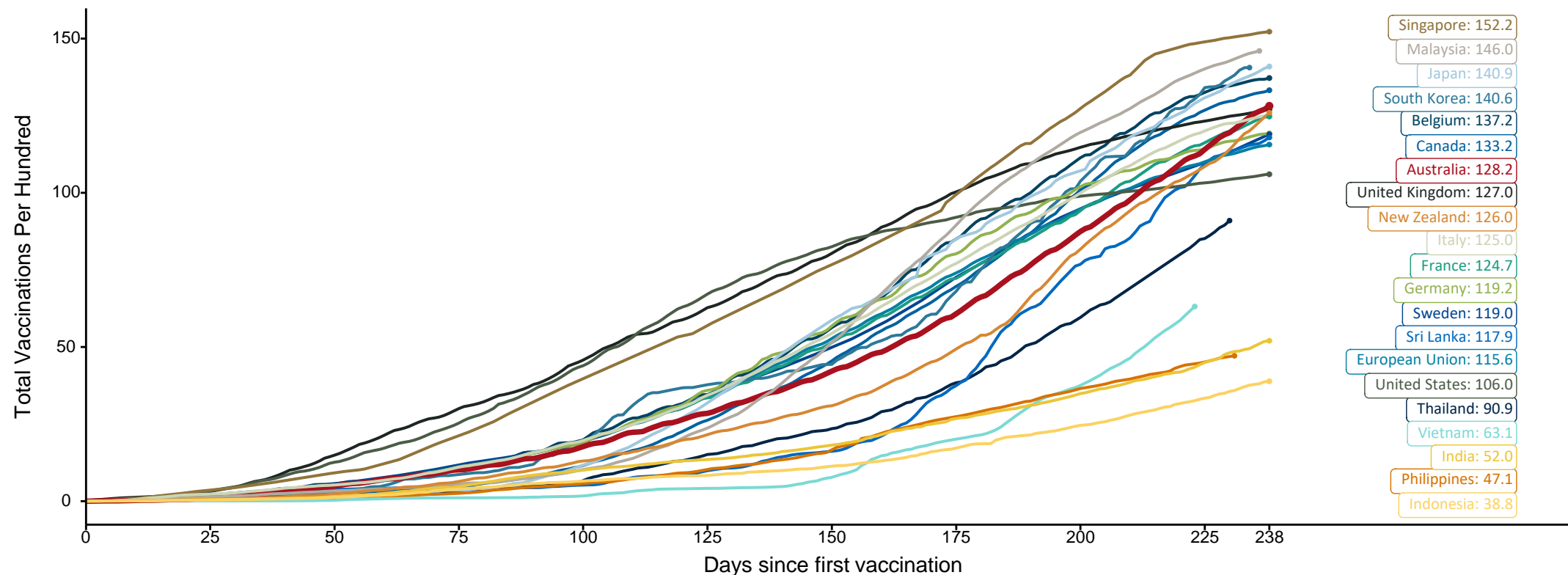

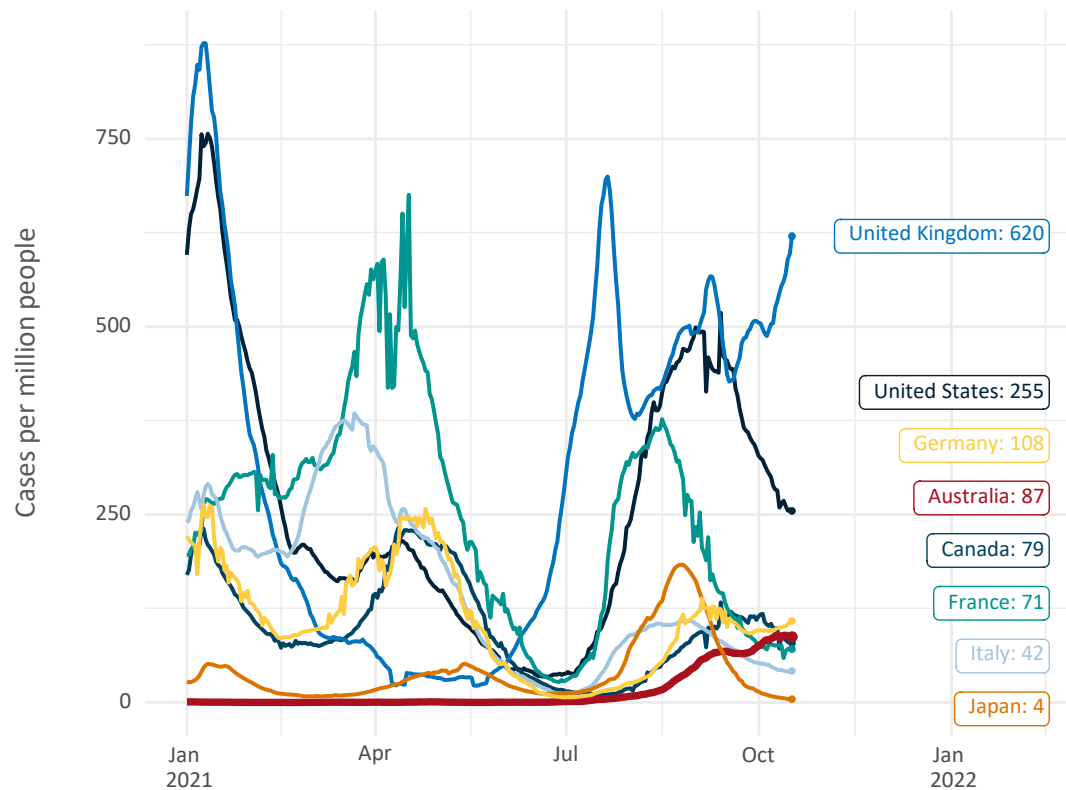

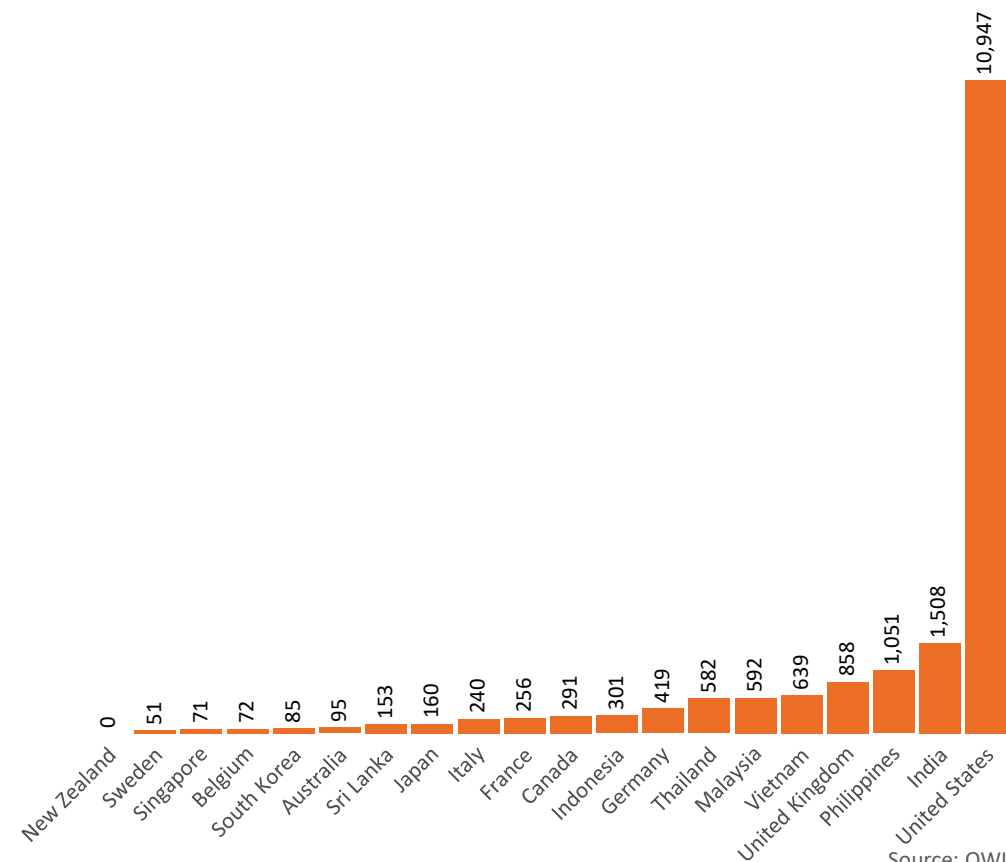

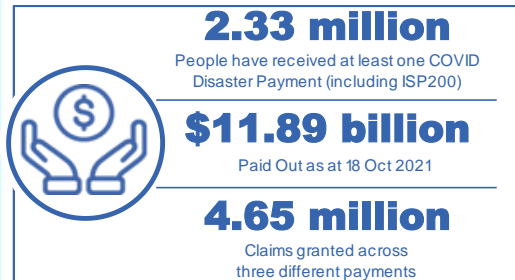
COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries

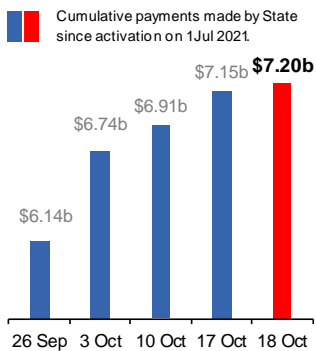

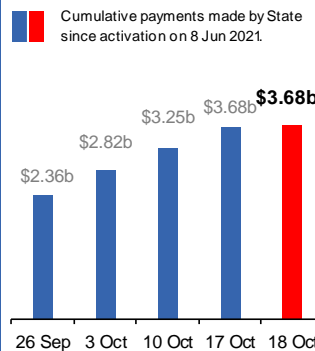

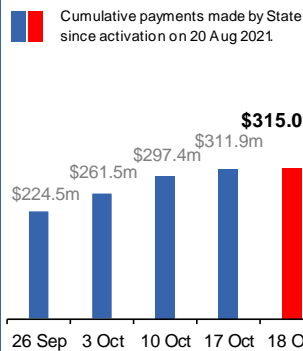

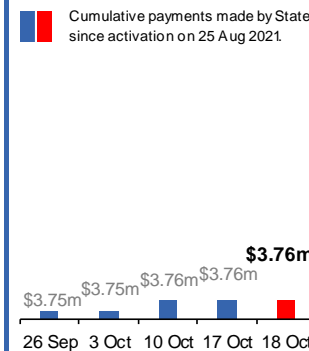

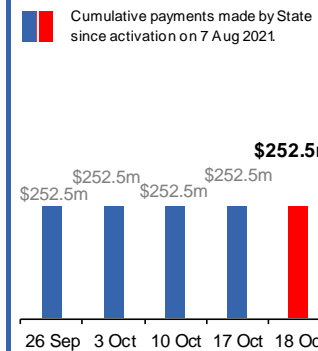
