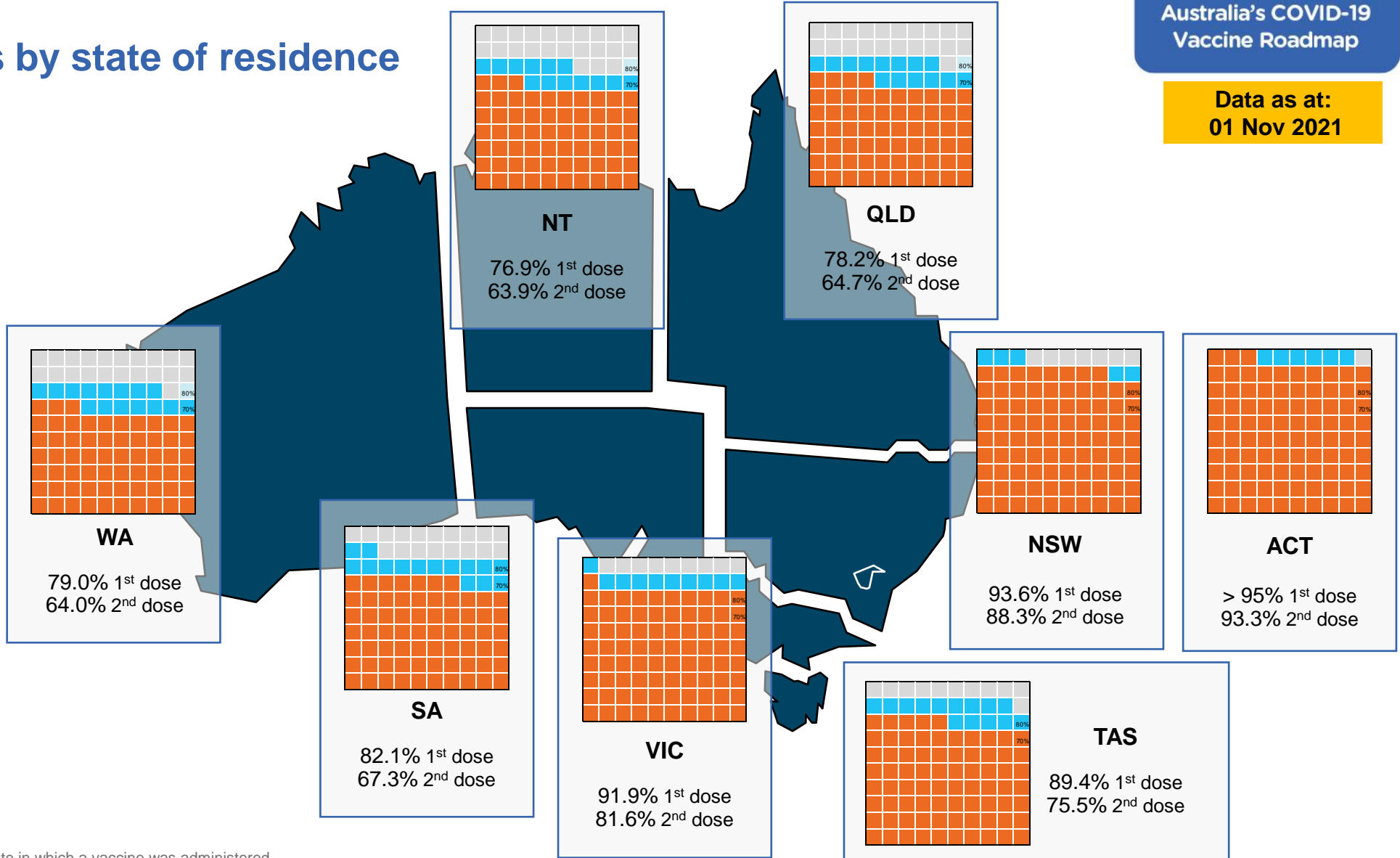

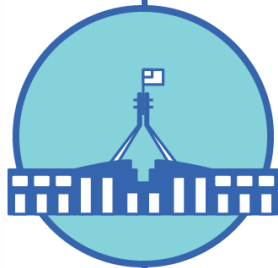

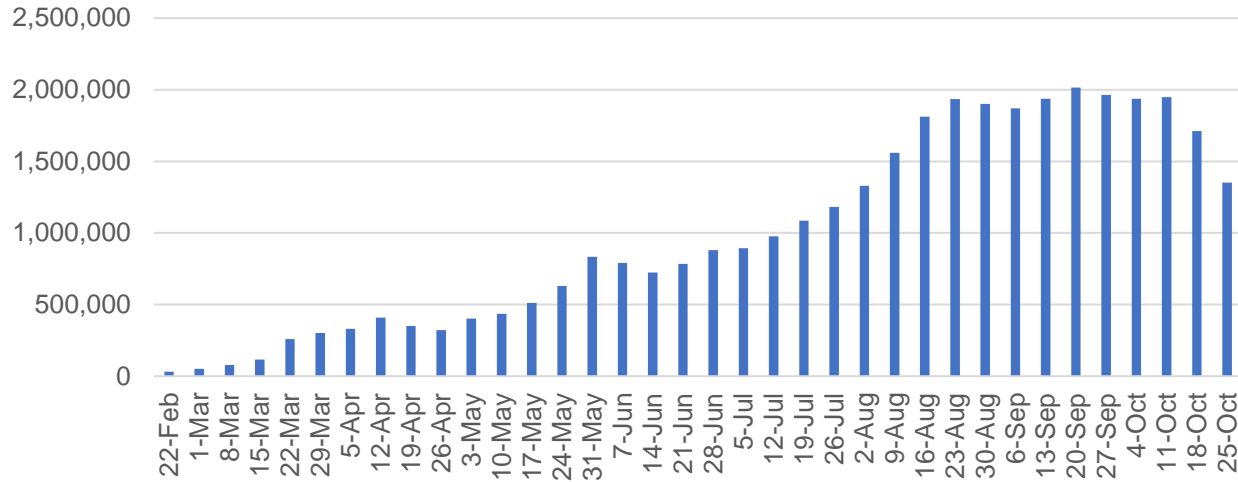

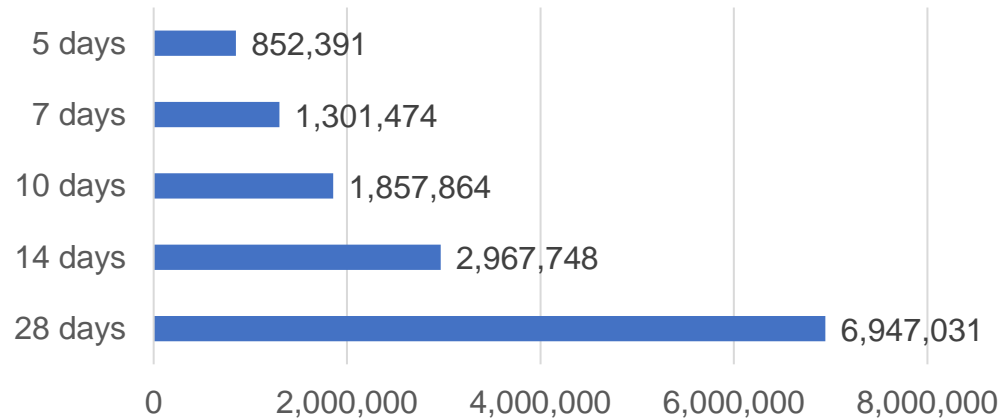

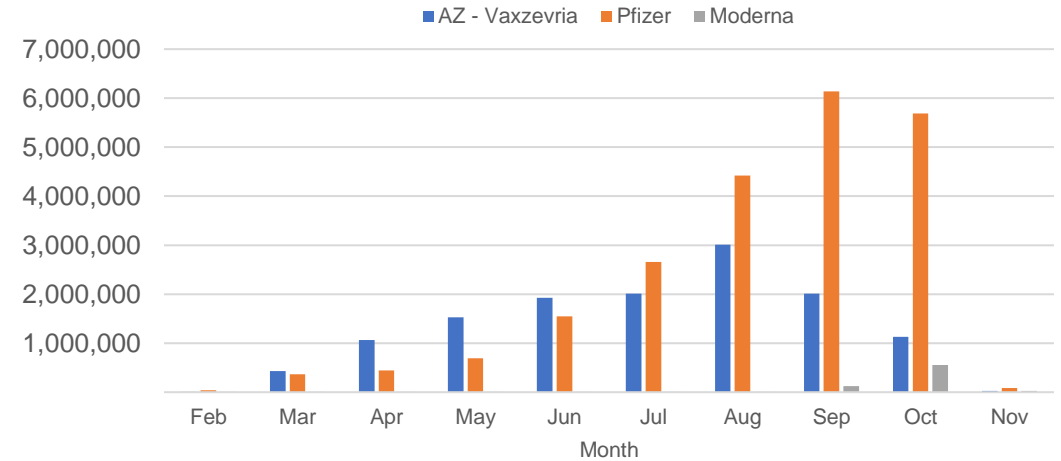

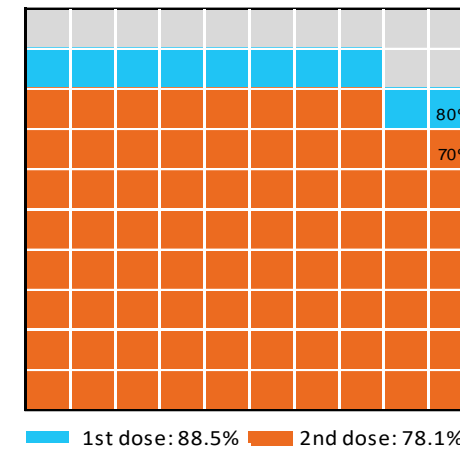

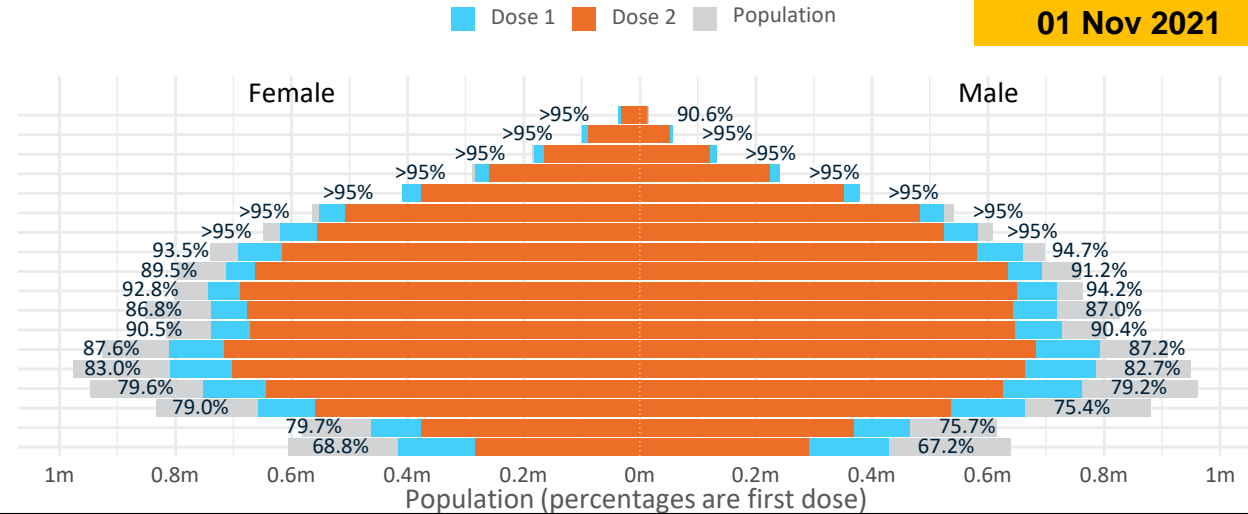

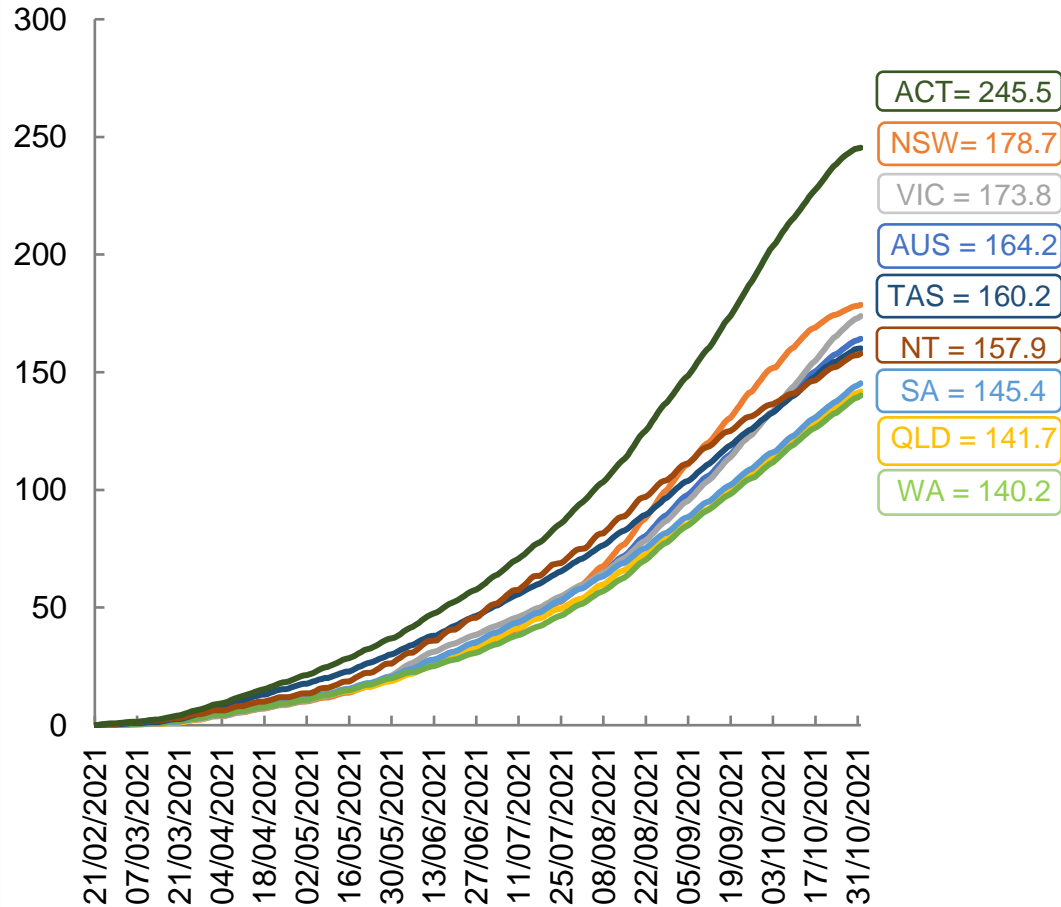

Vaccinations by location

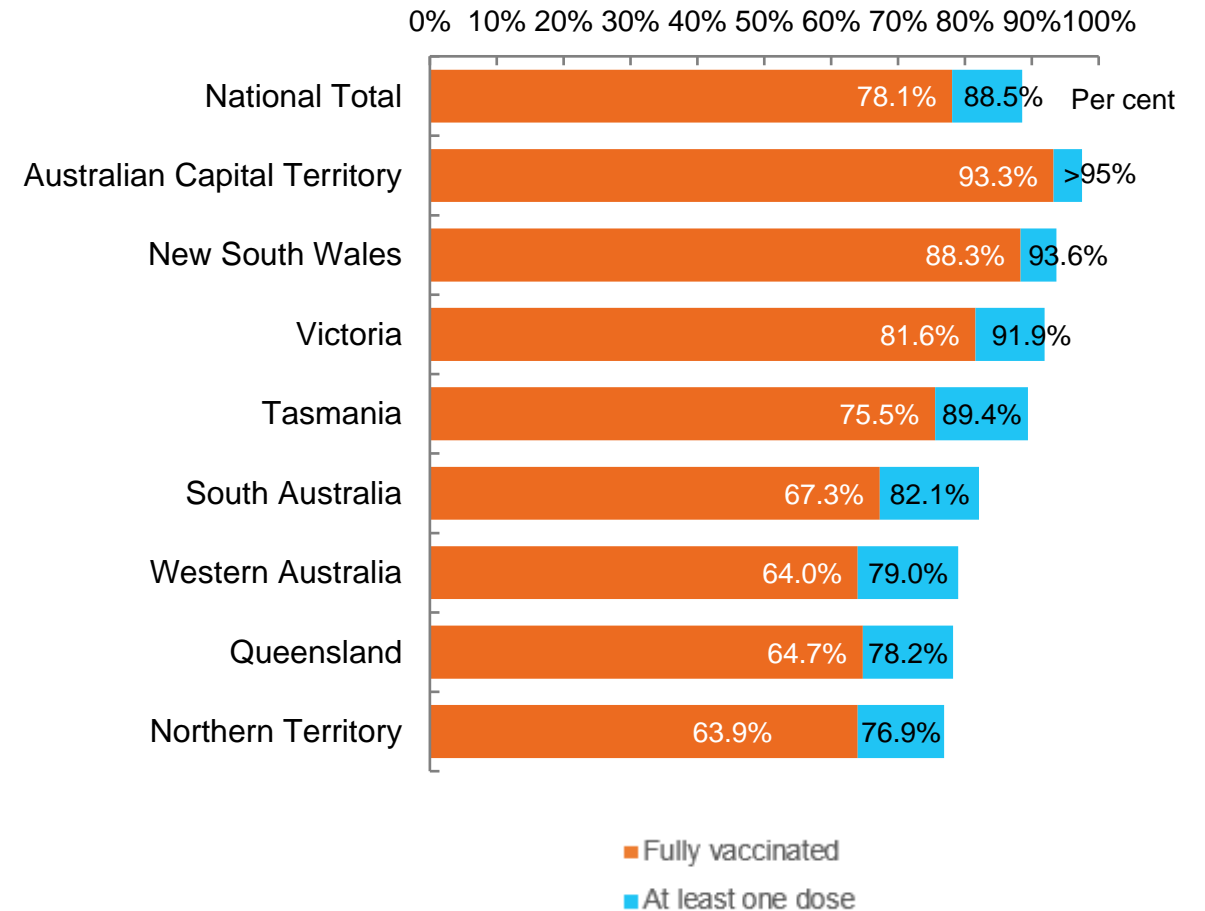

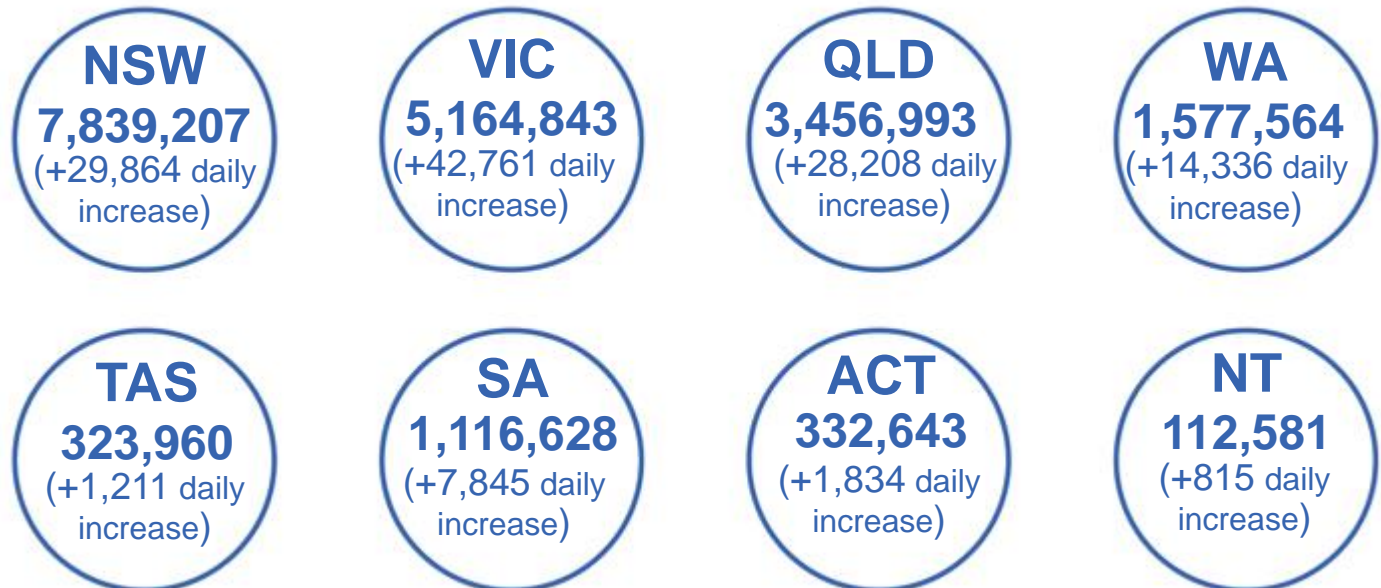

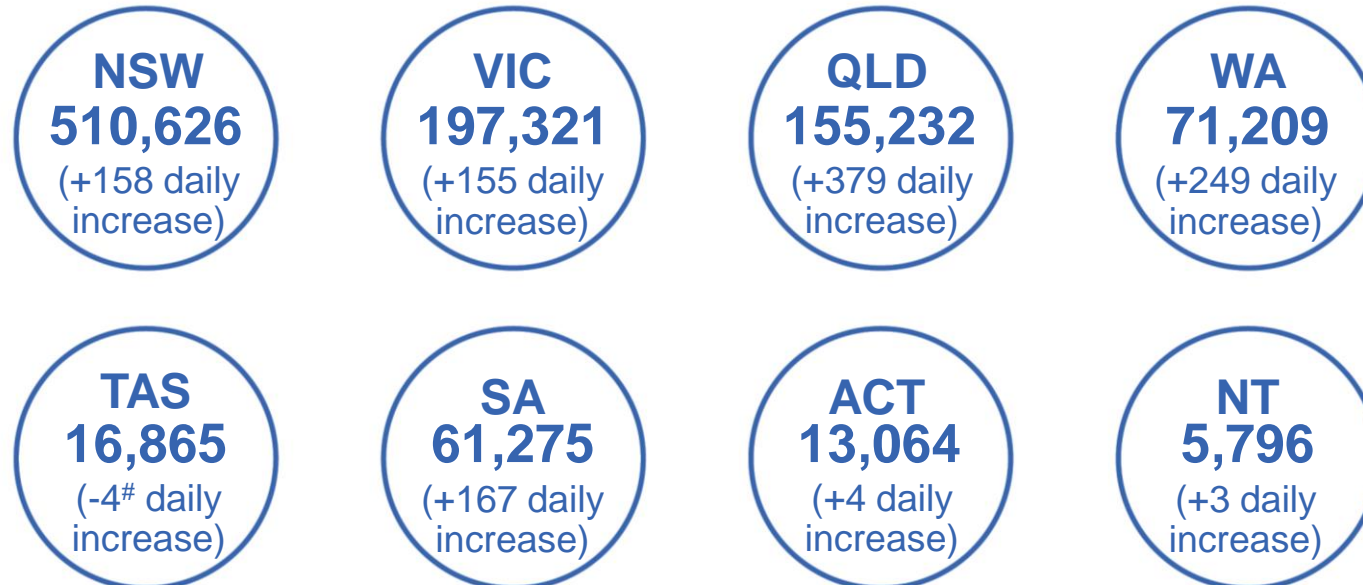

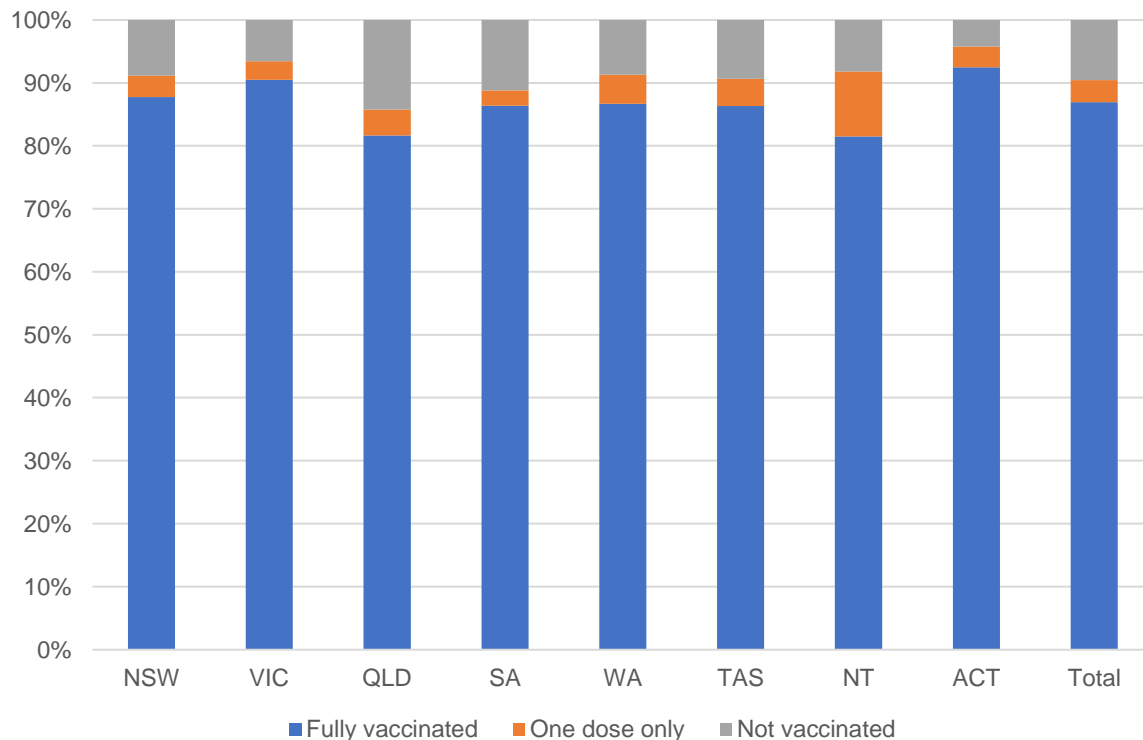

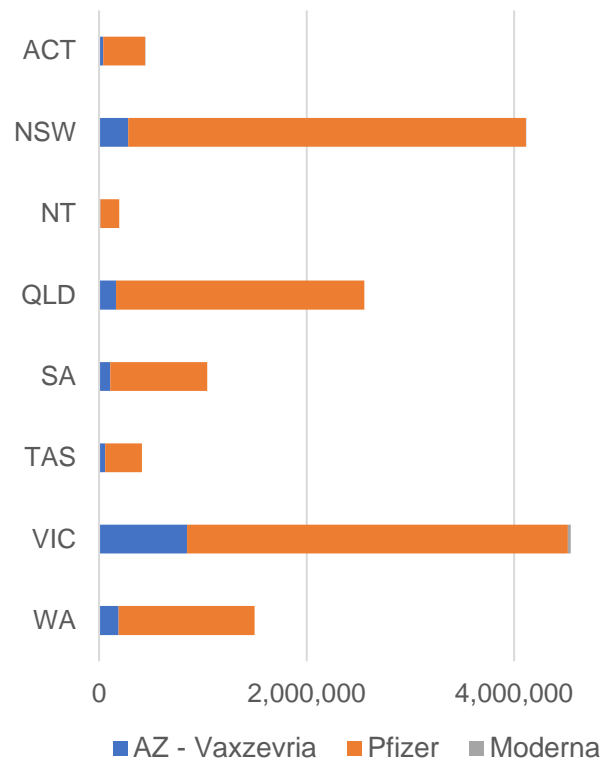

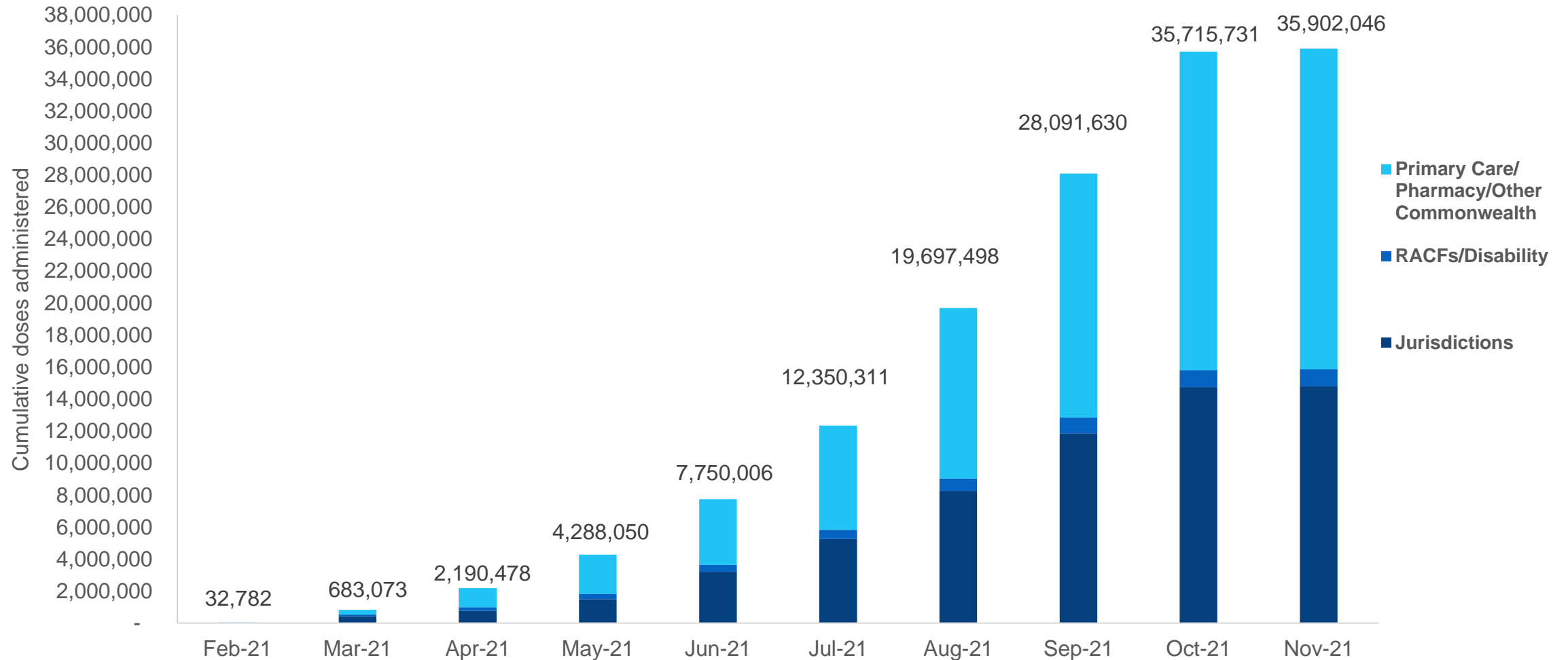

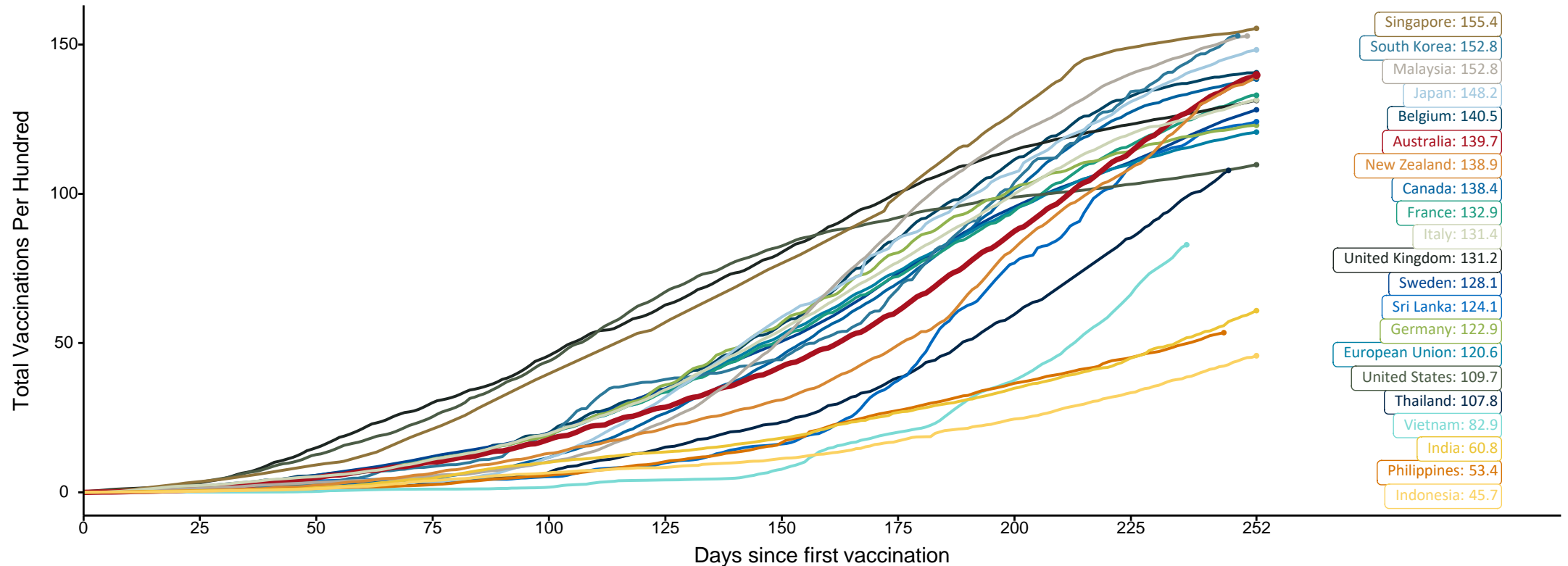

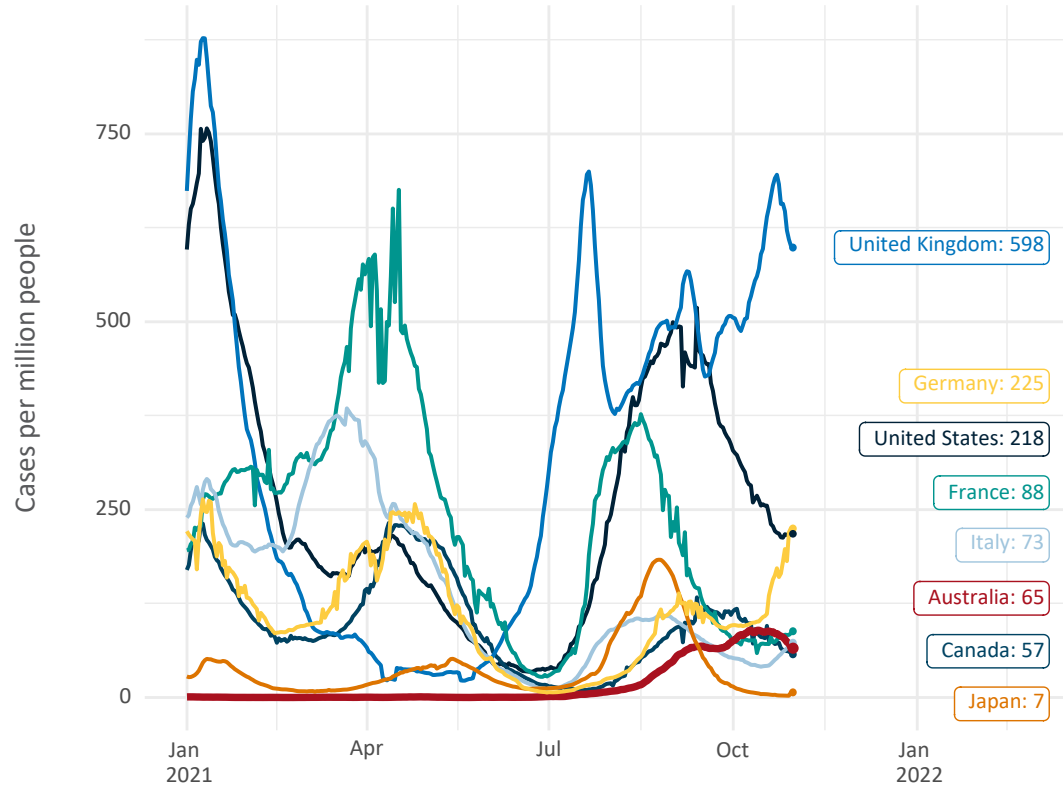

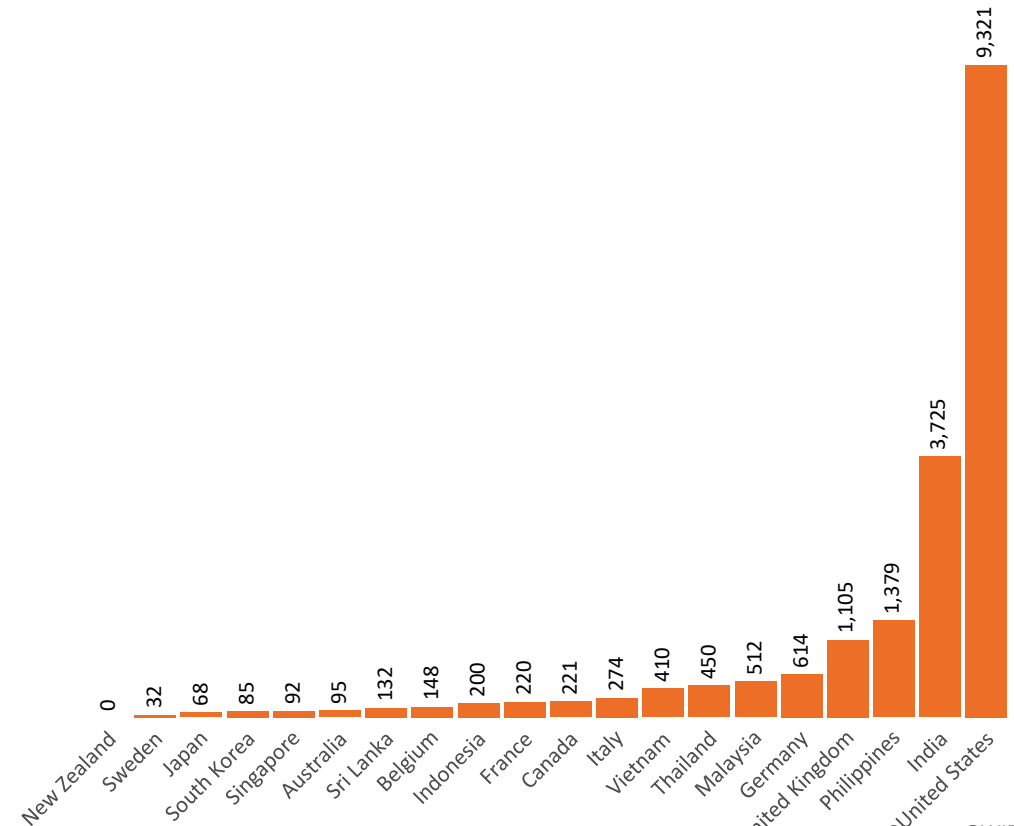


