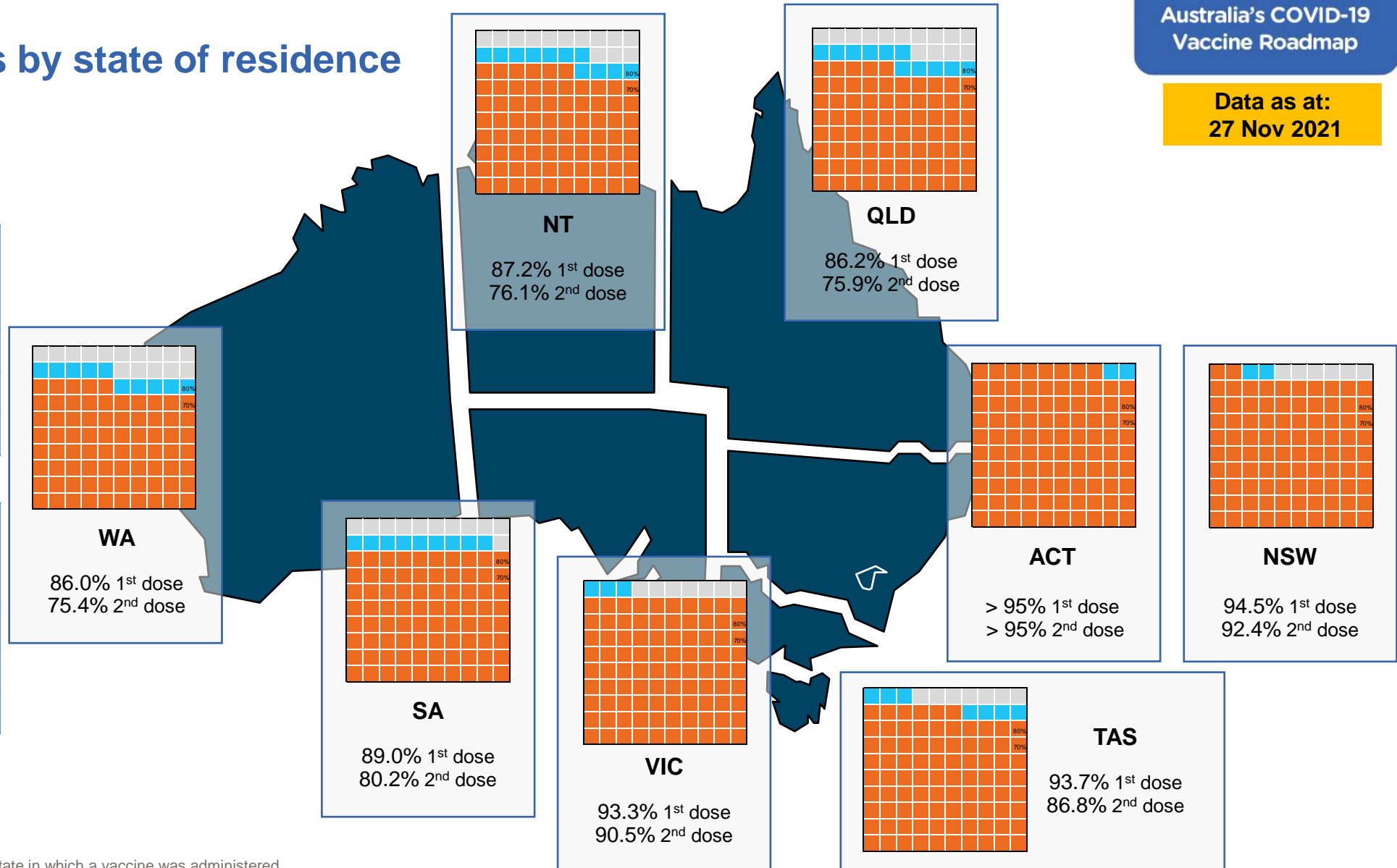

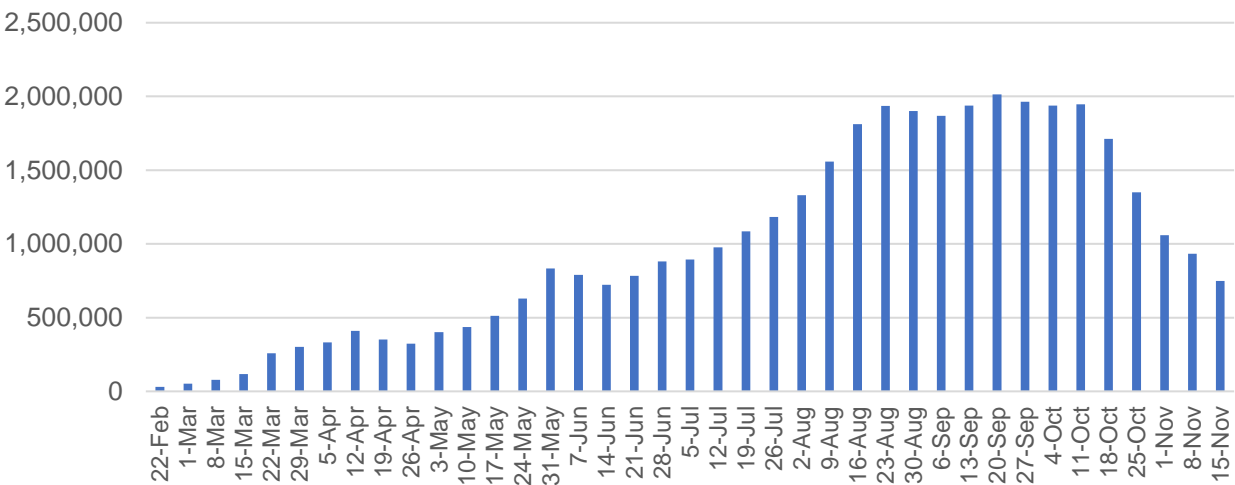

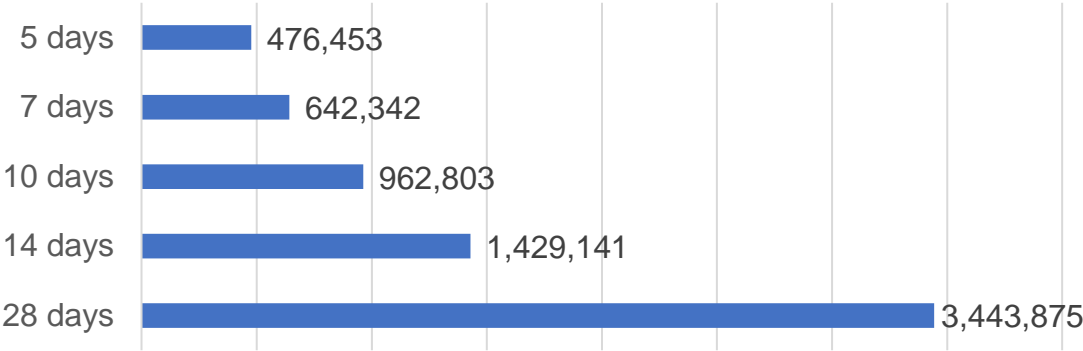

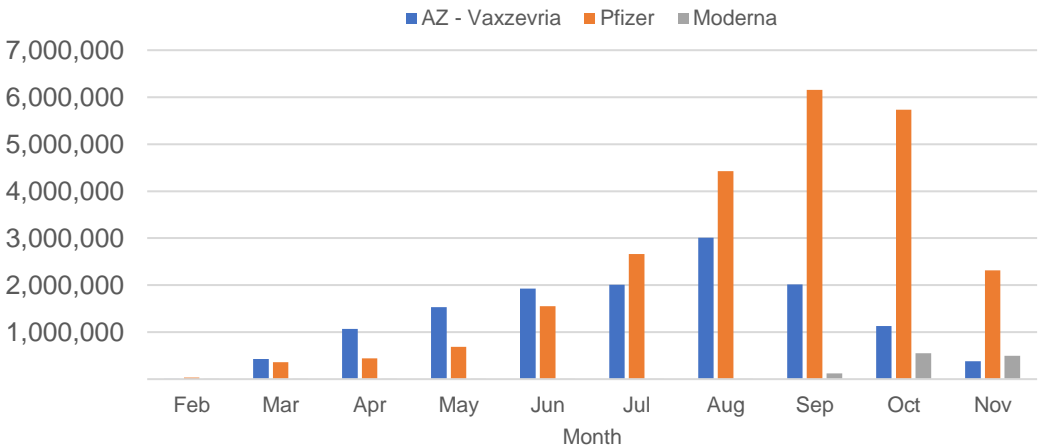
Doses Administered by Week



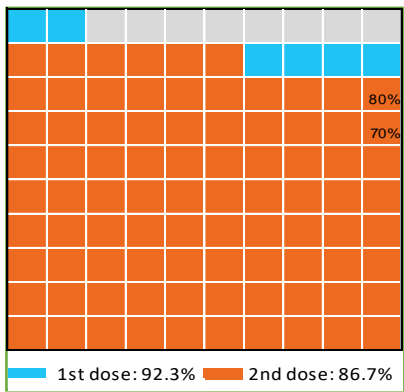
Doses Reported

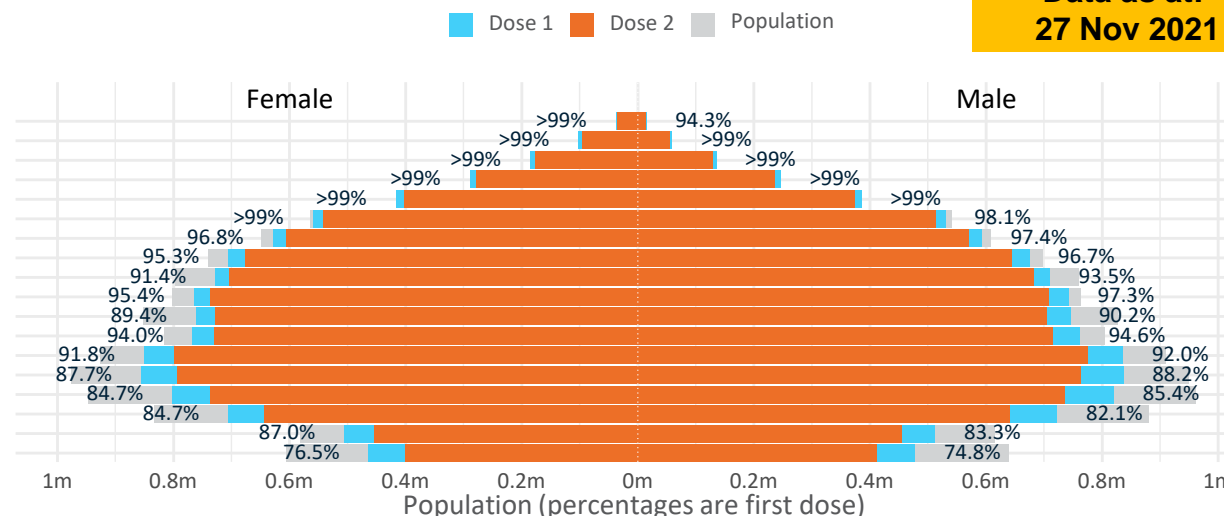

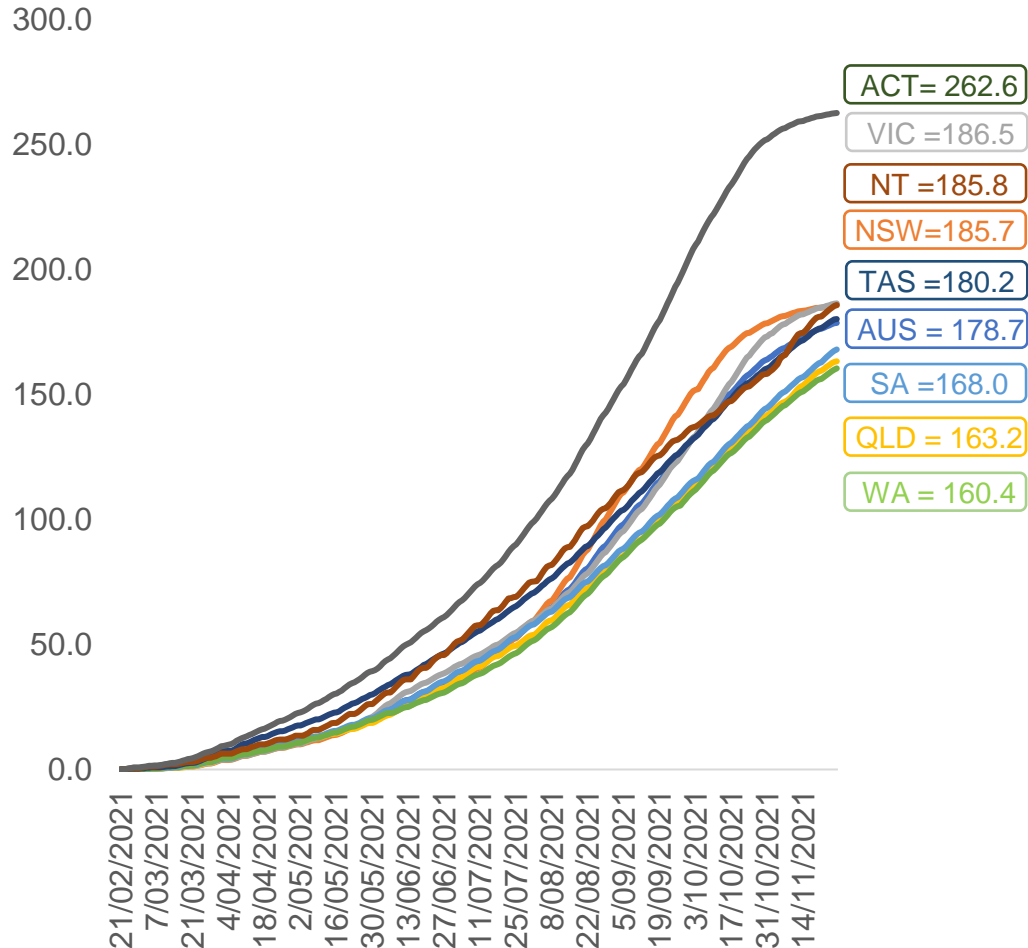

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations\*

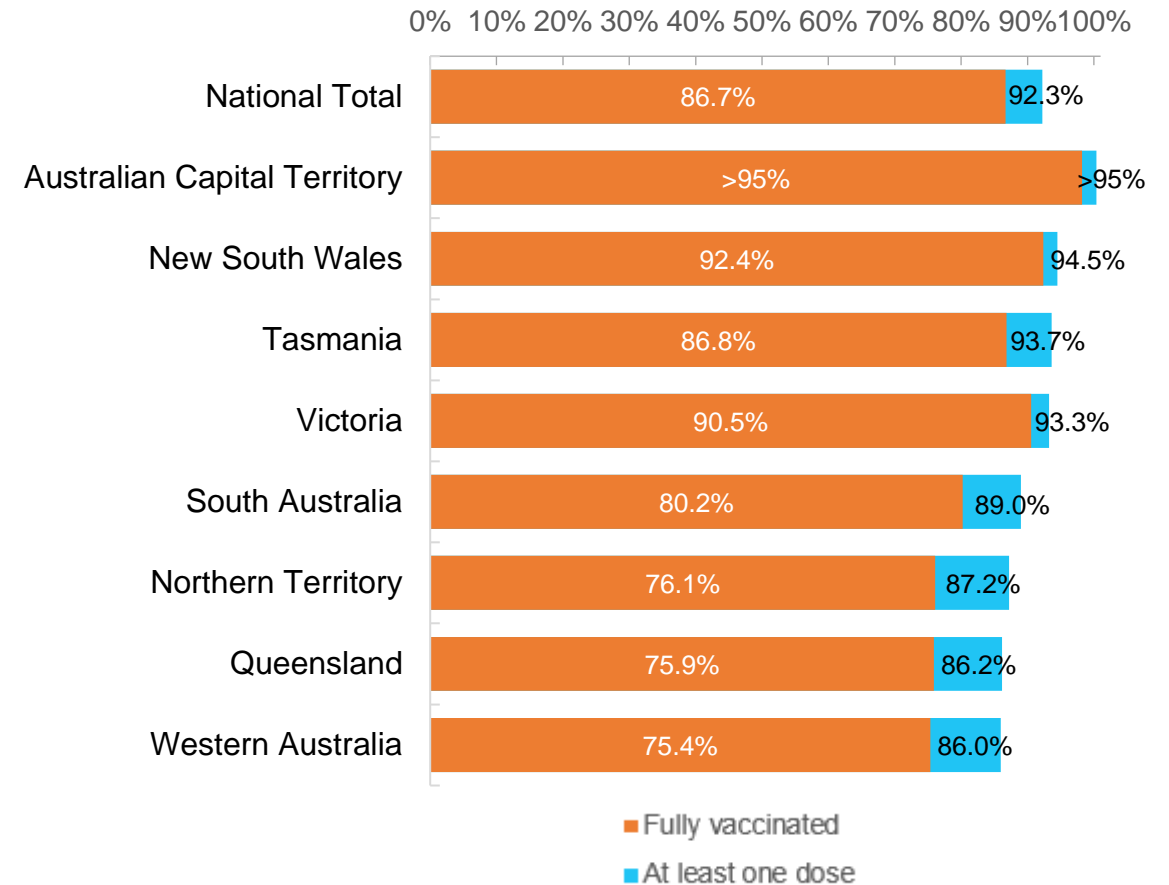

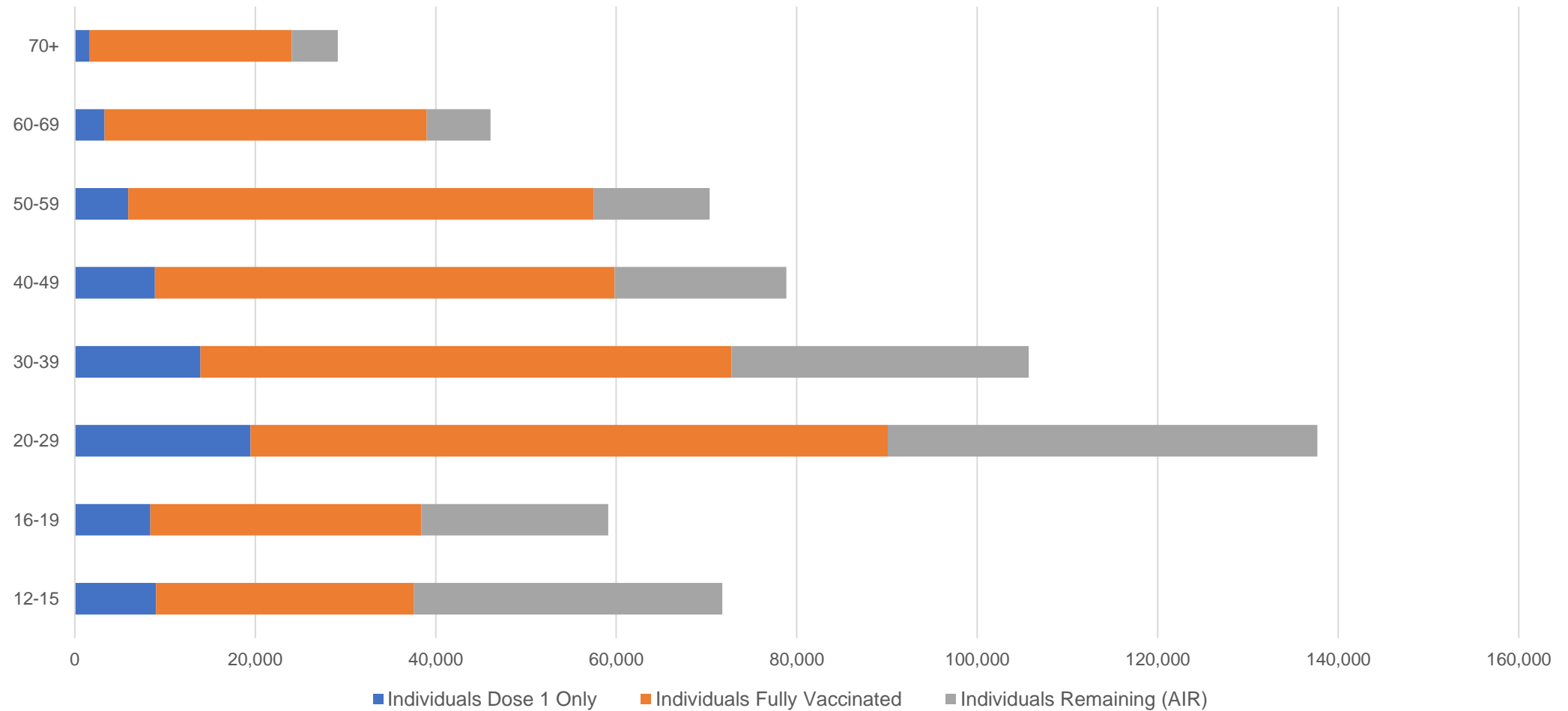

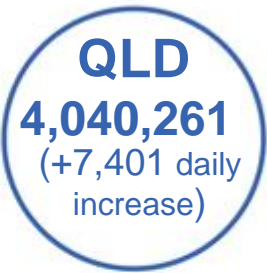

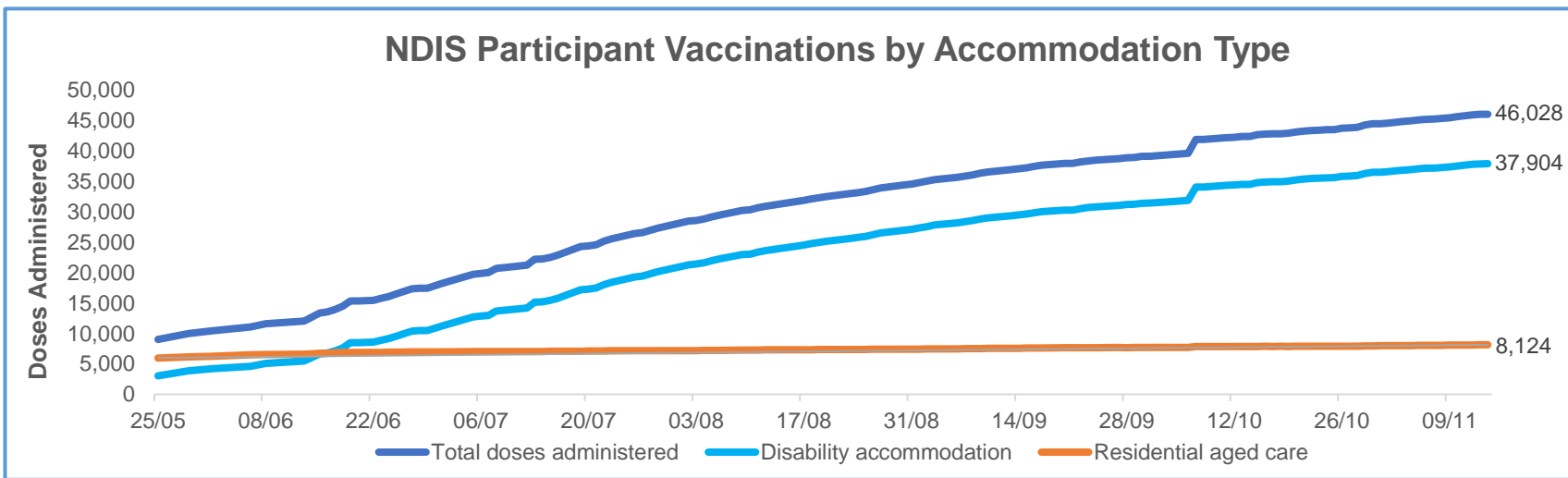

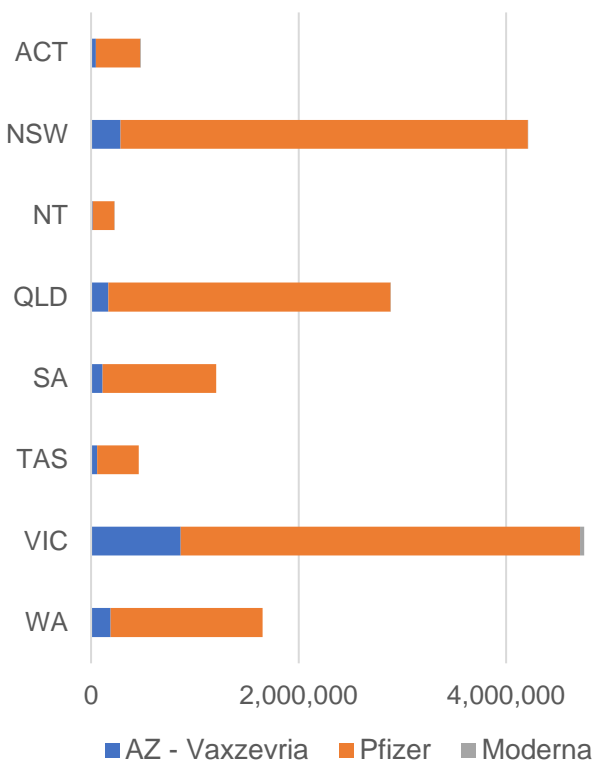

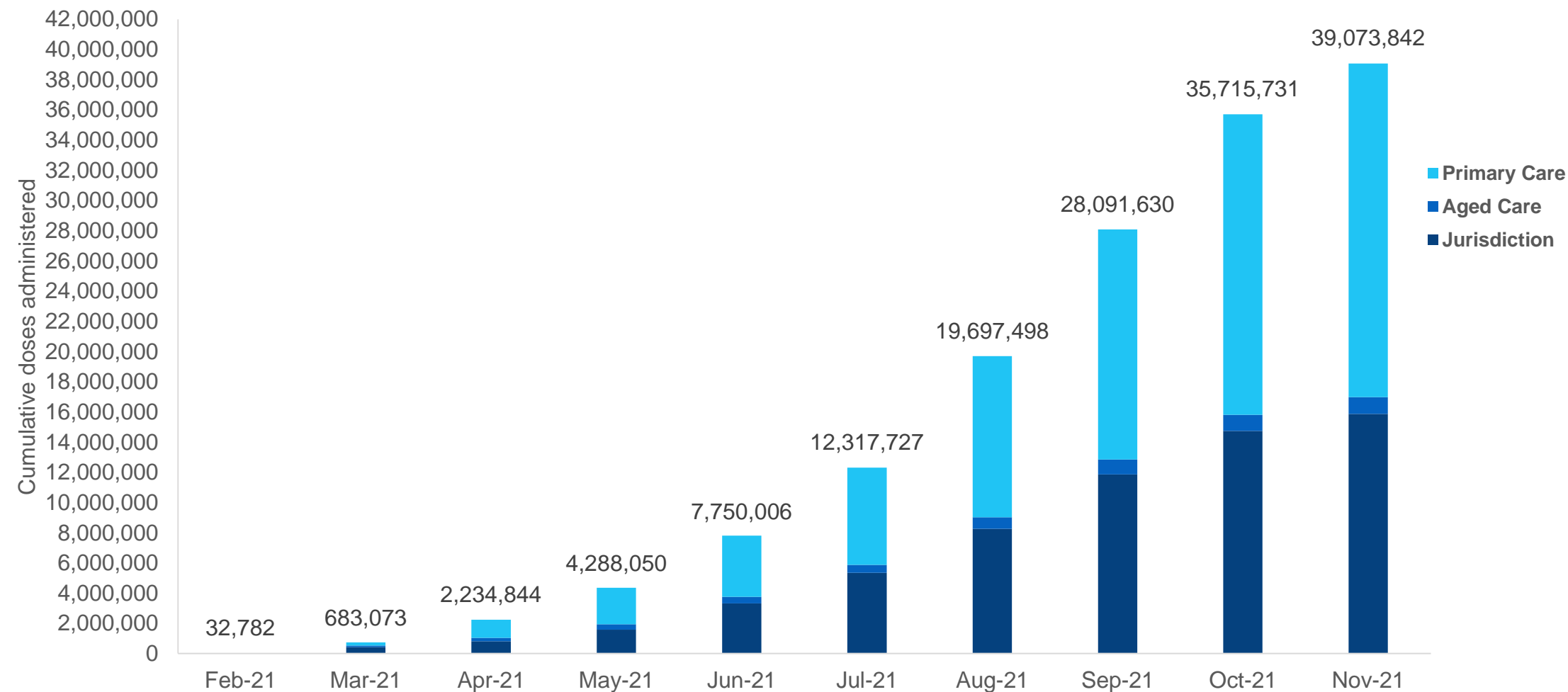

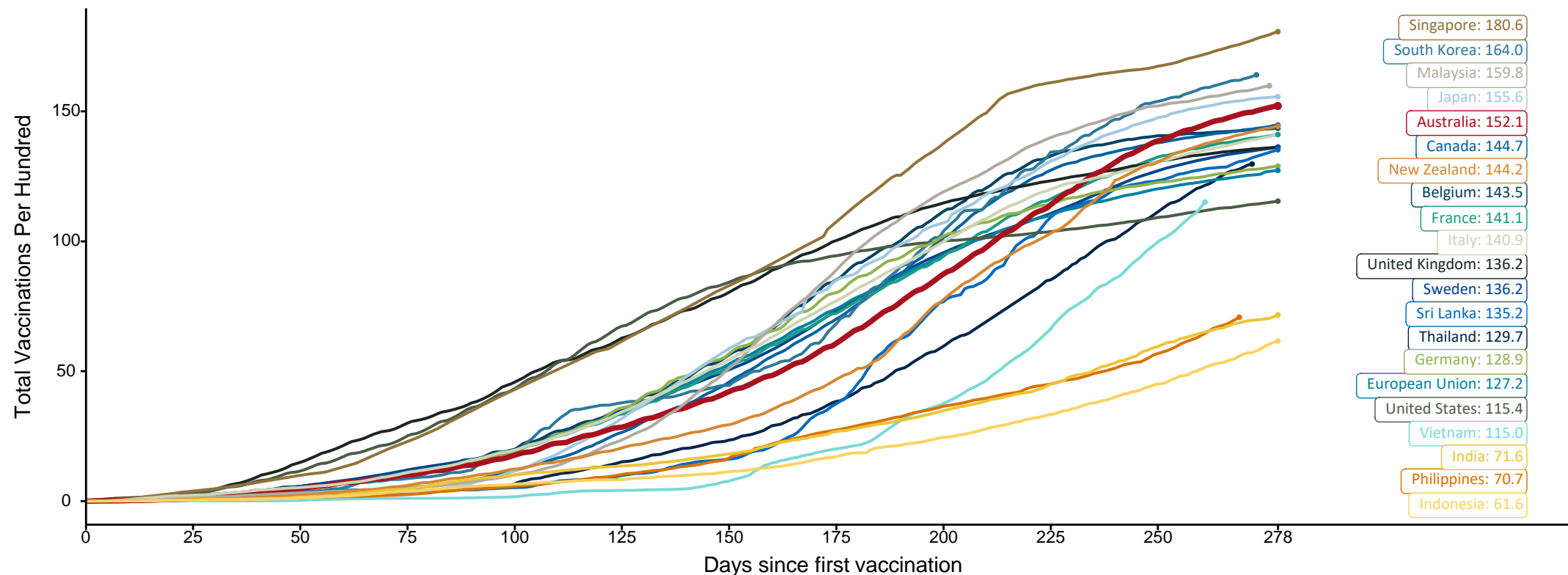


## Doses at equivalent stages of rollout (Day 278)

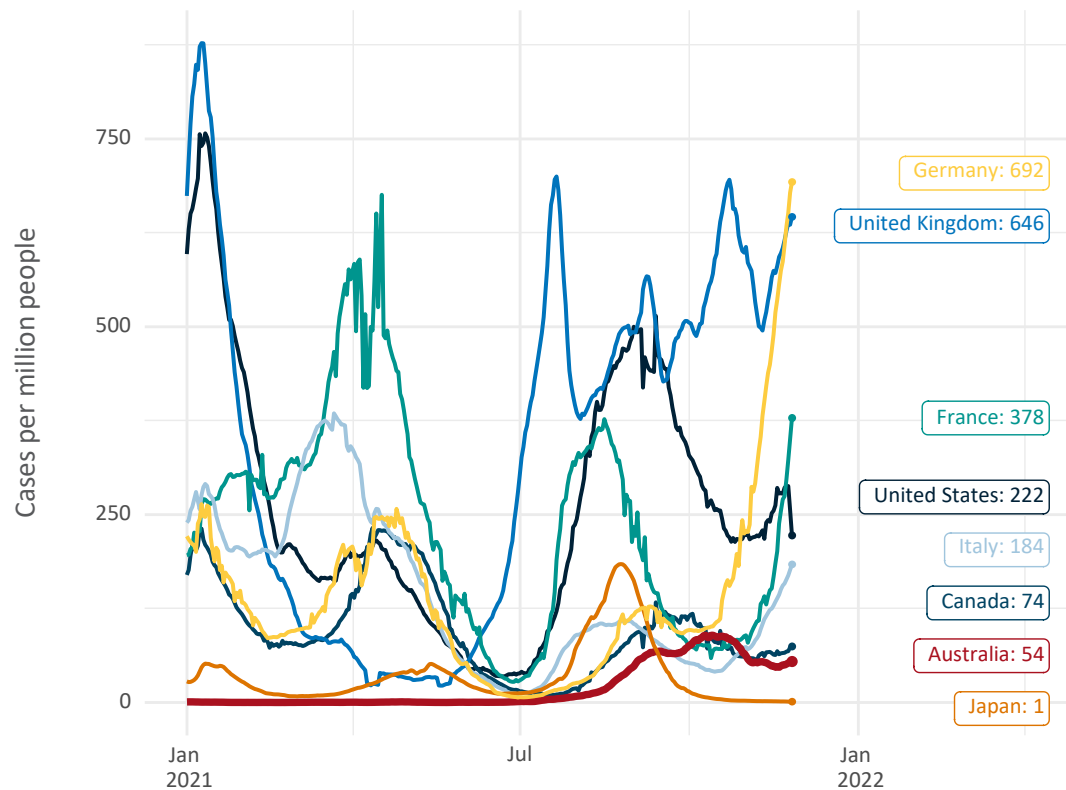

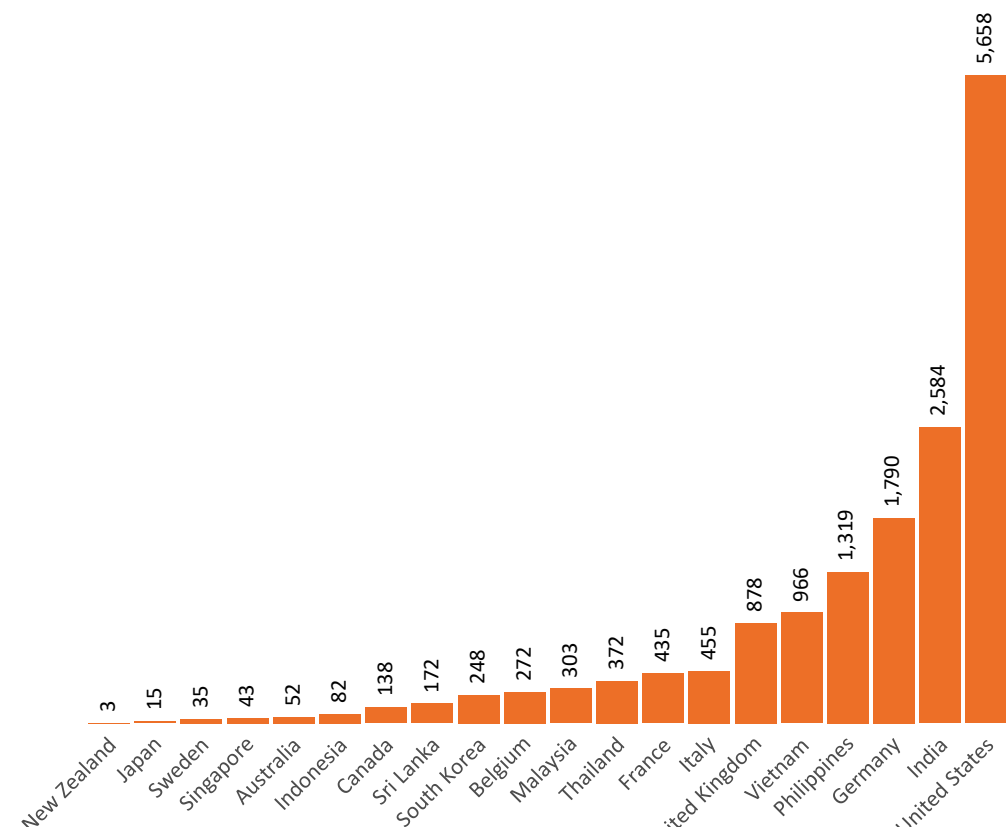

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries

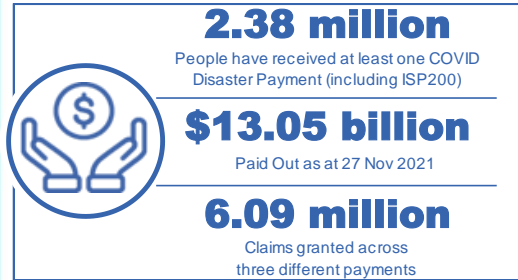

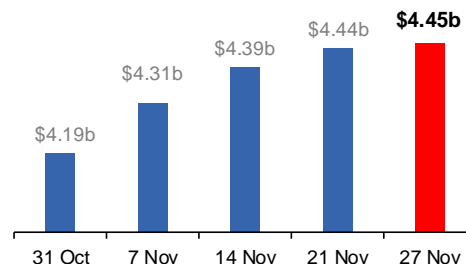

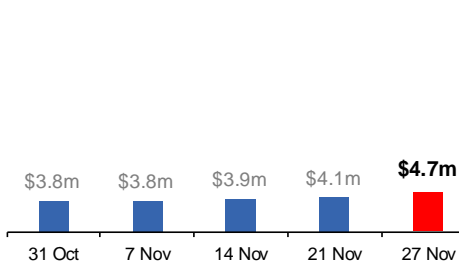

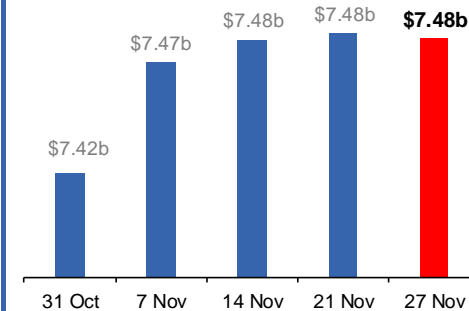

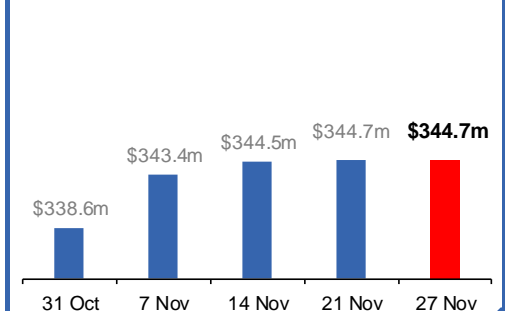

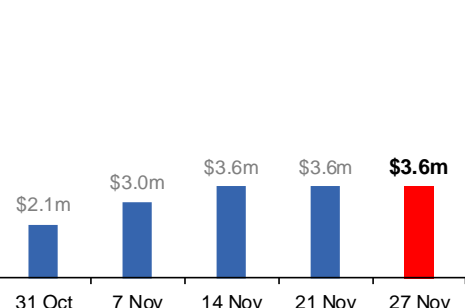

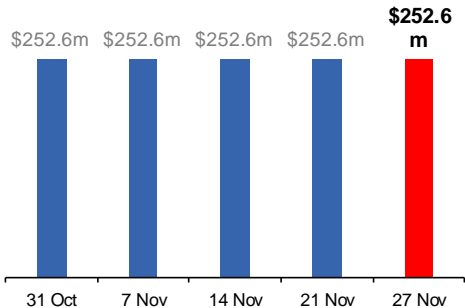
