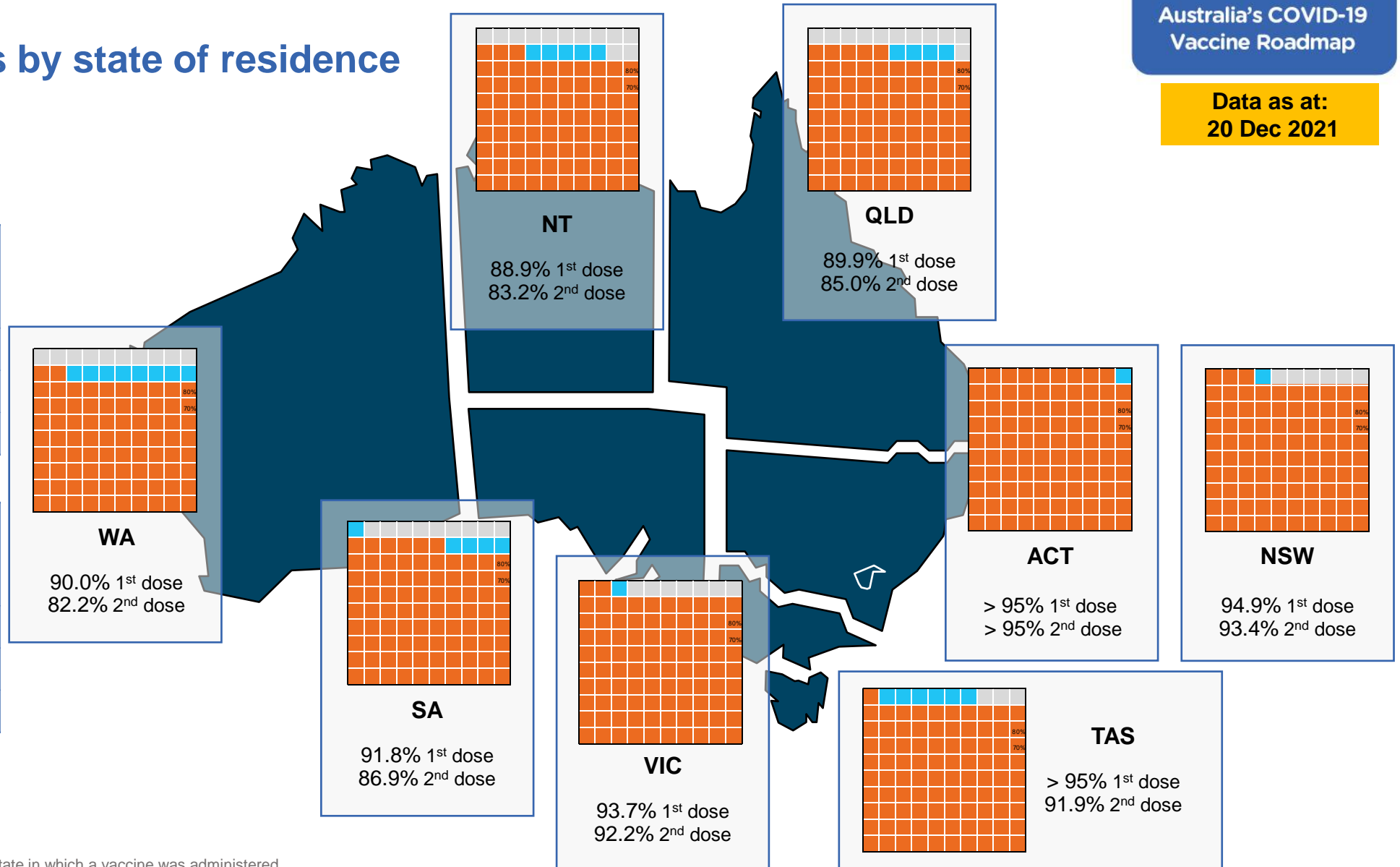

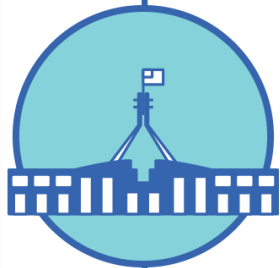

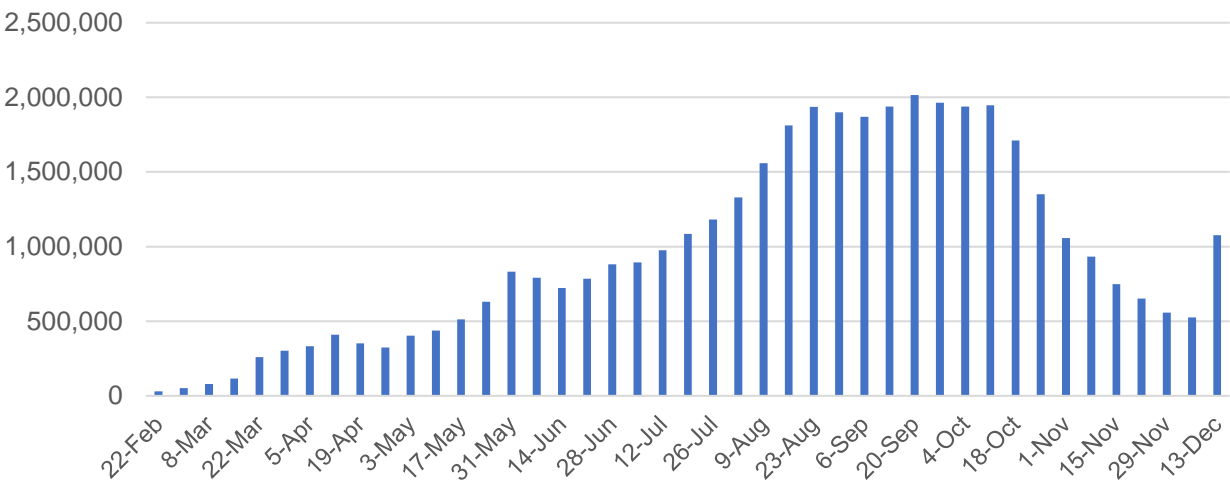

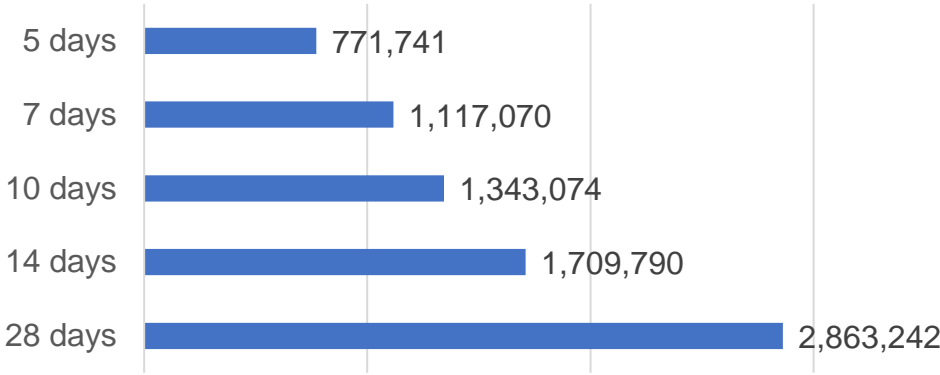

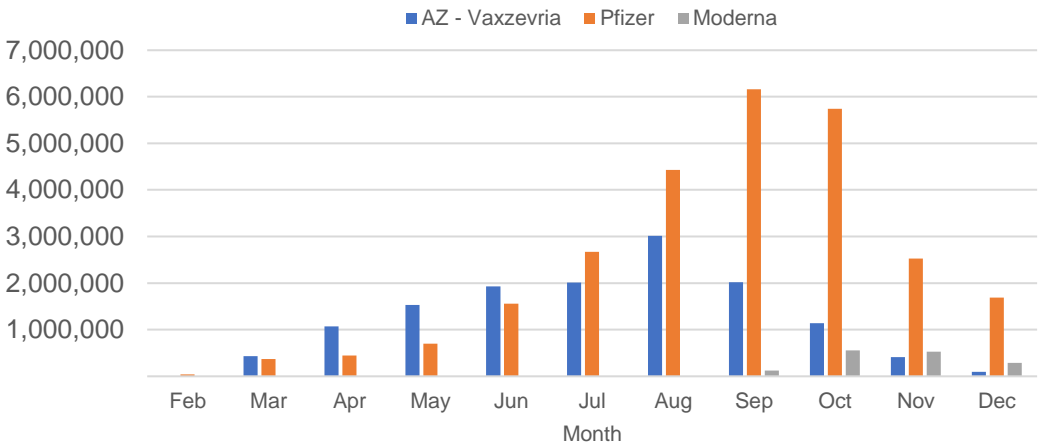
Doses Administered by Week



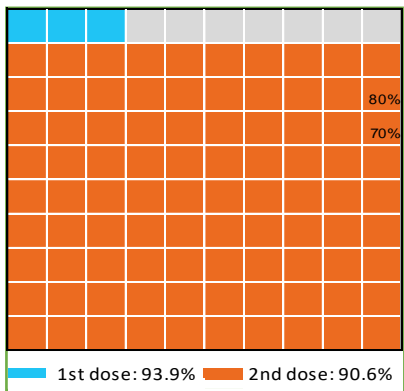
Doses Reported

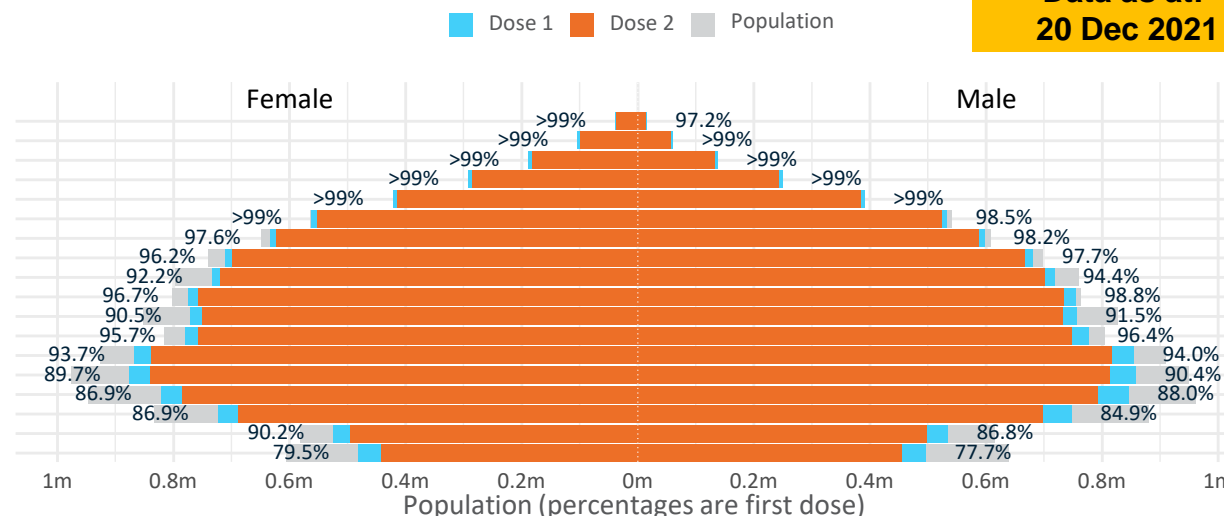

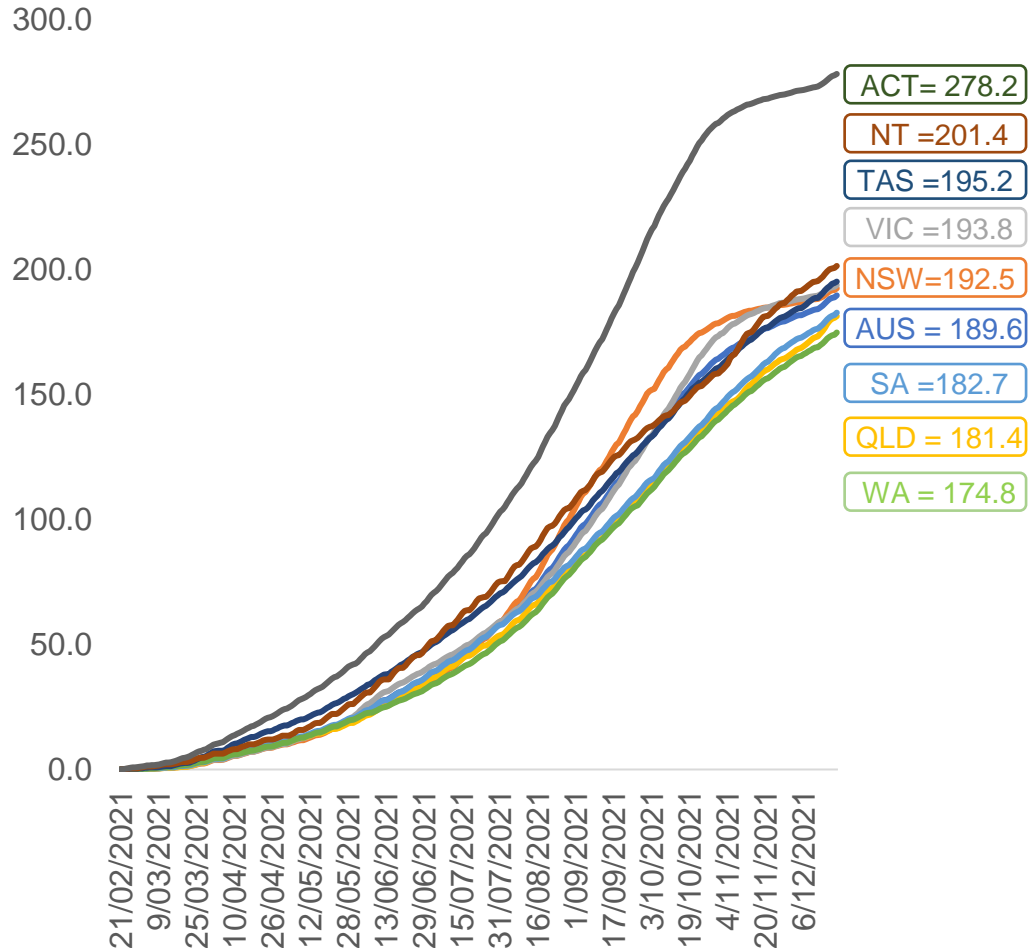

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations*

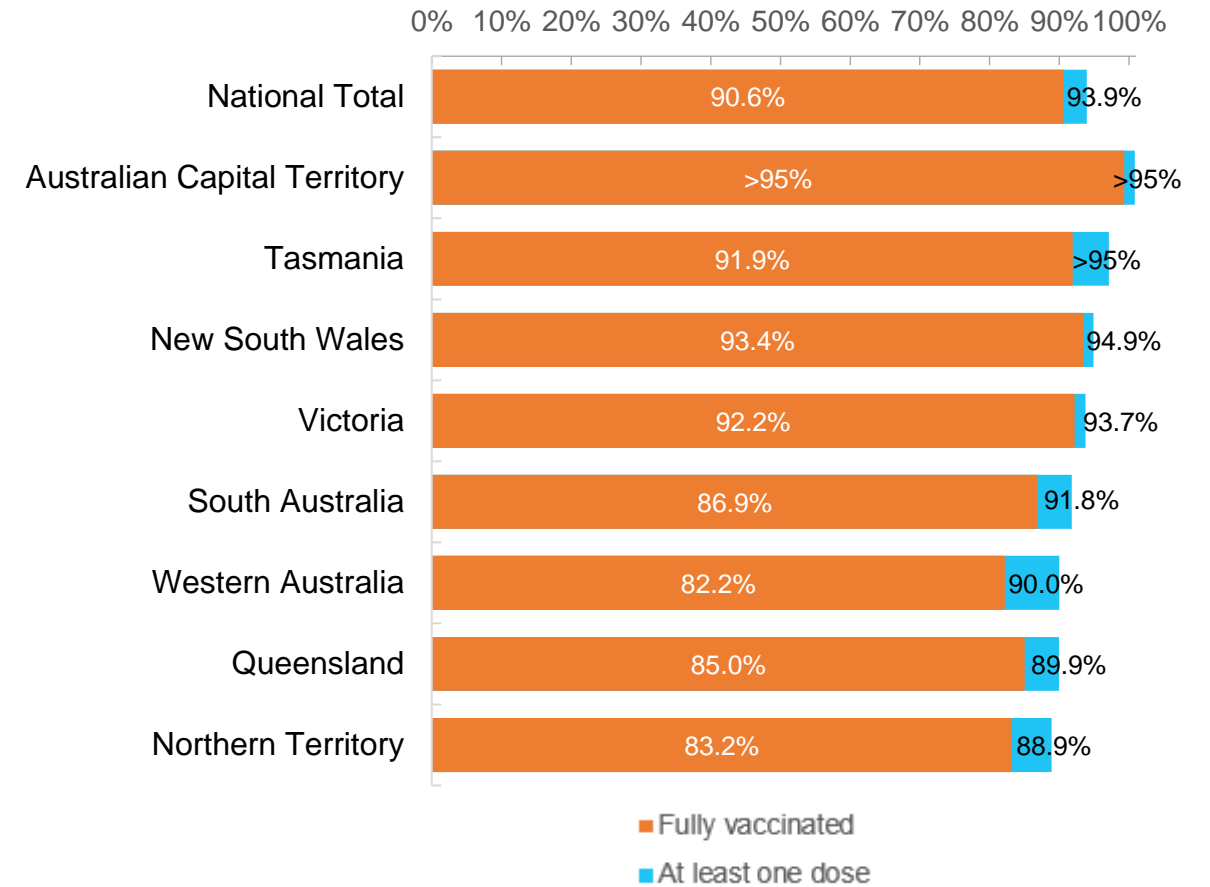

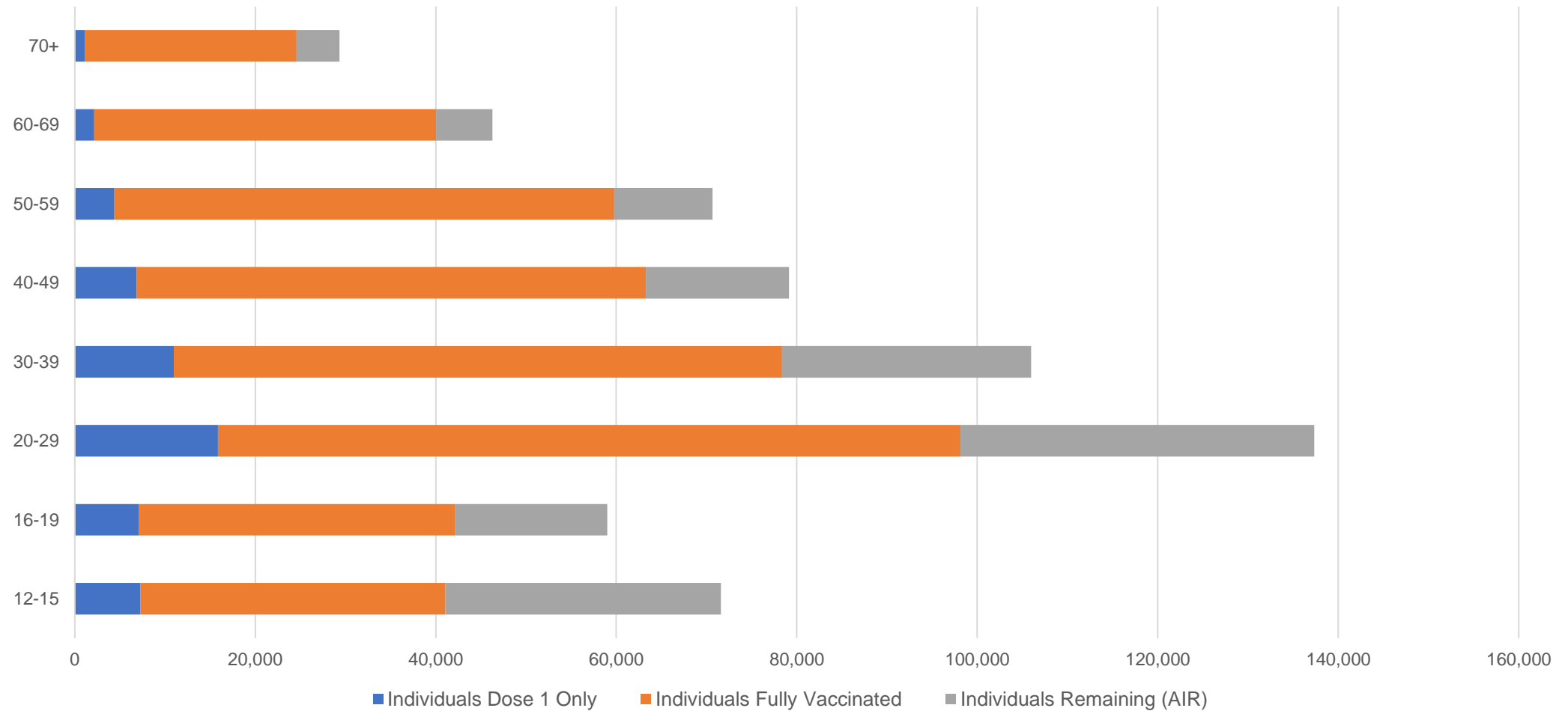

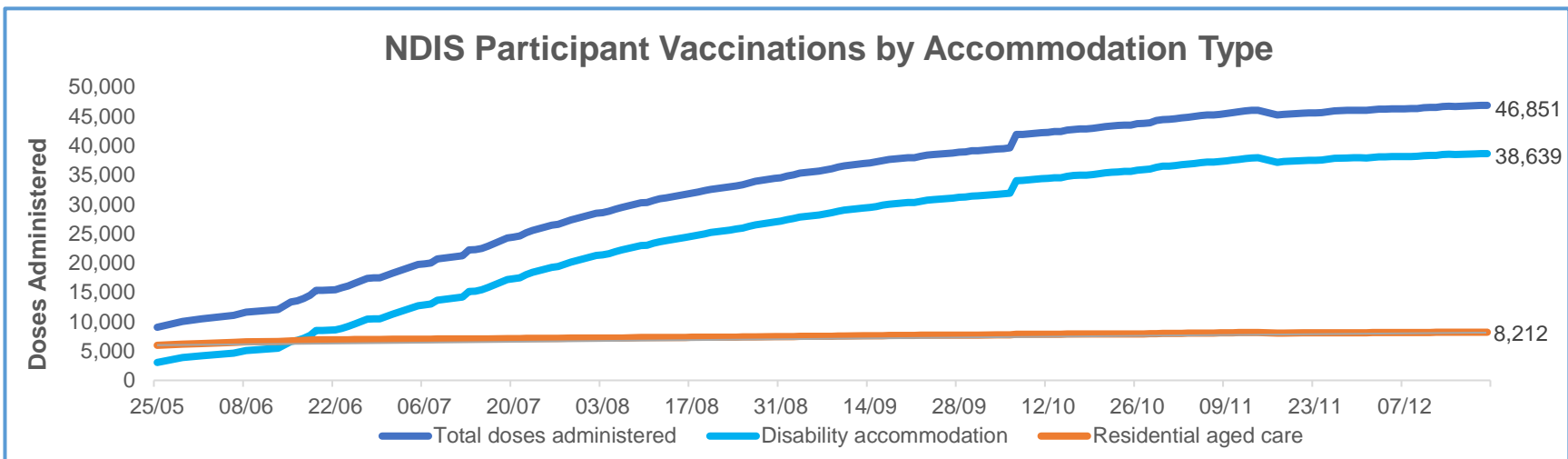

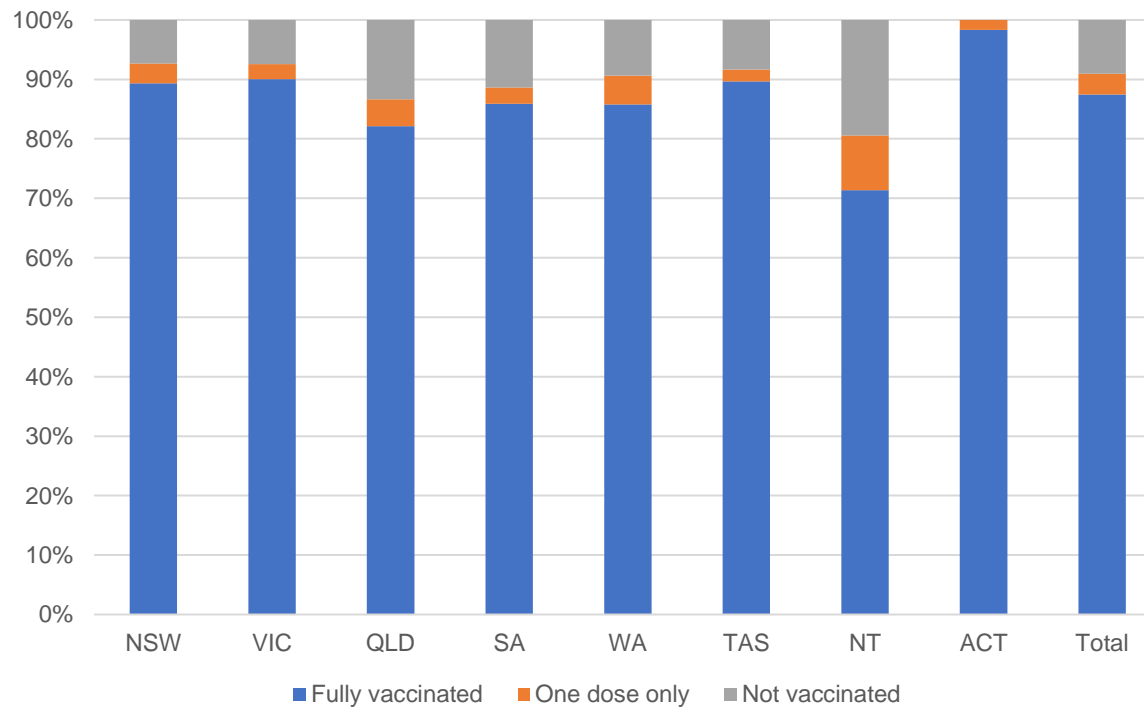

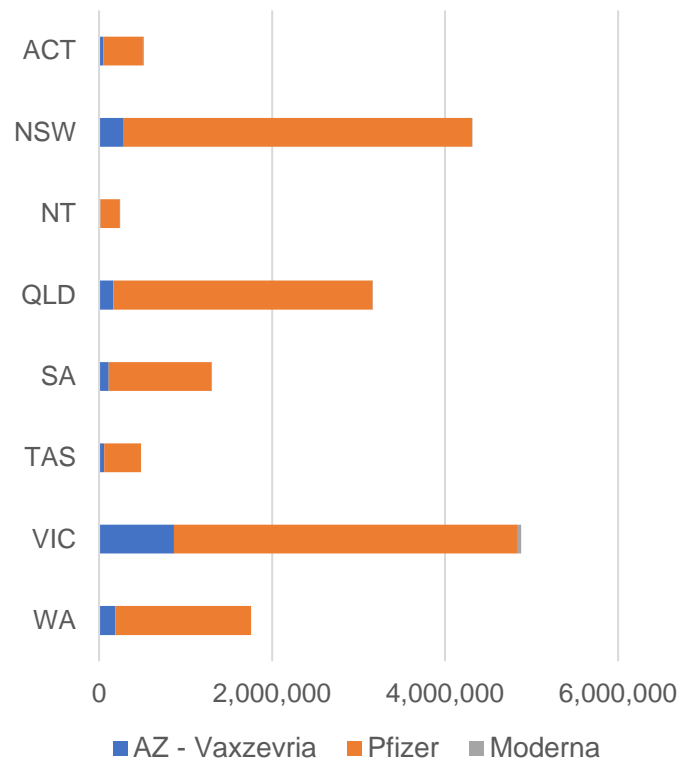

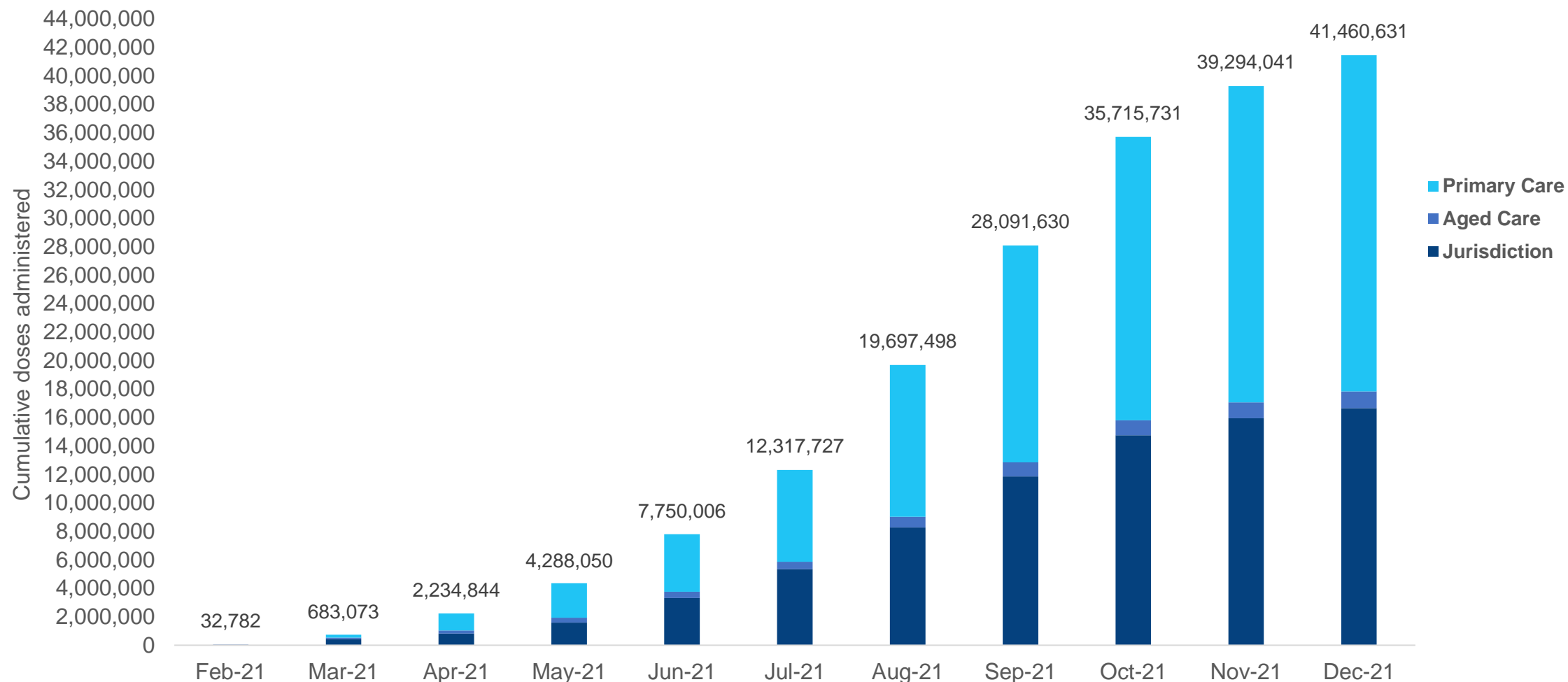

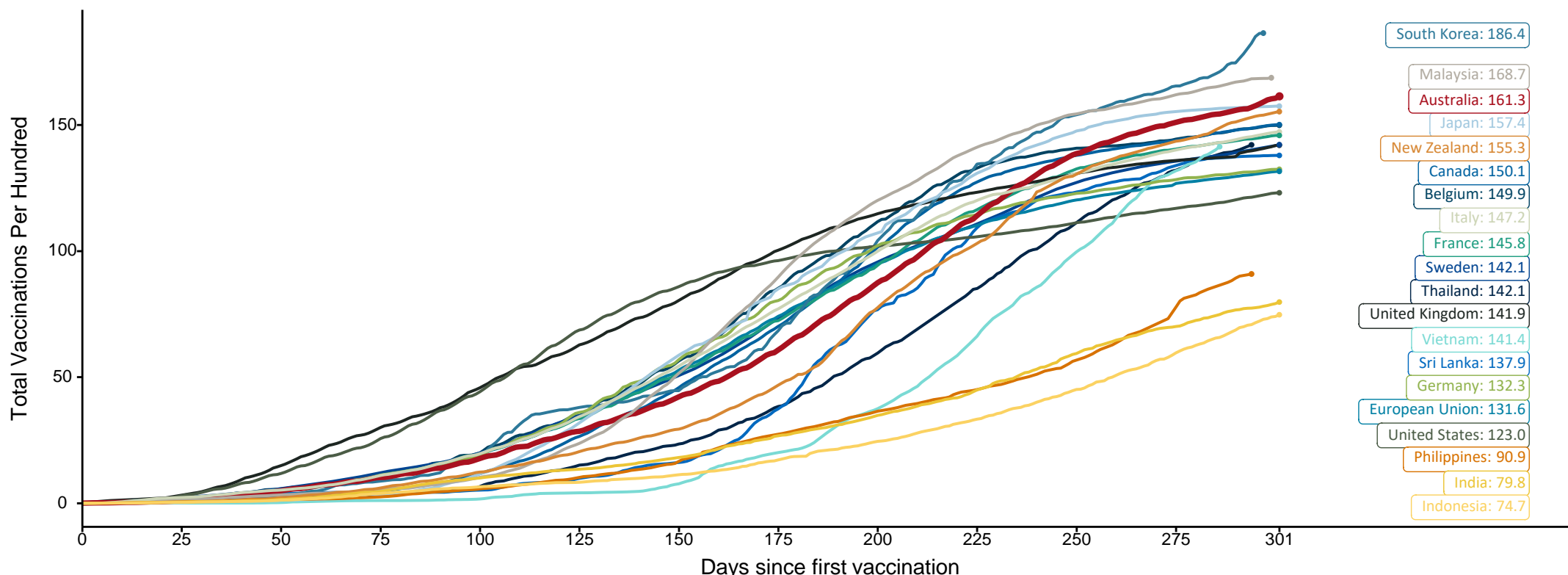

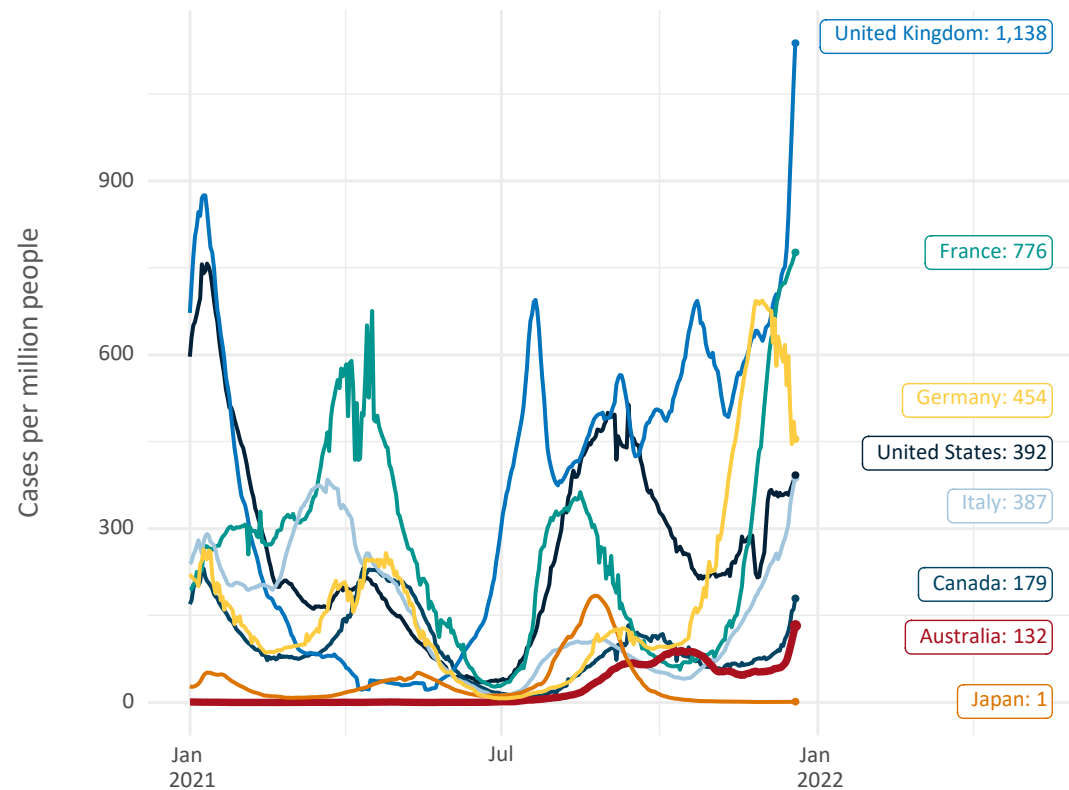

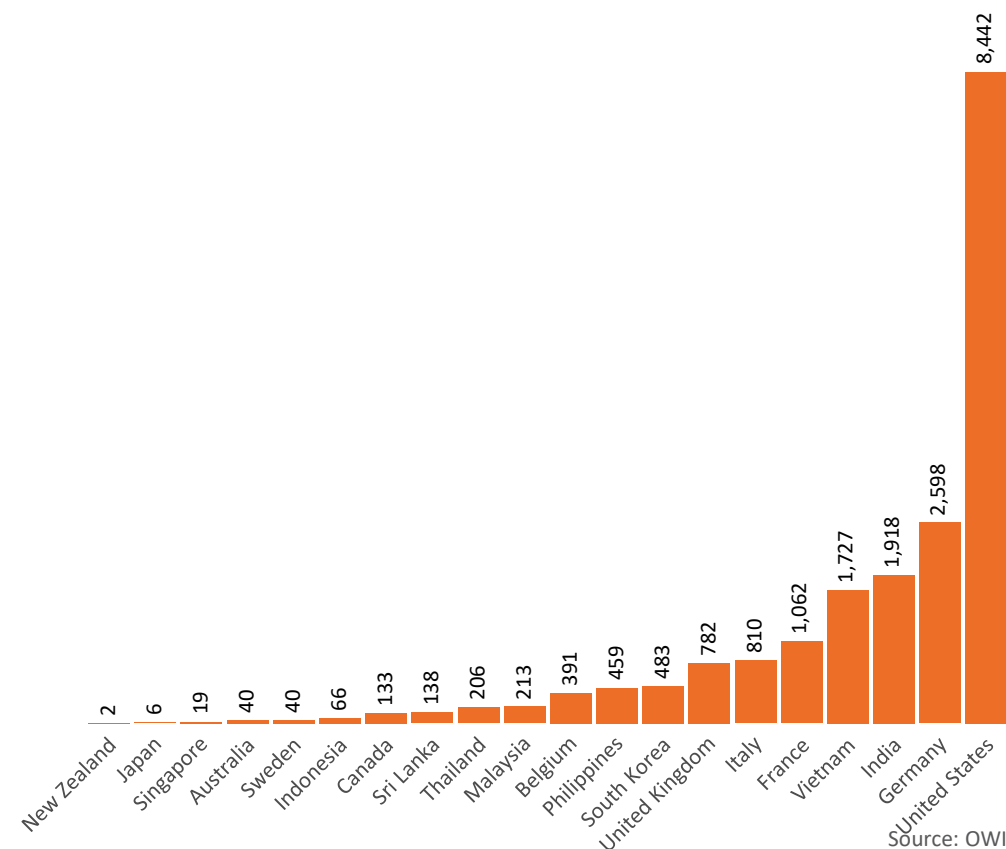

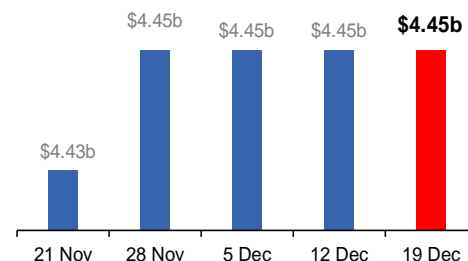

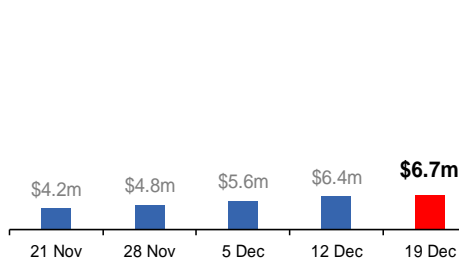

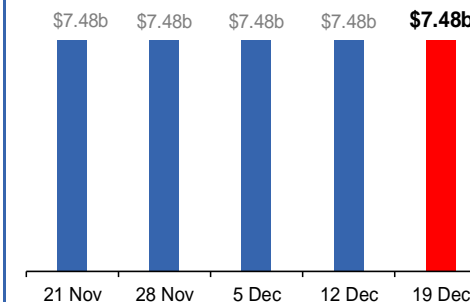

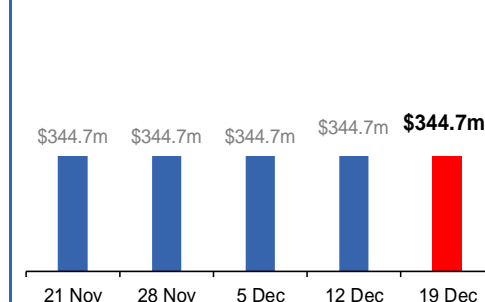

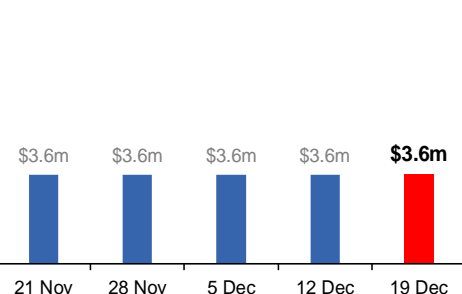

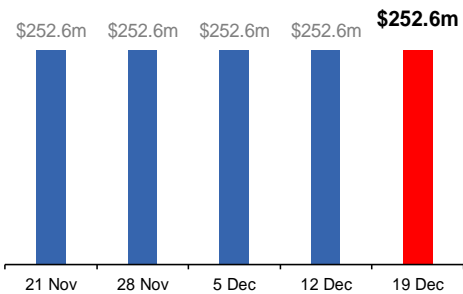
