# Metadata

**People with at least one dose.** The count of all people who have received at least one dose of an eligible vaccine. People with at least one dose encompasses people fully vaccinated and people with only one dose.

**People fully vaccinated.** Total people fully vaccinated with 2 doses of the same vaccine type.

**Estimated Resident Population (ERP).** The official measure of the population of Australia, based on their usual residence. It refers to all people, regardless of nationality, citizenship or legal status, who usually live in Australia, with the exception of foreign diplomatic personnel and their families. The ERP includes usual residents who are overseas for less than 12 months and excludes overseas visitors who are in Australia for less than 12 months.

**Statistical Area Level 3 (SA3).** Geographic boundaries established as part of the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (ASGS). SA3s are required to have large populations of between 20,000 and 100,000 people and are based around labour markets. SA3s are aggregations of whole Statistical Area Level 2 (SA2) boundaries and fit within whole state and territory boundaries. SA3s with less than 500 people aged 15 and over have been excluded.

## Update Information:

Vaccine data is sourced from the Australian Immunisation Register as at 11:59pm 16 Jan. 2022.

SA3 population is sourced from the Australian Bureau of Statistics Estimated Resident Population 2019 including individuals aged 15 and over.
