









Doses by administration month and vaccine type




Eligible population percentage coverage


Doses by age and sex


First and second doses by age and sex


















Doses at equivalent stages of rollout (Day 325)






New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average








