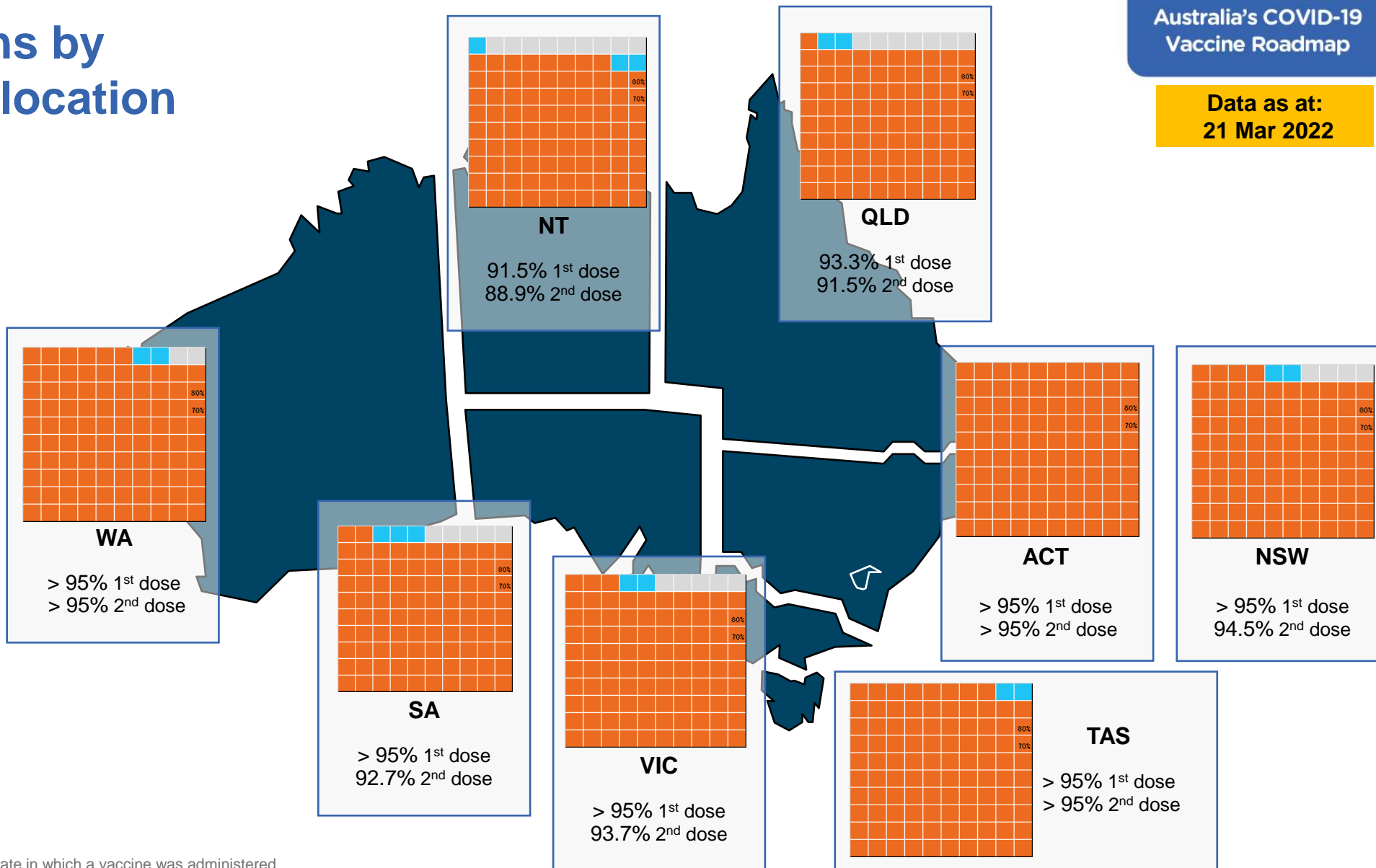

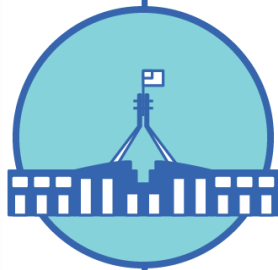

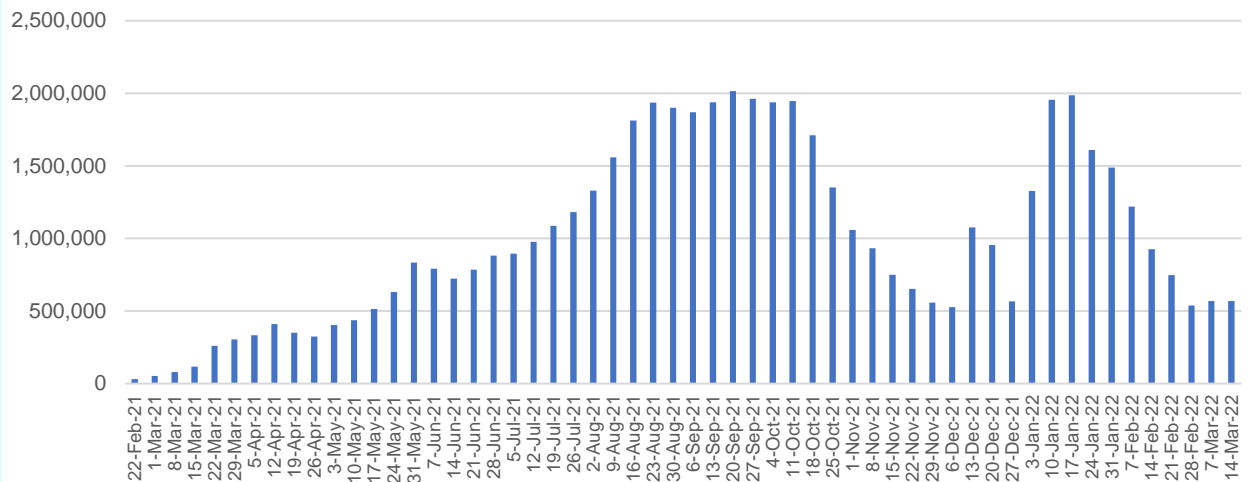

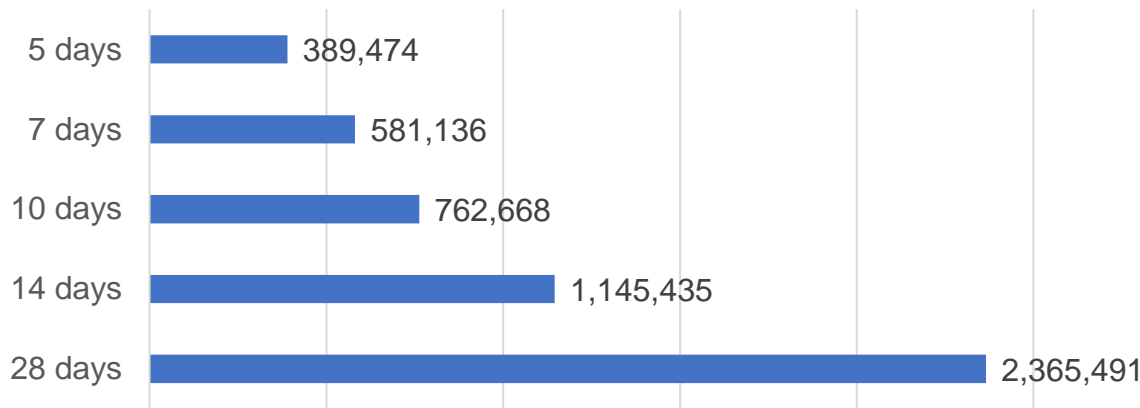

Doses Administered by Week

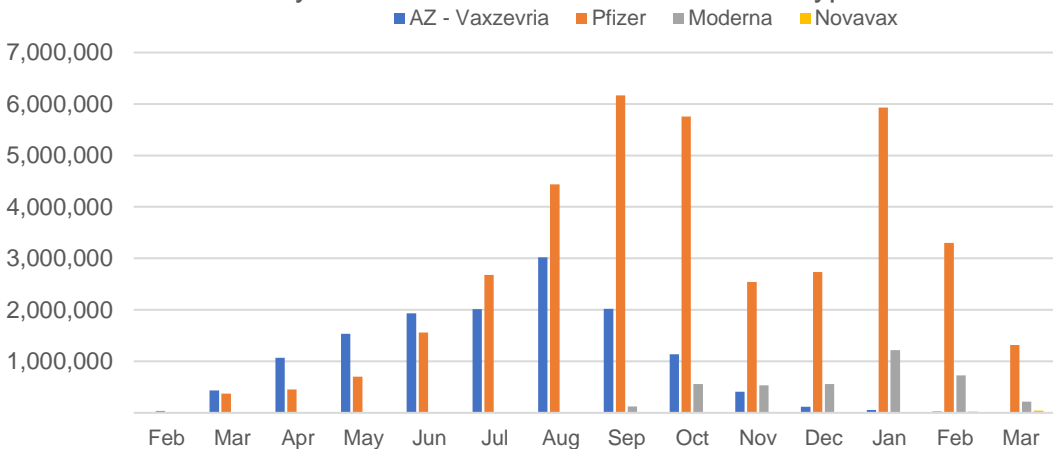

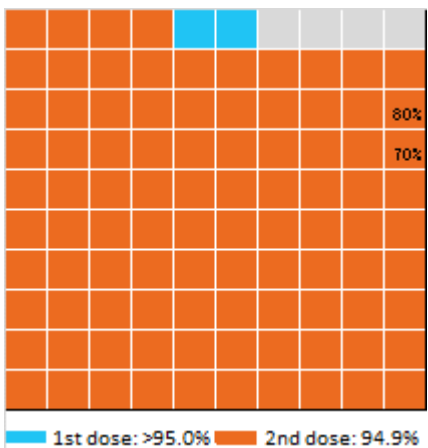

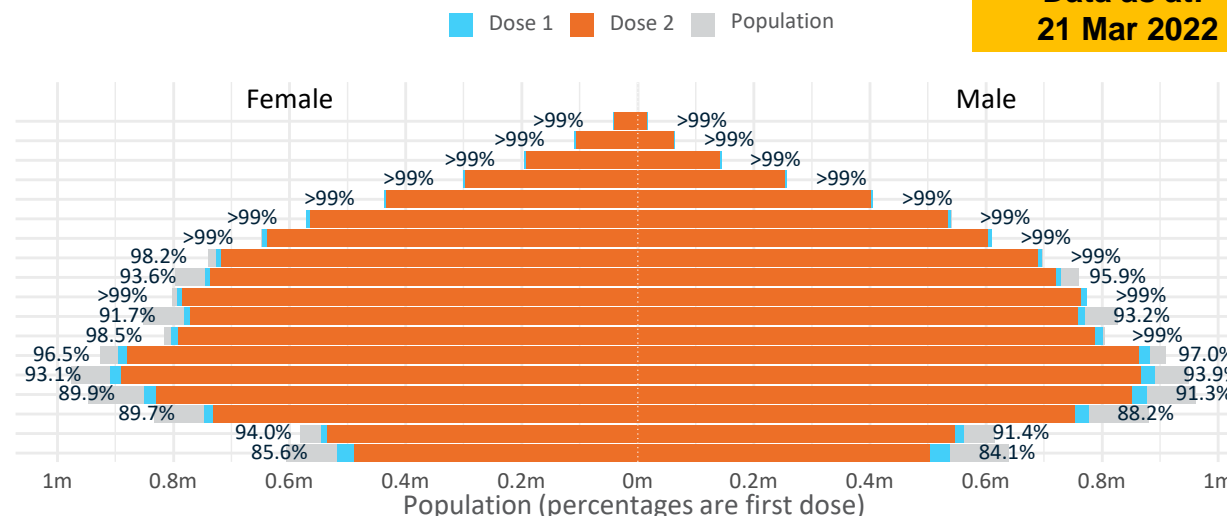

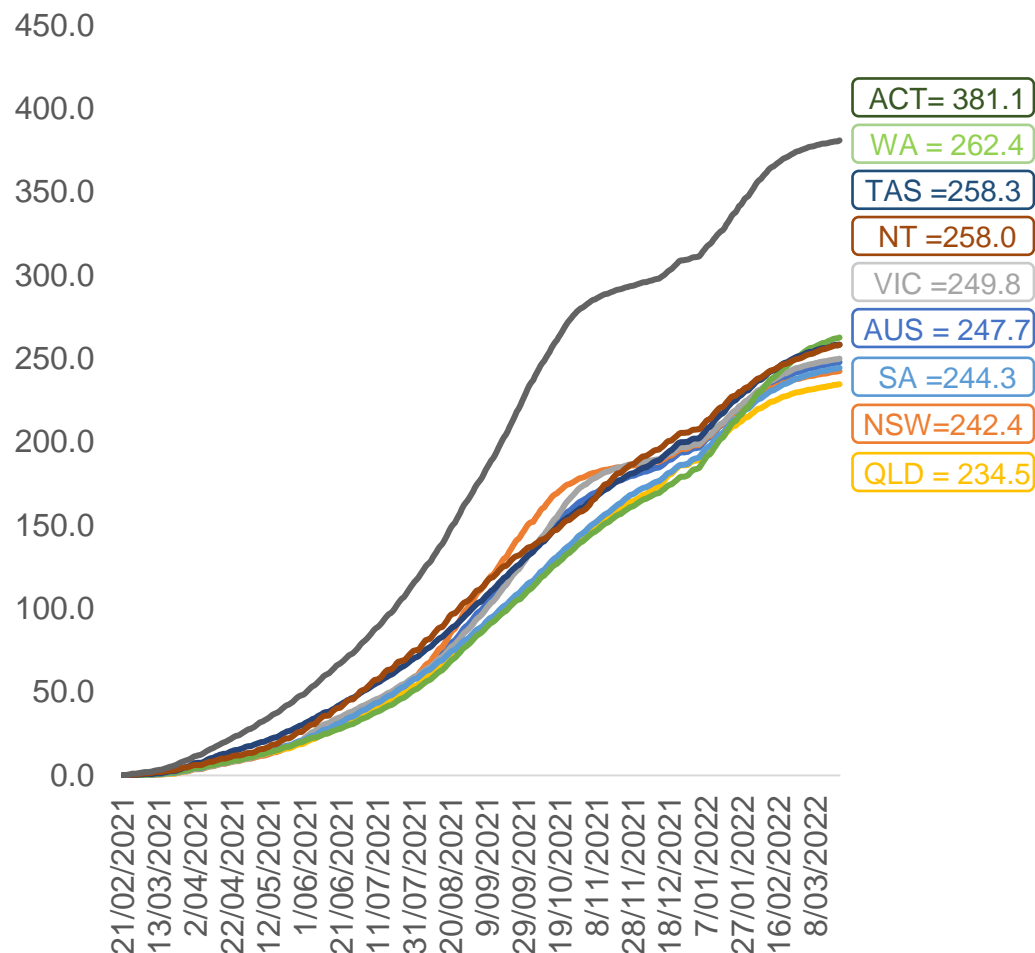

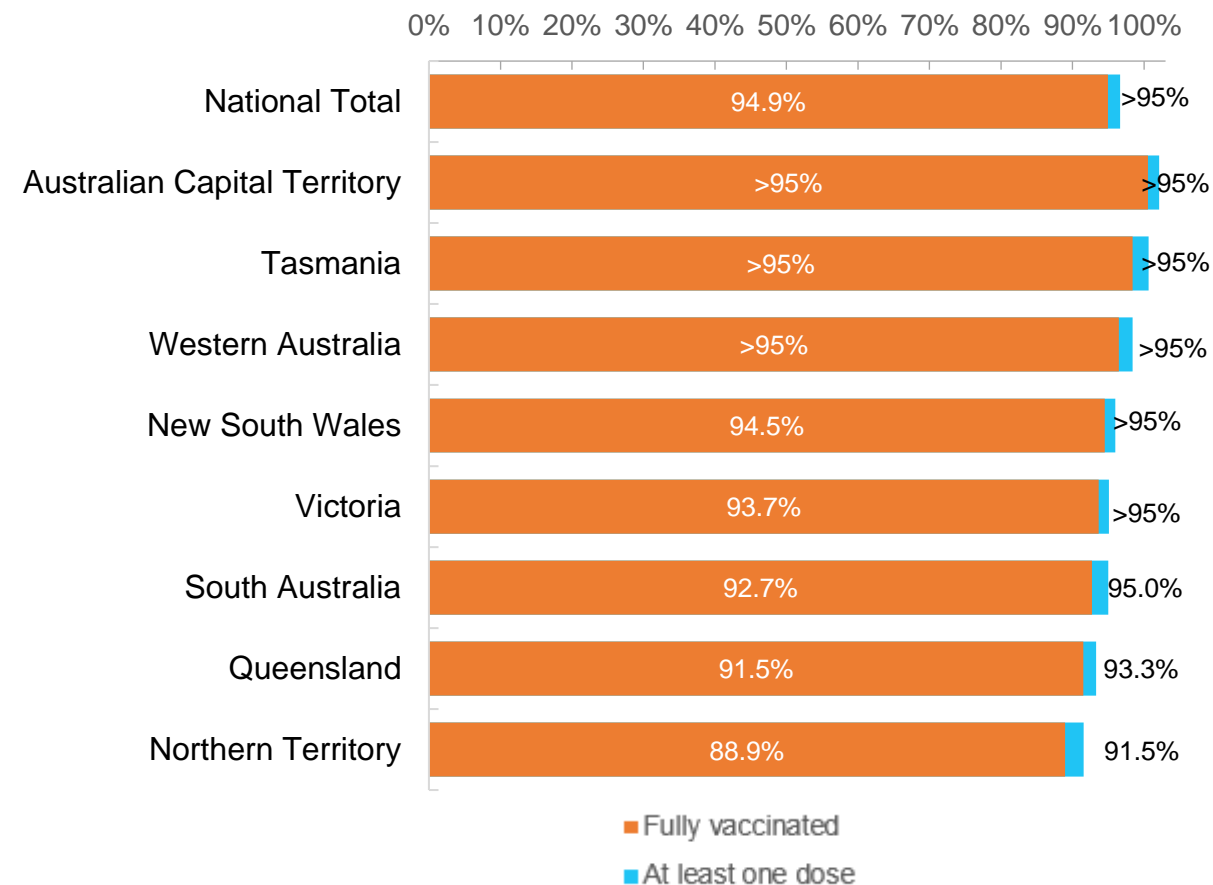

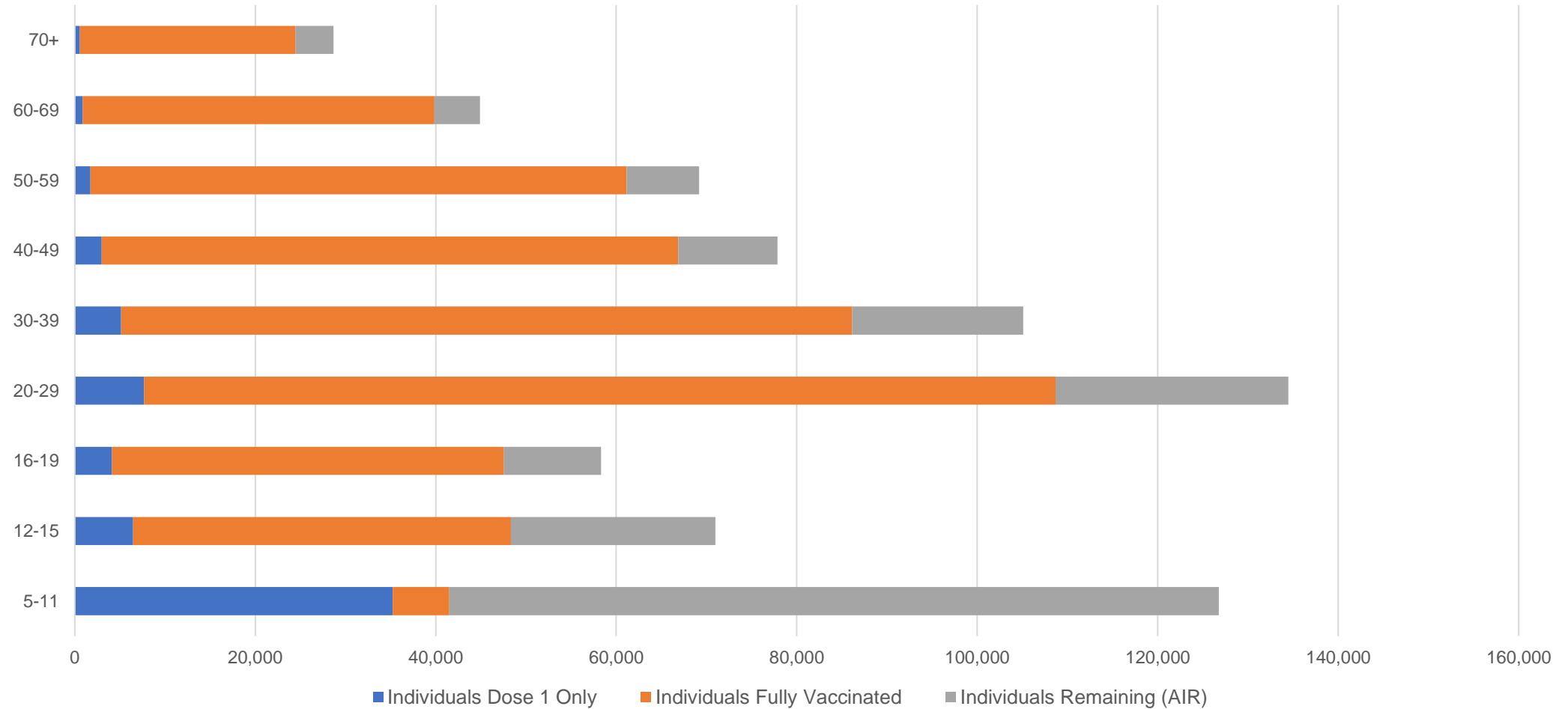

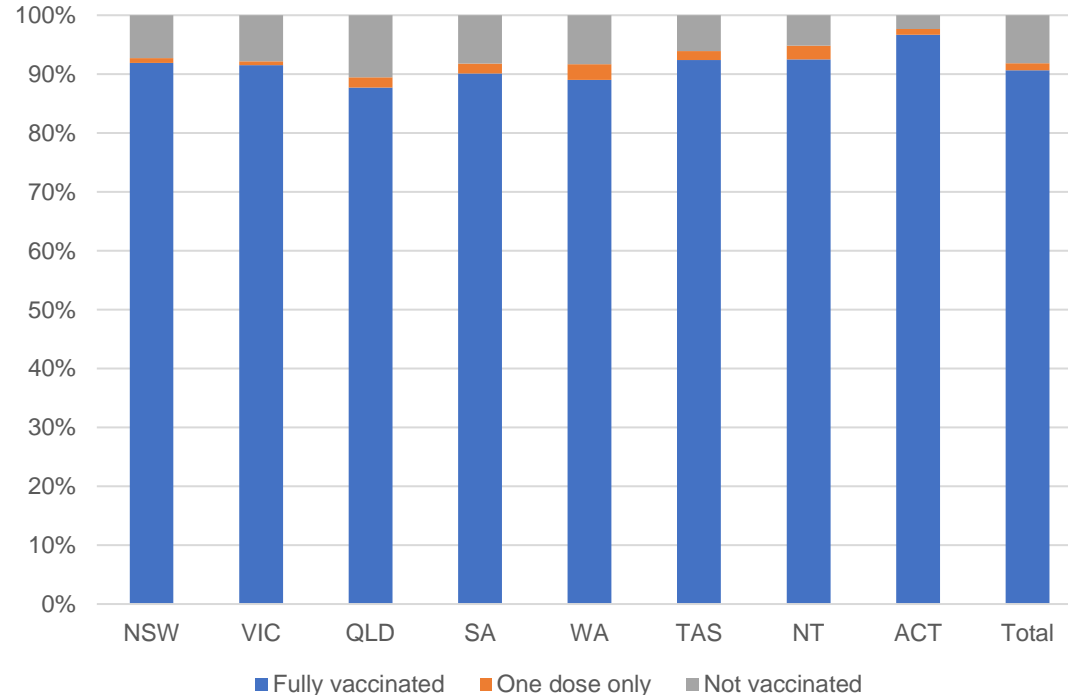

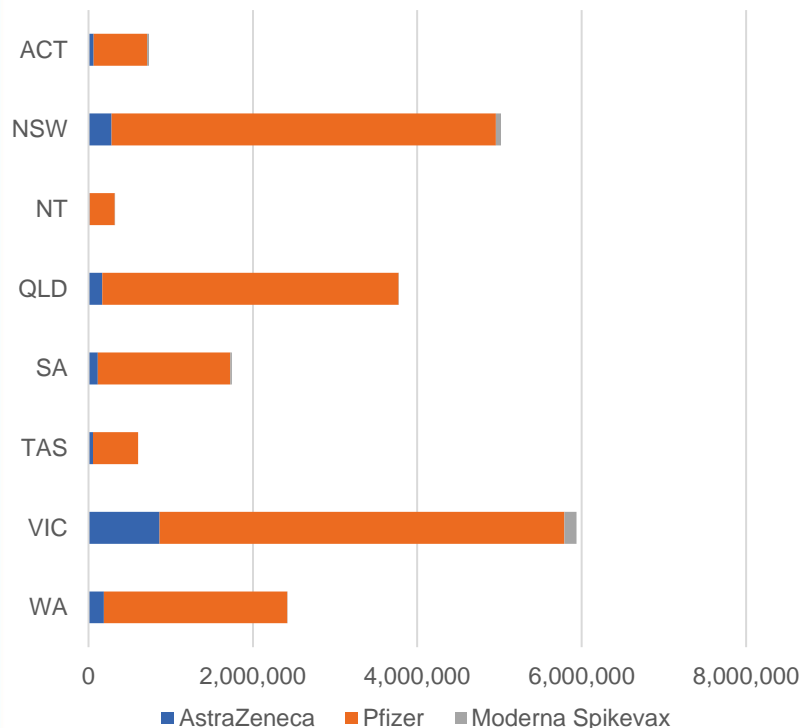

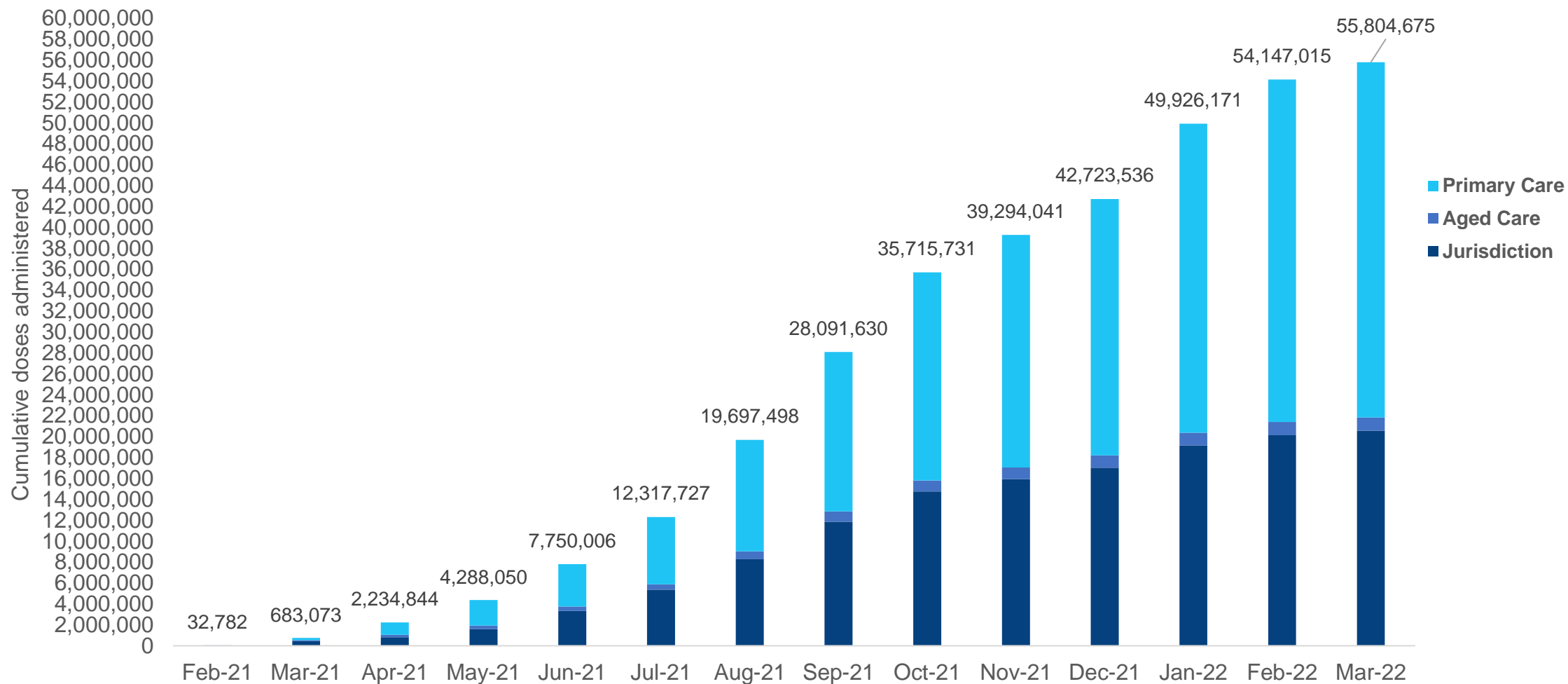

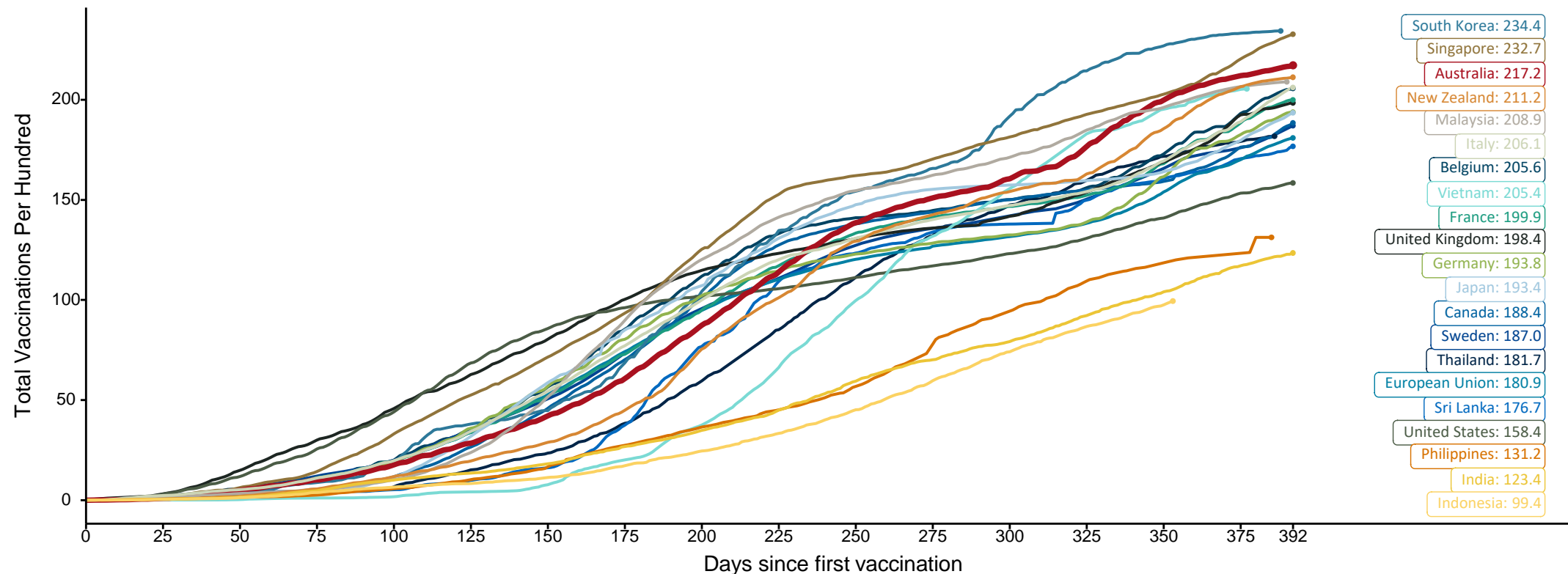

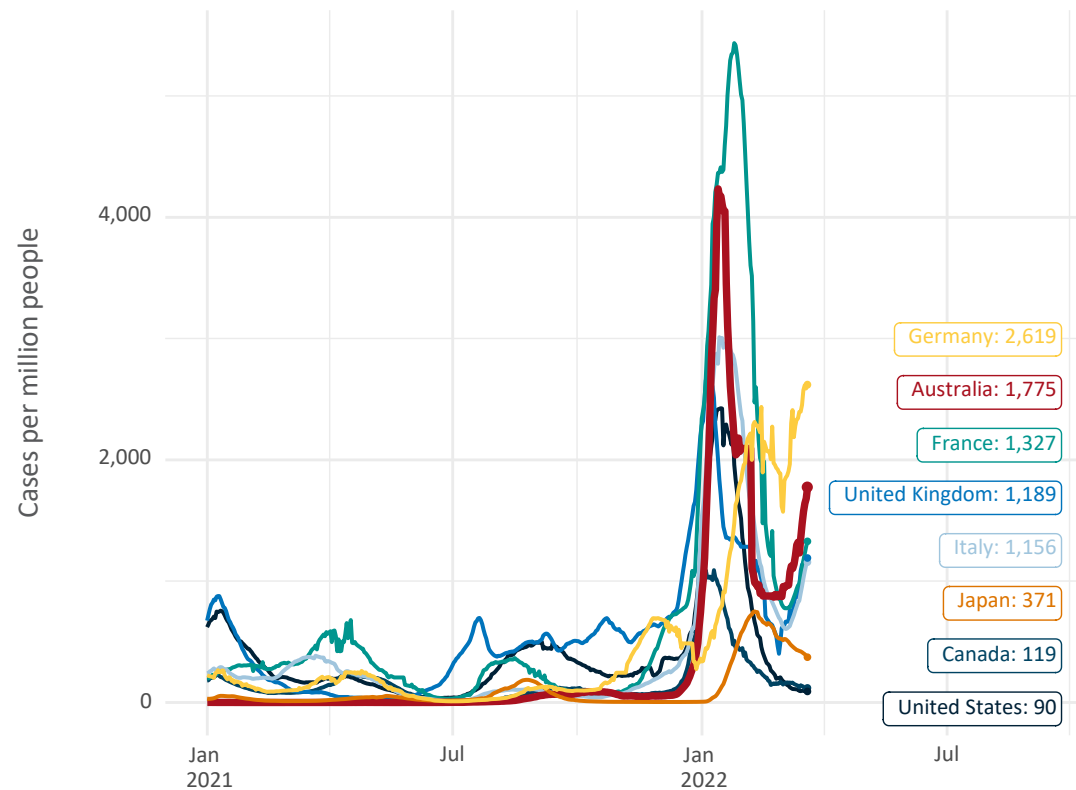

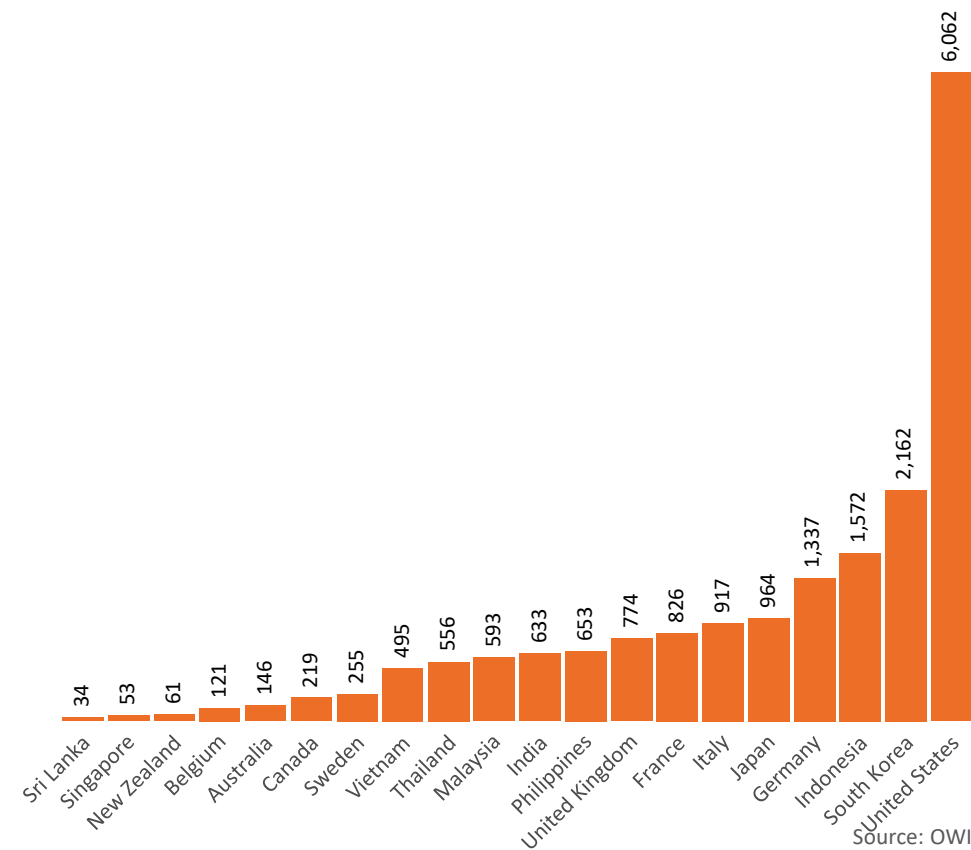

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries



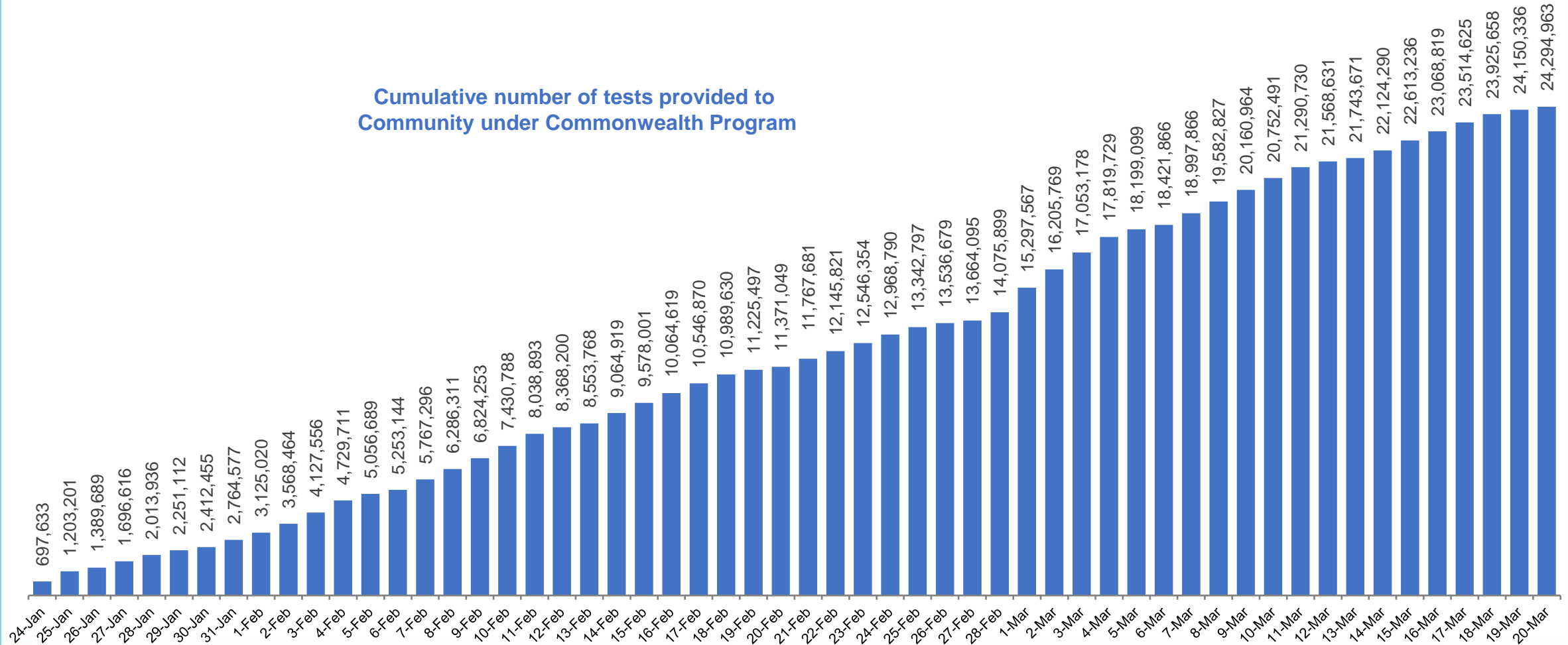

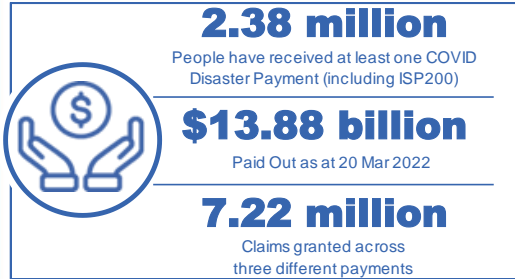
Cumulative number of tests provided to

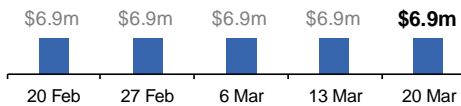

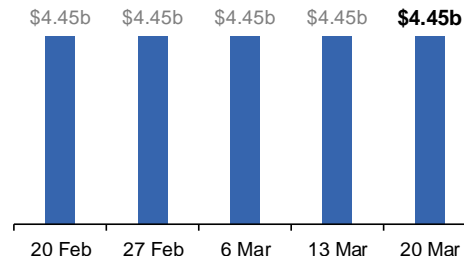

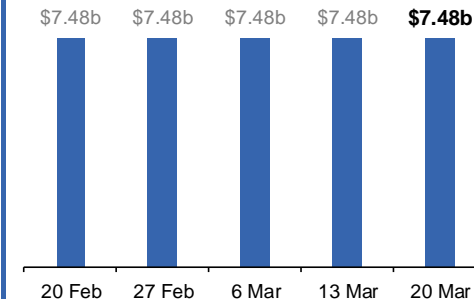

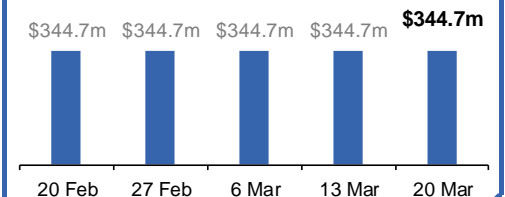
