


























Doses at equivalent stages of rollout (Day 392)

Cumulative doses administered (21 Mar): 55,804,675






New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries




