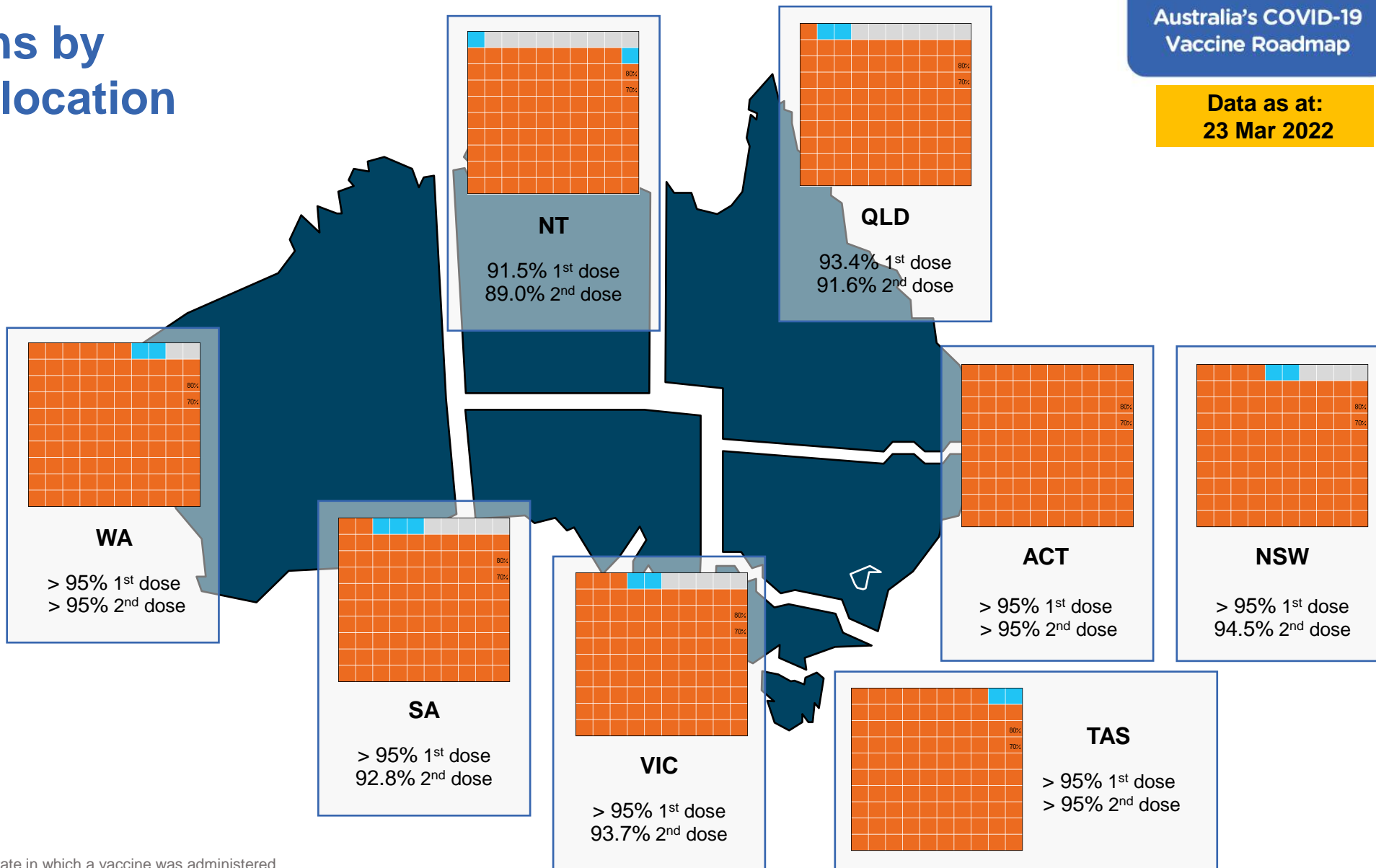

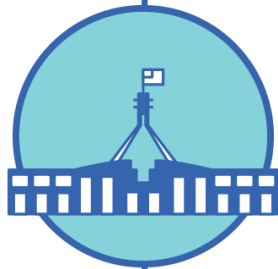

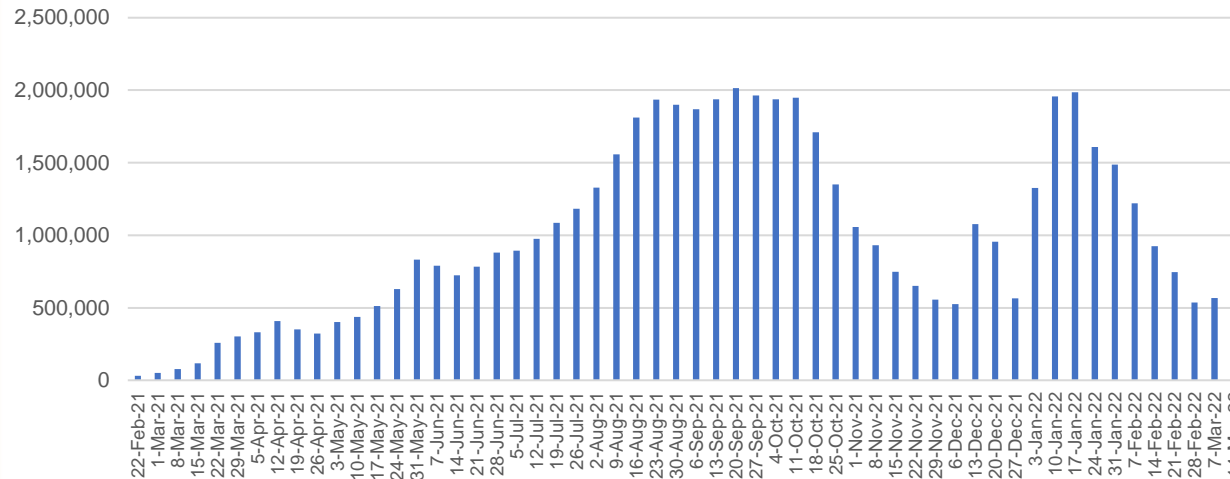

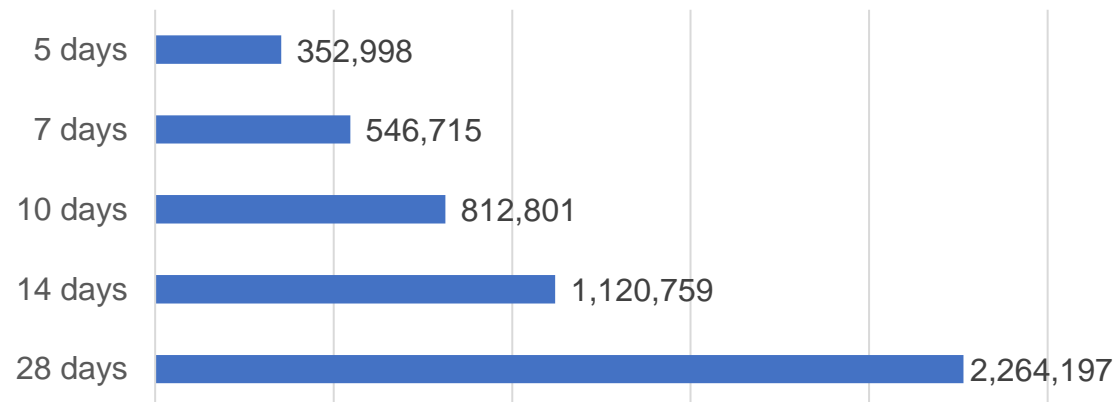

Doses Administered by Week

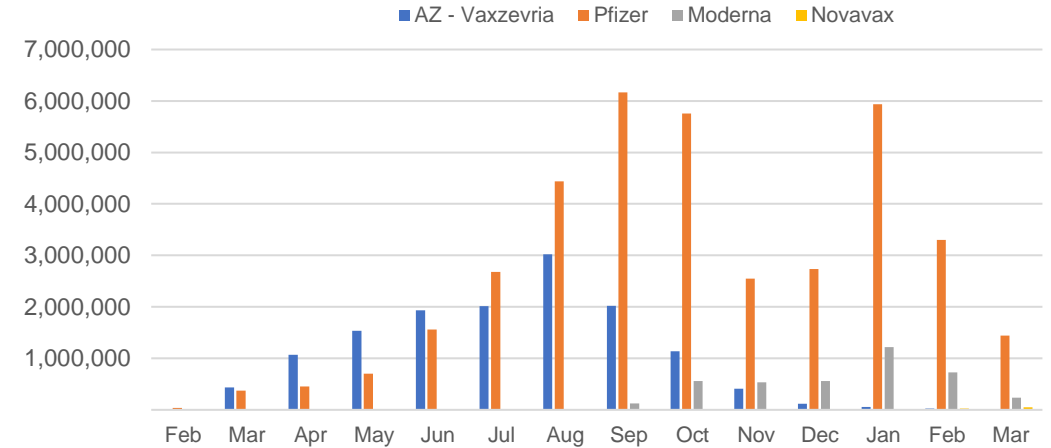

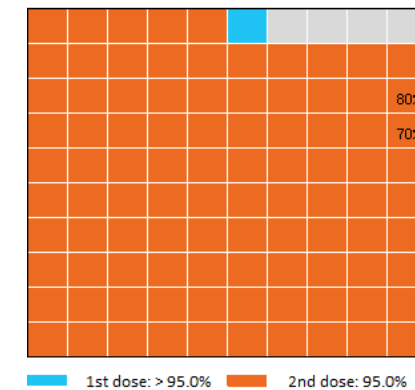

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations\*

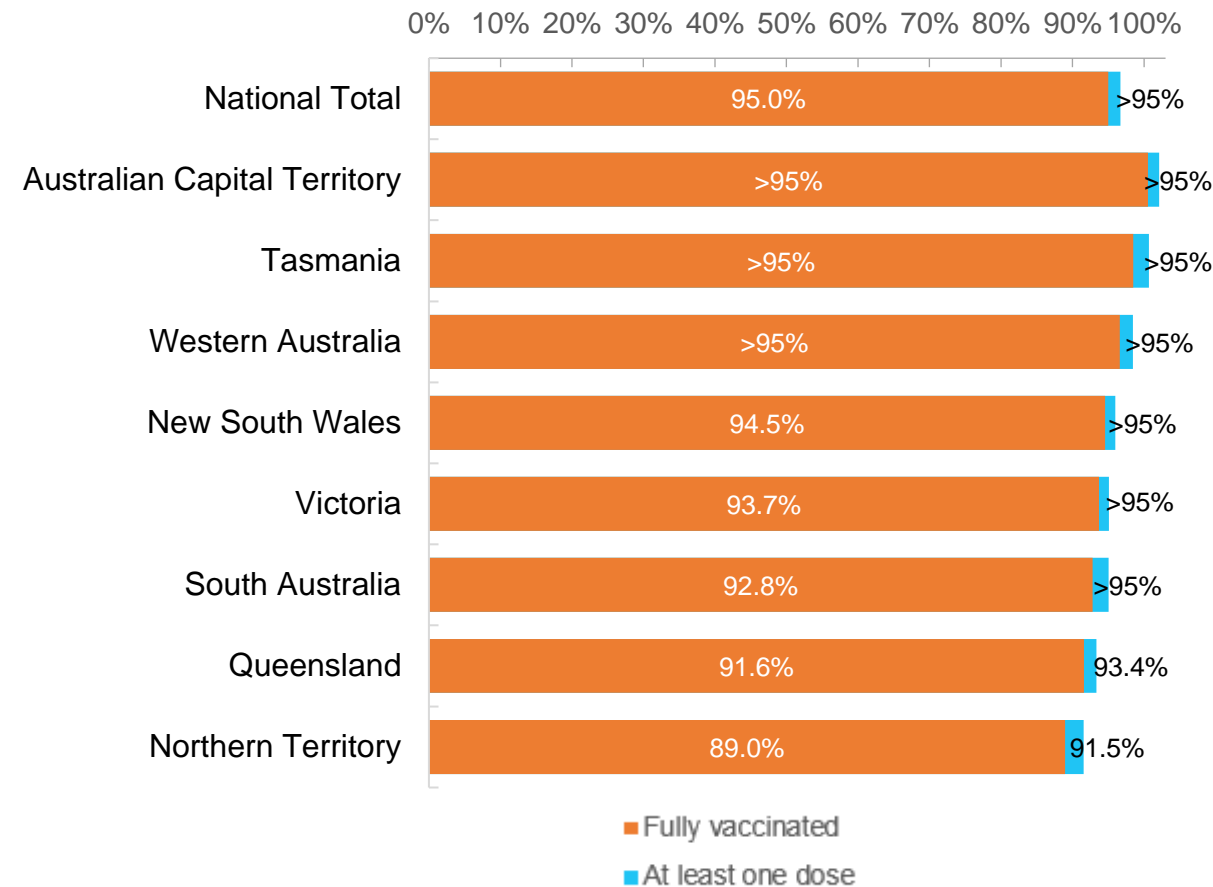

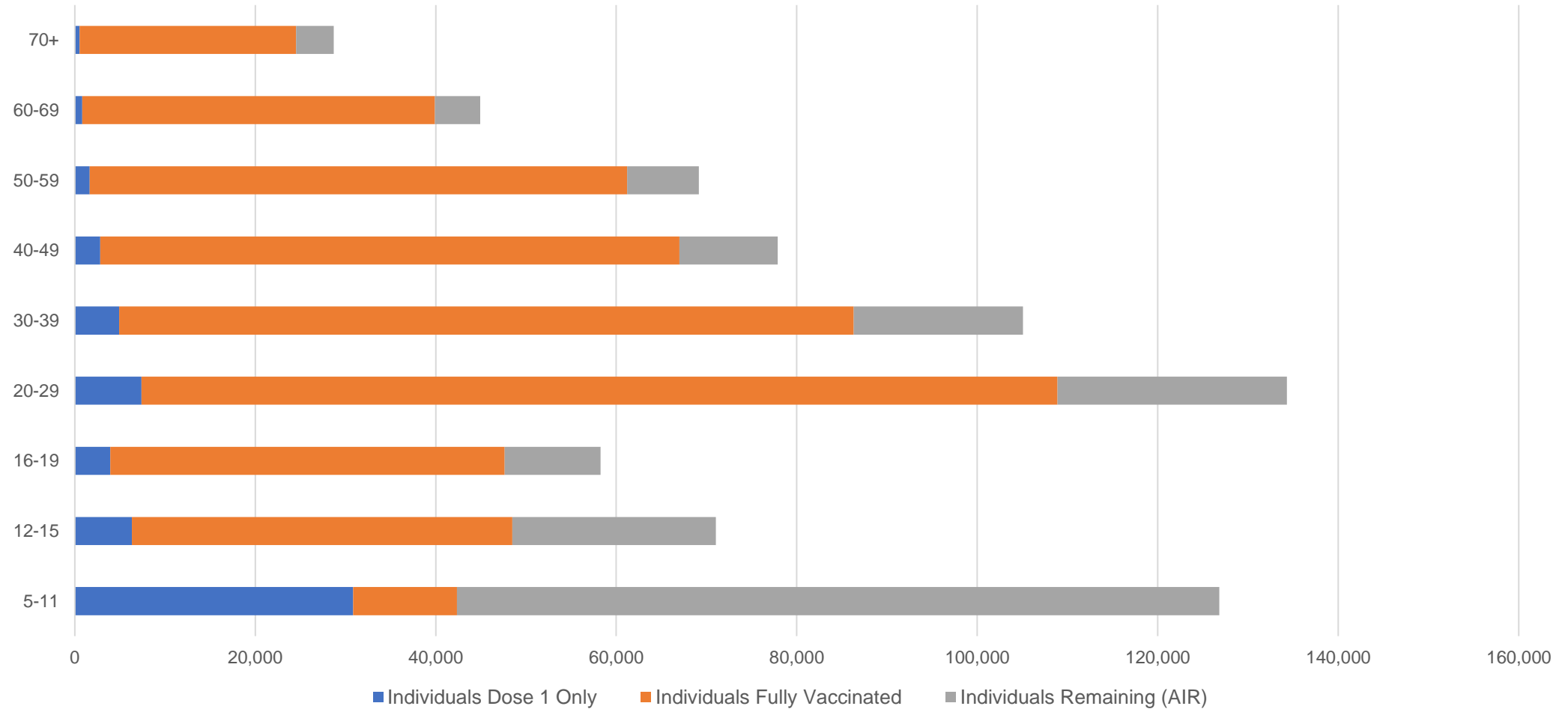

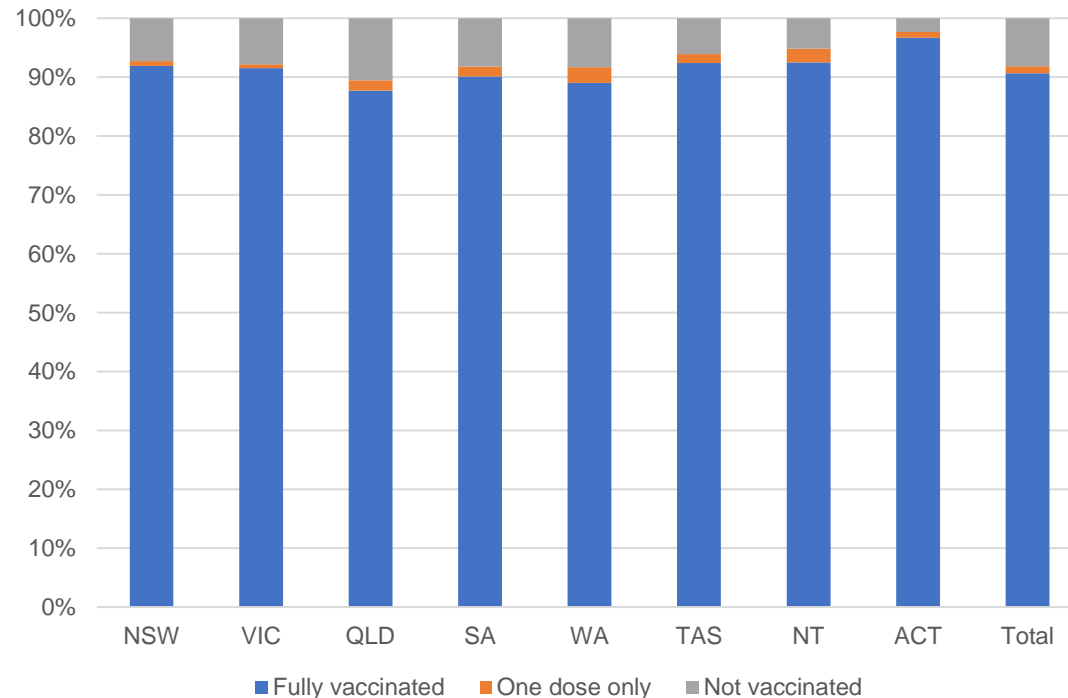

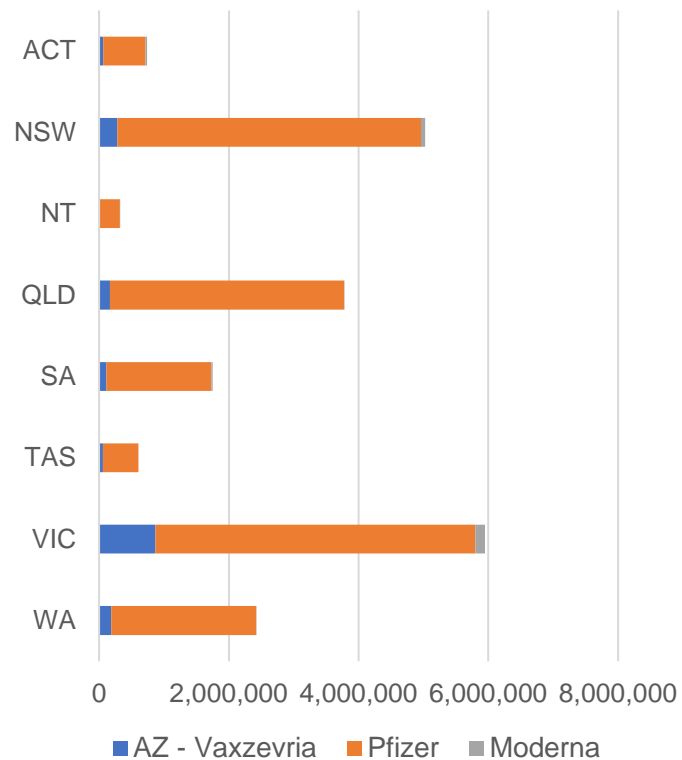

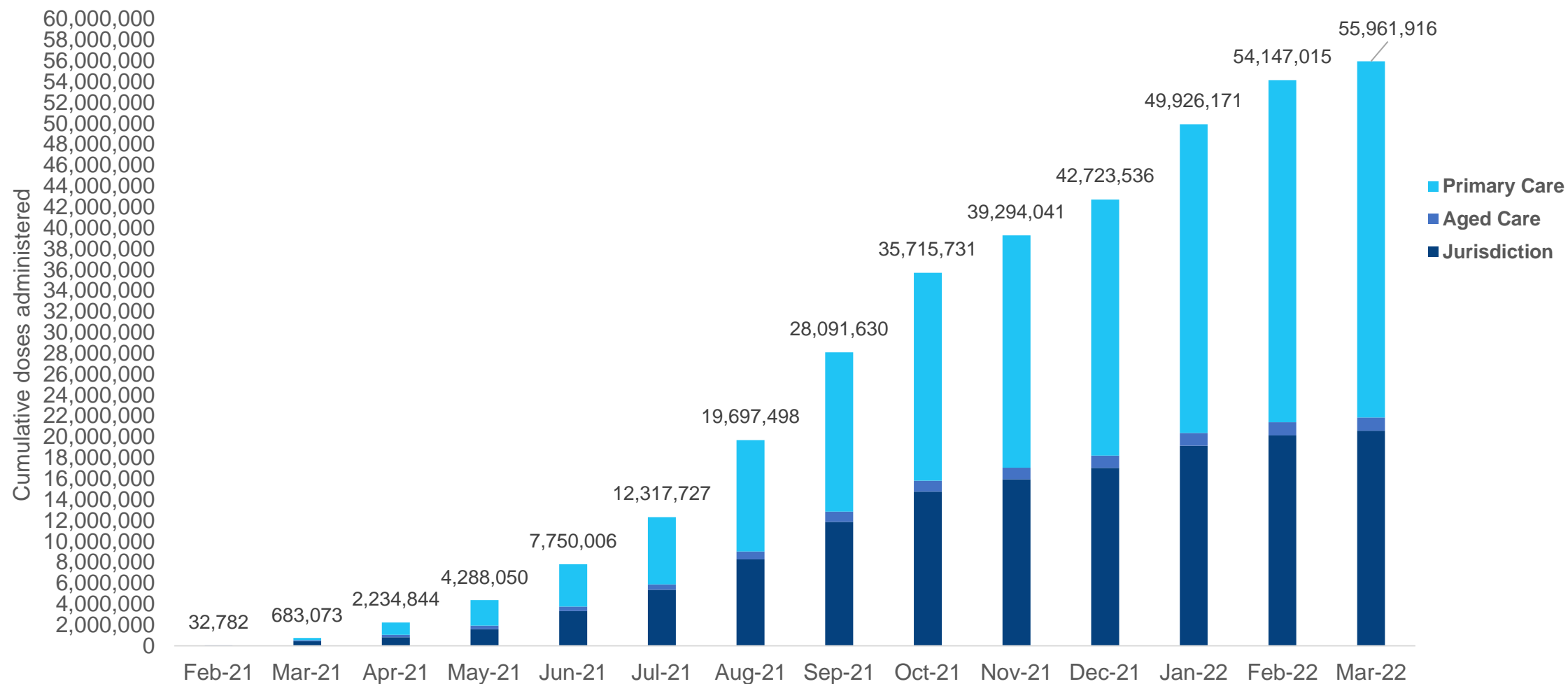

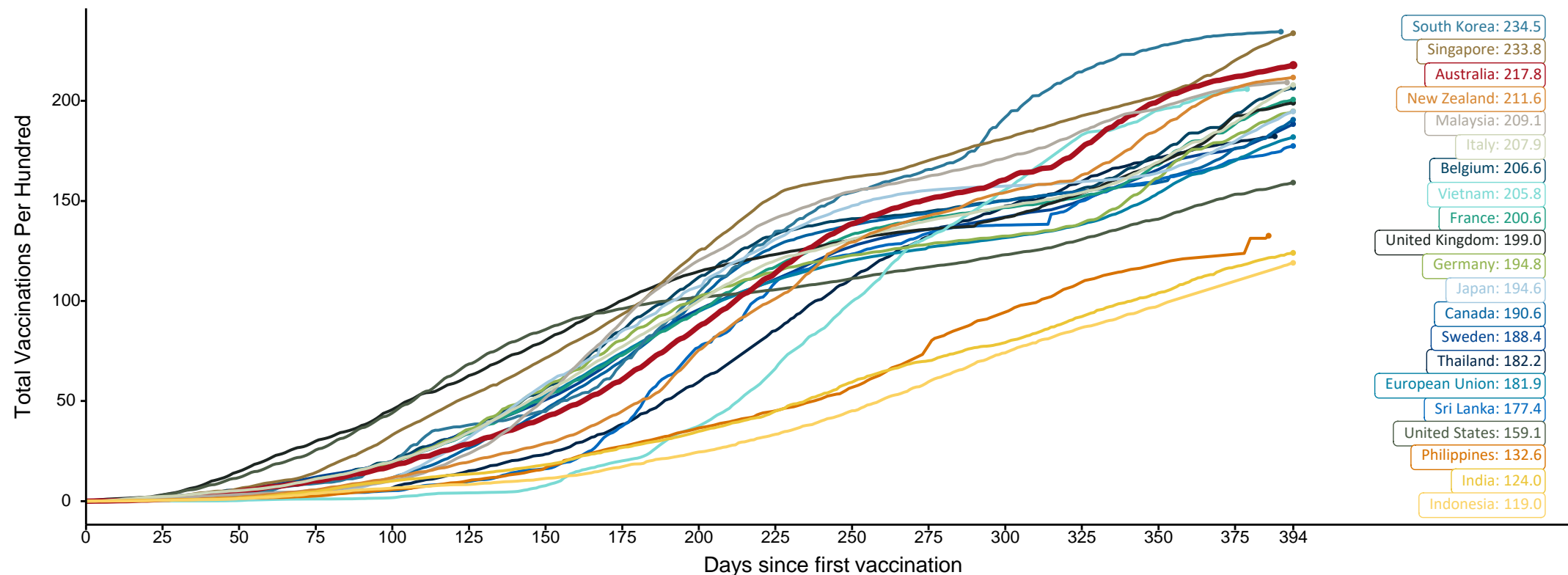

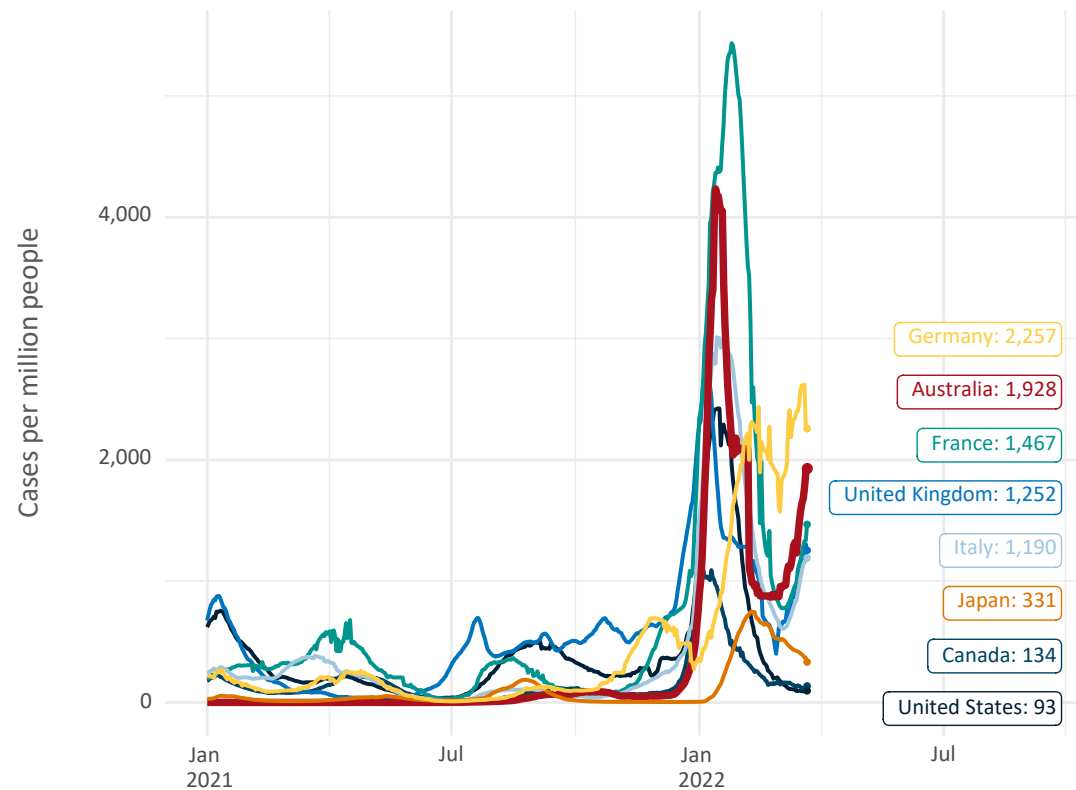

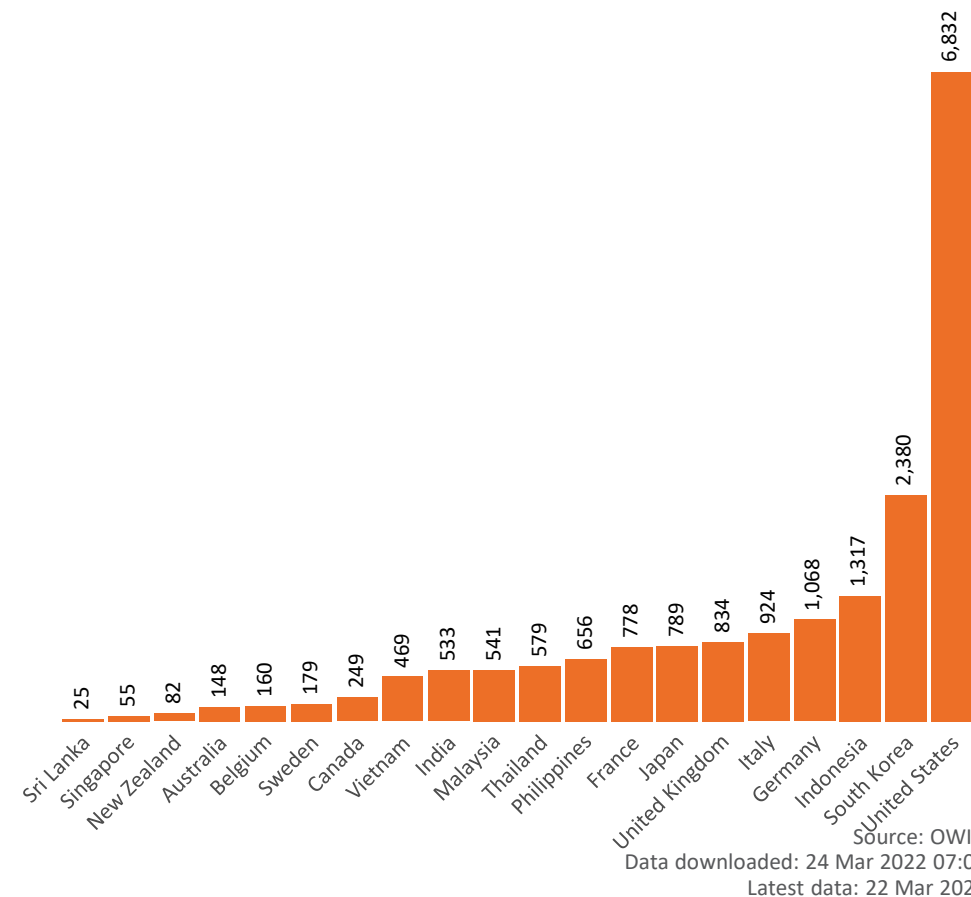

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries

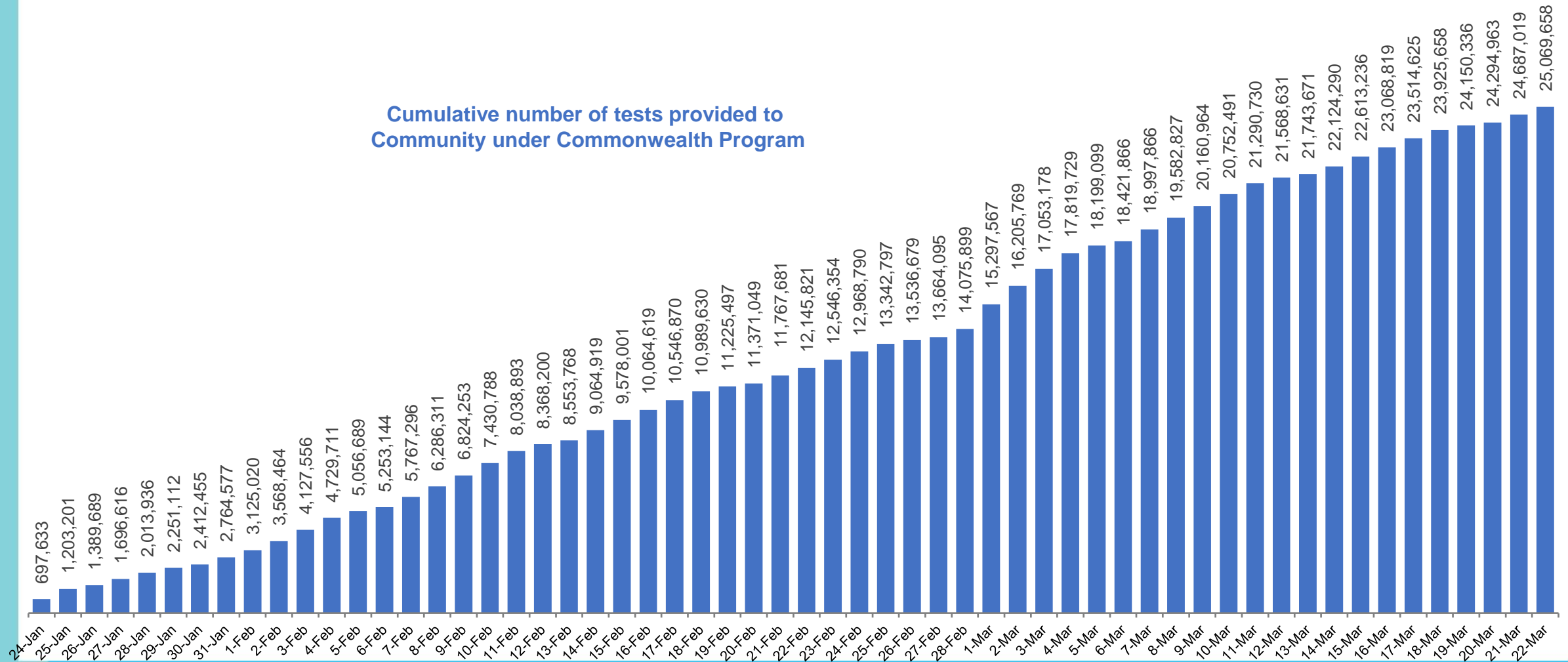

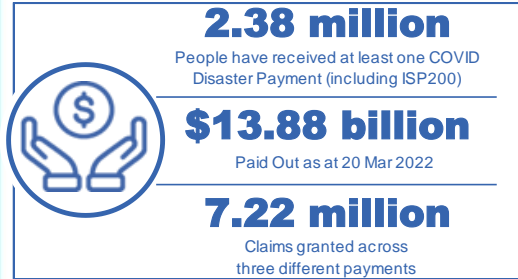
Cumulative number of tests provided to

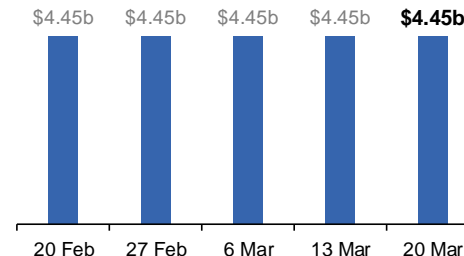

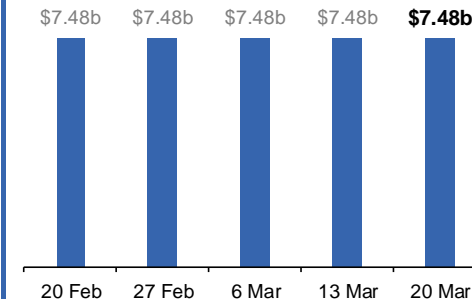

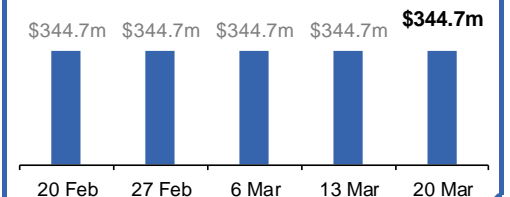
