









*Each square represents 1% of the national population. Squares are filled as milestones are achieved.

















Total vaccine doses administered in State and Territory clinics as at 02 March












New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries
