








Vaccine milestone charts




Eligible population percentage coverage




Commonwealth aged care and disability doses administered











Total vaccine doses administered in State and Territory clinics as at 05 March












New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries
