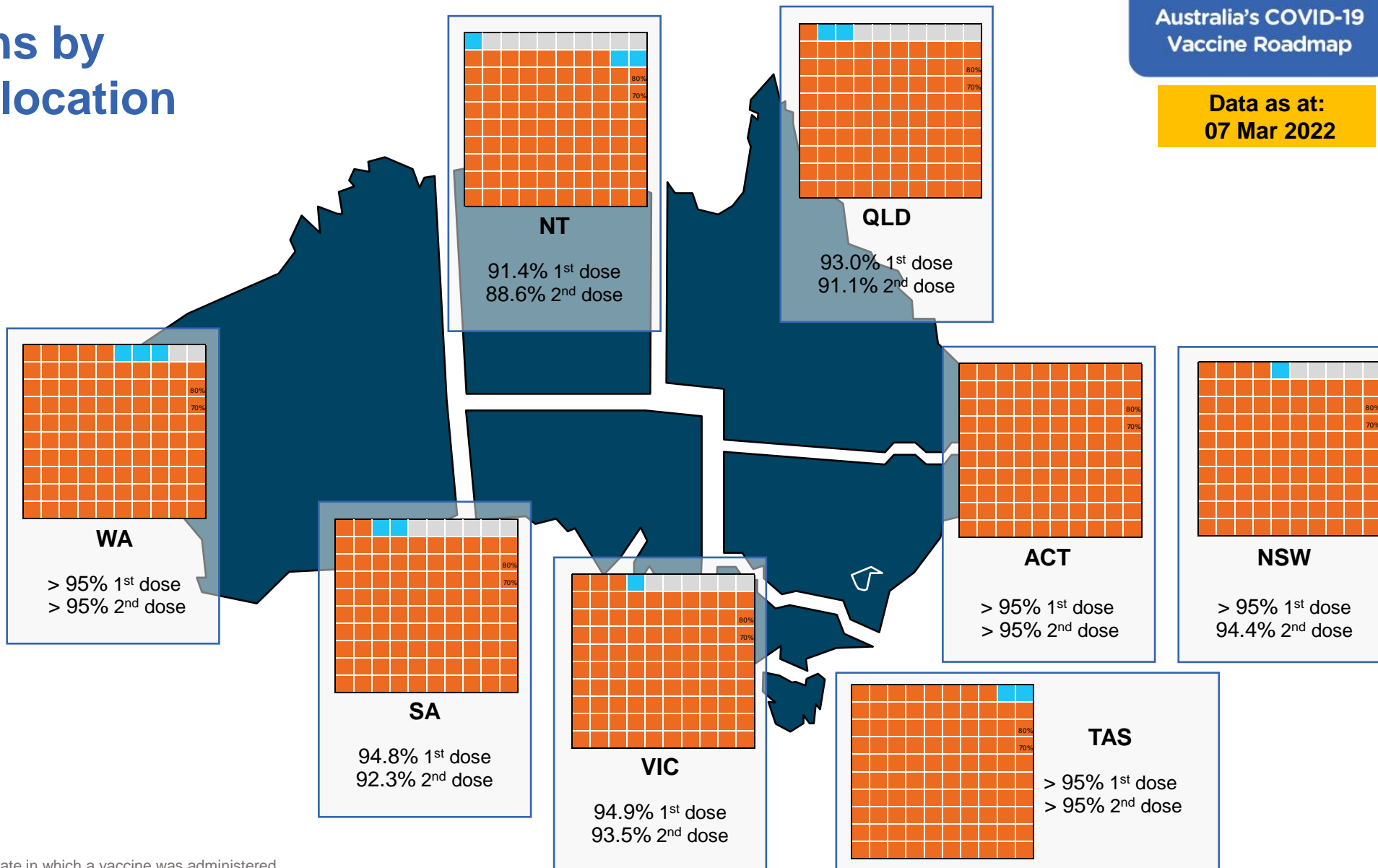

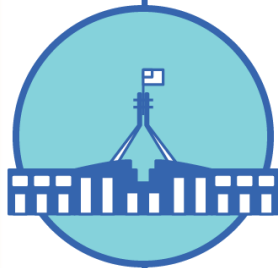

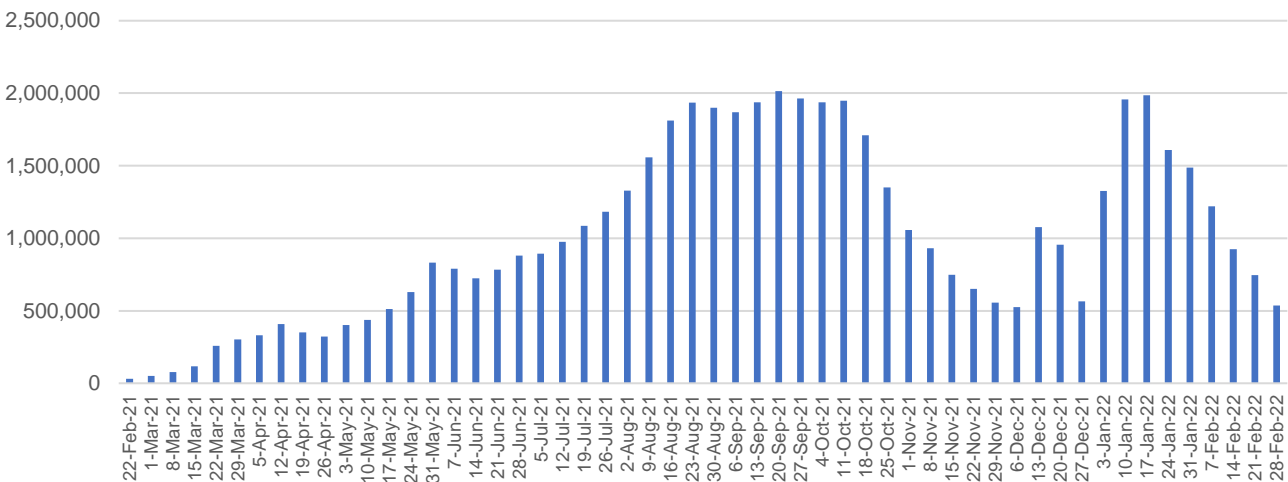

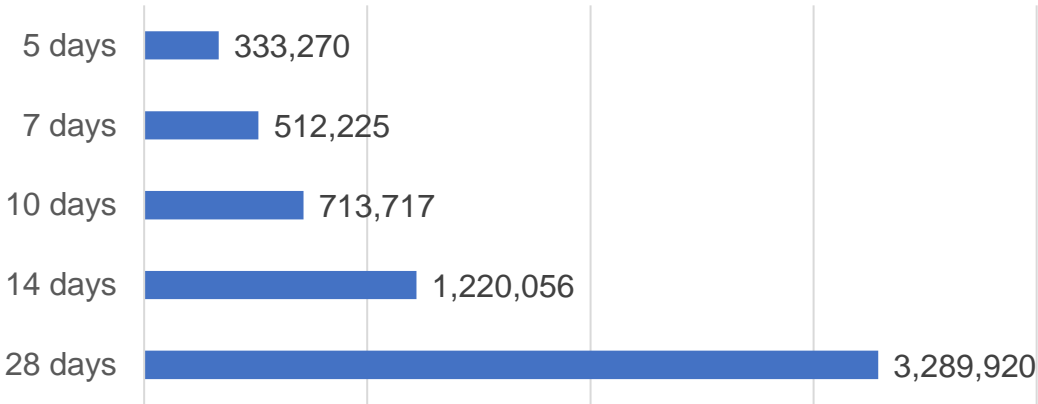

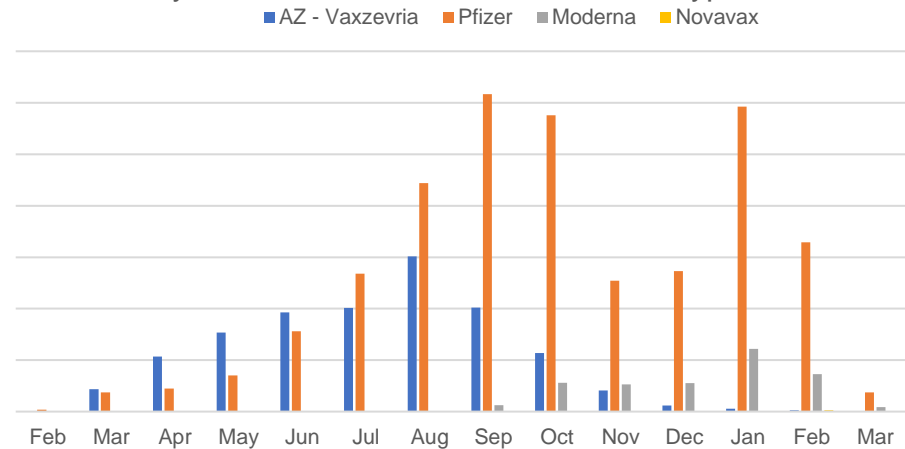
Doses Administered by Week



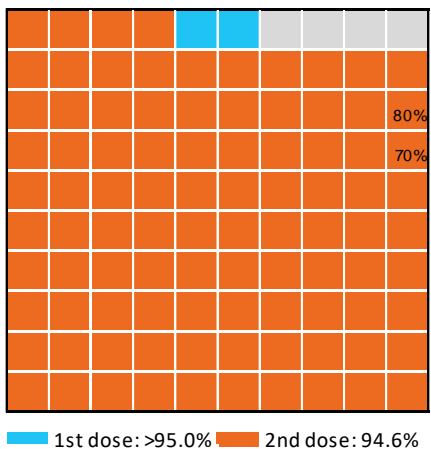
Doses Reported

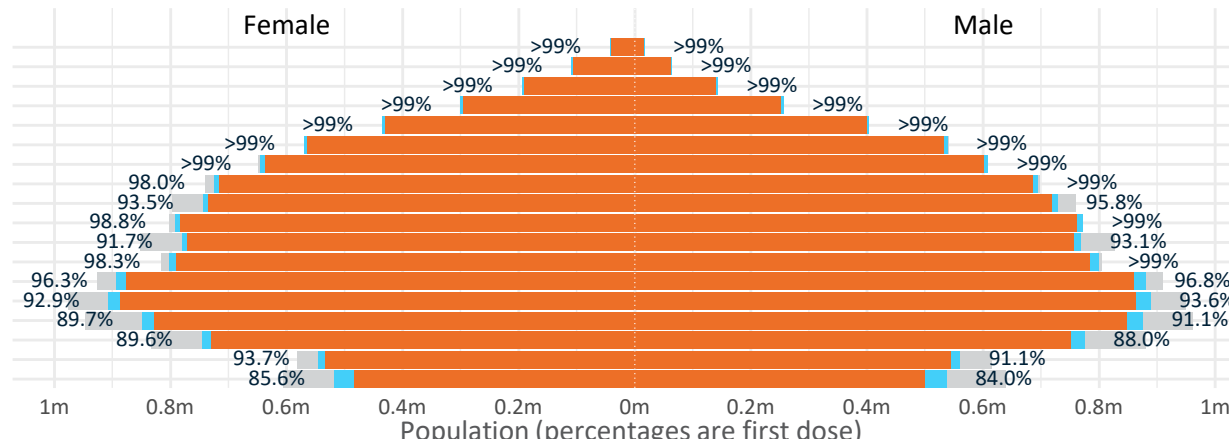

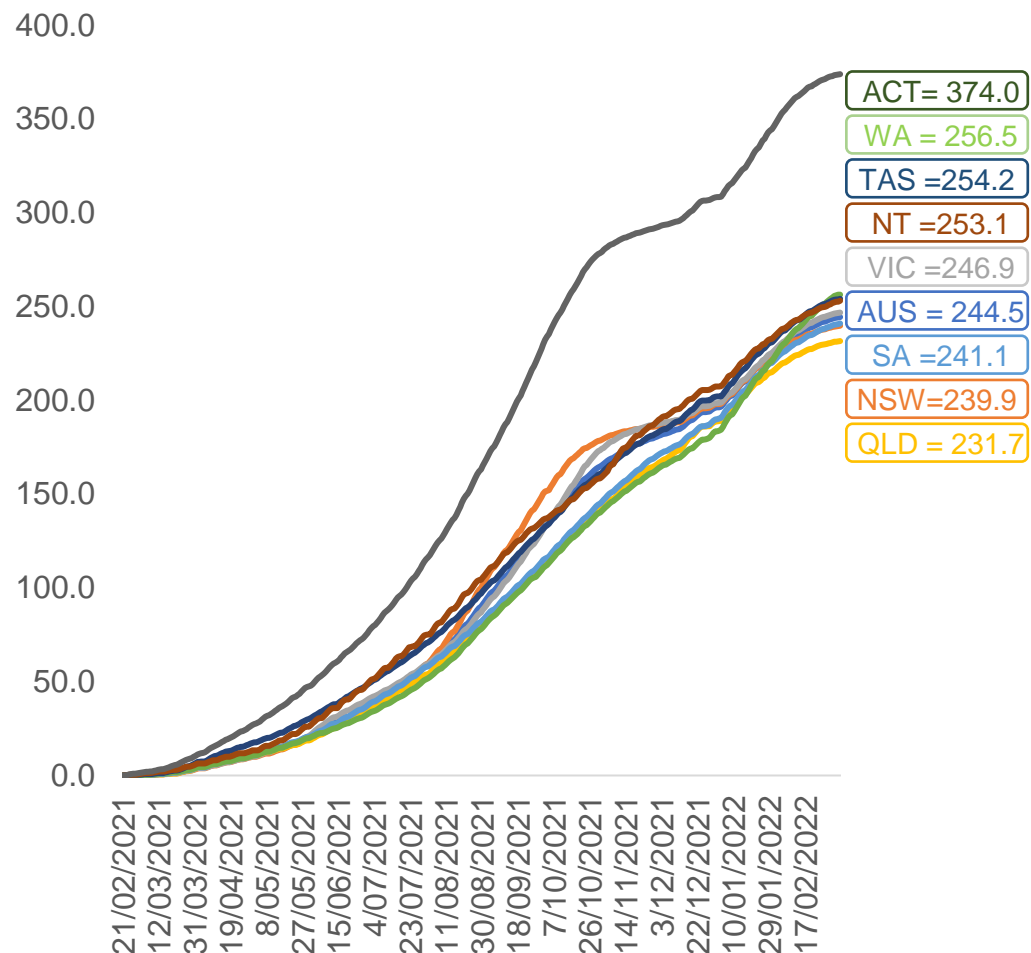

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations*

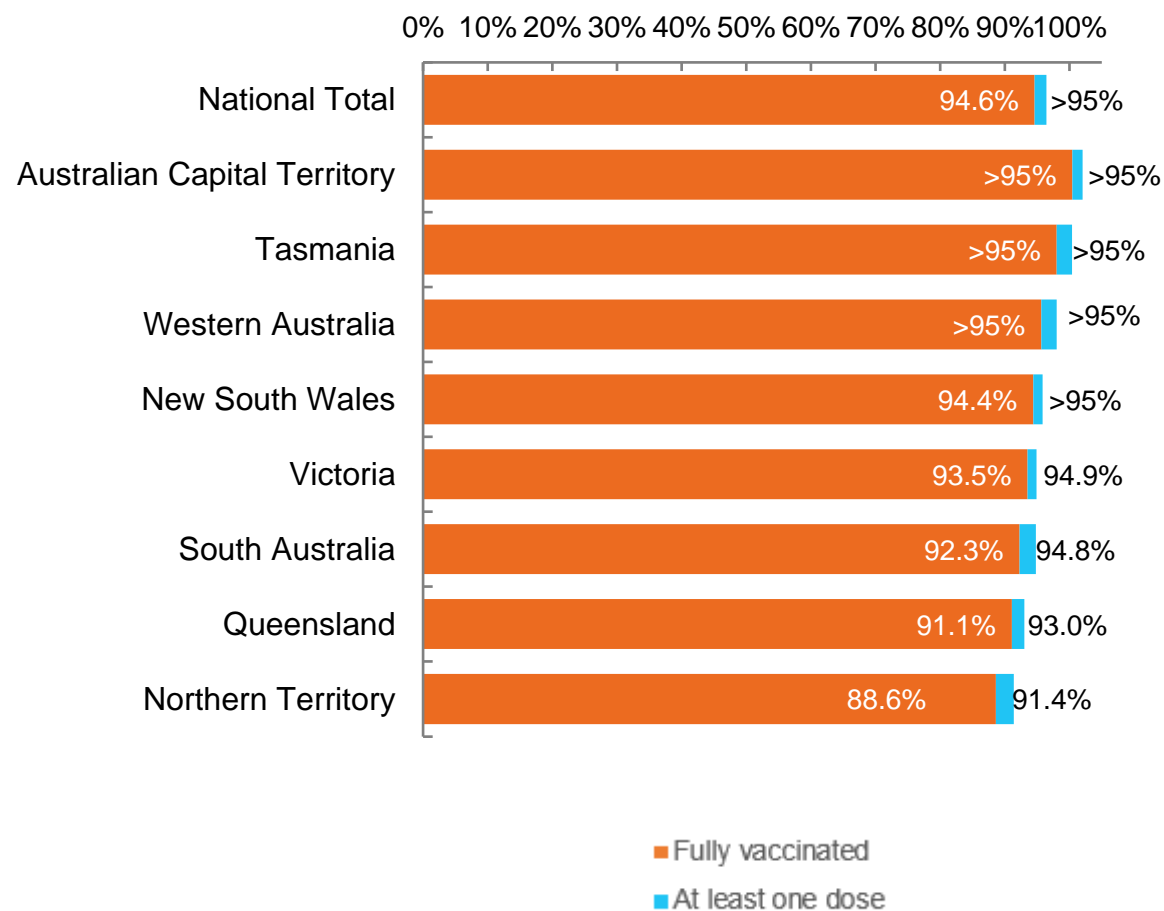

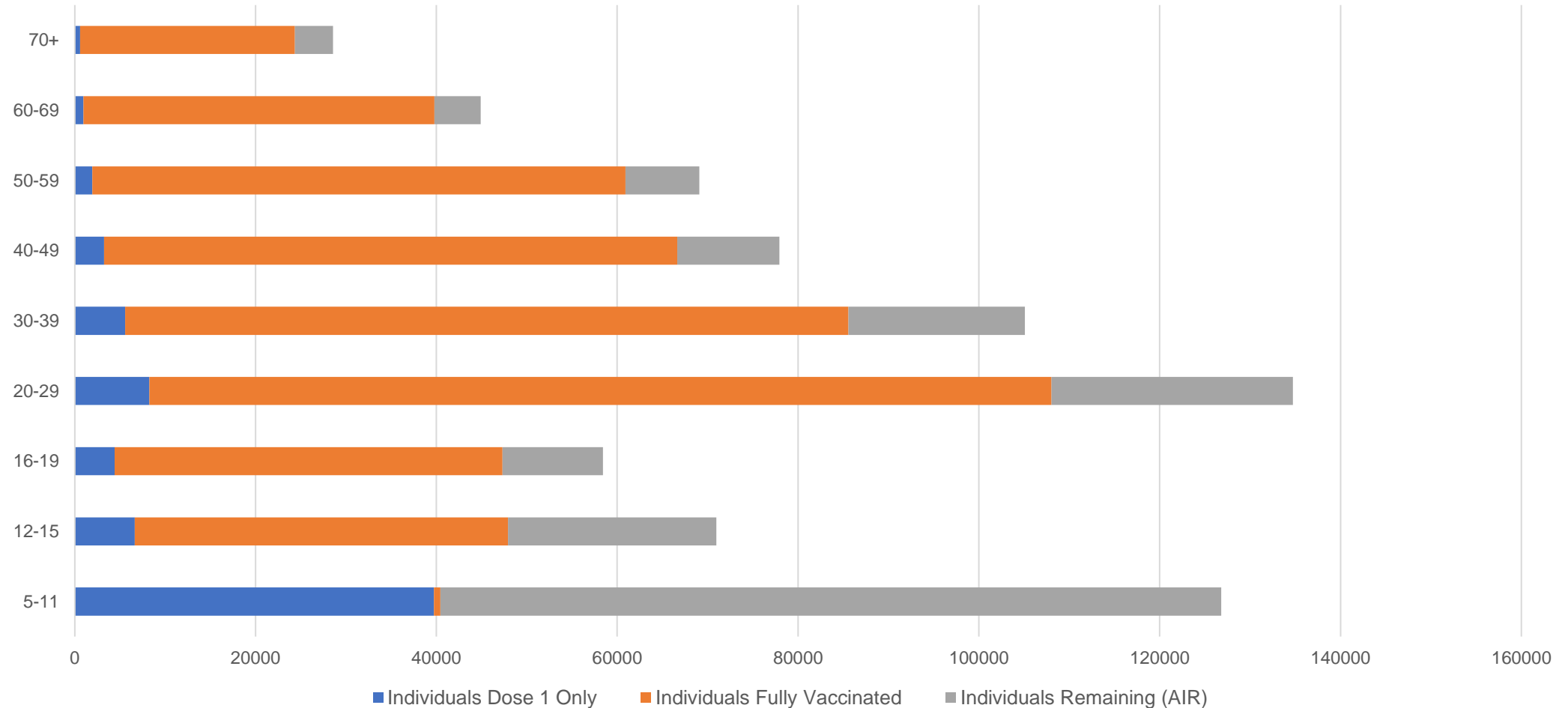

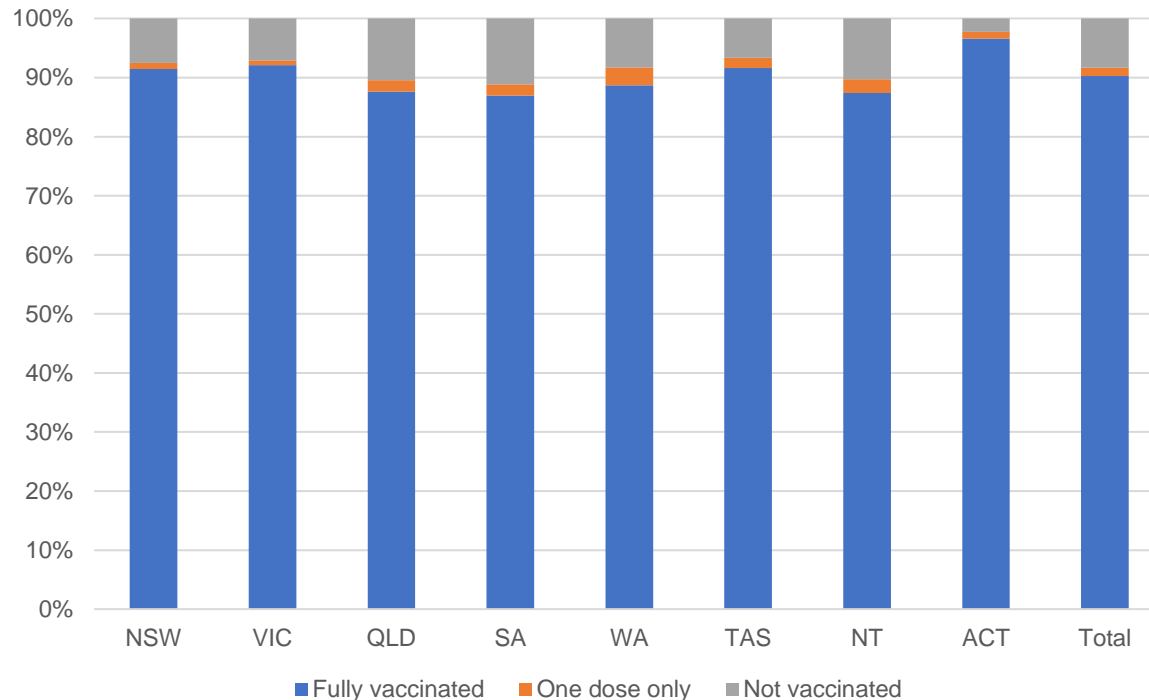

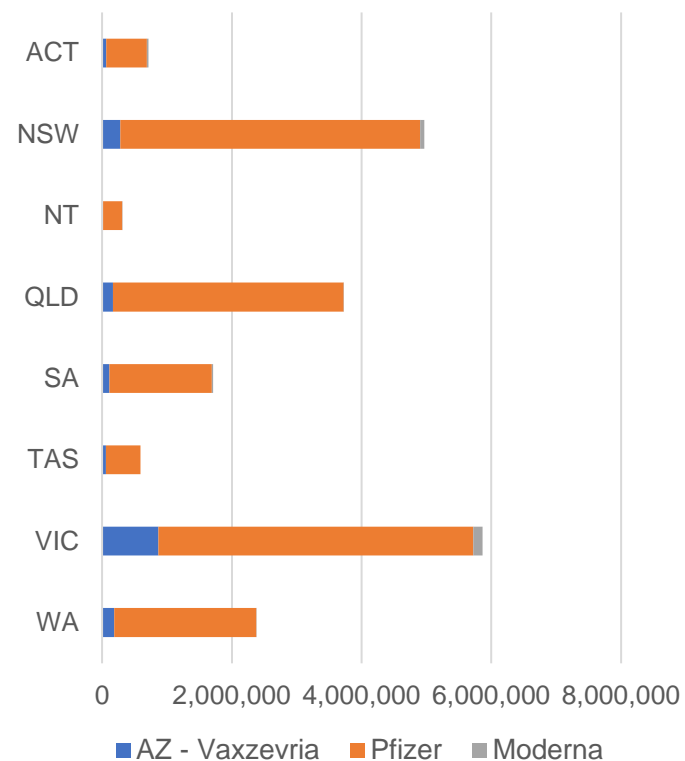

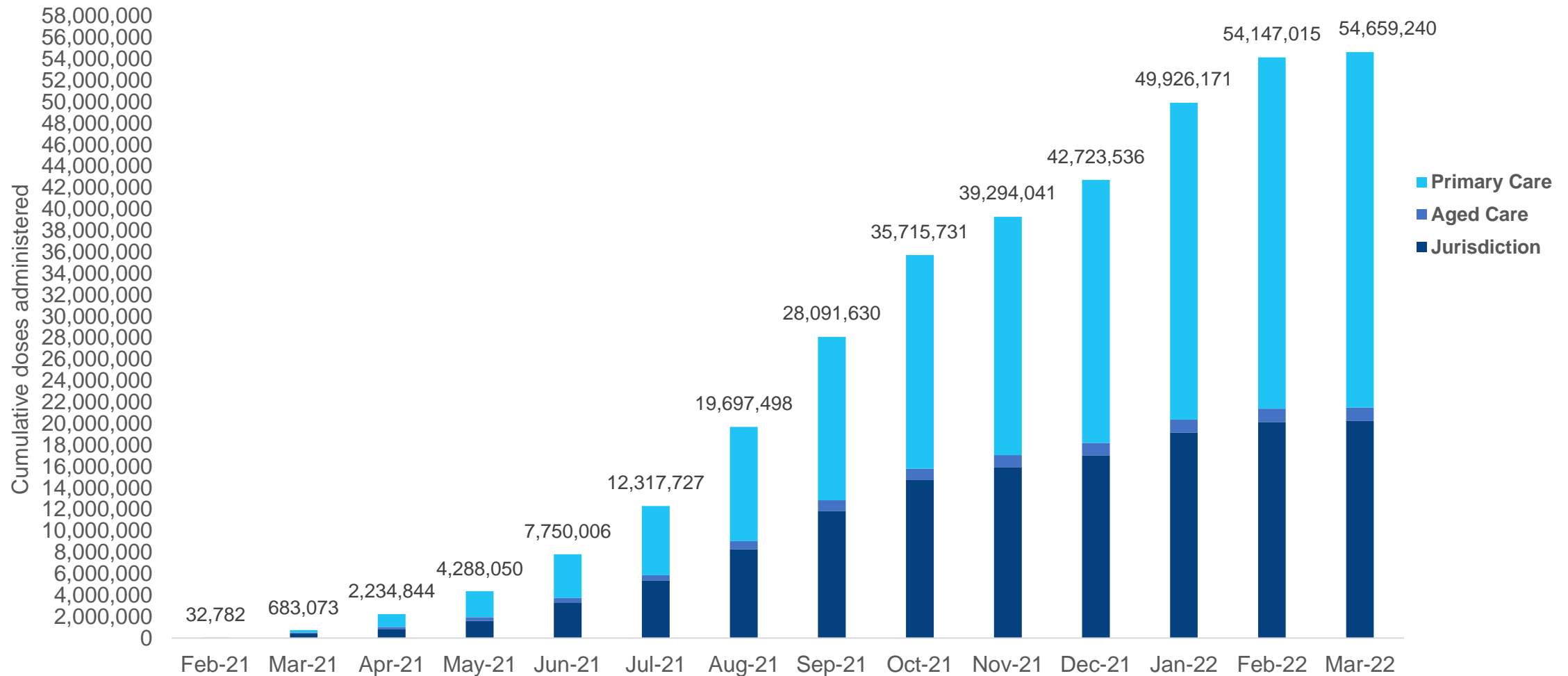

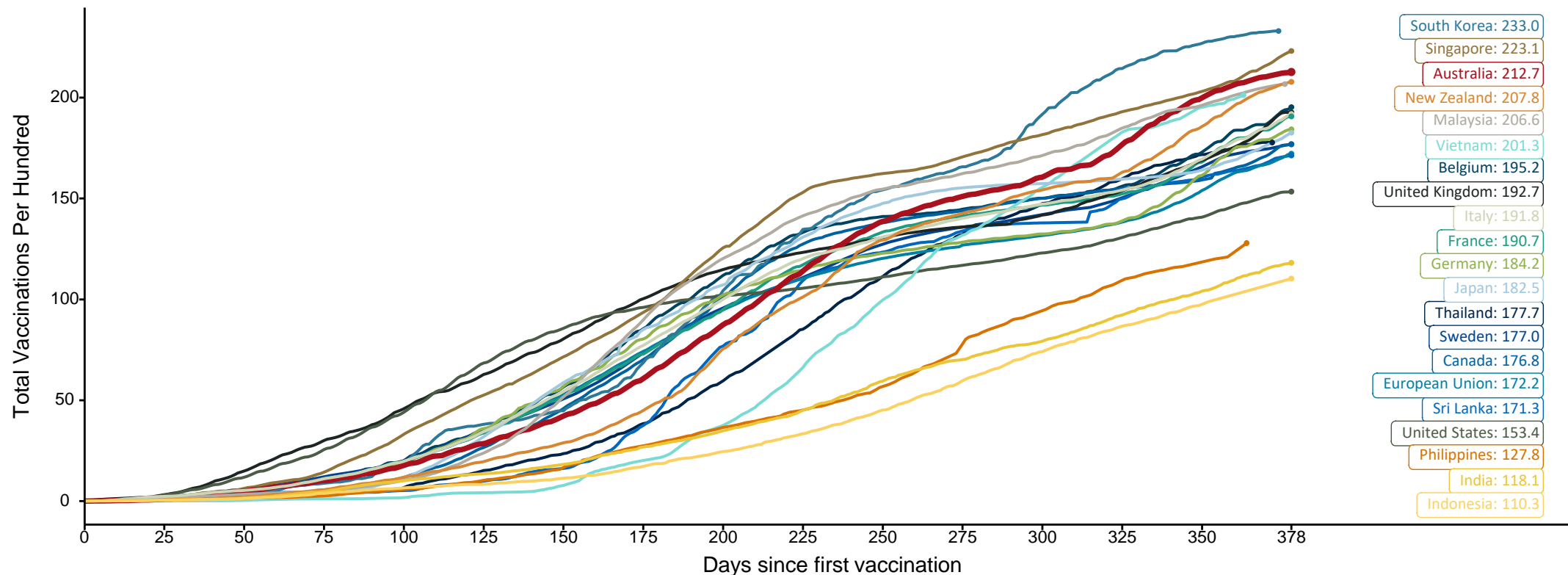

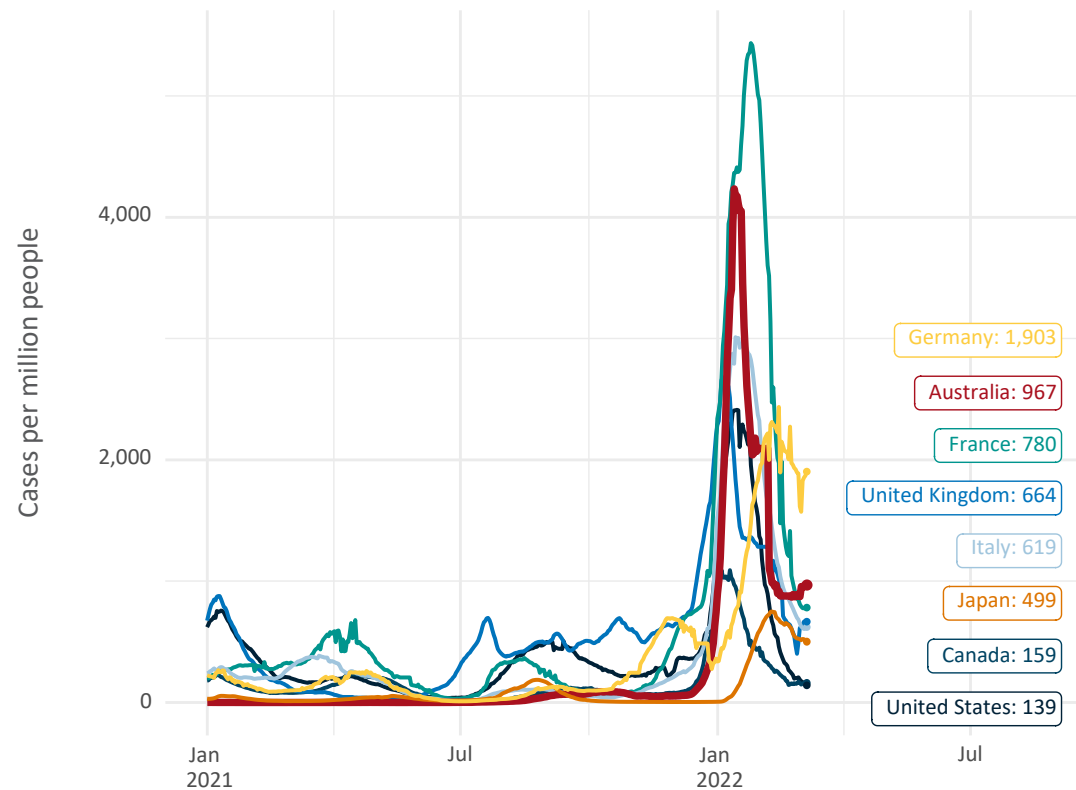

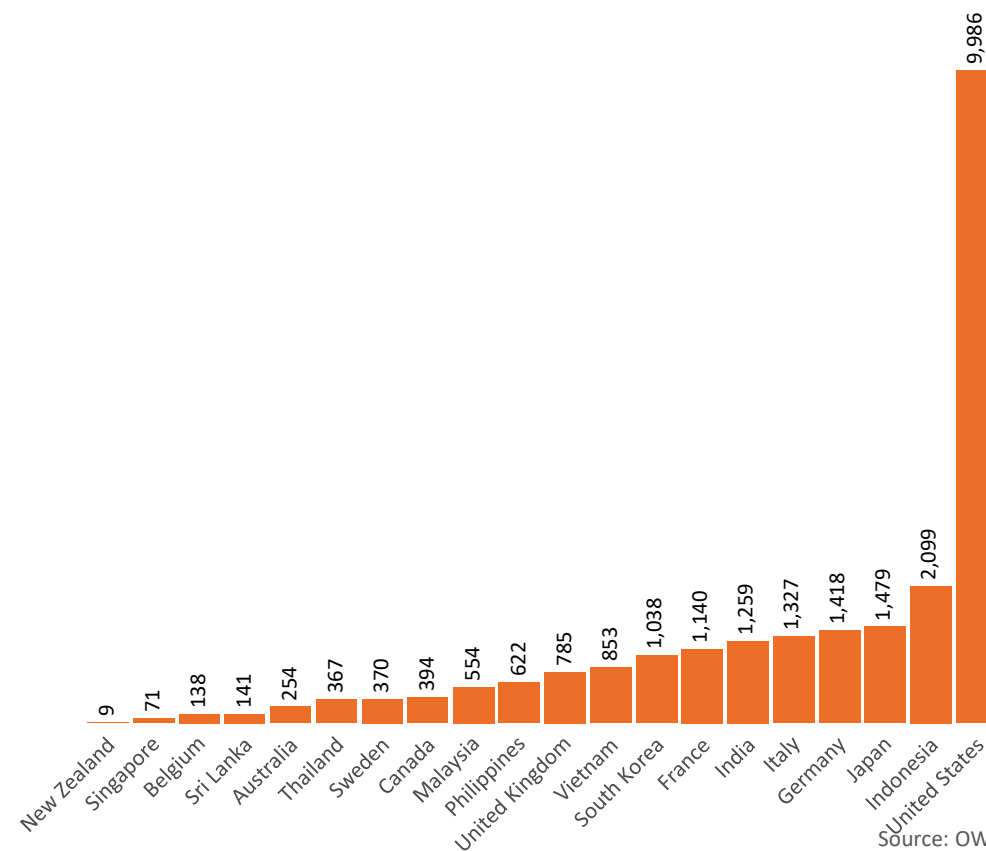

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries



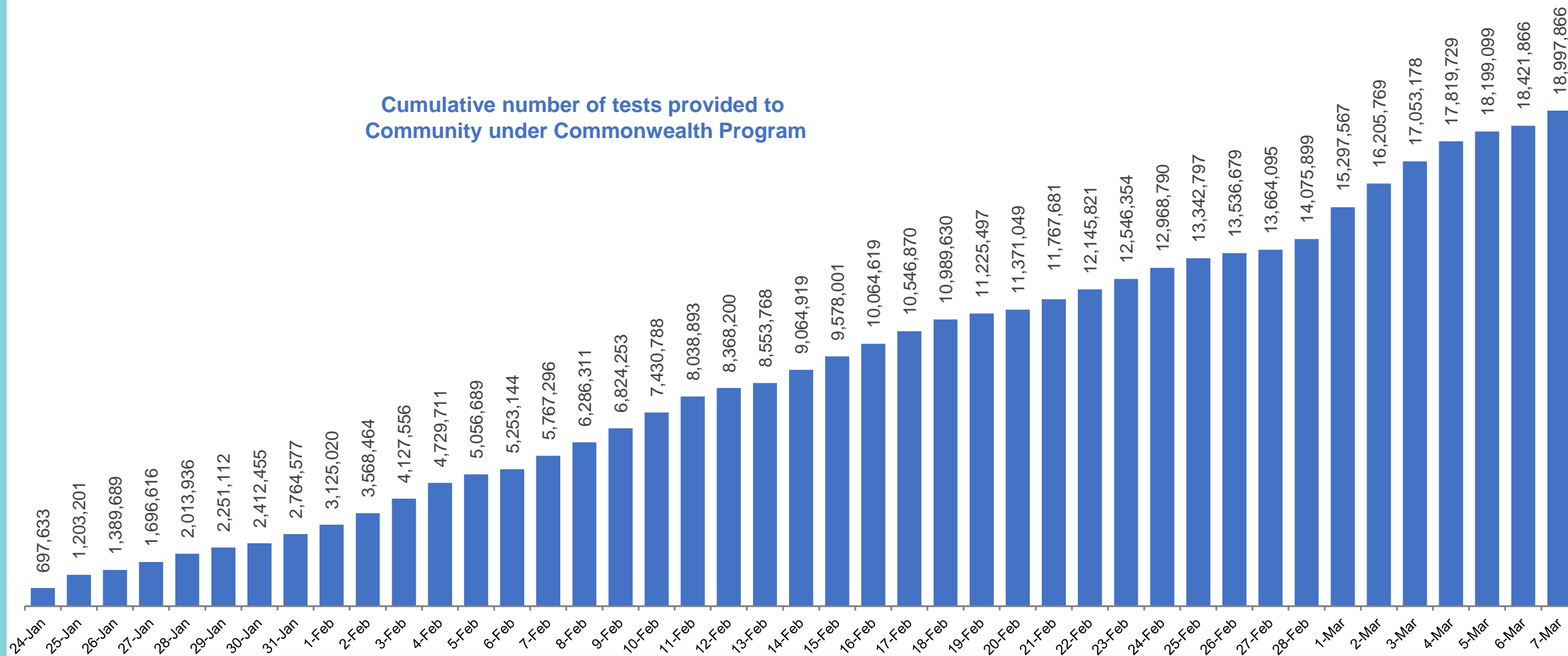

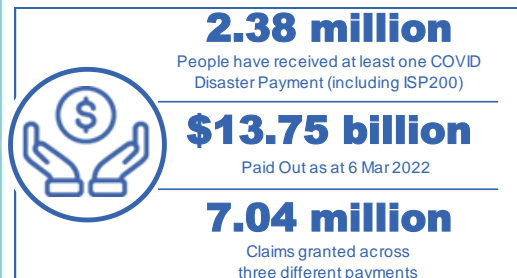
Cumulative number of tests provided to

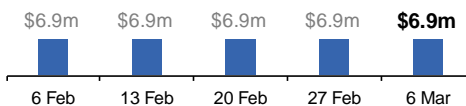

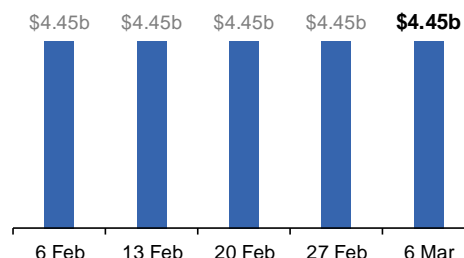

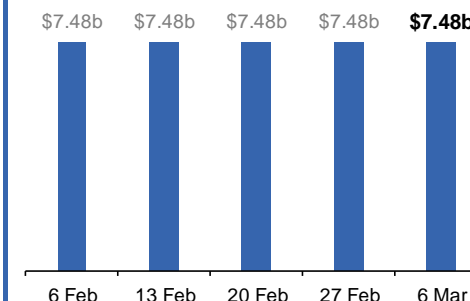

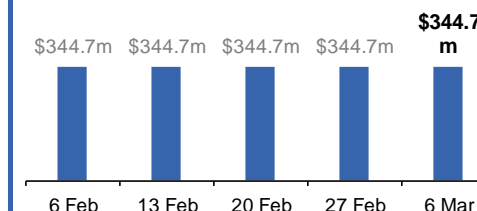
