



Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee

Communique – 16 March 2021

The fifth meeting of the Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee (TCLTAC) was held on 16 March 2021.

Following on from the previous meeting, members discussed the scope of functions that need to be considered within the future arrangements for GP training, including registrar and supervisor support, and academic research posts.

The Department reiterated that the Australian Government's funding commitment to GP training will be reinvested, at current levels, into the new arrangements.

A particular focus for the meeting was to further discuss how registrars will navigate their training journey through the transition process, including key contacts for support at each point in the transition. Members noted the need for clear communication with registrars on this process. The registrar experience will continue to be a key consideration in the development of the transition arrangements.

Members noted the establishment of the Advisory Network of the National Rural Health Commissioner (ANNRHC). TCLTAC will provide regular updates to the ANNRHC on transition planning and will seek ANNRHC's views in relation to the geographic distribution impacts of its proposed transition model(s).
