




























# Doses at equivalent stages of rollout (Day 416)

Cumulative doses administered (14 Apr): 57,157,973






New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average


COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries
