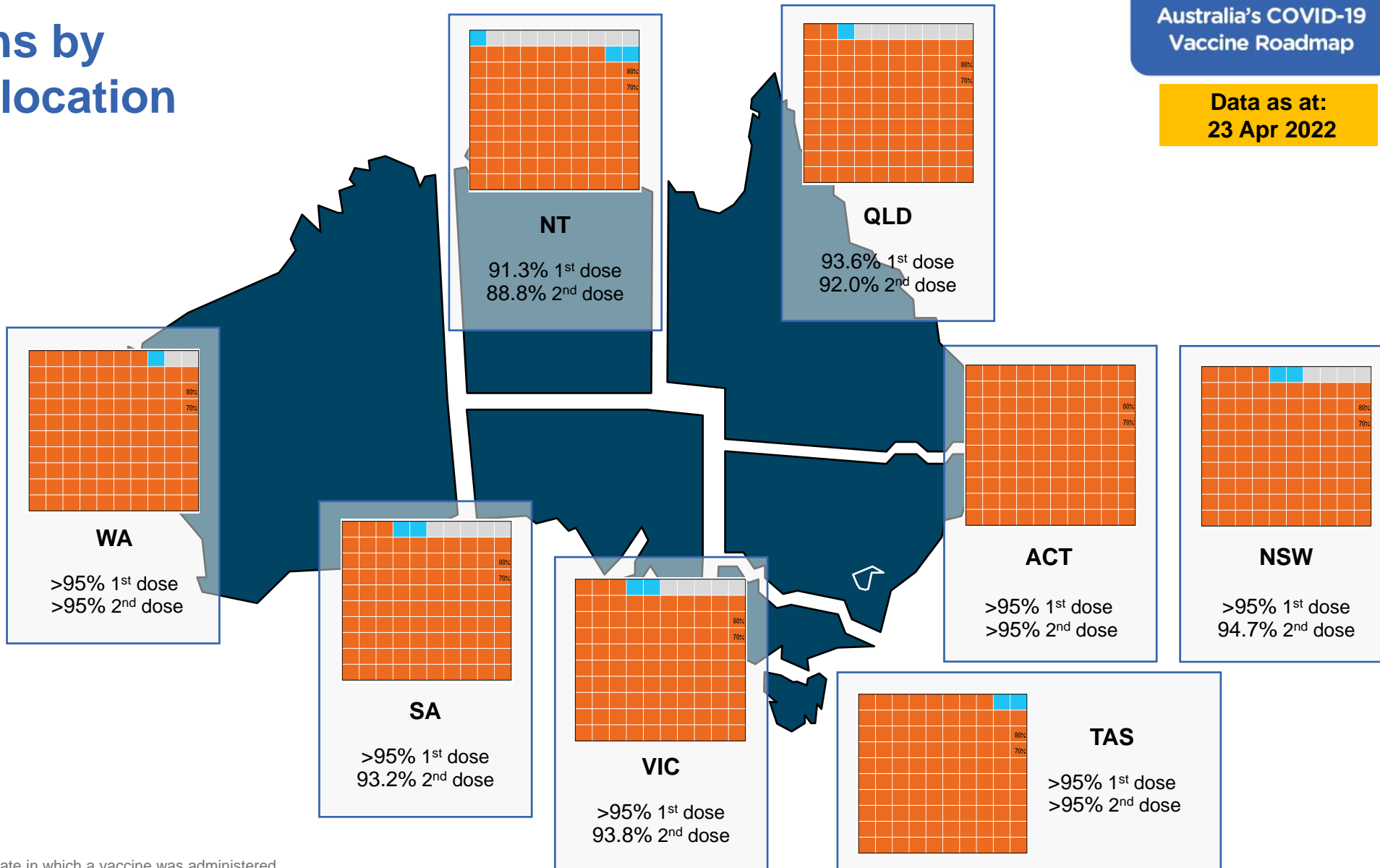

Commonwealth and Jurisdiction vaccine doses administered

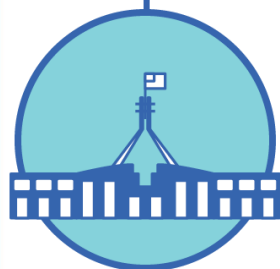

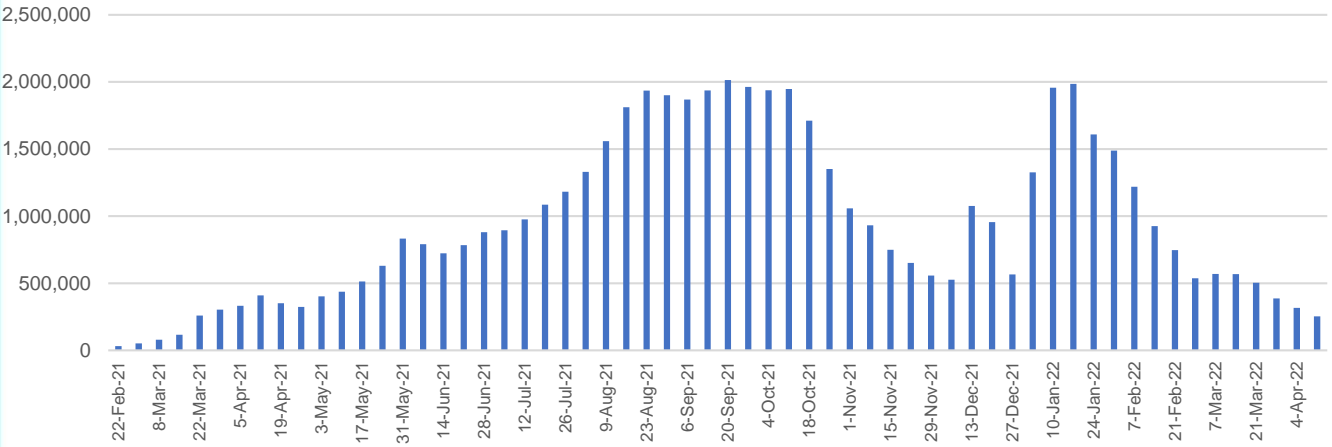

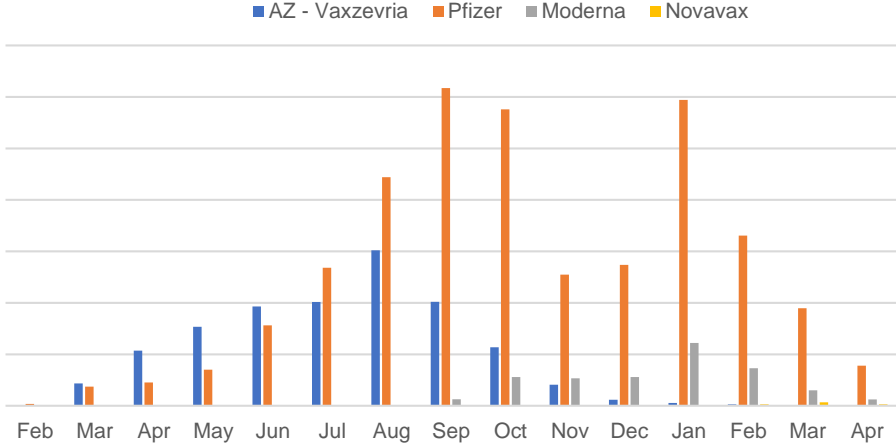

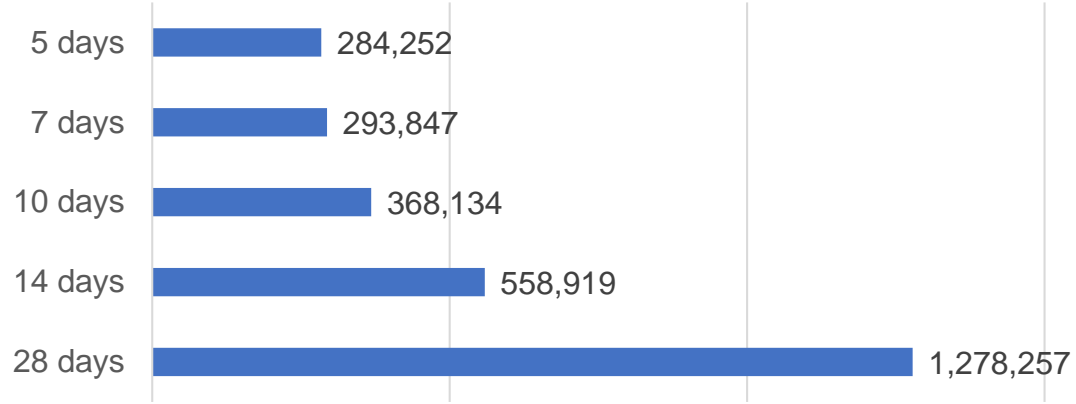
Doses Administered by Week



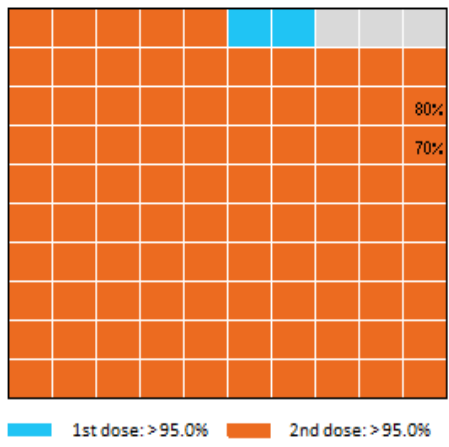
Doses by administration month and vaccine type

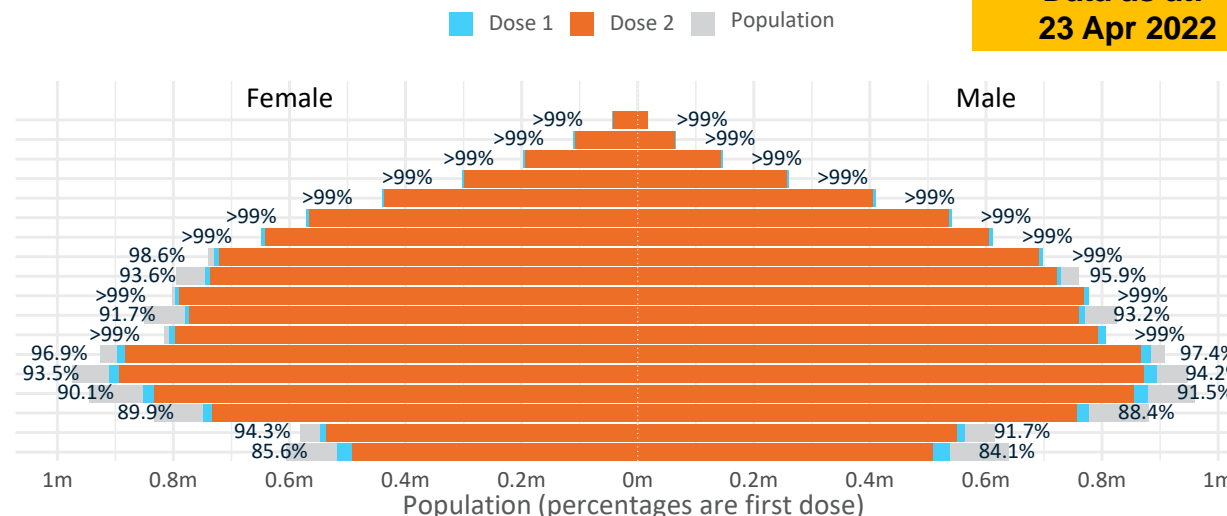

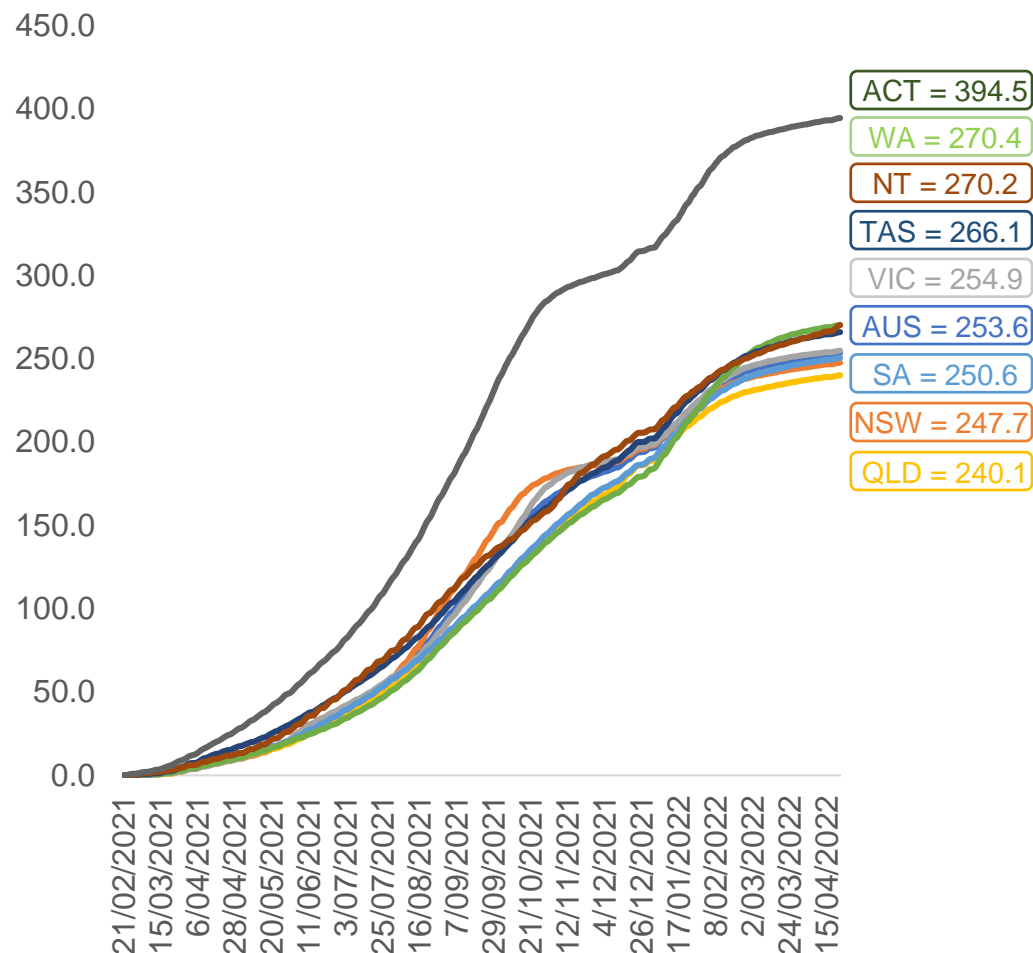

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations*

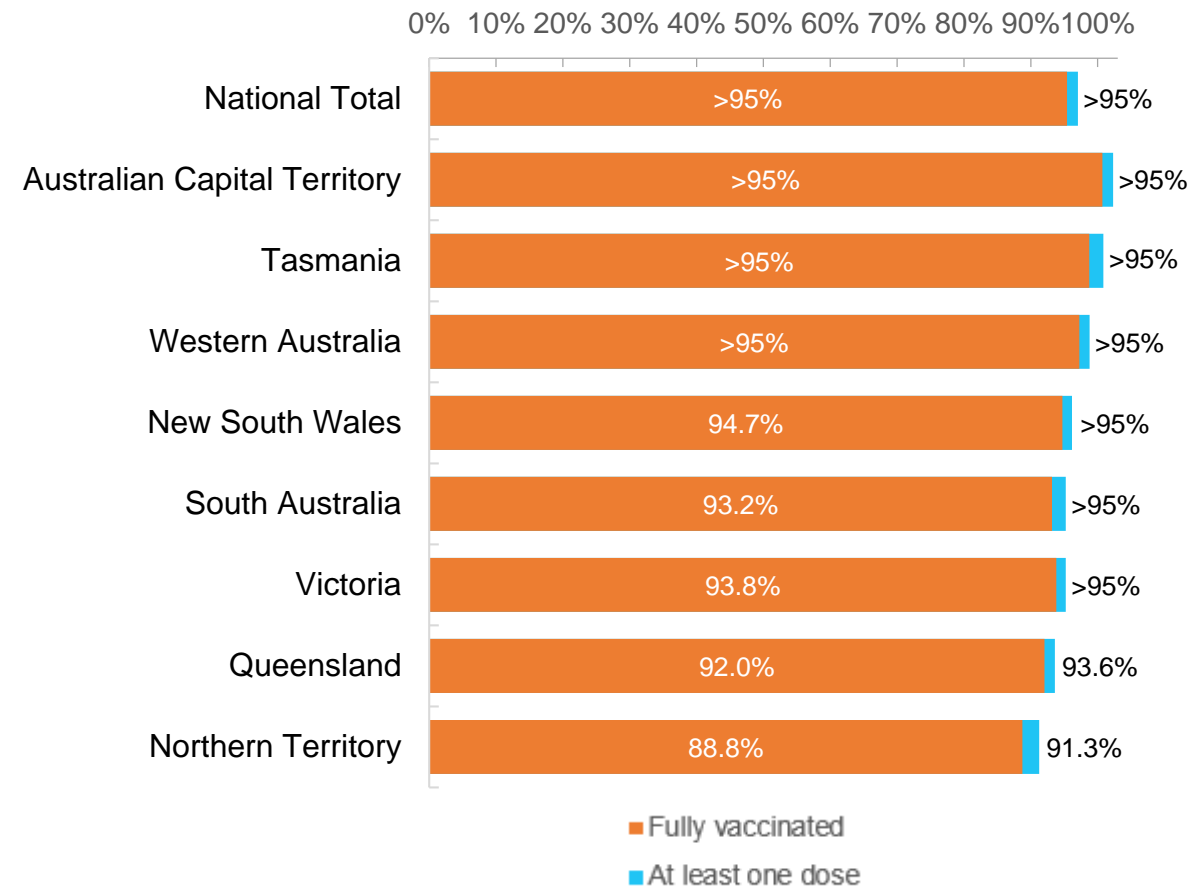

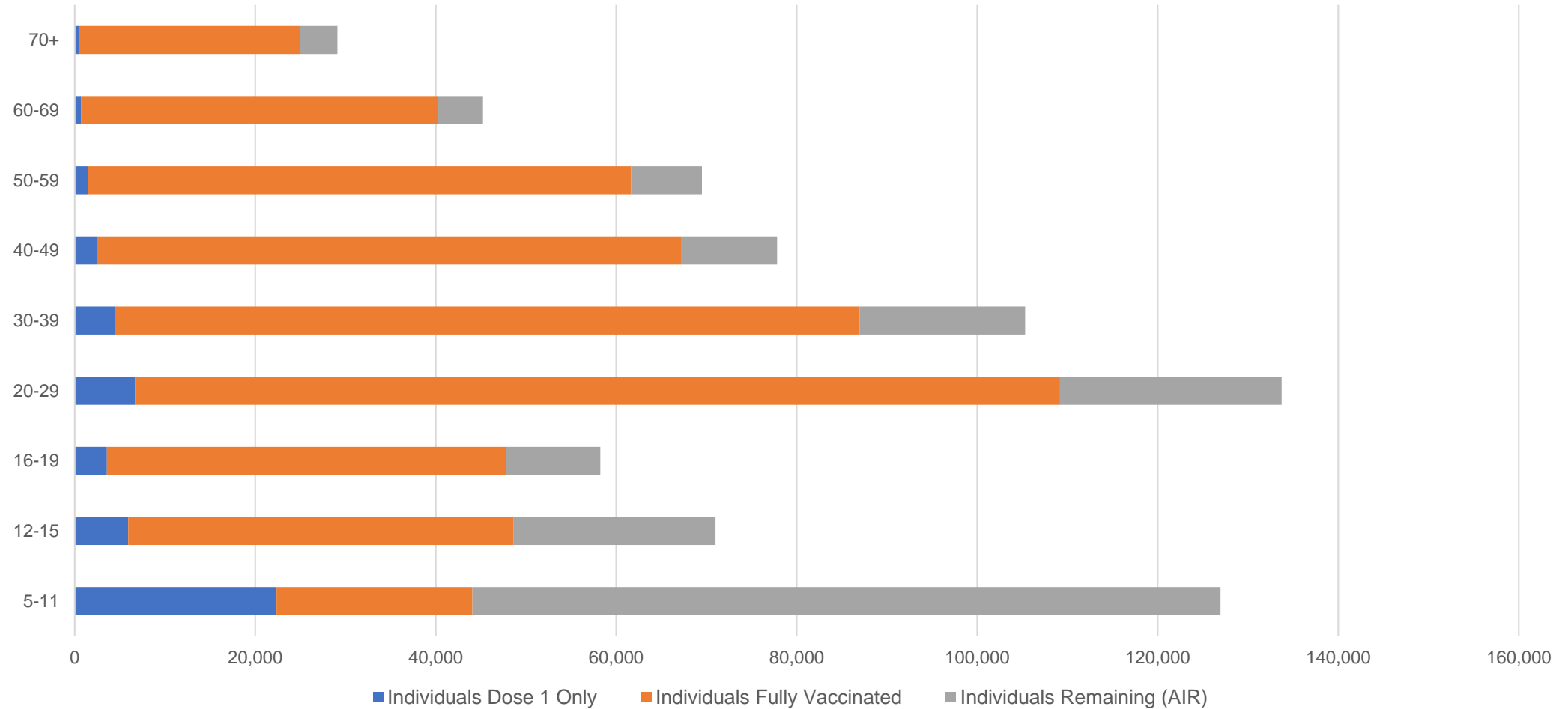

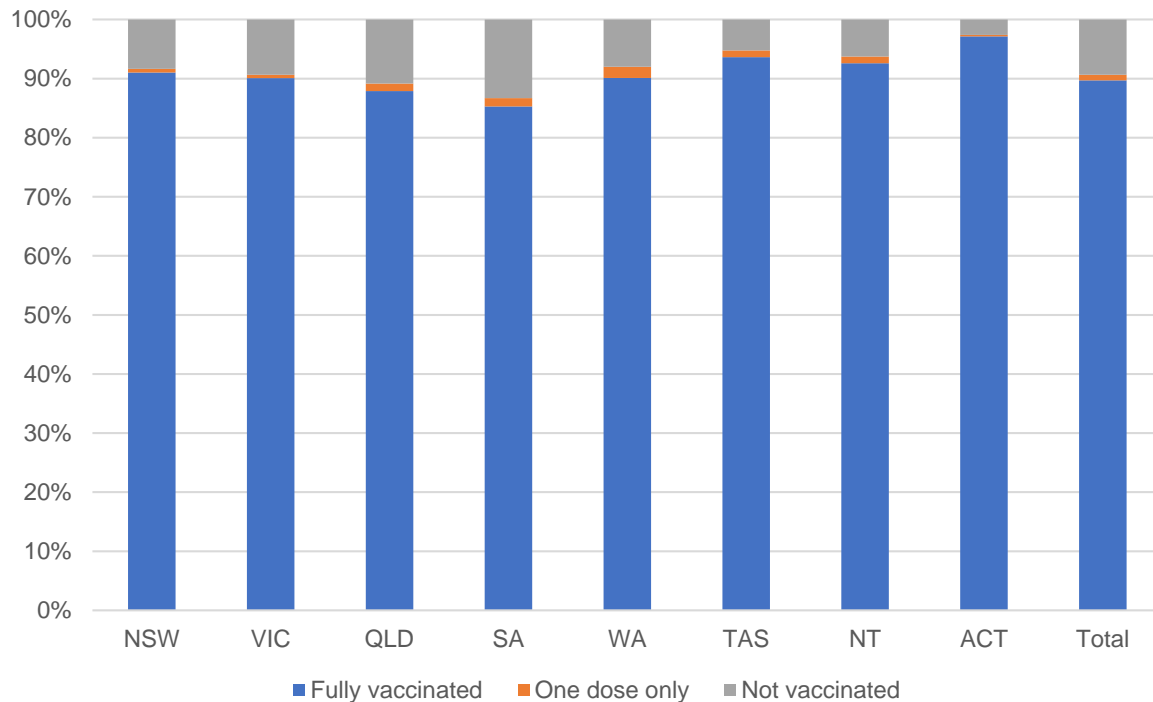

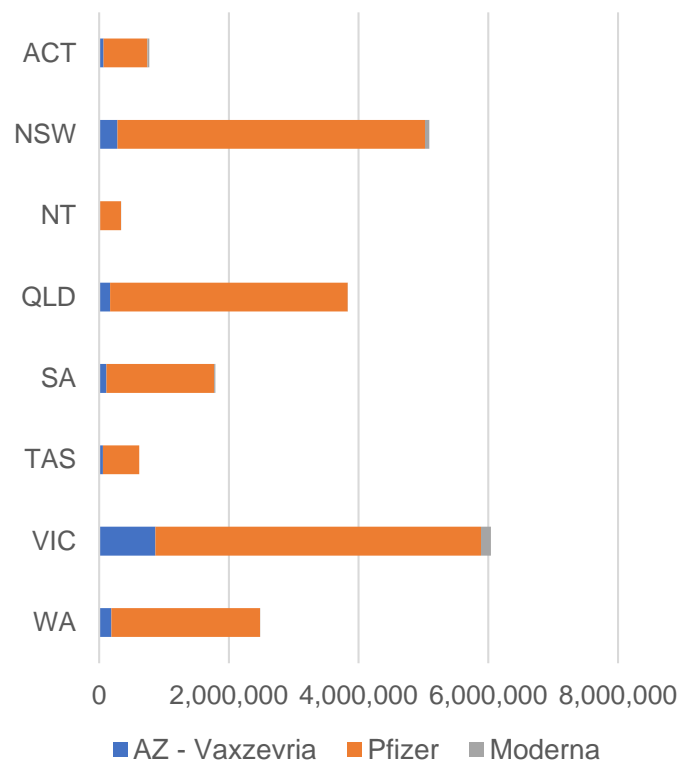

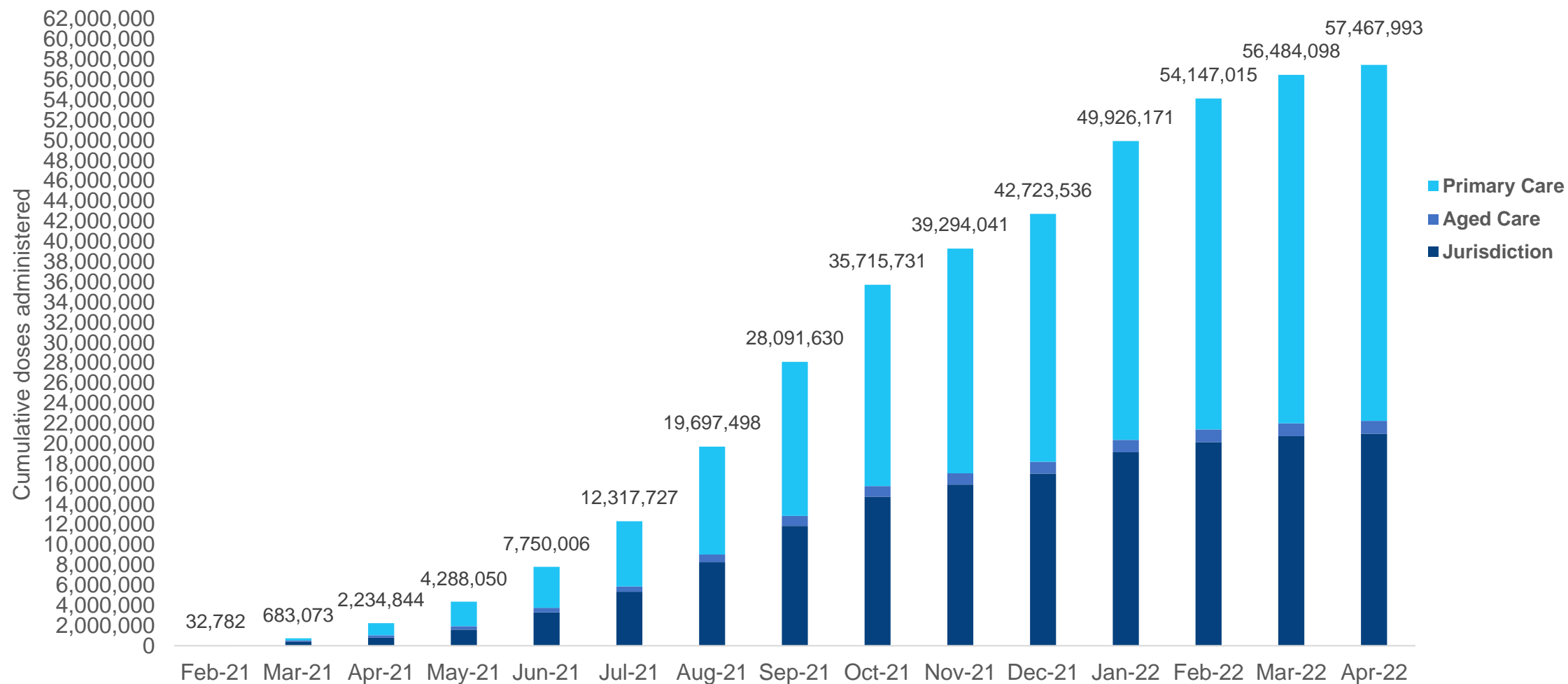

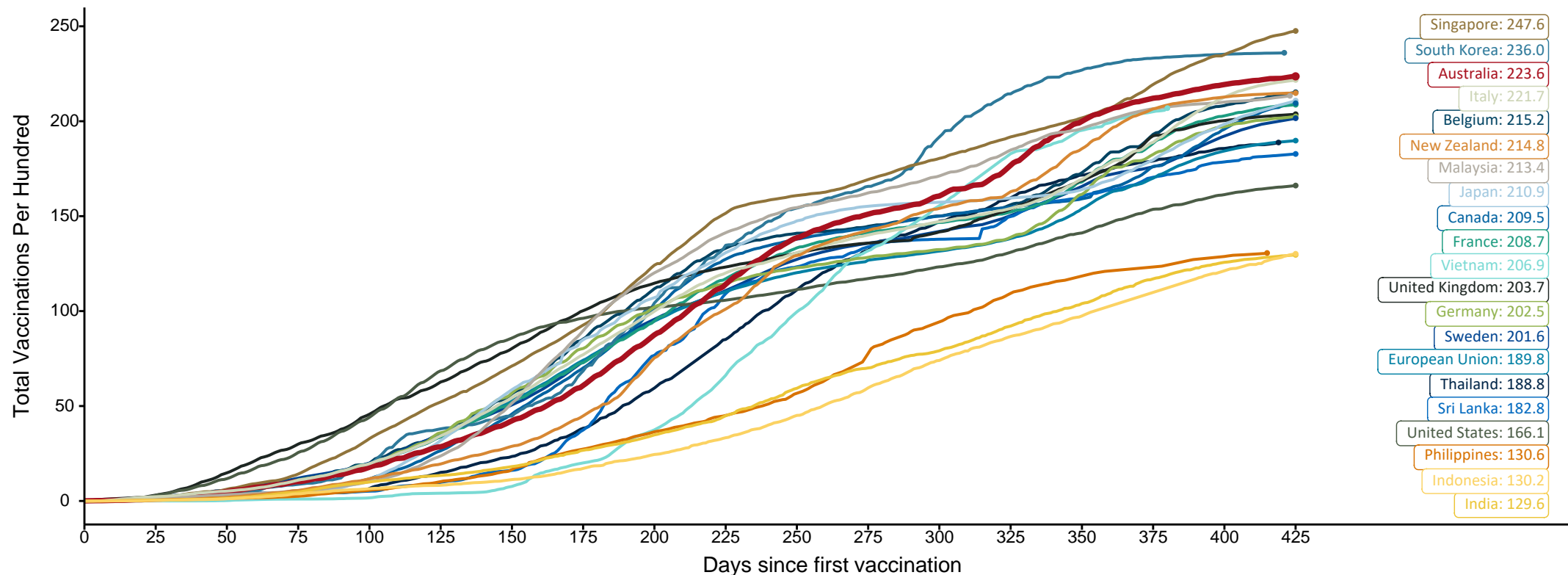

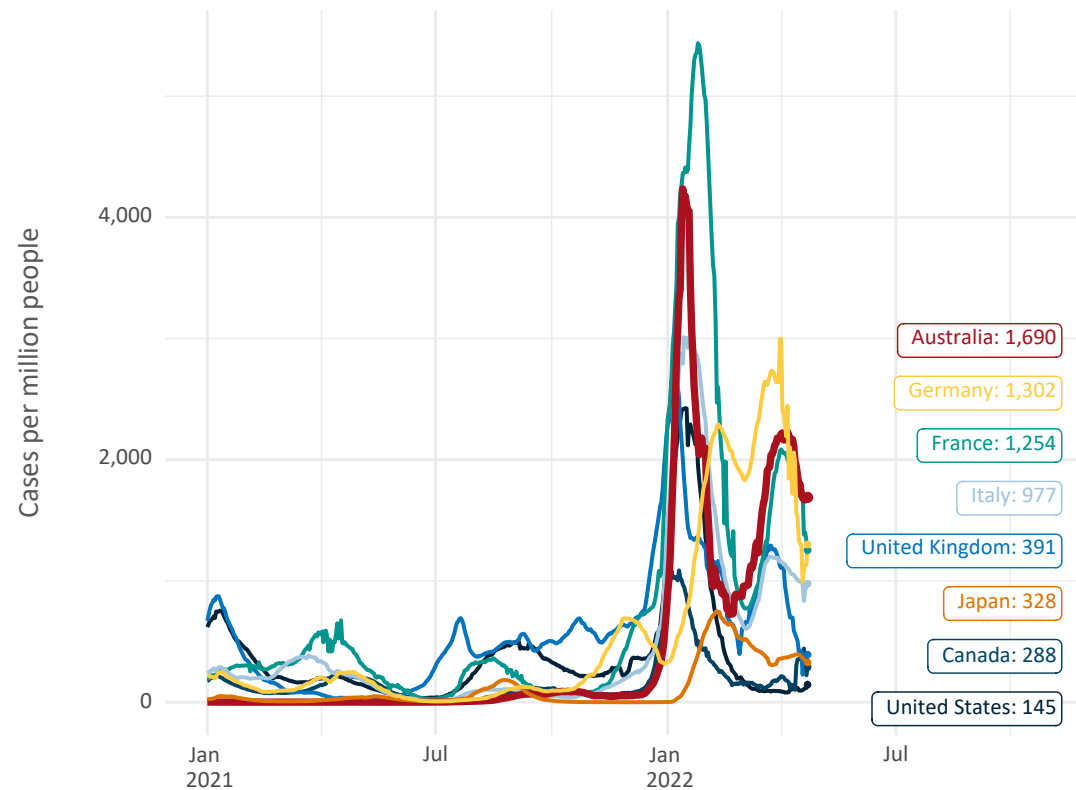

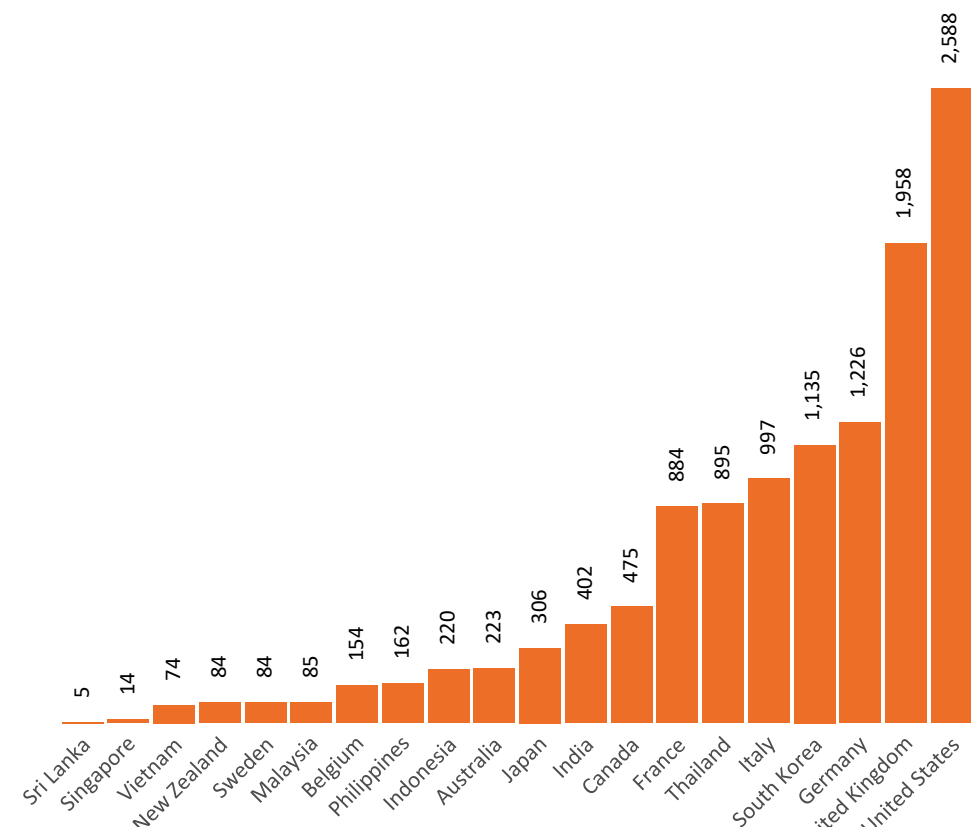

COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries



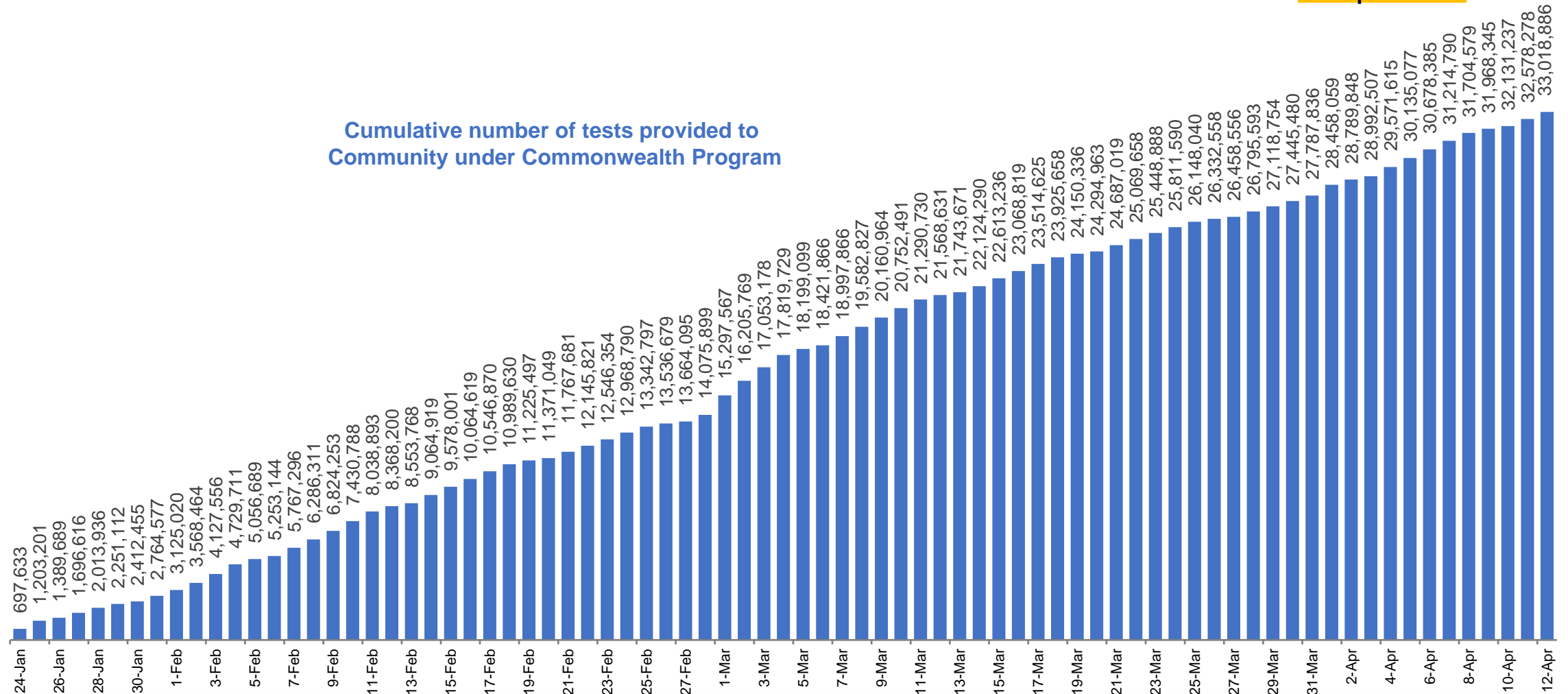

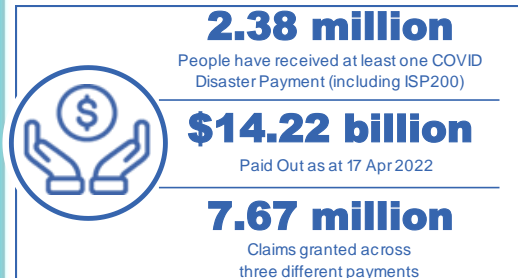
Cumulative number of tests provided to

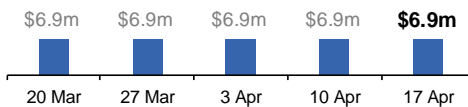

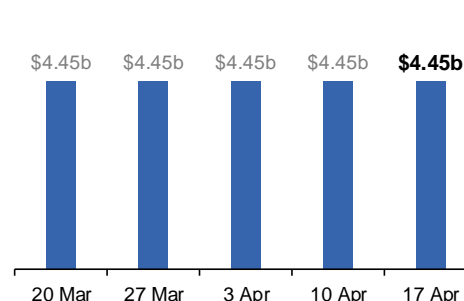

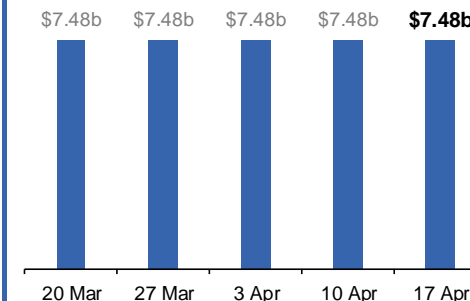

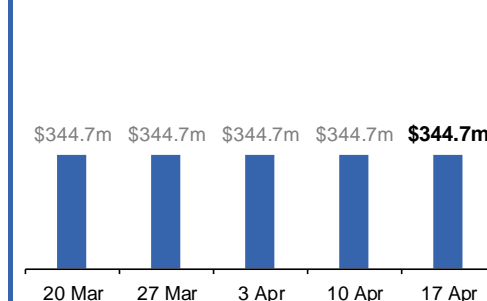

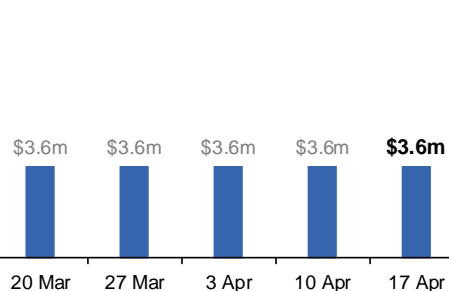

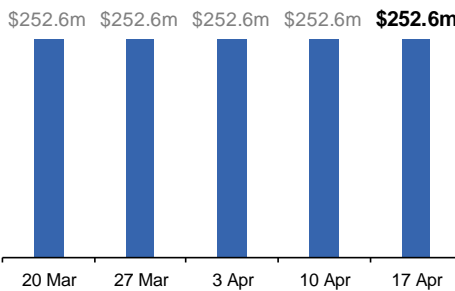
