











#### Eligible population percentage coverage




### **Vaccinations by location**













Total vaccine doses administered in State and Territory clinics as at 24 April










New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average


#### COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries
