








Commonwealth aged care and disability doses administered










Total vaccine doses administered in State and Territory clinics as at 06 April




New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average




COVID-19 deaths in past 7 days - Australia and select countries
