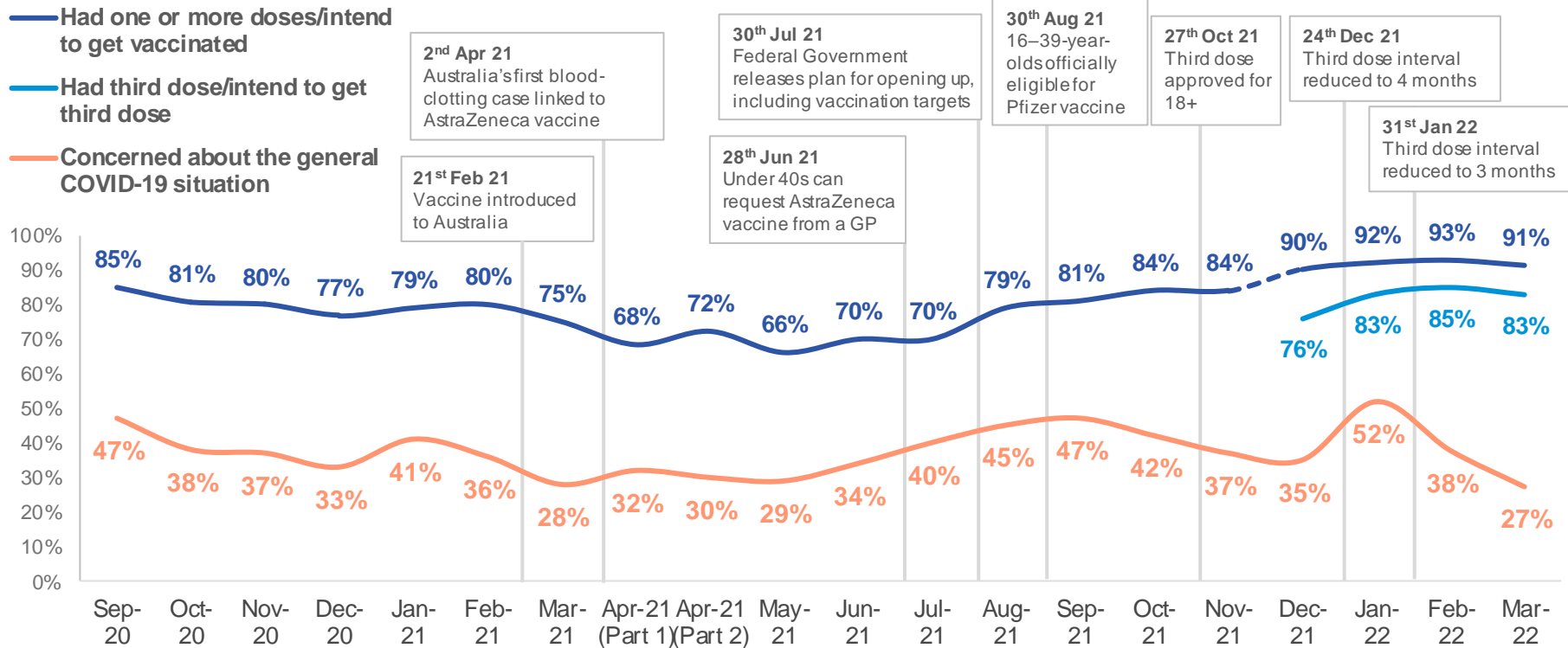


COVID-19 Community Sentiment Monitor: Summary (Mar-22)

- Third dose intentions have plateaued in March, with 83% of adult Australians having either already had, or plan to get, a third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine (down from 85% in February).
- Concern about the overall COVID-19 situation has dropped significantly over the past two months (27% very/extremely concerned).



Parents' intention to get children vaccinated against COVID-19

Awareness of third dose information

- Recommended dose interval (3 months): **85% aware**
- Where to get a third dose: **83% aware**
- Date of second dose is on vaccination certificate: **83% aware**
- Increases protection against infection, severe disease, and dying from COVID-19: **81% aware**
- You can have Pfizer or Moderna regardless of which vaccine you had for your first 2 doses: **78% aware**

Base (if not indicated otherwise): All Australian adults, n=1,000 per wave, measured in the **first week of the month** (in Apr-21 data was collected in the first two weeks). Note: Vaccination behaviour/intentions question wording was changed between Nov-21 and Dec-21 to highlight the 'already vaccinated' options. ¹Base: Parents of 12-15 year olds (n=120 Feb-22) ²Parents of 5-11 year olds (n=149 Feb-22).
