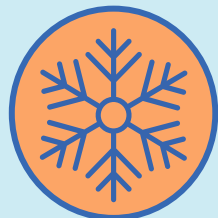

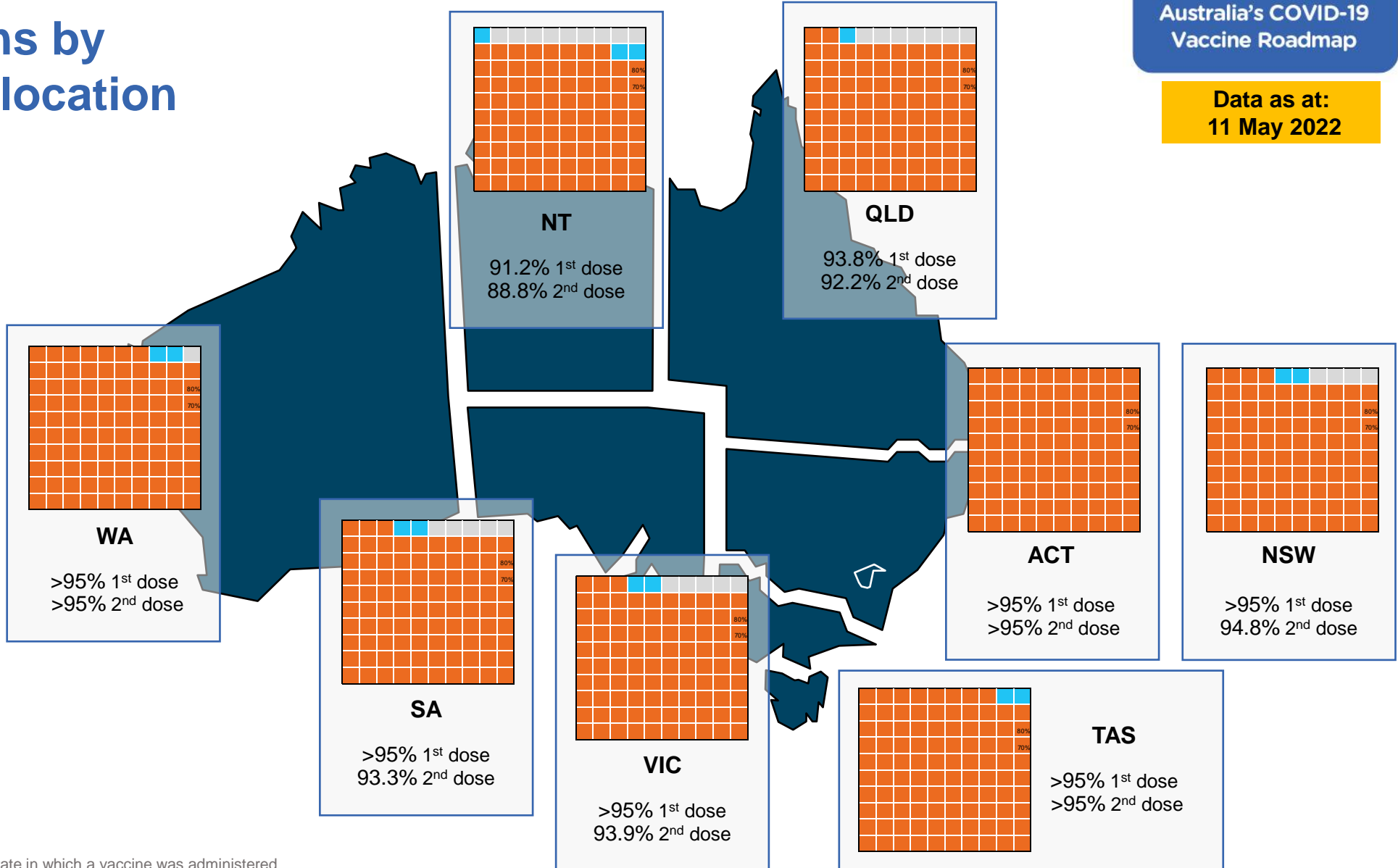

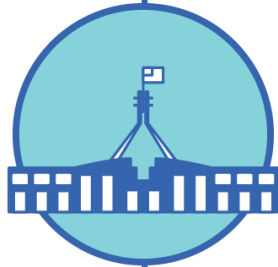

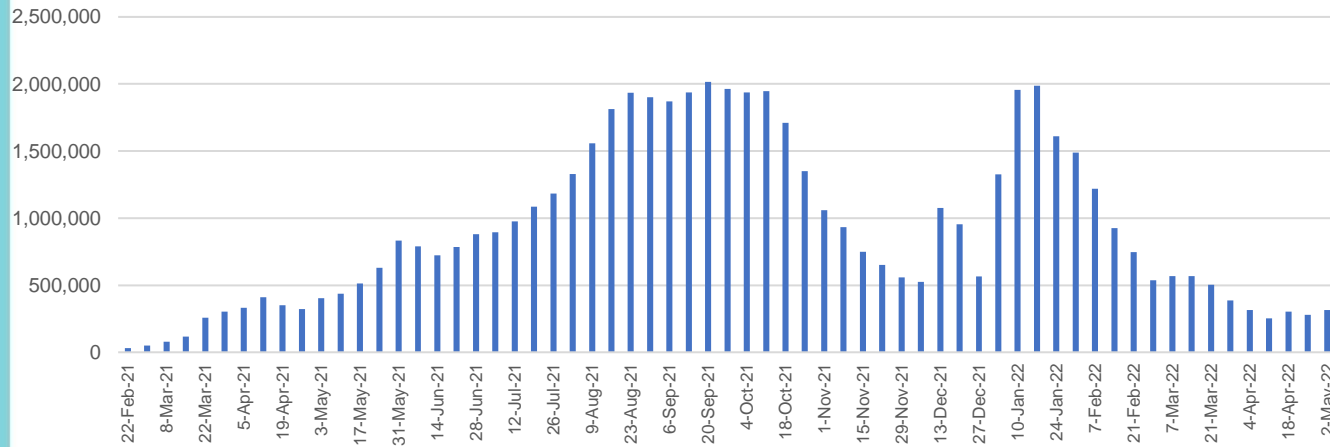

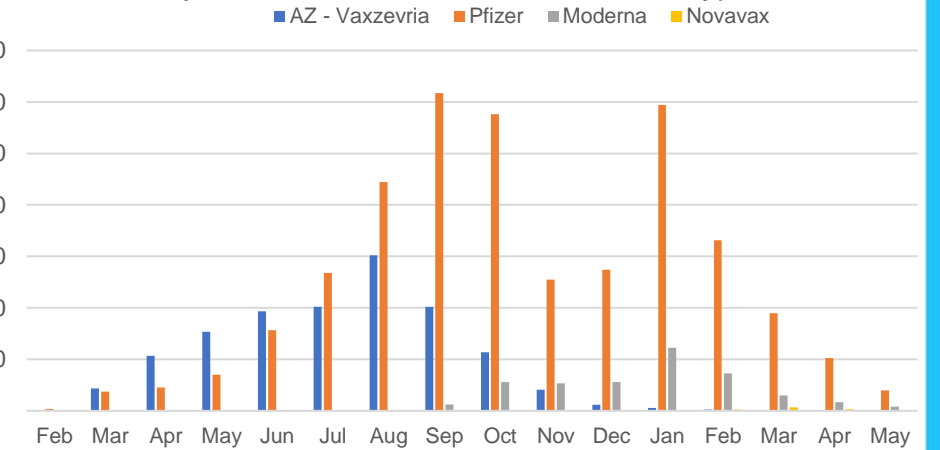

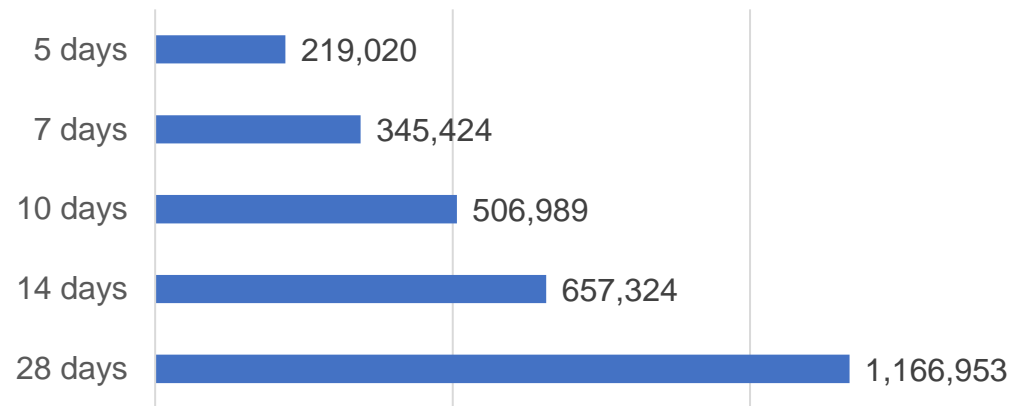
Doses Administered by Week



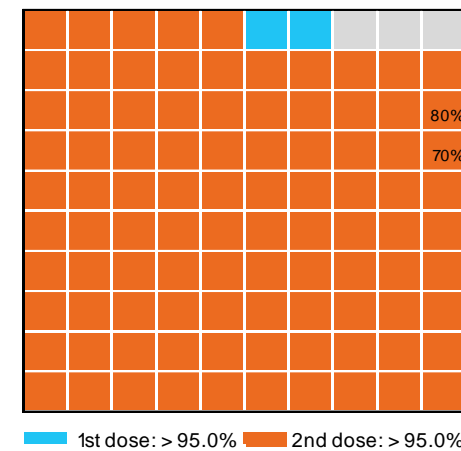
Doses by administration month and vaccine type

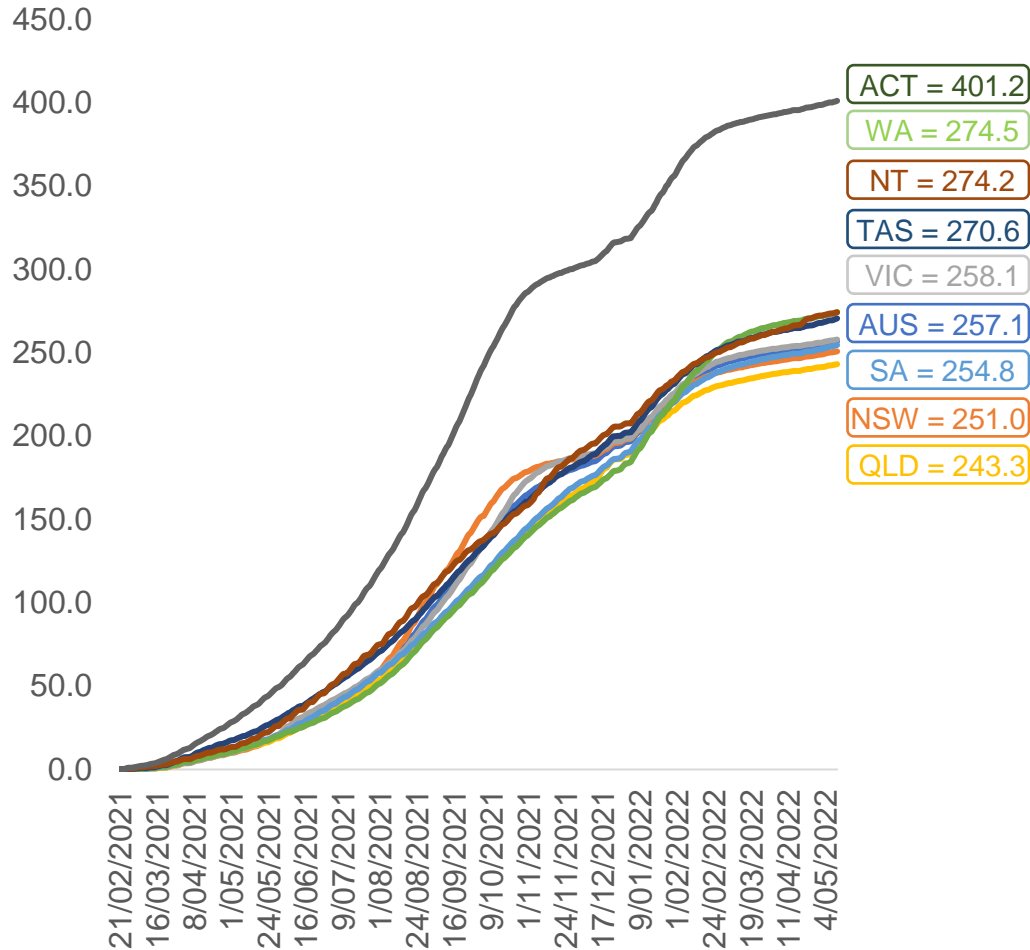

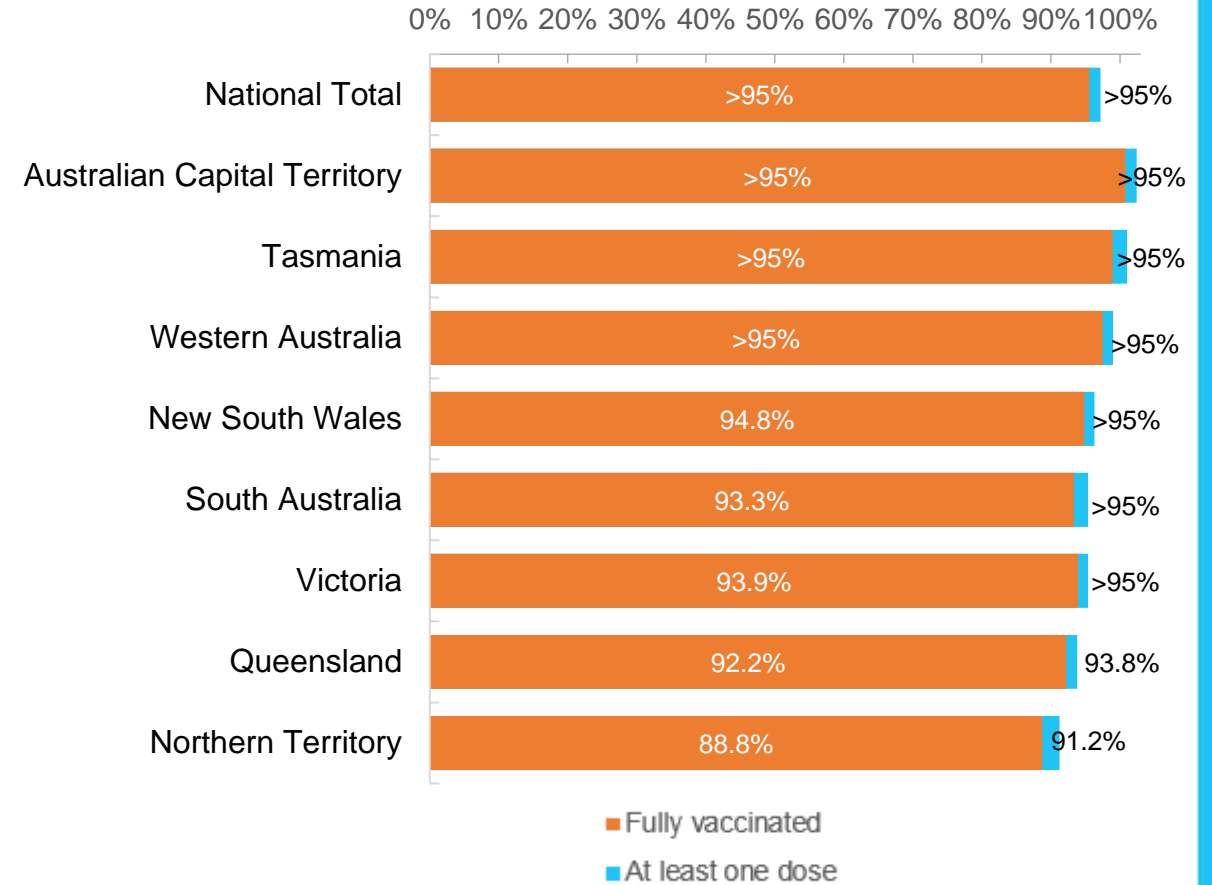

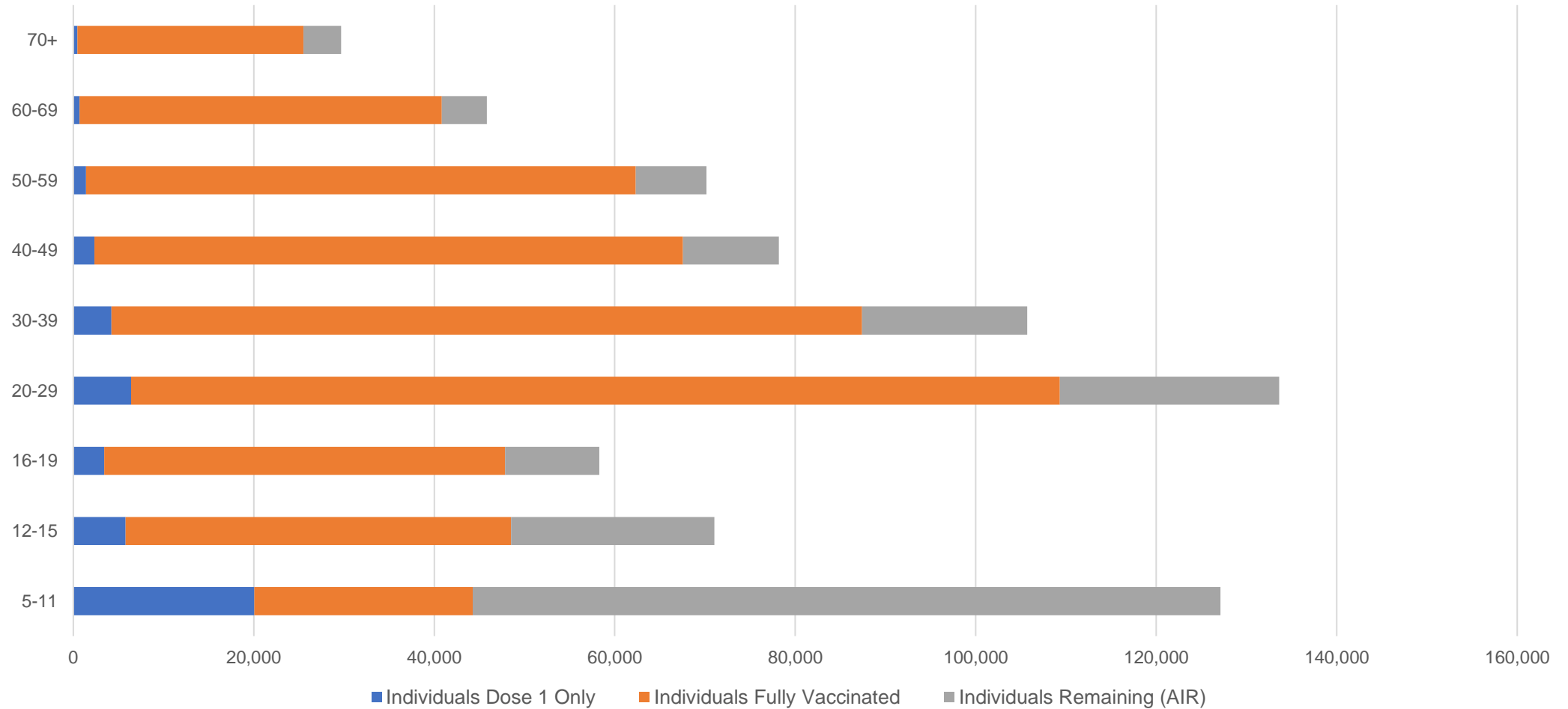

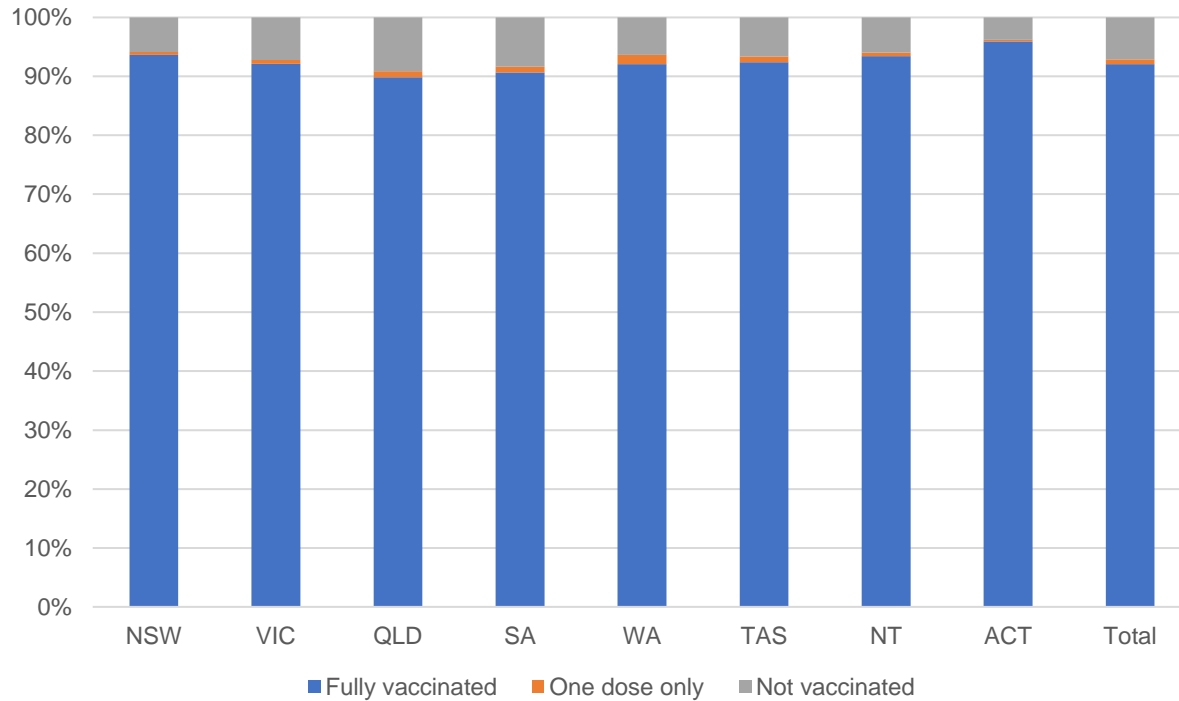

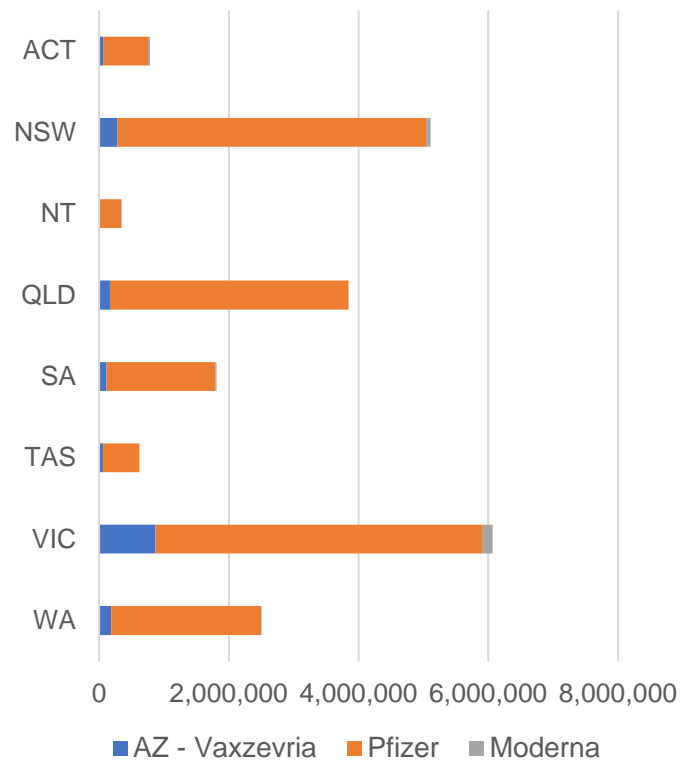

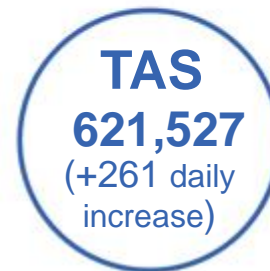

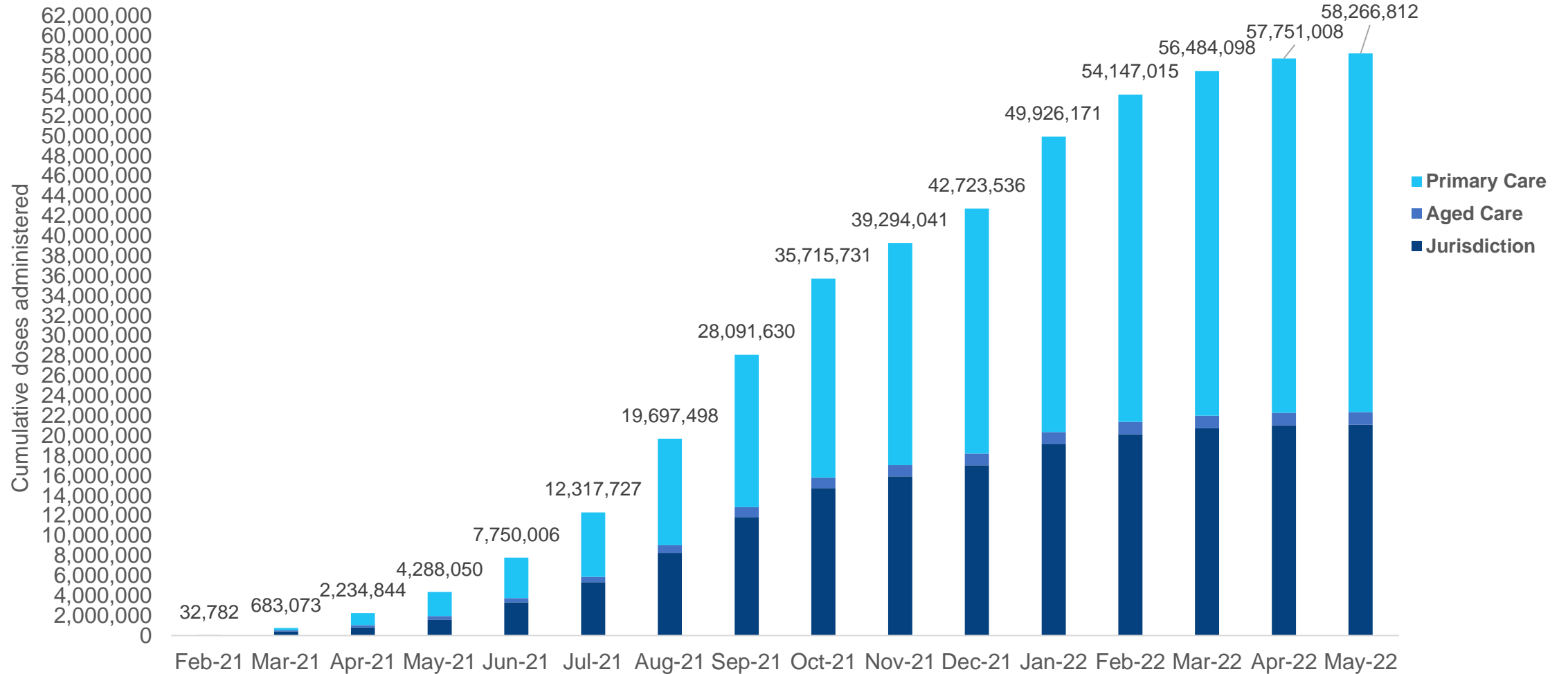

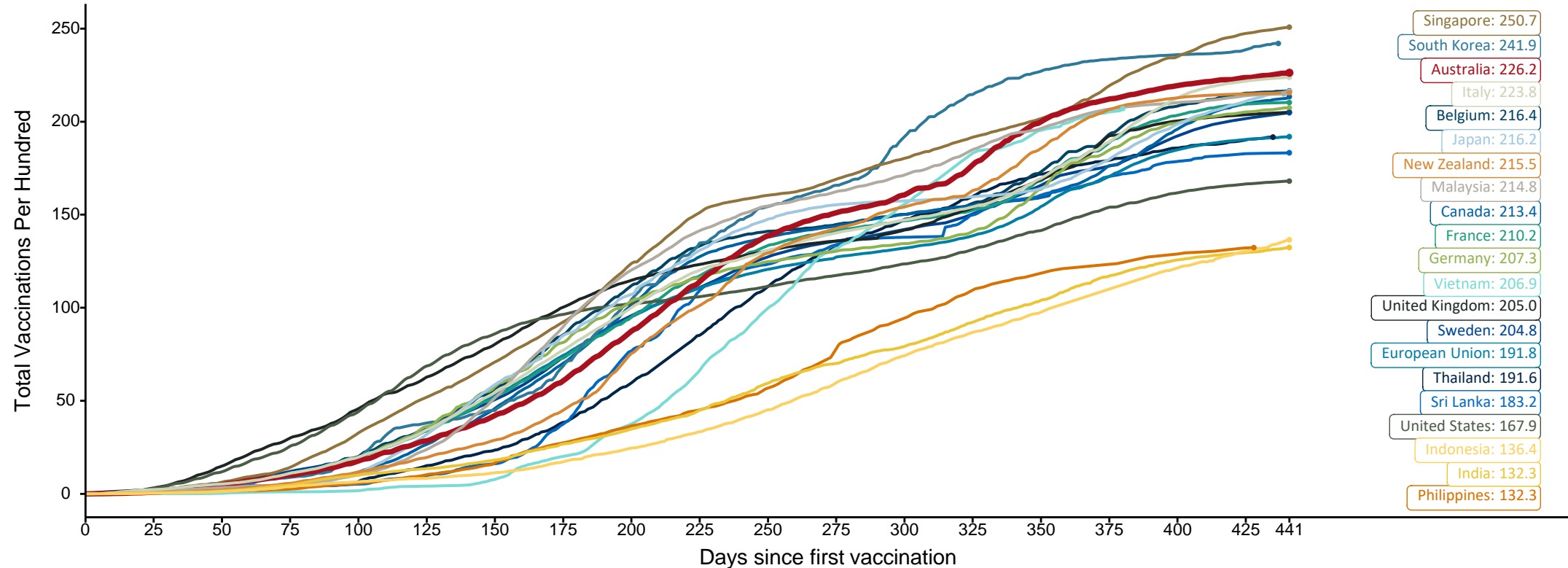

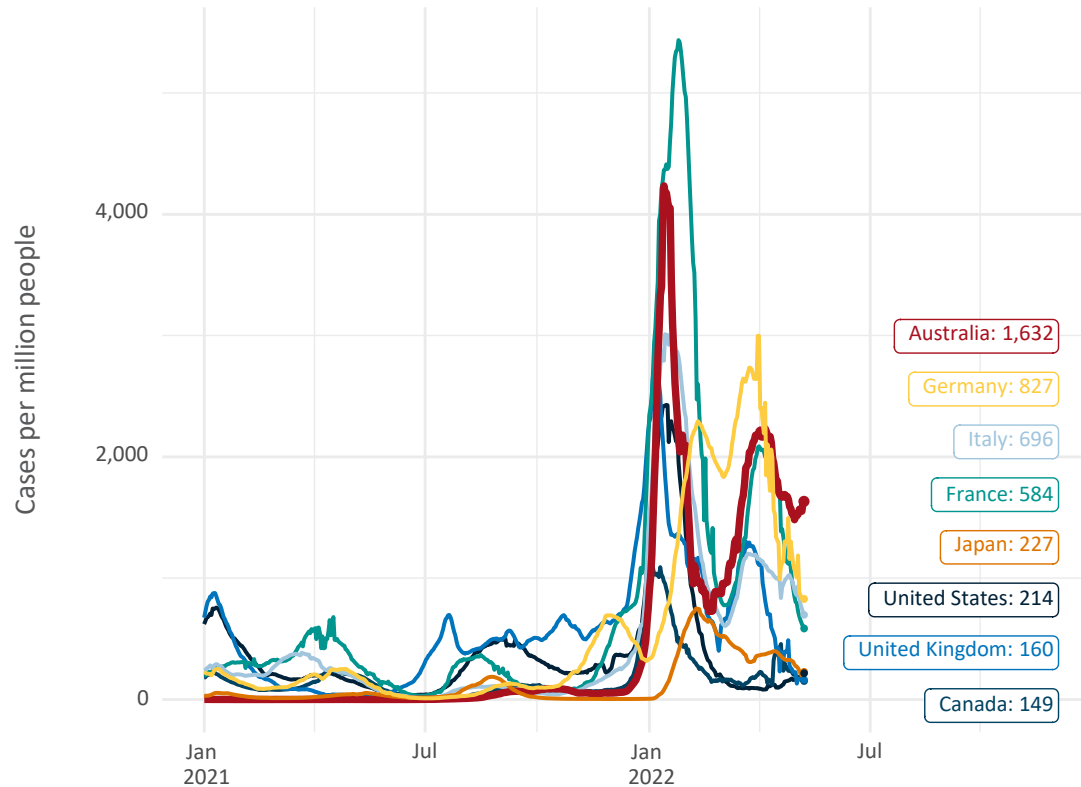

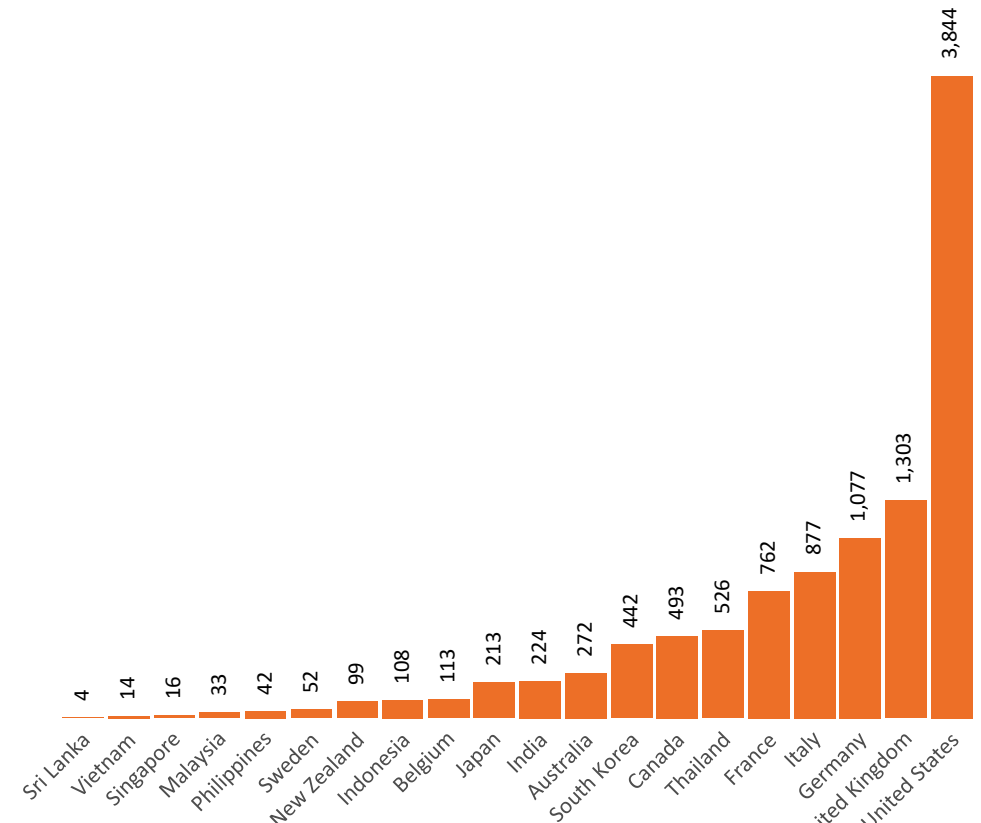
