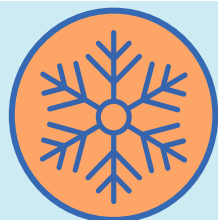

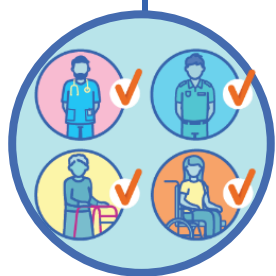

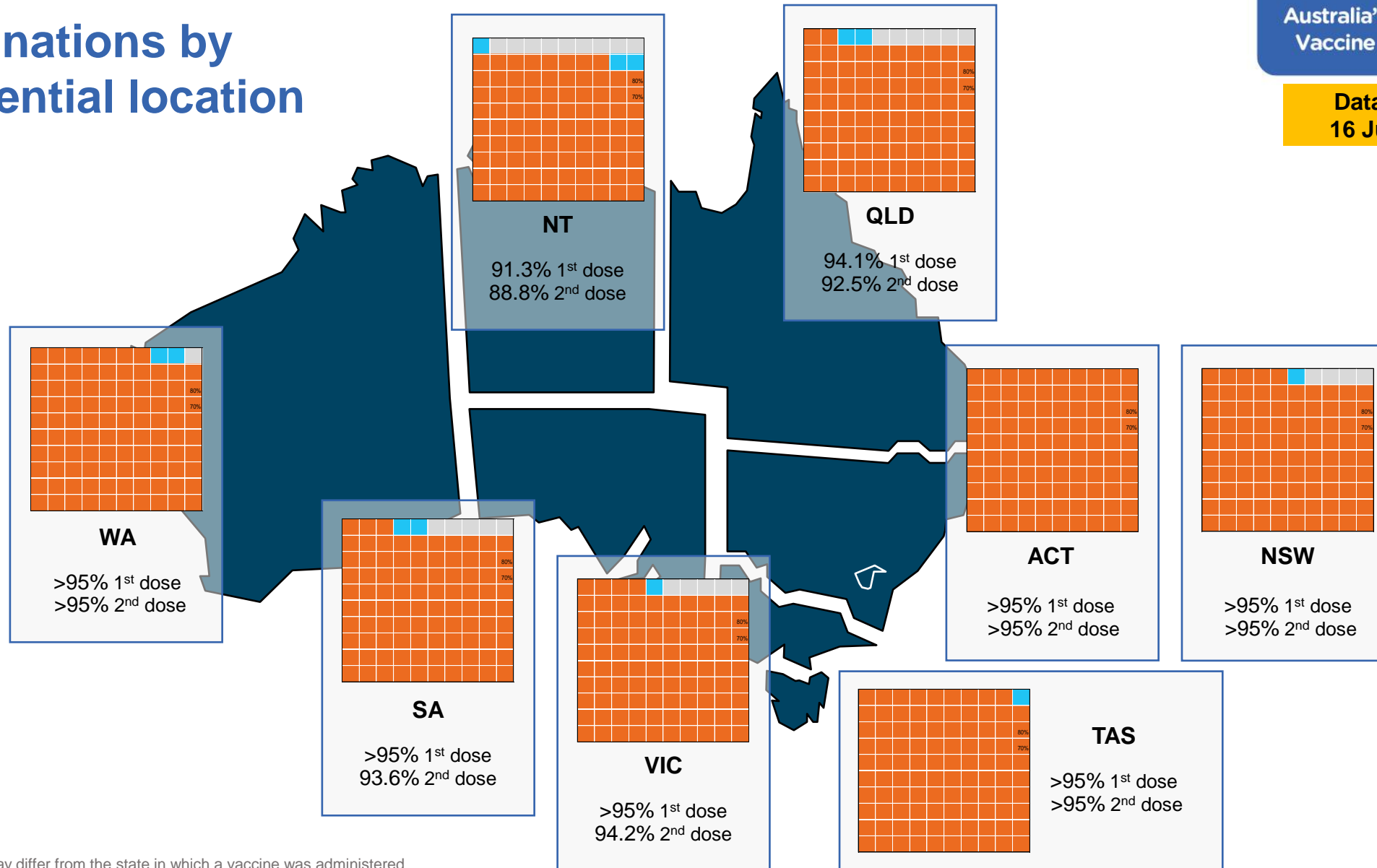

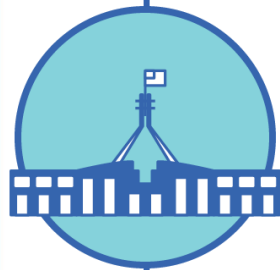

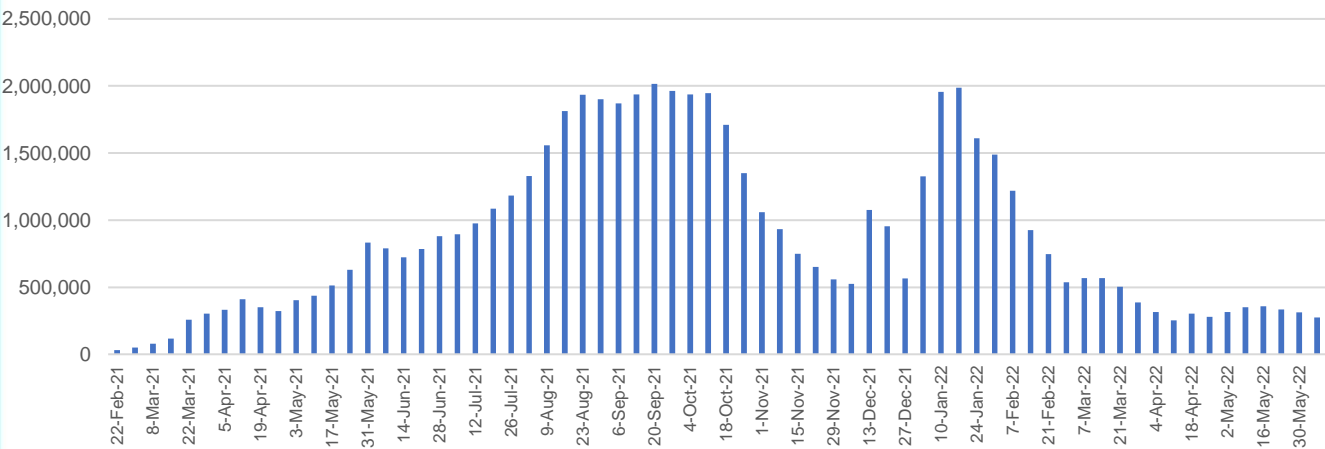

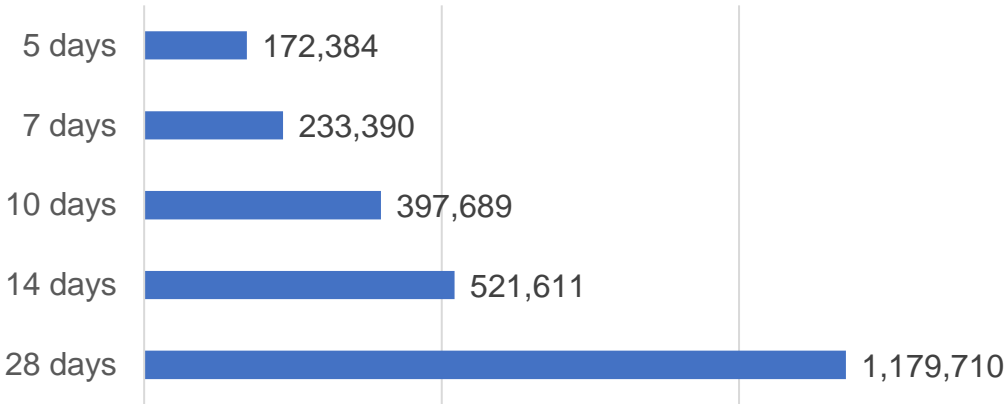

Doses Administered by Week

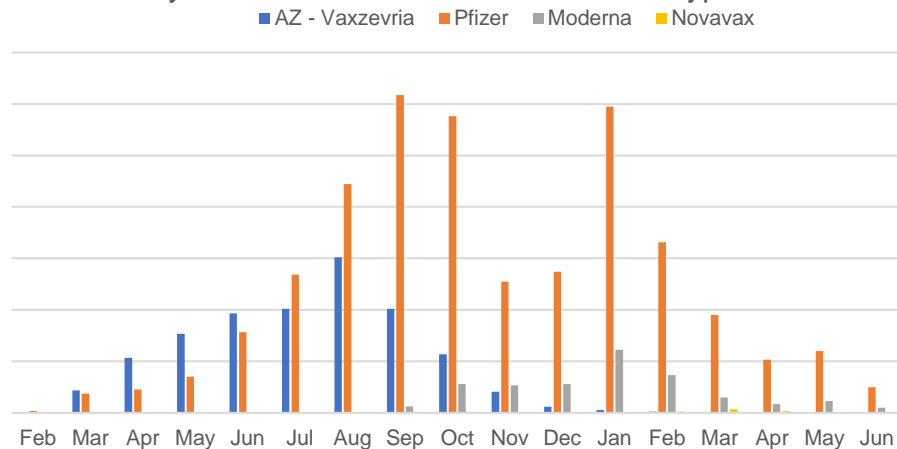

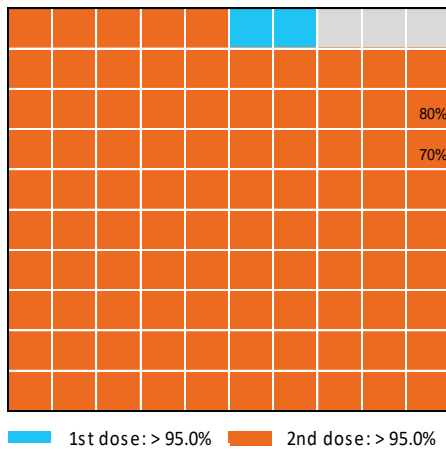

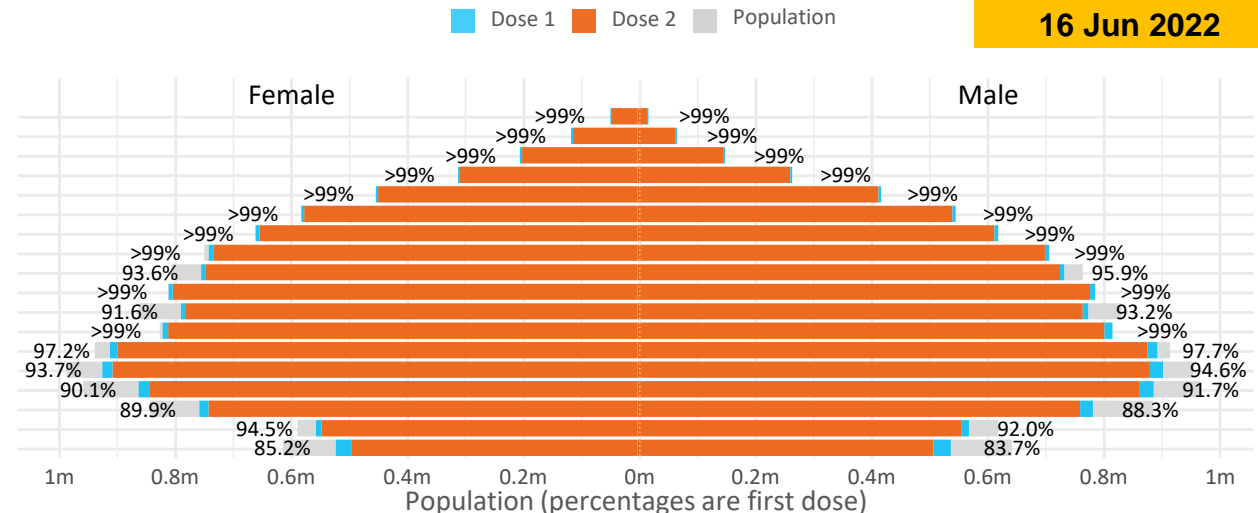

Cumulative total doses administered vs eligible state populations*

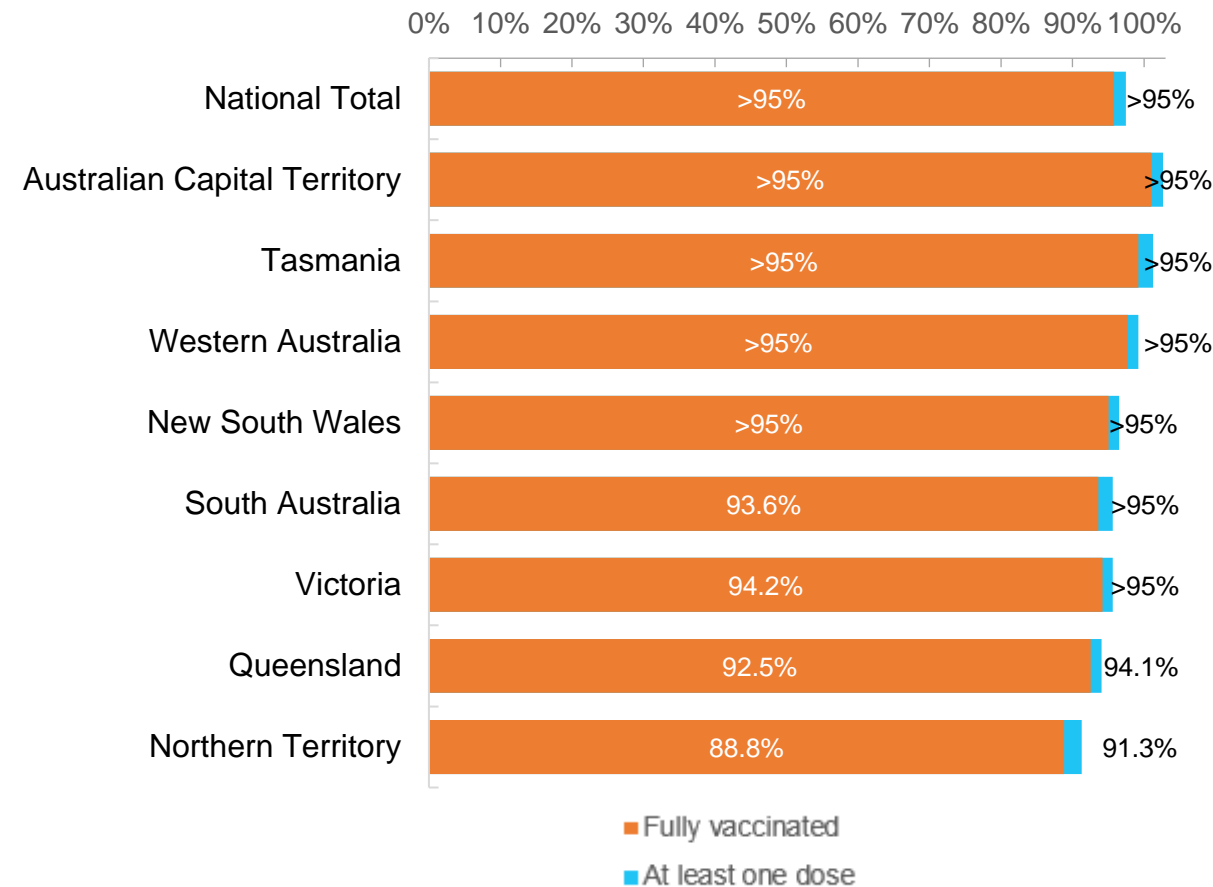

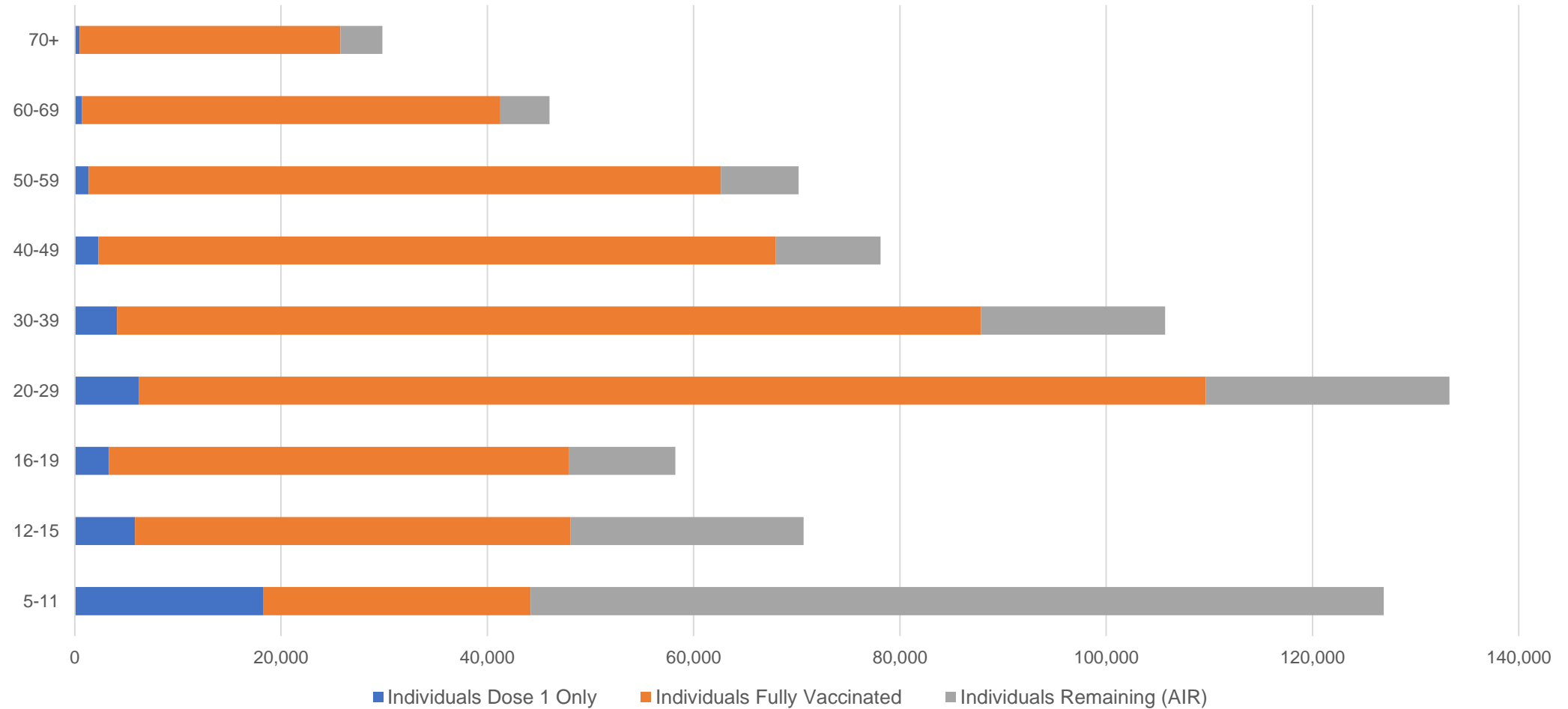

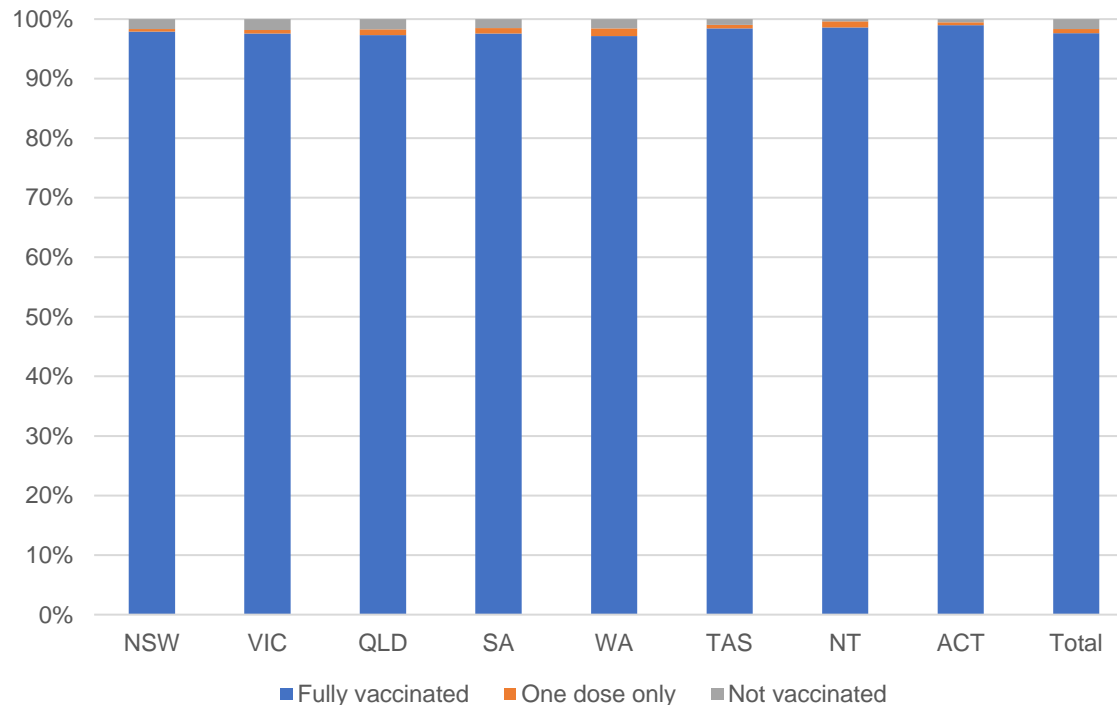

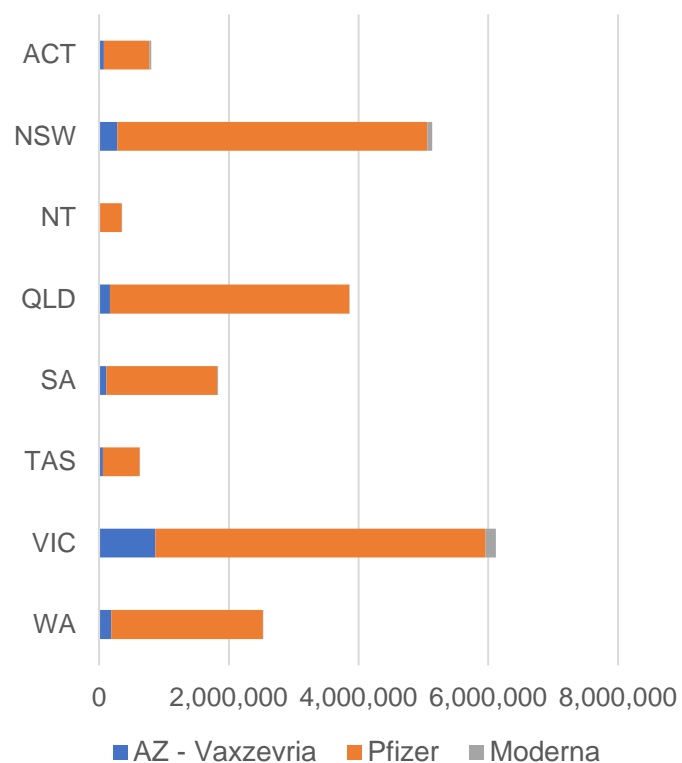

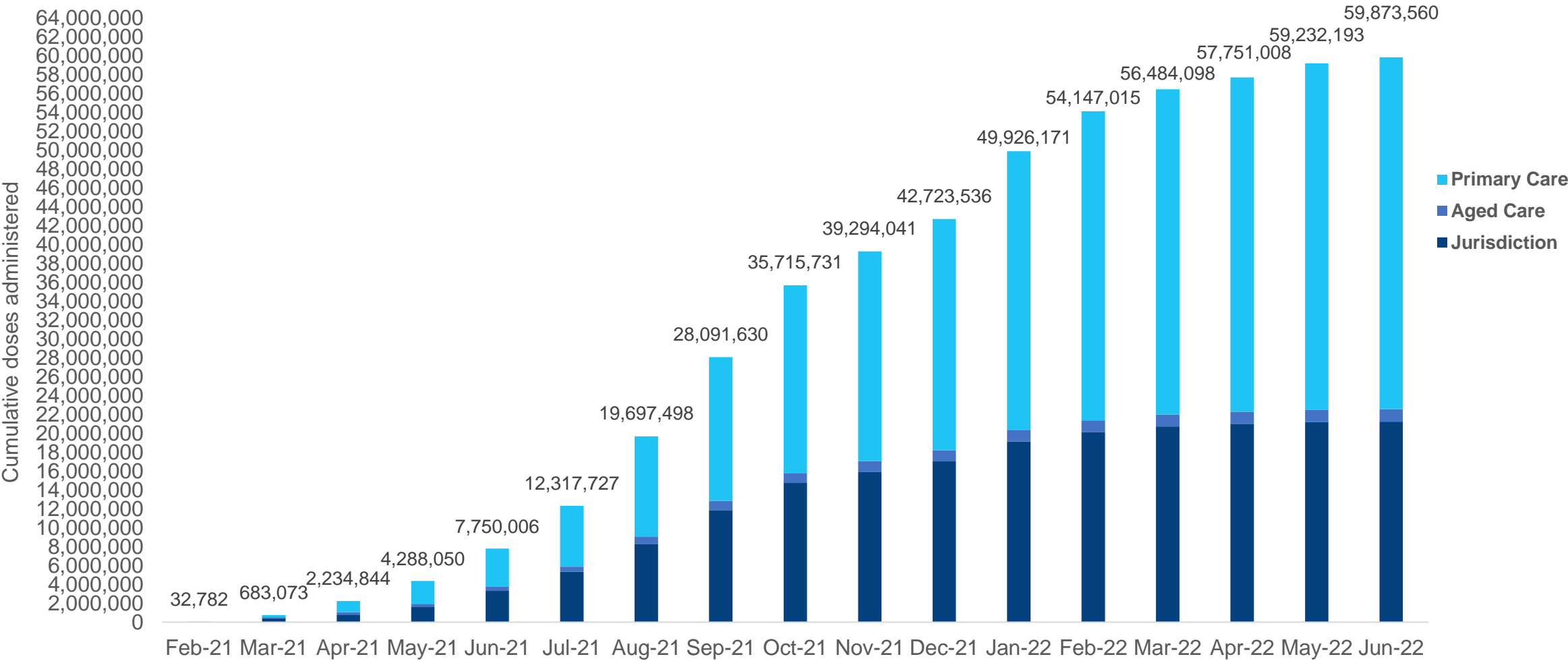

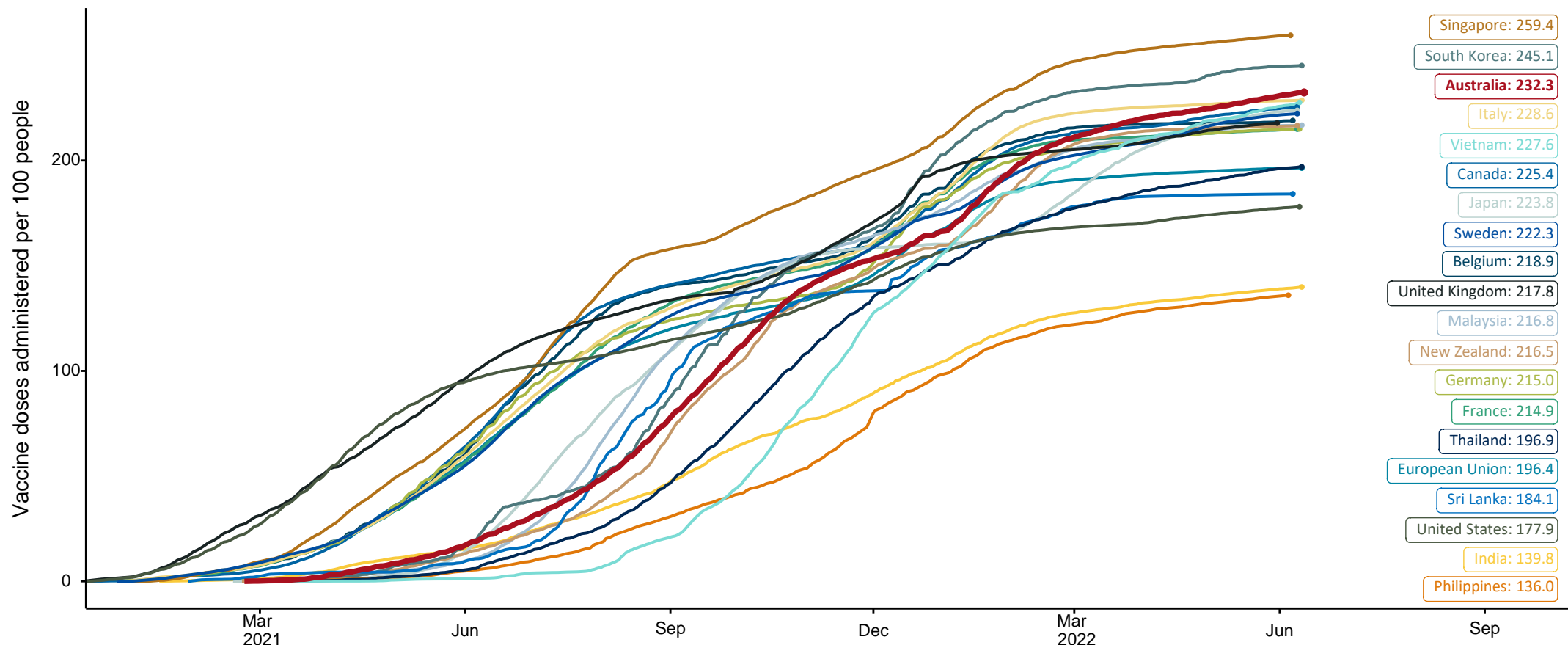

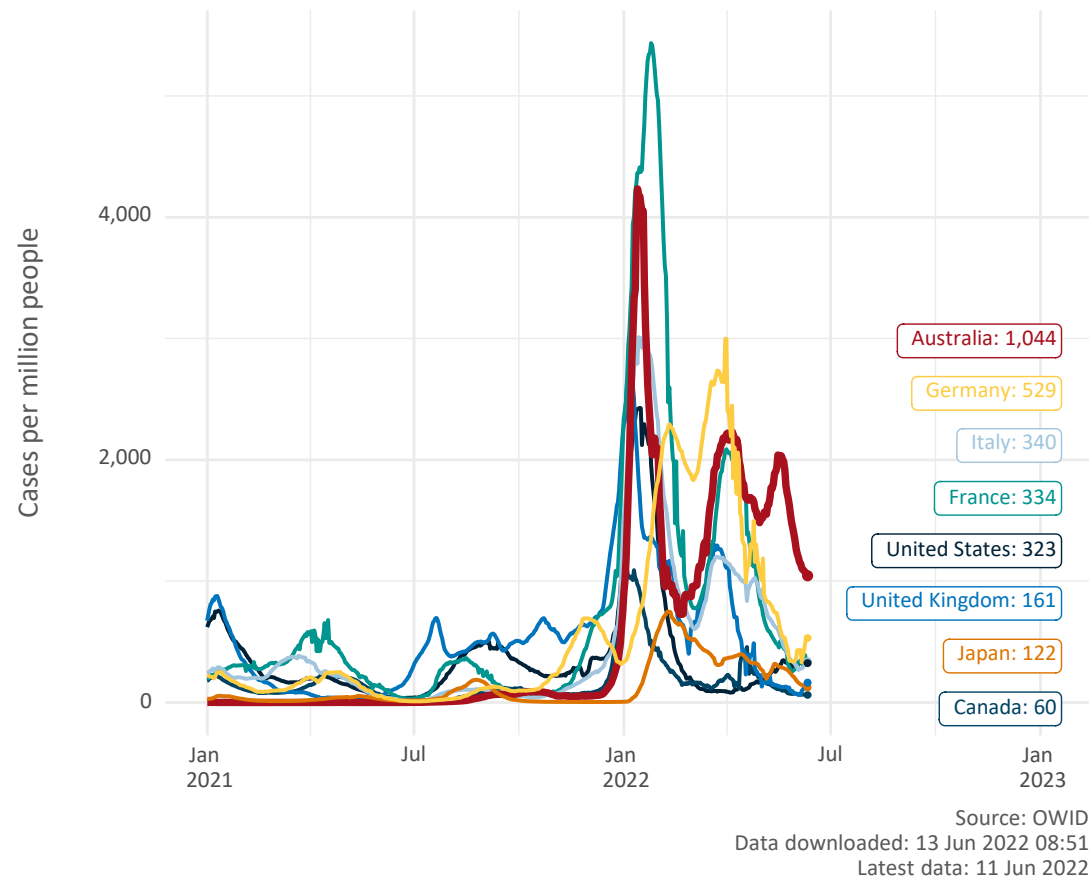
