PRIVACY AMENDMENT (PUBLIC HEALTH CONTACT **INFORMATION) BILL 2020**

INTRODUCTORY TALKING POINTS: \$22

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QUESTION 40: Does the COVIDSafe app work?

- Yes, the COVIDSafe app works.
- From its launch the app has been collecting data about users' close contacts after they download and register in the app.
 - If a user is diagnosed with COVID-19 they may upload close contact data to assist State and Territory contact tracing efforts.
- While there has been public conjecture about whether COVIDSafe works on iOS devices, the Government is assured that the app operates on these devices as intended.
 - The Government is aware of the variability in the quality of Bluetooth signals depending on whether the device is unlocked and whether the app is running in the foreground. The age of the device is also a significant contributor to this variability.
 - We continue to work on these performance issues, particularly as the app moves further into the background, and are working with Apple and Google on software improvements that can be made to Bluetooth connectivity.
- The Government will update the app as needed to take advantage of these improvements.

As requested, here are some dot points for the ministers discussion with the PM this morning

- At 6:30am this morning, 3,470,002 people have registered for COVIDSafe
- A number of issues have been identified over the past week which will be addressed

through a series of weekly releases commencing on Tuesday 5th May including:

- Support for older phones
- o Inability for people with an overseas phone number to register or those with overseas app store accounts to download the app
- o Invalid phone number error message for some users connected to WiFi on certain devices workaround exists and has been published

- o Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) apps on some devices experiencing Bluetooth interference when using the COVIDSafe app. CGM apps may be prone to interference from a variety of other applications that are also using Bluetooth. Diabetes Australia has issued a statement that people experiencing issues should uninstall the COVIDSafe app.
- o Misunderstanding the public state official process of notifying a positive diagnosis prior to uploading information causing concern.
- FAQ's on www.health.gov.au and www.covidsafe.gov.au have been updated to reflect the latest advice
- Agreements and standard operating procedures are being finalised with the states to access contact tracing data.
