Hi [s 22](#) just to clarify on this, what I told you yesterday was accurate—you were looking at state clinic data which didn't have all the vaccinations through primary care (GPs etc).

When I checked though—adding up state clinic, plus primary care and aged care for NSW I did get a different overall number to the first and second dose figure you quoted. The answer for that is what was sent last night:
