## Priority access for residential aged care workers

Residential aged care workers are a priority group for COVID-19 vaccination.

All primary care clinics, including general practices and pharmacies, have been requested to make priority vaccination appointments for residential aged care workers **within 7 days of the request**.

State and territory public health orders define who must be vaccinated and by when, and the limited exemptions that may apply. Residential aged care workers in a number of states and territories are required to be up-to-date with their COVID-19 vaccinations.

This document confirms proof of employment in residential aged care to qualify for access to a priority COVID-19 vaccination, including booster doses, as quickly as possible.
