Product: Coloplast New SenSura Mio Applicant: Coloplast Pty Ltd Date of Meeting: 26 April 2022

1. Proposed Variation on the Stoma Appliance Scheme

The applicant, Coloplast, sought the addition of one variant to the current listing of the Coloplast New SenSura Mio (SAS Code 3998K) in subgroup 2(a) of the Stoma Appliance Scheme (SAS) Schedule. The product, including 10 variants, is currently listed at a unit price of \$4.879 which includes a price premium of \$0.205 per unit, with a maximum monthly quantity of 30 units.

2. Variants to be added

The applicant requested the following variants be added to the existing listing for SAS Code 3998K.

3. Background

This product was first listed on the SAS Schedule in October 2014.

4. Financial Analysis

Listing one additional variant under the current SAS Code 3998K is unlikely to have a budgetary impact for the SAS.

5. SPAP Recommendation

The Panel recommended the addition of one variant to the current product range for Coloplast New SenSura Mio (SAS Code 3998K) listed in subgroup 2(a) of the SAS Schedule at the unit price of \$4.879 which includes a price premium of \$0.205 per unit, with a maximum monthly quantity of 30 units. The product code to be added under the SAS Code 3998K is 13690.

6. Context for Recommendation

The Panel provides advice on whether stoma products should be subsidised and, if so, the conditions of their subsidisation in Australia. Applications are considered in this context. Panel advice not to recommend listing or changes to a listing does not represent a final Panel view about the merits of a particular stoma product. A company can resubmit to the Panel following advice not to recommend listing or changes to a listing. The Panel is an advisory committee and as such its recommendations are non-binding on Government. All Panel recommendations are subject to Government approval.
