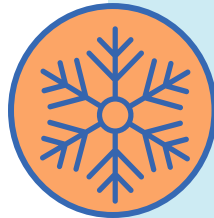

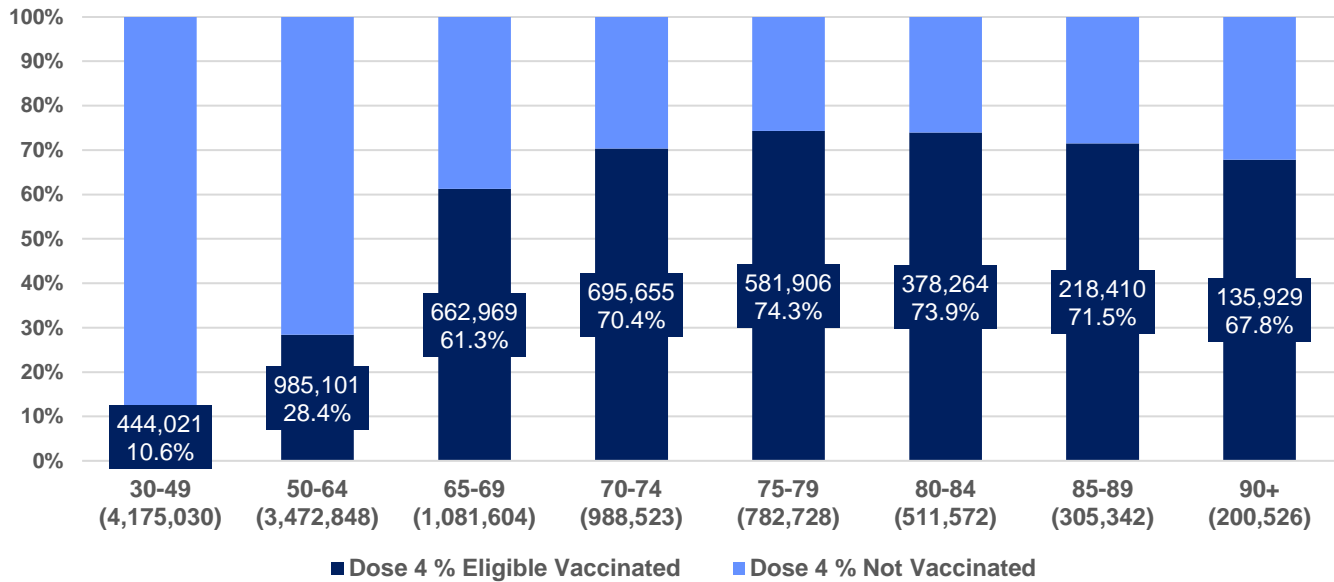

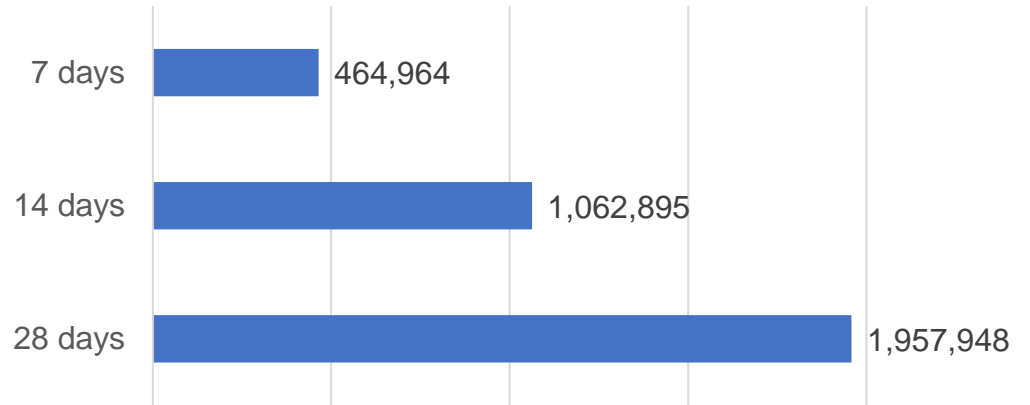

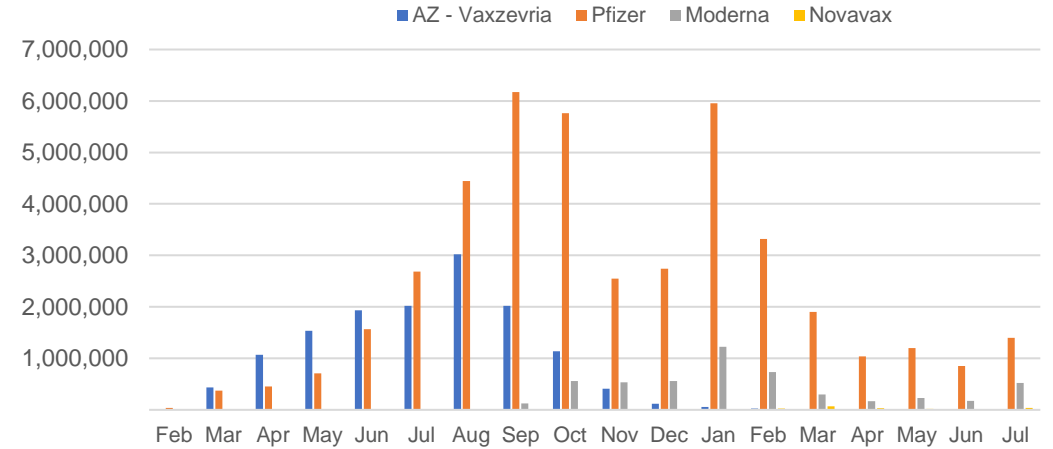

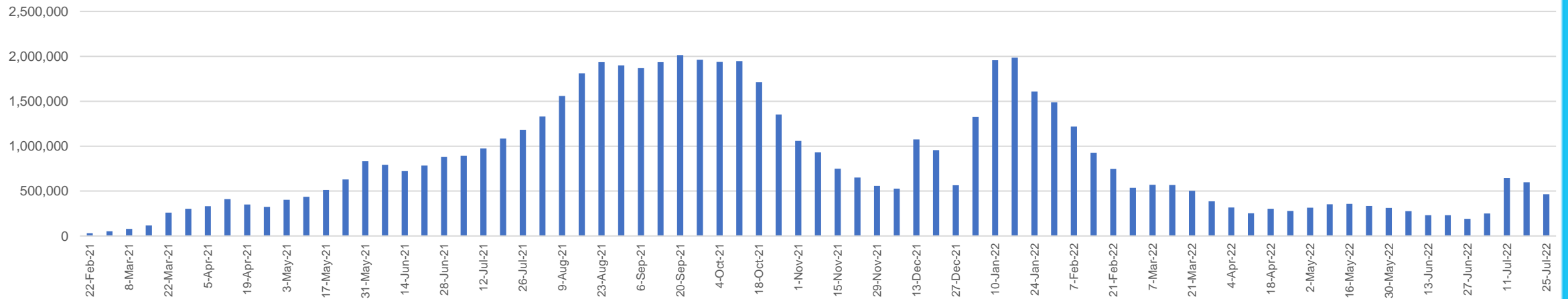
Doses Reported

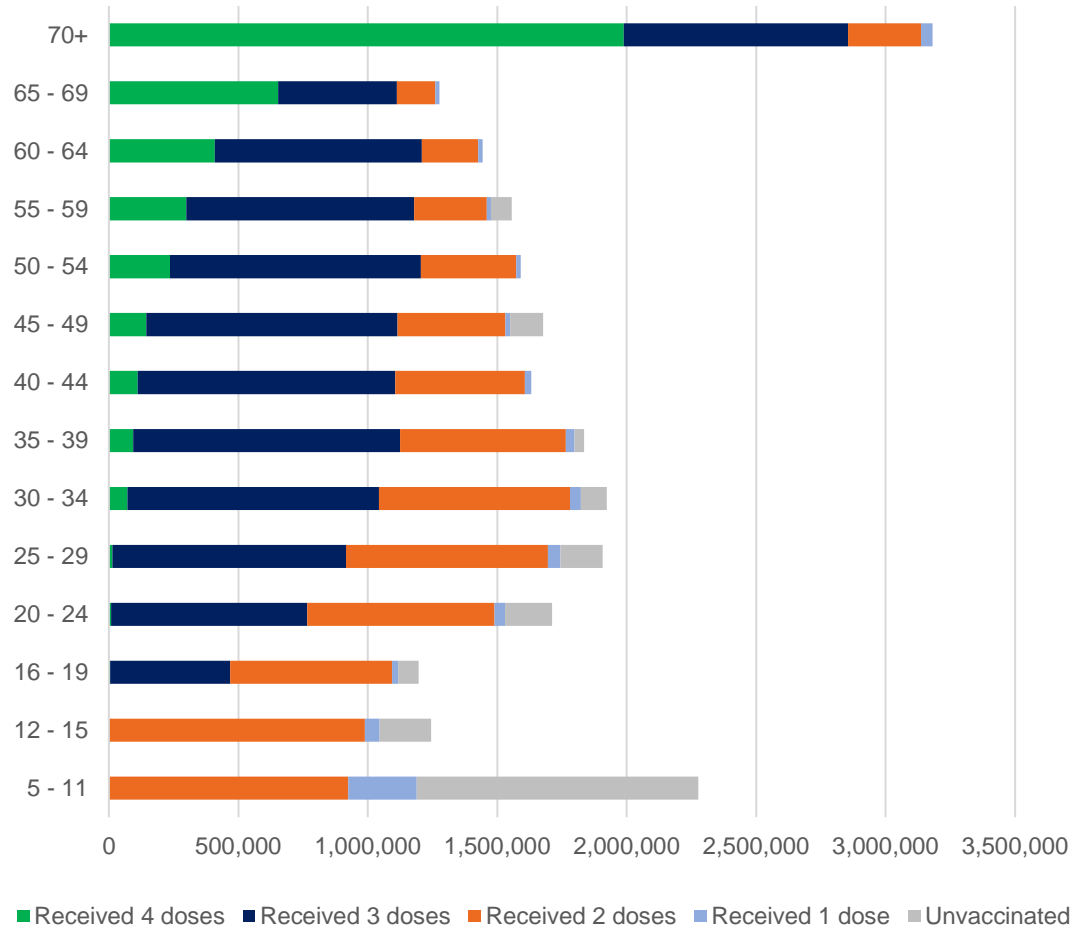

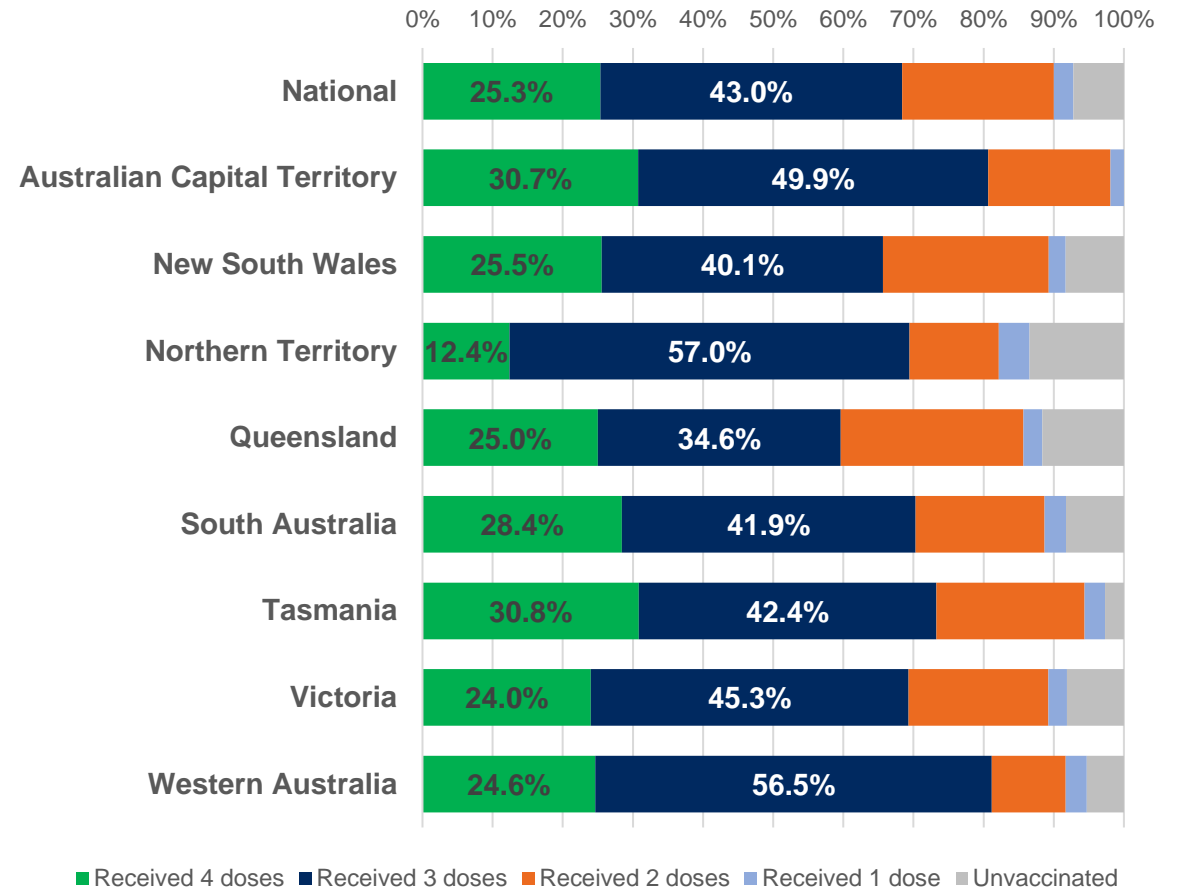

Number of people vaccinated by age

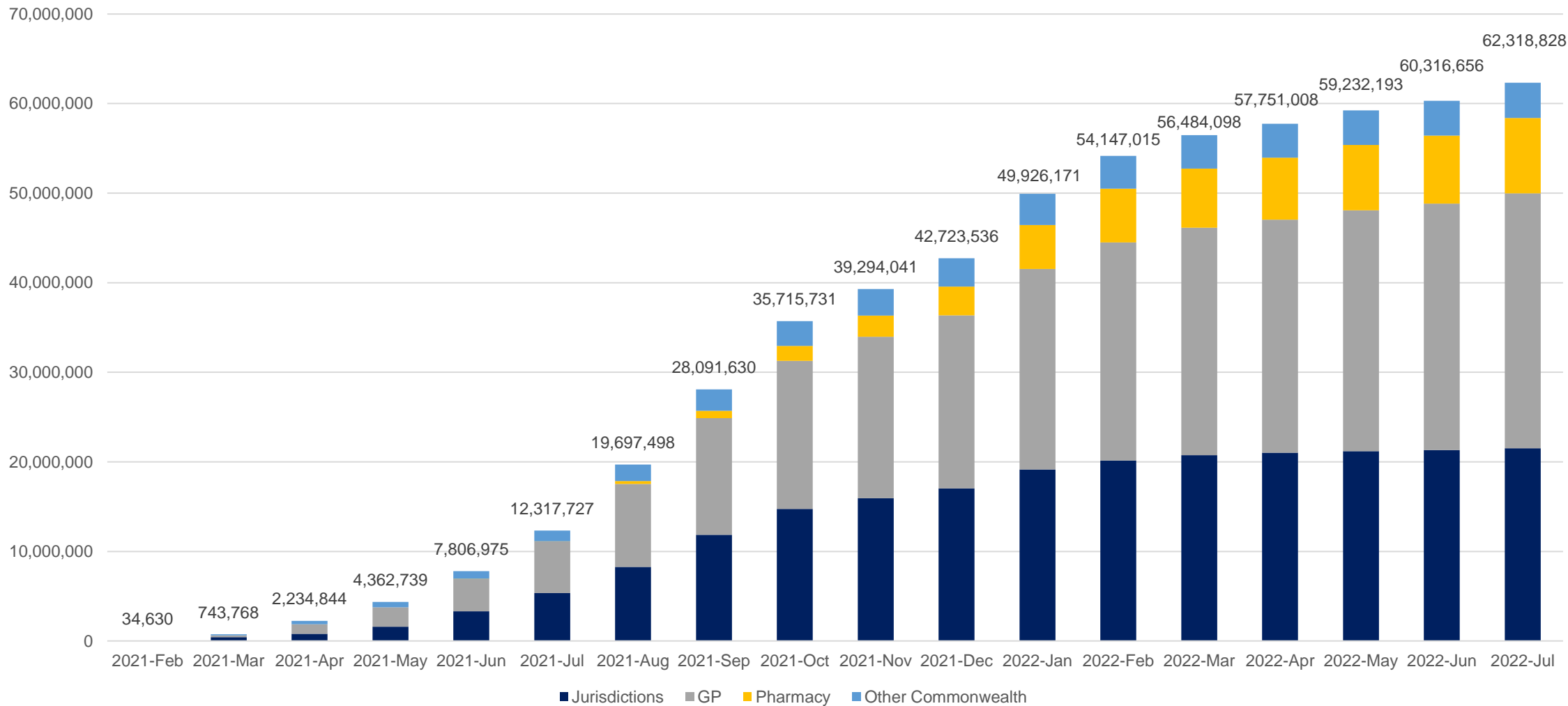


Individuals vaccinated by residential location

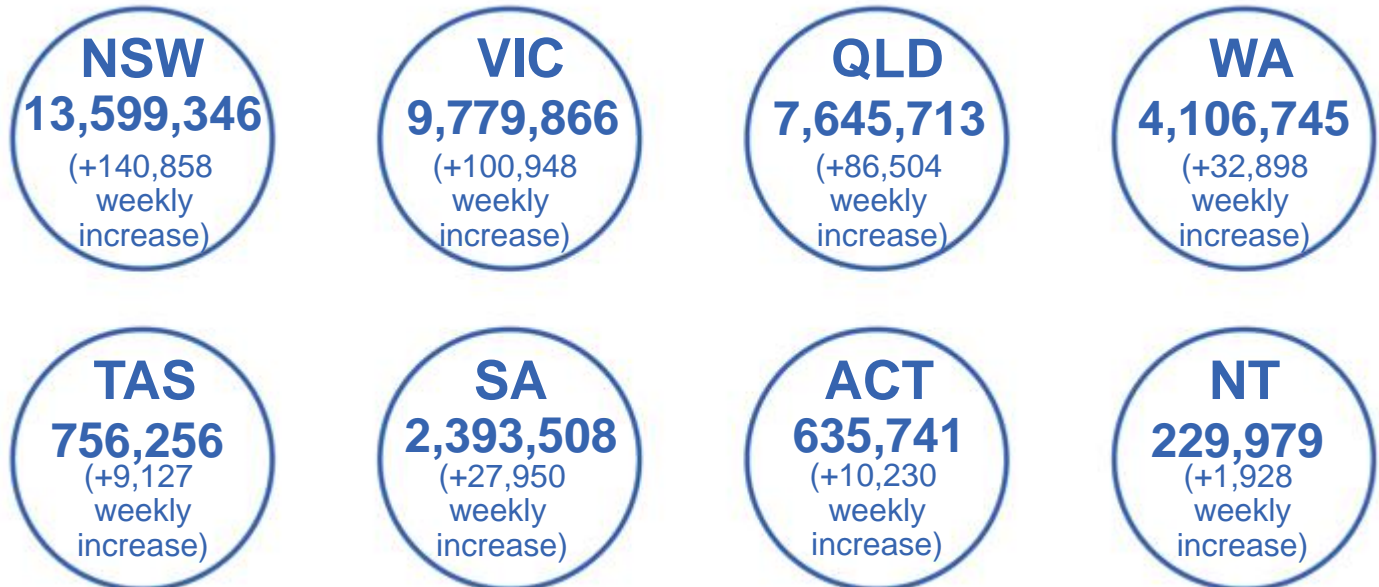

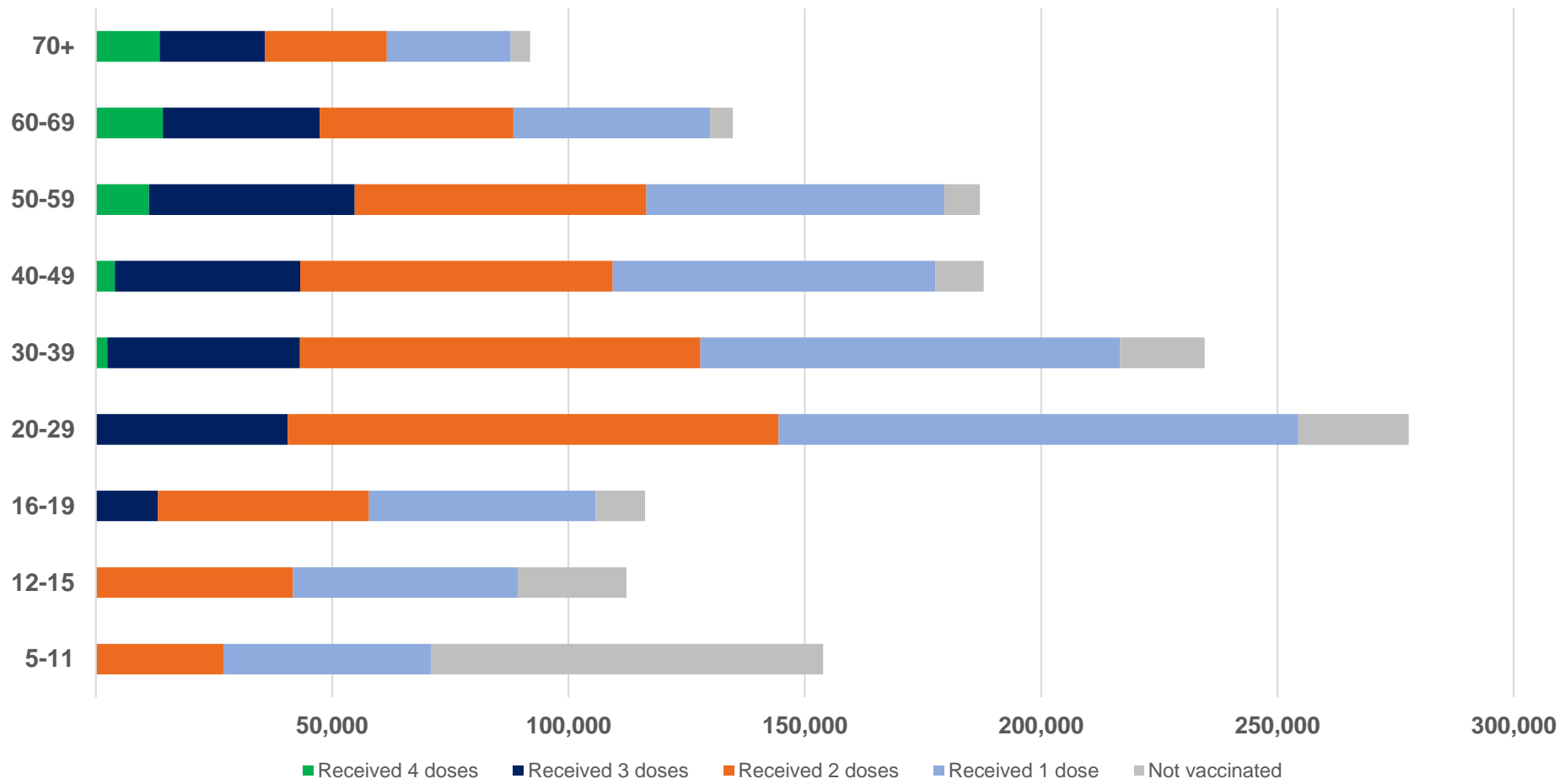

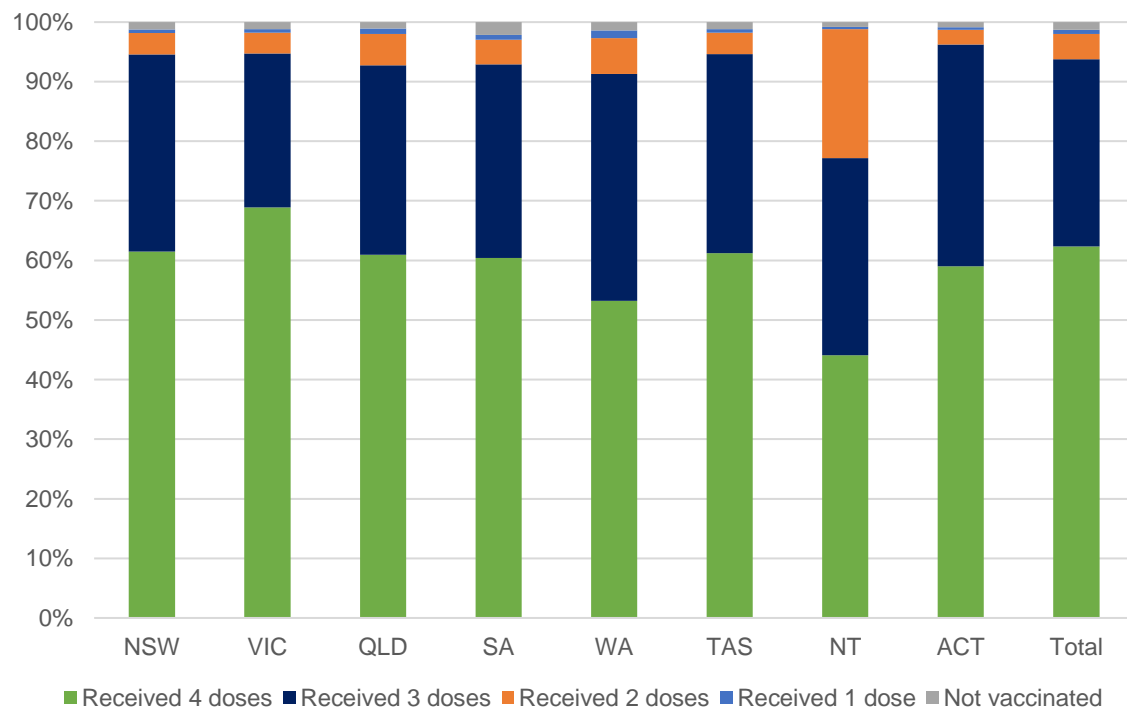

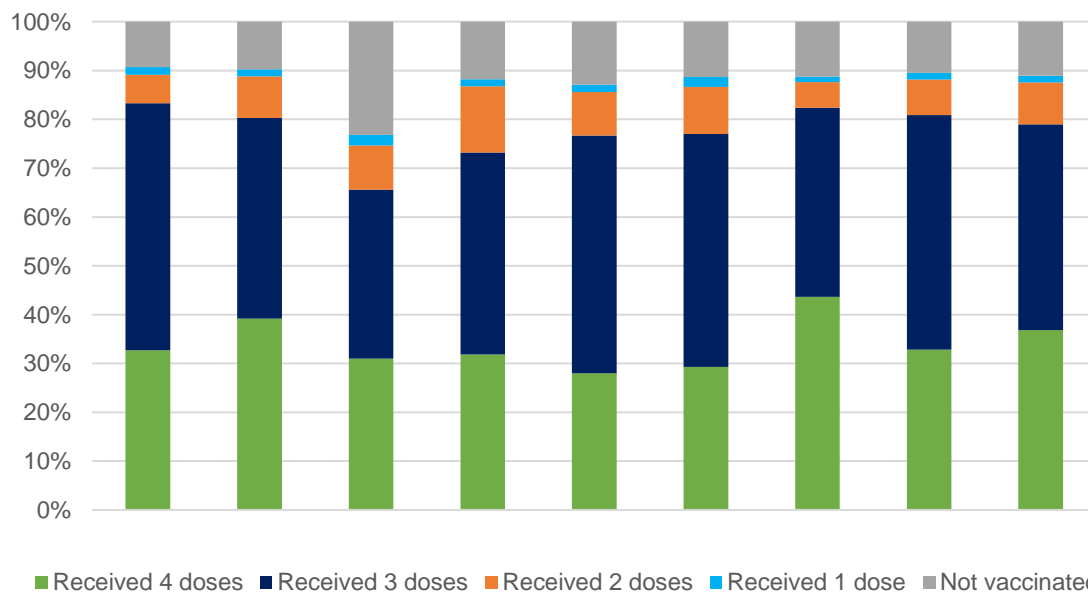
