

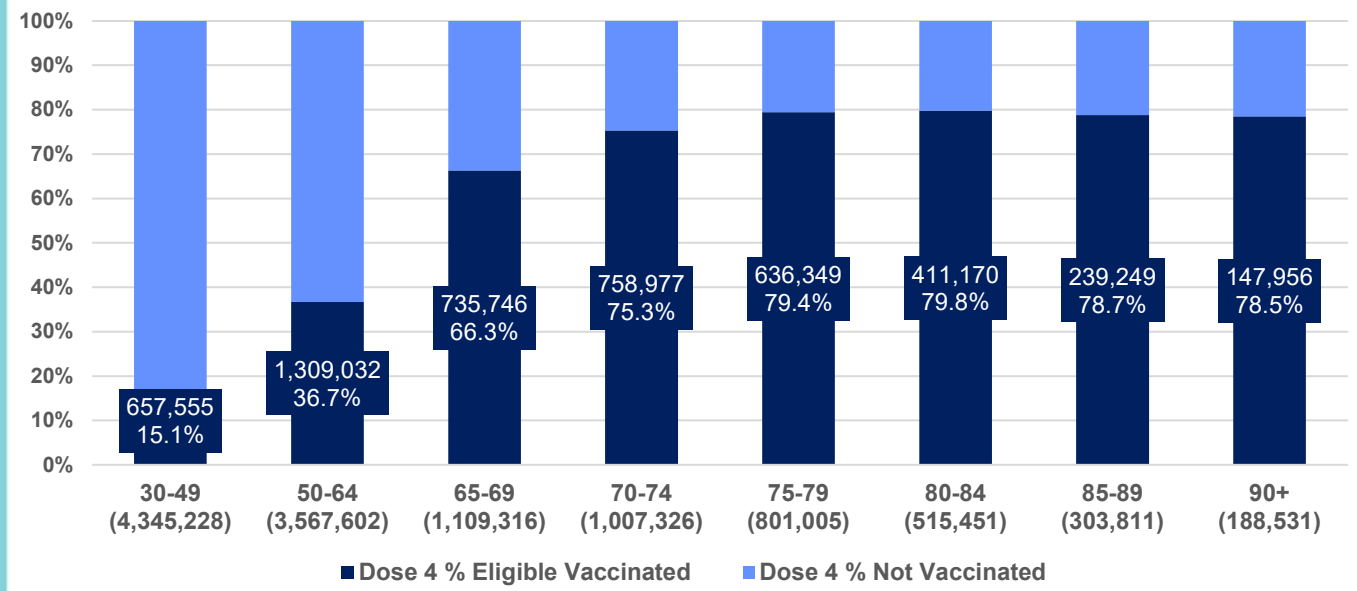

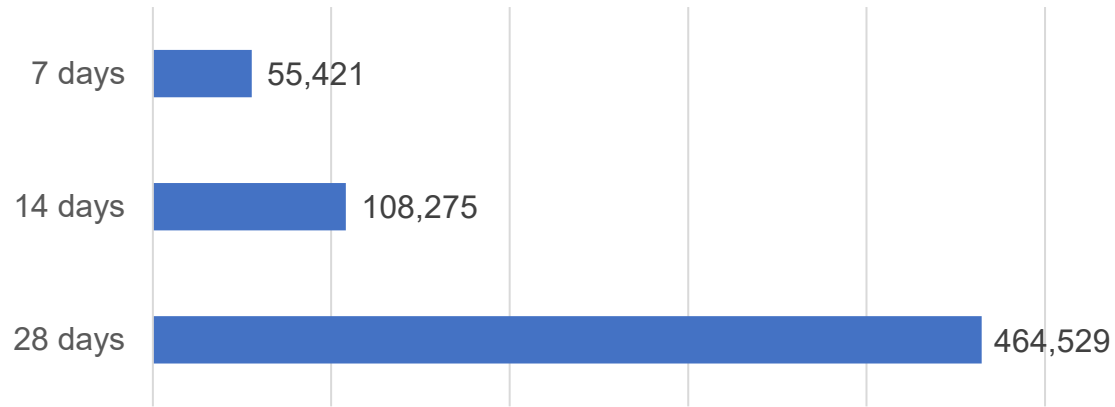

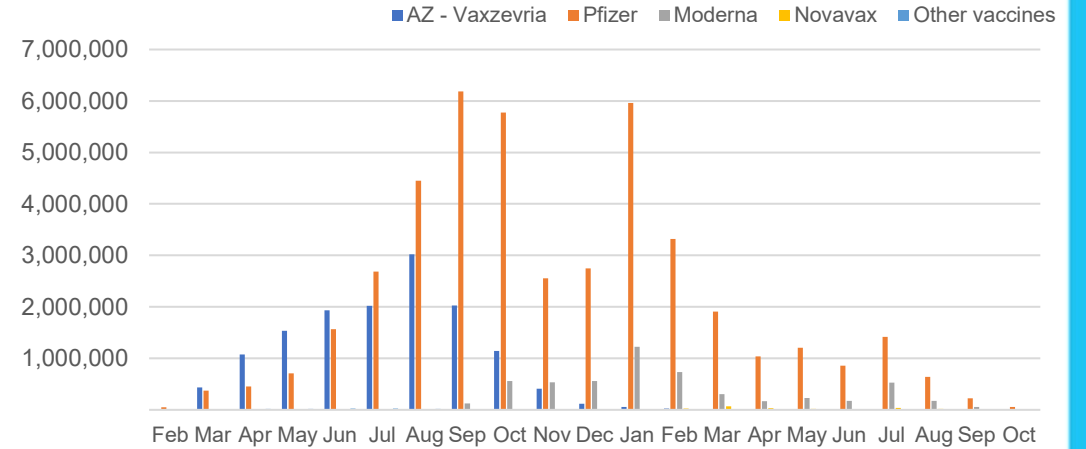

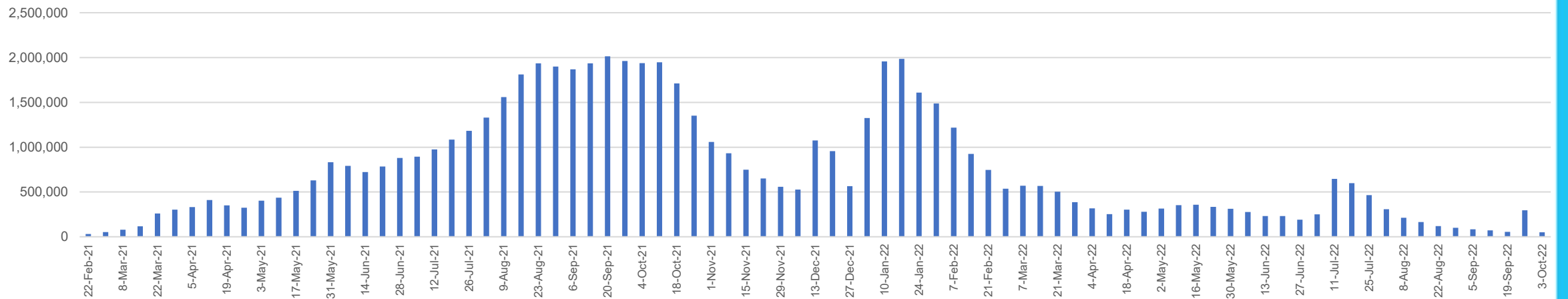
Doses Reported

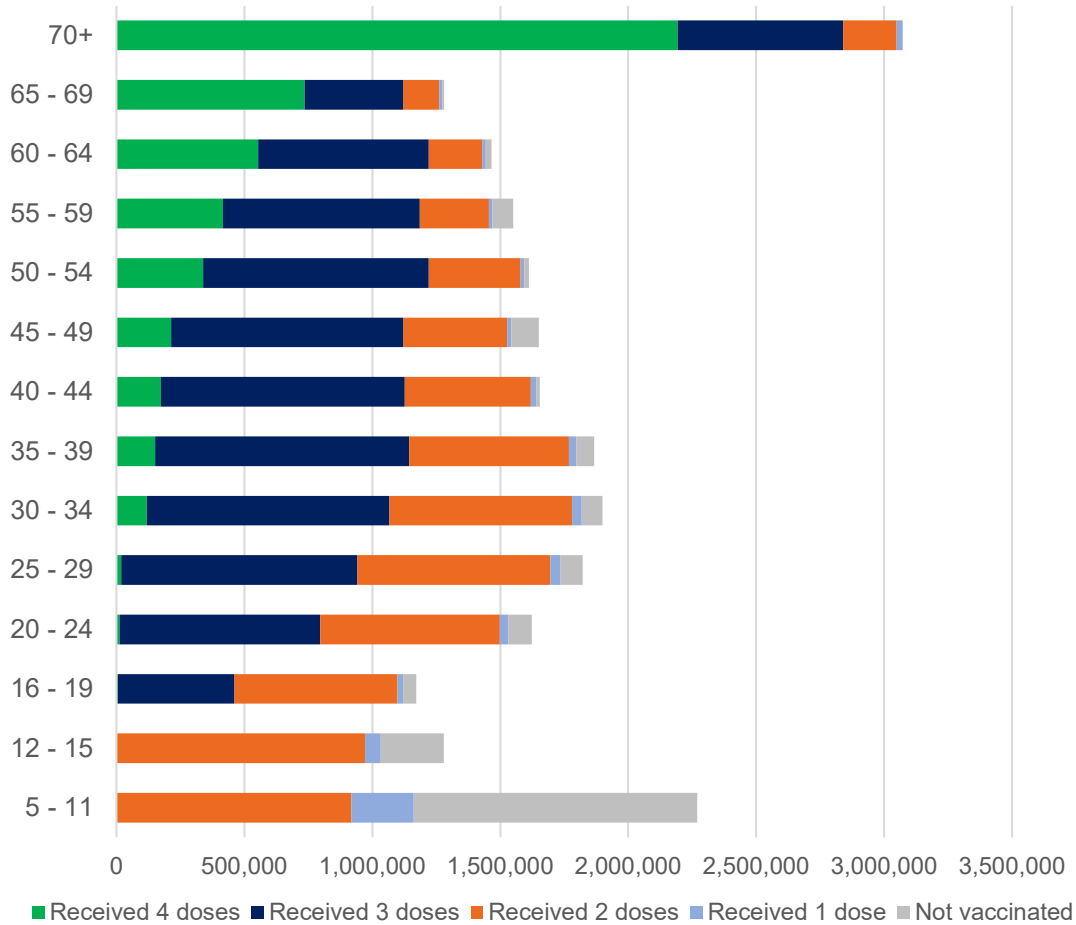

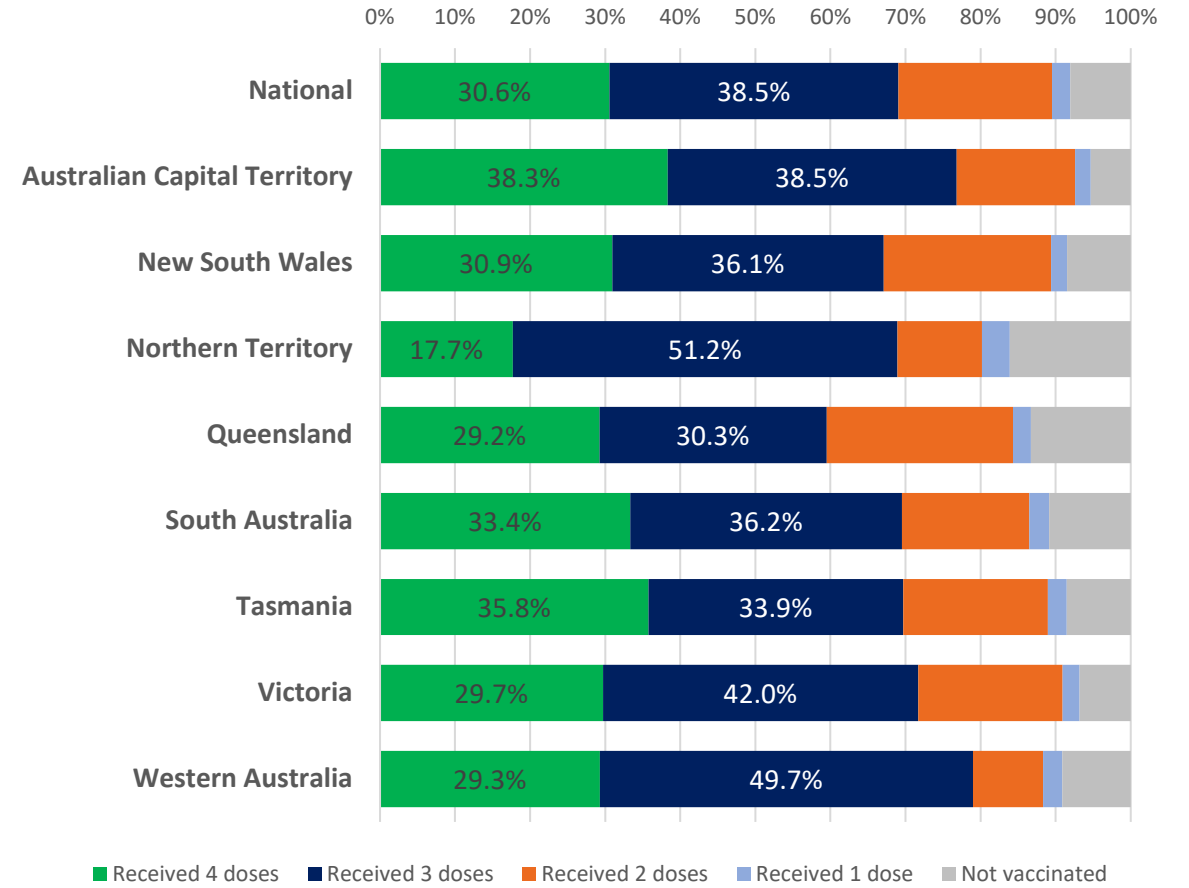
Vaccinations by age and location

Number of people vaccinated by age

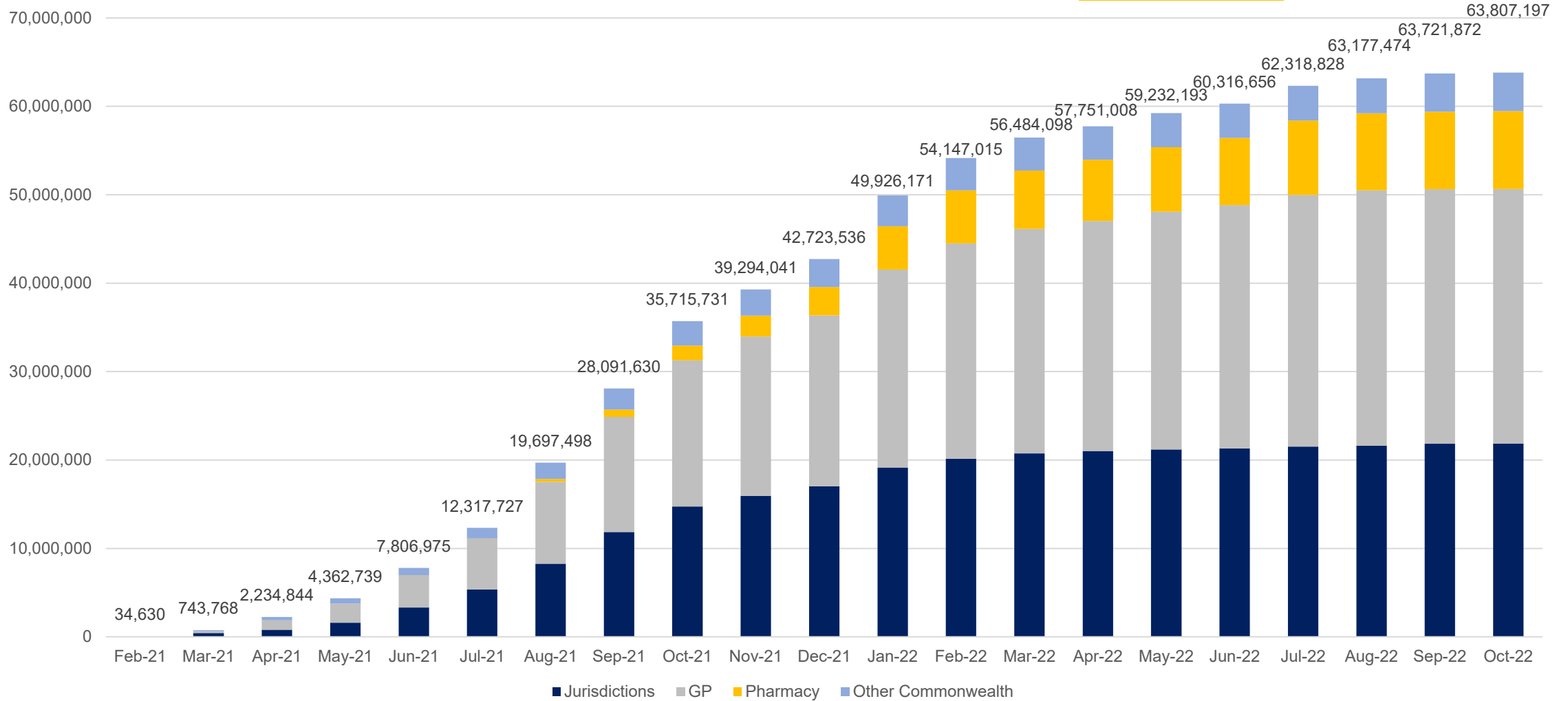


Individuals vaccinated by residential location

Primary care vaccine administration sites

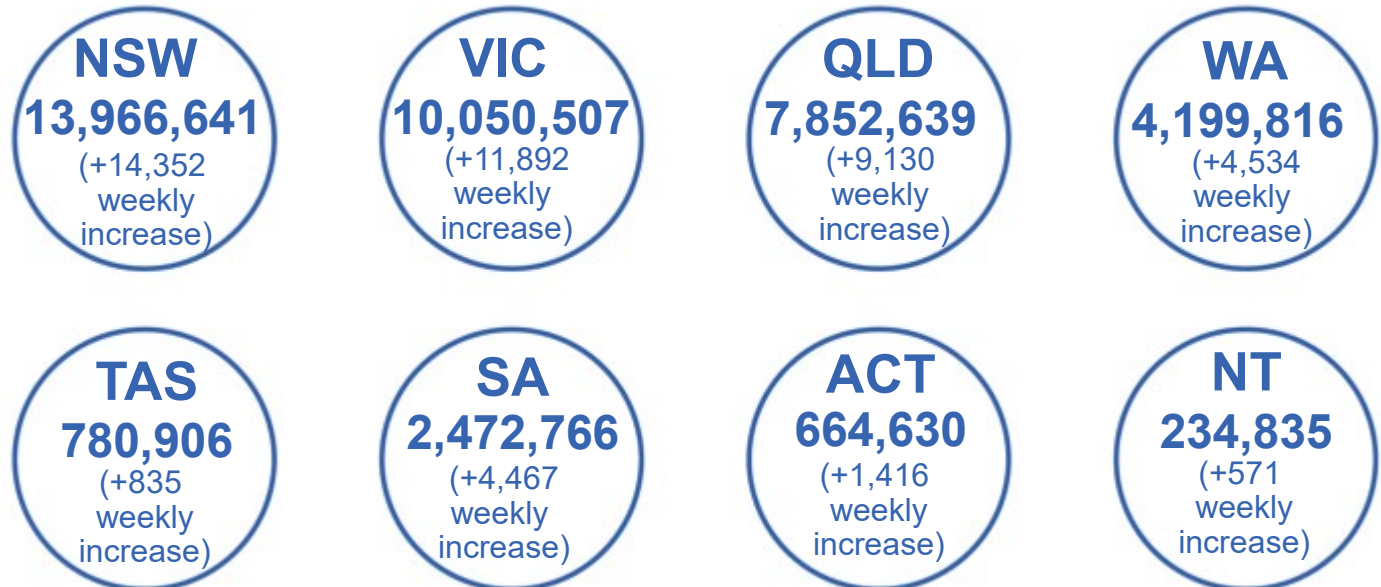

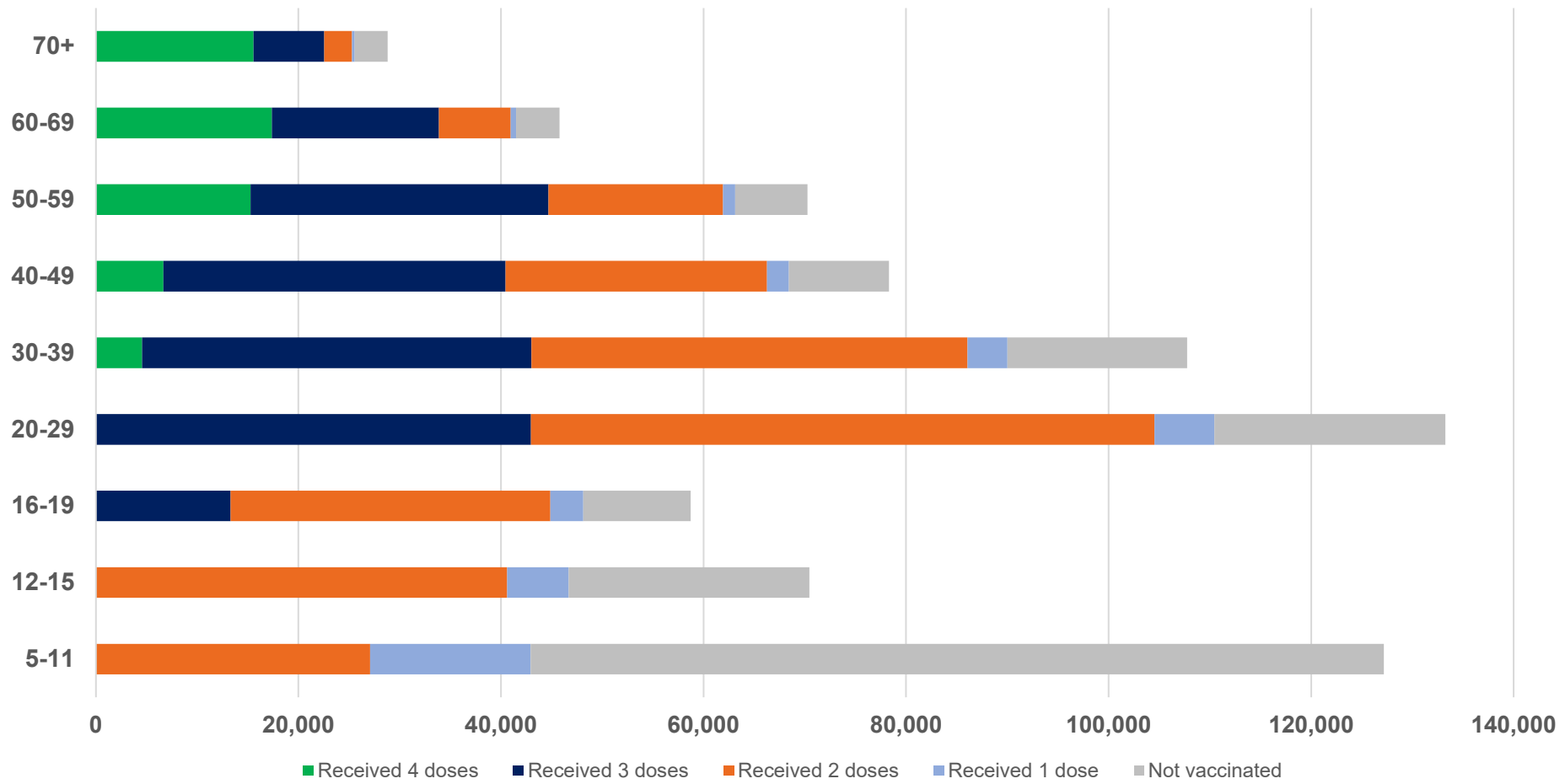

Please note there may be people under 30 who are eligible, but these are not included in coverage rates or population to protect privacy.

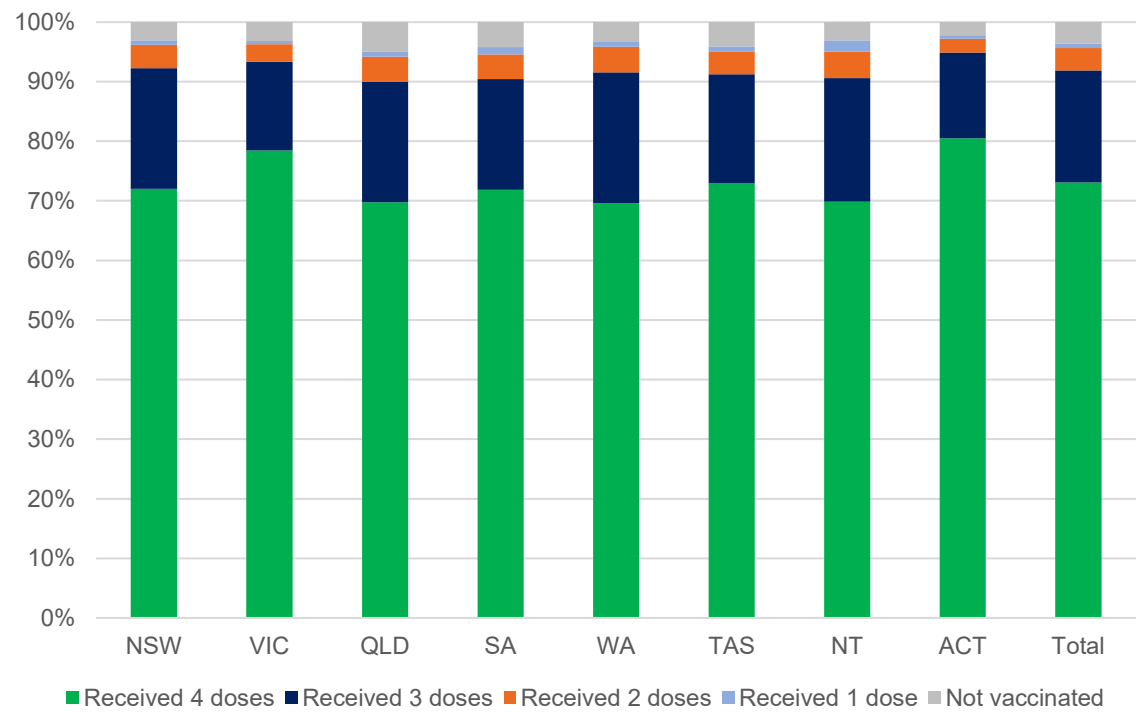

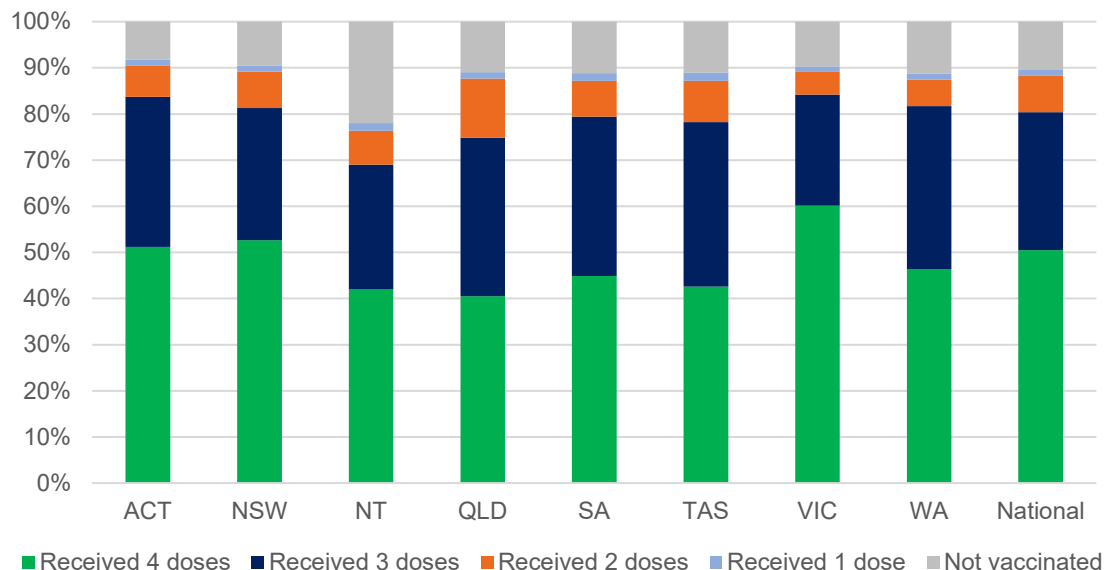

Source: the NDIS Commission has established a requirement for registered NDIS providers who provide intensive disability support services to report on the vaccination status of workers they employ, or otherwise engage, to deliver NDIS-funded supports and services, and who are required to be vaccinated in accordance with in-force state and territory public health orders. The statistics reflect data reported to the NDIS Commission by registered NDIS providers and should be considered indicative and subject to change

Note: Some registered NDIS providers are yet to report on the vaccination status of their workforce. The NDIS Commission is working with those providers around reporting requirements. Remaining workers not included include those exempt from vaccination requirements, workers whose vaccination status is not yet verified by the provider (such as workers on leave) and provider reporting anomalies.
