








Doses Reported





Number of people vaccinated by age




Individuals vaccinated by residential location





Please note there may be people under 30 who are eligible, but these are not included in coverage rates or population to protect privacy.





Note: Some registered NDIS providers are yet to report on the vaccination status of their workforce. The NDIS Commission is working with those providers around reporting requirements.
Remaining workers not included include those exempt from vaccination requirements, workers whose vaccination status is not yet verified by the provider (such as workers on leave) and provider reporting anomalies.
