*Minister Snowdon approved capital funding of \$2 million towards the construction of a new health clinic for Katungal in Narooma, NSW. Funding has been provided to NSW Health who will*

manage the construction project. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$5 million with NSW Health putting in \$2 million and Katungul \$1 million. This project is expected to be completed by June 2012. \*\*\*Start In Confidence - Katungul have not been advised of this decision as the project is contingent on the funding allocation from NSW Health, which will likely not occur until later in September 2010. \*\*\*End In Confidence.
