The \$2m contribution of funding for the Narooma clinic is via a funding agreement with NSW Health. It is conditional upon NSW Health also contributing up to \$2m, and Katungul selling the current Narooma facility and contributing the proceeds of sale to the construction costs of the new facility. If OATSIH no longer funded Katungul for service delivery from the Narooma facility we would need to discuss and negotiate options with NSW Health, the best option being that we redirect the funds to a different joint Commonwealth/State project.

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- The Narooma clinic has an ATSI Purposes Deed over the property, entered into on 9 June 1994. The ATSI Purposes Deed does not have an expiration date, agreed remedies in the event of a breach of the Deed, or any agreement on provisions for the transfer or sub-lease of the asset to another service provider in the event of a breach or insolvency event.
