The independent assessment of Katungul's financial position has been completed. It confirms the view of AFCB.

The review was undertaken by McGrathNicol and while they have made a number of disclaimers, which is to be expected when they were restricted to undertaking a desk top analysis, they have found as follows:

- in the absence of significant futher cash being injected into the organisation, Katungul may be a insolvent, or shortly about to become insolvent;
- [if the Dept released the 2nd quarter payment] it appears from the financial position of Katungul, that receipt of the Department's funding may do little more than pay existing debts leaving their ability to fund the next three months' operations in question;
- in the absence of significant injections of cash, it is unclear as to how Katungu will be able to meet its existing debts and fund ongoing operations.

AFCB are now putting the finishing touches, including reference to McGrathNicols findings, to the audit report, which I hope to receive tonight or early tomorrow morning. Once the report is to hand we can finalise the draft Show Cause letter and get it to Chris Reid for clearance. thefeedo

I suggest we meet tomorrow to discuss next steps.
