



Implementing Sport 2030 – Australian Sports Foundation capital funding

The Government will further support the Australian Sports Foundation to modernise its information and communication technology systems so it can continue to grow private funding for sport in the digital world and help community organisations raise funds for the development of Australian sport. This investment will support new philanthropic initiatives that increase donations to community and charitable sporting causes and help thousands of sports clubs, community groups and athletes raise funds each year.

Why is this important?

By updating, changing and developing its current technology, the Foundation will provide digital support for new charitable activities and, therefore, for the communities, clubs and athletes who rely on private donations. It is important that these organisations continue to find the best and latest ways to raise funds and embed new funding opportunities into their operations. This keeps them viable – and it means they are able to be more flexible in their strategic thinking.

Who will benefit?

This will benefit all Australians who interact with grassroots sports and sporting and community organisations, athletes across Australia, and National Sporting Organisations.

How much will this cost?

This will cost \$1.5 million in 2019–20.
